Serve It Up

- The University of Iowa volleyball team opens its season at the NIU Invitational for the second year in a row. Iowa went 2-1 in last year's tournament, defeating South Dakota State (3-0) and Pacific (3-2), and falling to NIU (3-1).
- Iowa returns 11 letterwinners and five starters from last season.
- The Hawkeyes welcomed five newcomers this offseason, including transfers Kasey Reuter (Missouri) and Meghan Buzzerio (Arizona), and freshmen Alexa Ito, Cali Hoye, and Emily Bushman.
- Eleven of Iowa's 2016 opponents are ranked or receiving votes in the American Volleyball Coaches Association Poll, including four teams ranked within the top 10 (No. 1 Nebraska, No. 3 Minnesota, No. 4 Wisconsin, No. 9 Penn State).
- Iowa has sold more tickets in 2016 than it has in each of its previous seasons dating back to 2010.
- The Hawkeyes were picked to finish 12th out of 14 teams in the Big Ten preseason poll released on Aug. 23.
- From May 24-June 6 the Hawkeyes traveled to Germany, the Netherlands, Poland, and Ireland as part of the program's first European Tour. The Hawkeyes squared off against professional and junior national teams to improve their game and bond as a unit.
- Nine Big Ten teams appeared in the 2015 NCAA Tournament with Nebraska winning its fourth national title. The title marked the third straight for the Big Ten Conference.

2015 IN REVIEW

The University of Iowa volleyball team ended the 2015 season with a 12-21 overall record and a 2-18 mark in Big Ten play under second-year head coach Bond Shymansky.

SCOUTING LOYOLA (CHICAGO)

- Loyola finished 2015 with a 20-12 overall record -- the team's first 20-win season since 2004.
- The Ramblers went 9-9 in Missouri Valley Conference action -- the most conference wins since 2004.
- Senior Morgan Reardon led the Ramblers in kills last season with 3.18 kills per set.
- Iowa owns a 4-2 advantage in the all-time series. The teams last met on Sept. 10, 2011 at the Iowa Invitational. The Hawkeyes won, 3-0 (25-19, 25-20, 25-17).

SCOUTING DEPAUL

- DePaul went 16-16 overall and 4-14 in Big East Conference action in 2015.
- Sophomore Brittany Maxwell led the team with 326 kills last season (2.69 k/s).
- The Hawkeyes own a 5-2 advantage in the all-time series. The teams last met at the Hawkeye-Holiday Inn Challenge on Sept. 20, 2008. Iowa won, 3-0 (25-13, 25-20, 25-19).

SCOUTING NORTHERN ILLINOIS

- The Huskies compiled a 19-11 overall record and a 14-2 mark in Mid-American Conference action.
- Northern Illinois won the Mid-American Conference Regular Season Championship in 2015 and advanced to the MAC Tournament Final.
- The Huskies return four starters from 2015 -- Malia Gabel, Meg Wolowicz, Jenna Radtke, and Lauren Zielinski - as well as libero Anna Brereton.
- Iowa owns a 6-5 advantage in the all-time series. The Hawkeyes fell to the Huskies in NIU Invite action last season. Northern Illinois defeated the Hawkeyes, 3-1 (25-27, 17-25, 25-21, 28-30).

ALL-TOURNAMENT HONORS

Lauren Brobst and Jess Janota each earned all-tournament team honors following the 2015 NIU Invitational (Aug. 29-30). Brobst recorded 51 kills throughout the two-day tournament, including a season-high 21 against Northern Illinois on Aug. 30. Janota finished the tournament with 31 kills. She paced the team with 17 kills against Pacific on Aug. 29.

THE PREMIER CONFERENCE

The Big Ten Conference has had an NCAA Champion in eight of the last 12 years. Nine teams -- Michigan State, Ohio State, Nebraska, Minnesota, Illinois, Penn State, Wisconsin, Michigan and Purdue -- appeared in the 2015 NCAA Tournament with Nebraska winning their fourth national title. The title marked the third straight for the Big Ten Conference.

Bond Shymansky – a University of Iowa graduate and Iowa City native – has renewed excitement surrounding the Hawkeye volleyball program in his first two years at the helm.

