QUICK HITS

- Iowa made its ninth consecutive postseason appearance (8 NCAA, 1 WNIT), earning an at-large bid to the WNIT last season.
- The Hawkeyes have made a postseason tournament appearance in 15 of head coach Lisa Bluder's 16 seasons at the helm of the program, receiving 12 NCAA Tournament and three WNIT (2003, 2005, 2016) opportunities.
- Bluder is one of 14 Division I head coaches to win 675 career games or more in her career. She has been a head coach for 32 seasons, including 16 at Iowa.
- Iowa returns four of its five starters from last season in senior Ally Disterhoft, junior Chase Coley, and sophomores Tania Davis and Megan Gustafson.
- Iowa's freshmen class of Bre Cera (2016 Journal Sentinel Player of the Year), Kathleen Doyle (Illinois Miss Basketball), Makenzie Meyer (Iowa Miss Basketball), Amanda Ollinger, (Gazette Female Athlete of the Year) and Alexis Sevillian (Finalist for Michigan Miss Basketball) was ranked No. 7 nationally by Blue Star -- the highest ranked recruiting class for head coach Lisa Bluder and her staff.
- Senior Ally Disterhoft was named Preseason All-Big Ten by the coaches and media, the Big Ten Conference announced Oct. 24. She led the Hawkeyes in scoring last season, averaging 17.1 points per game. The guard/forward netted double figures in every game last season and became the highest scoring junior in program history with 565 points.
- Disterhoft ranks seventh on Iowa's all-time career scoring list with 1,669 career points. Former Hawkeye Cindy Haugejorde holds the scoring record with 2,059 points.
- Disterhoft earned Academic All-America of the Year and first team Academic All-America accolades last season. She owned the highest GPA (4.03) of any Academic All-American last season and was the only junior to be named to the first team.
- Bluder owns a 328-190 (.633) overall record and a 160-106 conference mark at Iowa. In her 32 seasons as a head coach, Bluder is 684-332 (.673).

The University of Iowa women's basketball team (5-2) hosts top-ranked Notre Dame in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge on Wednesday. Tipoff is set for 8 p.m. (CT).

SEASON TICKETS

Season tickets are on sale for the 2016-17 Iowa women's basketball season. General public season tickets are \$100. UI faculty/staff can purchase tickets for \$80. Senior tickets are also \$80, while youth season tickets (18 or younger) are \$25. UI students are admitted free to women's basketball games. Fans can purchase tickets by visiting the ticket office in Carver-Hawkeye Arena, calling 1-800-IA-HAWKS, or online at hawkeyesports.com.

IOWA VS. THE ACC

- Iowa is 3-6 in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge after defeating Virginia, 85-73, on the road last year.
- The Hawkeyes are 16-9 all-time against ACC opponents.

SCOUTING NO. 1 NOTRE DAME

- Notre Dame is ranked No. 1 in the week four AP Poll and *USA Today* Coaches Poll. The Hawkeyes will host a top-ranked team in Carver-Hawkeye Arena for the first time since 1999. Iowa hosted No. 1 UConn on Nov. 21, 1999. The Huskies defeated the Hawkeyes, 73-45.
- The Fighting Irish are 6-0 on the season with wins over Central Michigan, Fordham, Green Bay, Washington, UL-Lafayette, and TCU. Notre Dame has topped the 90 point mark in three of its first six games.
- Sophomore guard Arike Ogunbowale leads the team with a 17.7 scoring average. Sophomore guard Marina Mabrey (14.2 ppg) and junior forward Brianna Turner (13.3 ppg) are also averaging double digits. Junior forward Kathryn Westbeld leads the team with 7.5 rebounds per game.
- Notre Dame is shooting .447 from the field and .422 from three point range this season.
- The Fighting Irish are coached by Muffet McGraw. The 30-year head coach owns a 736-223 overall record at Notre Dame.
- Notre Dame leads the all-time series, 2-0.
- The teams last met in the 2013 NCAA Second Round. The Fighting Irish defeated the Hawkeyes, 74-57, in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

DOYLE GETS STARTING NOD

- Kathleen Doyle registered the first two starts of her career at the Cancun Challenge last weekend.
- The freshman averaged 7.5 points, 3.0 assists, and 3.0 rebounds in games against No. 9 UCLA and James Madison.
- Doyle tied her career high with 11 points in Iowa's win over James Madison on Nov. 25. Eight of her 11 points came in the second half.
- The LaGrange Park, Illinois, native is tied for third in the Big Ten Conference, averaging 2.3 steals per game.

GUSTAFSON NAMED TO ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM

- Sophomore Megan Gustafson was named to the 2016 Cancun Challenge All-Tournament Team.
- Gustafson averaged 19.0 points and 7.5 rebounds in games against No. 9 UCLA and James Madison. She shot .720 from the field (18-for-25) in 51 minutes of action.
- The all-tournament honor was the second of the season for Gustafson. She was named to the 2016 Hawkeye Challenge All-Tournament team. Gustafson averaged 17.0 points, 10.5 rebounds, and shot .727 (16-of-22) from the field in contests against Massachusetts and South Dakota State.

AROUND THE NATION

- The Hawkeyes rank seventh in the nation in rebounds with 308 boards in seven games this season.
- Iowa also ranks ninth in the nation in assists (130), 20th in defensive rebounds per game (31) and assists per game (18.6), 22nd in field goal percentage (.477), and 25th in free throws made (97).
- Megan Gustafson ranks fifth in the NCAA in field goal percentage (.688) and field goals made (53). She also ranks 21st in double-doubles (3) and 26th in points (123).
- Senior Ally Disterhoft ranks 14th nationally in free throw attempts (46), 18th in field goal percentage (.613), 20th in points (127), 23rd in field goals made (46), and 31st in free throws made (30).

AROUND THE LEAGUE

- Iowa ranks second in the conference in defensive rebounds (31.4), third in scoring margin (+15.6), field goal percentage (.477), and field goal percentage defense (.228), and fourth in offensive rebounds (44.0), assists (18.6), and steals (8.3).
- Sophomore Megan Gustafson leads the league with a .688 field goal percentage and a .895 three throw percentage. She also ranks fifth in rebounding (9.3) and defensive rebounds (6.3) and eighth in offensive rebounds (3.0).
- Senior Ally Disterhoft is averaging 18.1 points per game, the seventh-highest average in the Big Ten. Sophomore Megan Gustafson's 17.6 points per game ranks ninth.
- Freshman Kathleen Doyle is tied for third in the conference with 2.3 steals per game.
- Three Hawkeyes rank within the top-15 in field goal percentage. They include: Megan Gustafson (.688), Ally Disterhoft (.613), and Hannah Stewart (.540).

HISTORICALLY GOOD DEFENSE

- The Hawkeyes held Massachusetts to just 30 points in the first game of the Hawkeye Challenge on Nov. 19, tying a Carver-Hawkeye Arena record for fewest points allowed. It also marked the fewest points allowed in the Big Ten this season.
- Iowa held the Minutewomen to just 10 first half points, breaking a program record for fewest points allowed in a first half.

HAWKEYE CHALLENGE ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM

- Sophomore Megan Gustafson and senior Ally Disterhoft were one of five players named to the 2016 Hawkeye Challenge All-Tournament Team, as voted on by media.
- Gustafson averaged 17.0 points, 10.5 rebounds, and shot .727 (16-of-22) from the field in two contests.
- Disterhoft averaged 13.0 points, 8.0 rebounds, 3.0 assists, and 3.0 steals per game.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE MACHINE

- Sophomore Megan Gustafson registered the 12th double-double of her career against South Dakota State on Nov. 20. It was her third double-double of the season.
- Megan Gustafson ranks fifth in the NCAA in field goal percentage (.688) and field goals made (53). She also ranks 21st in double-doubles (3) and 26th in points (123).
- The Port Wing, Wisconsin, native tied a career high in points (25) in Iowa's season opener against Oral Roberts on Nov. 11. She followed that up with 14 points and 11 boards against Hampton on Nov. 13. She added her third double-double of the season against South Dakota State with 21 points and 13 rebounds.