In 2015, Shymansky led the Hawkeyes to their best overall start since 2006 with a 10-3 mark in nonconference action. Iowa won eight straight matches from Sept. 6-19 – the longest streak for the program since 2006 – and defeated the Cyclones, 3-1, for the first time since Sept. 13, 1997. The Hawkeyes won eight matches in Carver-Hawkeye Arena, marking the most home wins for the program since 2000, and started the season with a perfect 7-0 mark on Mediacom Court – the best start at home for the Hawkeyes since 1993.

The Hawkeyes saw a significant increase in attendance in Shymansky's second year, setting two top-10 attendance marks in 2015. The Hawkeyes downed the Cyclones in front of the fifth-largest crowd in program history (2,488) on Sept. 11, before hosting the nationally ranked Huskers on Sept. 23 in front of 2,447 fans – the sixth-largest crowd in Iowa volleyball history.

Mikaela Gunderson and junior Loxley Keala etched their names into the Iowa record book in 2015. Gunderson ended her career with a .294 attack percentage – 16 points higher than the previous school record of .278 (Alessandra Dietz, 2014). Keala tallied 1,247 assists in her first year as a Hawkeye, moving her into eighth on Iowa's all-time assists list. She also earned the first Big Ten Setter of the Week honor of her career for her play at the Comfort Suites Challenge on Sept. 11-12. Keala became the first Hawkeye to earn a Big Ten weekly award since Bethany Yeager in 2013, and the first to win a weekly setter award.

The Hawkeyes also succeeded in the classroom in Shymansky's second year. Following the regular season, five Hawkeyes – Mikaela Gunderson, Jess Janota, Alyssa Klostermann, Alli O'Deen, and Erin Radke – received Academic All-Big Ten recognition for maintaining a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.

In his 13th season overall as a head coach, Shymansky guided the Hawkeyes to a 14-17 overall record and a 6-14 mark in Big Ten Conference action. He has amassed a 316-147 record and .683 win percentage over 14 seasons, earning his 300th win milestone on Oct. 31, 2014, with a 3-0 sweep of Maryland on the road.

The program's six conference victories in 2014 were the most for the program since 2008. Four of the Big Ten wins came consecutively, as the Hawkeyes defeated Maryland (3-0), Rutgers (3-1), Indiana (3-2) and No. 12-ranked Purdue (3-1). It is the longest conference win streak for the program in 20 years, dating back to 1994 when Iowa won eight straight matches and went on to clinch a berth to the NCAA Tournament. The team's win over the Boilermakers marked the team's first ranked win since 2012.

Alessandra Dietz and Alex Lovell wrote their names in the Iowa volleyball record book in the final season of their careers under Shymansky. Dietz broke Jen Barcus' eight-year-old career attack percentage record (.276), finishing her career with a .278 attack percentage. She also broke the program's five-year-old single match attack percentage record, hitting .882 with 15 kills in Iowa's 3-0 win at South Dakota State, and ended her career ranked 11th all-time with 274 career blocks. Lovell closed her career ninth all-time with 1,279 kills, and earned the team's Big Ten Sportsmanship Award.

Seven student-athletes – Julianne Blomberg, Dietz, Alyssa Klostermann, Erin Leppek, Lovell, Alli O'Deen, and Emily Yanny – were named to the 2014 Big Ten Fall Academic All-Conference Team.

University of Iowa Director of Athletics Gary Barta announced Shymansky as the volleyball program's ninth head coach on January 31, 2014.

Shymansky's 14-year resume as a head coach boasted 24 all-conference honorees, three conference players of the year, two conference freshmen of the year, 17 AVCA All-Americans, two AVCA Region Freshman of the Year selections, and eight professional volleyball players.

Shymansky has a deep understanding of what it means to be a Hawkeye, as he earned a Bachelor of Arts in Communications in 1995 and a Master of Arts in English Education in 1997 from the UI. From 1991-93, Shymansky was a setter and outside hitter on the UI men's volleyball club team.

An Iowa City resident, Shymansky has a daughter, Corrina, and two sons, Nicholas and Bond.

NATIONALLY SPEAKING

Nine Big Ten teams appeared in the AVCA Division I Coaches Top 25 Preseason Poll, released Aug. 10. Defending National Champion Nebraska appeared at No. 1 followed by No. 3 Minnesota, No. 4 Wisconsin, No. 9 Penn State, No. 14 Illinois, No. 15 Ohio State, and No. 20 Purdue. Michigan State (107) and Michigan (83) also received votes in the poll.