MOVIN' ON UP

Senior Ally Disterhoft now ranks seventh on Iowa's all-time career scoring list. Disterhoft has 1,669 career points and is 390 points from tying Iowa's all-time scoring record of 2,059 set by Cindy Haugejorde (1976-80). Disterhoft also ranks 11th all-time in 3-point field goals (121), 13th in career blocks (57), and 14th in rebounds (655).

Head Coach Lisa Bluder

Lisa Bluder (pronounced BLUE-dir), the all-time winningest coach in program history, completed her 16th season as head coach at the University of Iowa and her 32nd season as a college head coach in 2015-16.

Under her direction, the Hawkeyes have advanced to 15 postseason appearances (12 NCAA and three WNIT) in 16 seasons, including NCAA Tournament berths in eight of the last nine seasons.

Bluder, the 2015 Carol Eckman Award winner, has posted a 328-190 (.633) record at Iowa and her career record stands at 684-332 (.673). Bluder surpassed Hall of Famer C. Vivian Stringer (269 wins) as the all-time winningest coach in program history on Feb. 10, 2014, as the Hawkeyes defeated Northwestern, 90-84.

Bluder, 1-of-14 active Division I coaches with 675 or more wins, is a three-time Big Ten Coach of the Year (2001, 2008 and 2010) and two-time WBCA Regional Coach of the Year (2001 and 2008). She has guided Iowa to a winning record in 15 of her 16 years at Iowa, including 11 upper-division finishes in the challenging Big Ten Conference. Bluder, who ranks third among Big Ten coaches all-time in league victories (160), has led Iowa to nine 20-win seasons in her 16 years, including seven of the last nine years.

Bluder has coached numerous players to different awards in her 16 years in Iowa City. She has mentored 19 players to 47 All-Big Ten honors, including 12 first team picks, 16 second, 11 third and eight honorable mention selections. She has also had two Big Ten Freshman of the Year award winners, two Big Ten Sixth Player of the Year recipients, eight members of the Big Ten All-Freshman team and three players named to the Big Ten All-Defensive team, with Kachine Alexander earning the honor twice.

Five players during Bluder's tenure have earned a total of seven Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) all-region team accolades and six players have earned a total of 11 honorable mention All-American honors. Bluder coached her first consensus All-American in Samantha Logic, who earned the honor after being named a WBCA Division I Coaches All-American, USBWA All-American, ESPN Second Team All-American, and Third Team Associated Press All-American.

With Bluder on the Iowa sidelines, student-athletes have been named Academic All-Big Ten 75 times, including a program-best eight honorees in 2011 and 2012. The 75 honorees is the highest total mentored by any of the Big Ten coaches. Bluder has also mentored three Academic All-Americans in Ally Disterhoft (2015, 2016), Logic (2015), and Lindsey Meder (2001, 2002). Disterhoft was also named Academic All-America of the Year in 2015.

In her 10 years at Drake, Bluder brought great success and tradition to the Bulldog program and established herself as one of the top coaches in the country. She led Drake to five 20-plus win seasons in her last six years, including five postseason appearances. She guided the Bulldogs to eight Missouri Valley Conference Tournament appearances, reaching the semifinals six times and winning the tournament four times. Bluder was also named the Conference Coach of the Year three times at Drake.

Bluder began her coaching career at St. Ambrose, where she coached six successful seasons, building the Bees into a NAIA powerhouse. During her tenure at St. Ambrose, Bluder guided the Bees to four straight national tournaments, including two consecutive Final Four appearances. The 1990 St. Ambrose team was ranked No. 1 and Bluder was named the NAIA Converse Coach of the Year.

A graduate of Linn-Mar High School in Marion, Iowa, Bluder was a three-year starter at Northern Iowa. She graduated from UNI in 1983 with a bachelor's degree in marketing.

- The week three *USA Today* Coaches Poll will be released on Tuesday (11/29) afternoon.

STEWART STEPS UP

- Sophomore Hannah Stewart registered a career-high 11 points in Iowa's win over James Madison on Nov. 25. She's scored 10 points three times this season (Hampton, UMass, and UCLA).
- The Minot, North Dakota, native is registering 8.0 points through seven games this season.
- After scoring just five points in 12 contests last season, Stewart has netted 56 points in seven games this year.

CALL ON ME

- Senior Ally Disterhoft has netted double figures 85 of her 91 career starts.
- The Iowa City, Iowa, native has started 91 consecutive games and appeared in every game of her Hawkeye career (110).
- Disterhoft led the team with a career-high 29 points in Iowa's season opener against Oral Roberts on Nov. 11. She also registered seven boards, two blocks, an assist and a steal in 27 minutes of play.
- Disterhoft has 1,669 career points and is 390 points from tying Iowa's all-time scoring record of 2,059 set by Cindy Haugejorde (1976-80).
- Disterhoft has registered 20 or more points in three of seven games this season.
- Last season, Disterhoft became the program's highest scoring junior, netting 565 points to break Michelle Edwards' record of 564 points in 1986-87.

GUSTAFSON NAMED BIG PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- Center/forward Megan Gustafson was named Big Ten Player of the Week, the conference office announced Nov. 14. It is the second weekly honor of Gustafson's career
- The Port Wing, Wisconsin, native posted back-to-back double-doubles to lead Iowa to wins overall Oral Roberts and Hampton on Nov. 11 and 13. The sophomore tied a career high in points (25) and recorded 12 rebounds, an assist and a block in 26 minutes of action against Oral Roberts on Nov. 11. Two days later, Gustafson netted 14 points and pulled down 11 boards to lead the Hawkeyes past Hampton. She also went a combined 7-for-8 from the free throw line.
- Gustafson earned Big Ten Freshman of the Week honors on Feb. 22, 2016. She is the first Hawkeye to win Big Ten Player of the Week since Samantha Logic won the award on March 2, 2015.

CARVER-HAWKEYE ARENA ENHANCEMENTS

The Iowa Athletic Department upgraded Carver-Hawkeye Arena's video boards, sound system, lighting, digital scoretable displays, and playing surface this past summer.

A new four-sided centerhung video system is the centerpiece of the installation. The two main centerhung displays measure approximately 14.5 feet high by 26 feet wide and the other two centerhung displays measure 9.5 feet high by 16.5 feet wide. The project also upgraded the auxiliary displays located near the ceiling at each side of the arena.

DISTERHOFT EARNS PRESEASON HONOR

Senior Ally Disterhoft was named Preseason All-Big Ten by the coaches and media, the Big Ten Conference announced Oct. 24. The Iowa City, Iowa, native was a second team All-Big Ten selection in 2015 and 2016 and an honorable mention All-Big Ten honoree in 2014. She was also named to the Big Ten All-Freshman Team and Big Ten All-Tournament team in 2014.

RETURNING EXPERIENCE

- Iowa returns four of its five starters from last season in senior Ally Disterhoft, junior Chase Coley, and sophomores Tania Davis and Megan Gustafson.
- Senior Ally Disterhoft garnered second team All-Big Ten accolades by coaches and media for the second consecutive season and received Iowa's Sportsmanship Award. The preseason All-Big Ten pick by coaches and media scored in double figures in every game last season and in 78 of her 84 consecutive starts.
- Tania Davis and Megan Gustafson were named to the 2016 Big Ten All-Freshman Team.
- Davis was one of two Big Ten freshmen to lead her team in assists per game (3.4) and average at least one steal per game (1.2) last season. She has dished out 111 assists in 33 games played, the second-highest total recorded by a freshman at Iowa (Samantha Logic; 136).
- Gustafson was the only freshman and one of three players in the conference overall to lead her team in field goal percentage (.554), rebounds (225), and blocks (58) last season.
- Chase Coley averaged 11.1 points per game last season -- the second highest mark on the team. The junior compiled 365 points, 194 rebounds, 53 assists, 37 blocks, and 24 steals in her sophomore campaign to receive Iowa's Most Improved Award.

QUALITY YOUTH

- Iowa's freshman class was ranked No. 7 nationally by Blue Star -- the highest ranked recruiting class for head coach Lisa Bluder and her staff.
- Iowa's freshmen class consists of Bre Cera (2016 Journal Sentinel Player of the Year), Kathleen Doyle (Illinois Miss Basketball), Makenzie Meyer (Iowa Miss Basketball), Amanda Ollinger (2016 Gazette Female Athlete of the Year), and Alexis Sevellian (finalist for Michigan Miss Basketball).
- Cera has started all seven games this season, while Meyer has started five and Doyle has started the last two.



HAWKEYES CONTINUE POSTSEASON STREAK

- Iowa made its ninth straight postseason appearance (8 NCAA, 1 WNIT) with an at-large bid to the WNIT in 2016.
- Iowa was one of six Big Ten Conference teams (Minnesota, Michigan, Nebraska, Northwestern, Rutgers) and one of three teams from Iowa (Drake, UNI) to be included in the WNIT field of 64.

HOUSTON SIGNS WITH IOWA WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

Jinaya Houston has inked a National Letter of Intent to play basketball at the University of Iowa, UI head coach Lisa Bluder announced Nov. 9.

Houston, a 6-1 guard from Davenport, Iowa, attends Davenport North High School where she is coached by Rob O'Brien. Houston is a three-time all-state, all-metro, and all-conference honoree and a two-time all-district selection.

As a junior, Houston guided her high school team to a 20-3 overall record and its first state tournament appearance in school history. The second-year team captain averaged 19.4 points, 8.4 rebounds, 2.7 assists, 1.5 steals, and 1.6 blocks per game her junior campaign.

The 2015-16 Mississippi Athletic Conference Player of the Year was named first team all-state by the Iowa Newspaper Association and second team all-state by the Iowa Coaches Association. She earned all-metro co-captain, all-district, Chicago Showcase Player of the Game, Des Moines Register Elite 8 accolades, and was a finalist for the Quad City Times Female Athlete of the Year.

As a sophomore, Houston averaged 21.4 points, 6.1 rebounds, 2.2 assists, two steals, and one block per game to help her team to a 17-5 overall record in its first year as a 5A institution. The first-year team captain collected first team all-conference and all-metro accolades following the season. She was also a second team all-state honoree (Iowa Newspaper Association) and a second team Sports Spotlight selection in the state of Iowa.

Houston was named third team all-state by the Iowa Newspaper Association, second team all-metro, and first team all-conference as a freshman. She averaged 17.8 points, 7.6 rebounds, one assist, two steals, and one block per game her freshman campaign.

THE BLUDER FILE

- Head coach Lisa Bluder begins her 17th season at the helm of the Iowa women's basketball program this season. She owns a 328-190 (.633) overall record and a 160-106 Big Ten record at Iowa. In her 32 seasons as a head coach, Bluder is 684-332 (.673).
- Bluder is one of 14 active Division I coaches to collect 675 or more career wins.
- The head Hawkeye is second in career Big Ten wins (160) and in total wins among Big Ten coaches. She trails only C. Vivian Stringer who has compiled 189 Big Ten wins and 971 career wins.
- Bluder ranks third all-time among all Big Ten coaches with 160 conference victories.

ACADEMIC PROWESS

- Ally Disterhoft was named Academic All-America of the Year for Division I women's basketball and a CoSIDA first team Academic All-American last season. Disterhoft became the only junior to earn first team Academic All-America recognition and owned the top GPA (4.03) of all Academic All-Americans this year.
- Christina Bутtenham, Ally Disterhoft, Alexa Kastanek, and Hailey Schneden, earned Academic All-Big Ten recognition following the 2015-16 season. To be eligible for Academic All-Big Ten, student-athletes must be letterwinners and be in at least their second academic year at the institution. They must also carry a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or better.
- In 2014-15, Iowa was the only program to have two Academic All-Americans in Disterhoft and Samantha Logic. There were 15 total honorees.