EUROPEAN TOUR

From May 24-June 6 the Hawkeyes traveled to four different countries as part of the program's first European Tour. With stops in Germany, the Netherlands, Poland, and Ireland, the Hawkeyes squared off with professional and junior national teams to improve their game and bond as a unit.

NEW FACES

- The 2015 roster features five newcomers, including two with collegiate experience.
- Redshirt sophomore Kasey Reuter (OH) transferred from Missouri and joined the Hawkeyes last spring. The Sioux City, Iowa, native appeared in 31 matches with 12 starts as an outside hitter for the Tigers in 2014 before redshirting in 2015.
- Redshirt freshman Meghan Buzzerio (OH/RS) transferred from Arizona to join the Hawkeyes this fall. The Chino Hills, California, native went to Arizona ranked 96th nationally on PrepVolleyball.com's Senior Aces list.
- The Hawkeyes also welcome three incoming freshman including defensive specialists Alexa Ito and Emily Bushman and outside hitter Cali Hoye.

BIG PRESEASON POLL

The Hawkeyes were picked to finish 12th out of 14 teams in the Big Ten Preseason Poll released Aug. 23. Defending national champion Nebraska was at the top of the poll followed by Minnesota, Wisconsin, Penn State, Illinois, Ohio State, Michigan State, Michigan, Purdue, Northwestern, Maryland, Iowa, Indiana, and Rutgers.

ATTENDANCE RECORDS/SEASON TICKET SALES

- Iowa set two top-10 attendance marks in 2015. The Hawkeyes downed the Cyclones in front of the fifth-largest crowd in program history (2,488) on Sept. 11, before hosting the nationally ranked Huskers on Sept. 23 in front of 2,447 fans -- the sixth-largest crowd in program history.
- Iowa has sold more tickets in 2016 than it has in each of its previous seasons dating back to 2010.

2015 NONCONFERENCE SUCCESS

The Hawkeyes compiled a 10-3 record in nonconference action last season, marking the best overall start for the program since going 11-1 in 2006. Two of Iowa's three losses were against ranked opponents (No. 17 Hawaii and No. 25 UCLA). The nonconference season included wins over South Dakota State, Pacific, American, Milwaukee, Iowa State, No. 25 Texas A&M, Gardner Webb, Coastal Carolina (2x), and Drake.

OLSEN COLLECTS NO. 500

Annika Olsen recorded her 500th dig of the 2015 season against Northwestern on Nov. 21. The junior led the Big Ten in total digs (546) and digs per set (4.75) last season. Olsen is the sixth Hawkeye to surpass 500 digs in a single season. The Johns Creek, Georgia, native registered 20 or more digs 11 times last season, including a career-high 26 in Iowa's win over Rutgers on Oct. 31.

KEALA MAKES HISTORY

Loxley Keala recorded her 1,000th assist against Purdue on Nov. 7, 2015. The junior's 1,247 assists rank eighth on Iowa's all-time career assists list and ninth all-time in assists in a single season. Janet Moylan (1987-90) holds the school record with 5,471 career assists. Keala started every match and every set as Iowa's setter in 2015. The Kaneohe, Hawaii, native registered 50 or more assists seven times last season, including a career-high 64 against Michigan on Oct. 7.

STAFF UPDATES

- Bre Payton was elevated from director of operations to interim assistant volleyball coach in March. Payton played collegiate volleyball at Northern Iowa. The four-year starting setter earned first team all-conference honors and conference player of the year recognition in three consecutive seasons (2009-11). She is a two-time second team All-American (2010-11) and an honorable mention All-American (2009).
- Iowa City, Iowa, native Emily Sparks joined the volleyball staff in March as the director of volleyball operations. Sparks previously worked as a staff member in the Iowa Athletic Department, spending time in Academic Services, sports operations, and event management. Sparks played collegiate volleyball at Upper Iowa University from 2009-13.
- Peter Gustin joined the staff this summer as a volunteer assistant coach. The Frankfort, Illinois, native led Solon High School to a class 3A State Championship in 2014 and was named the Class 3A Coach of the Year. Gustin began coaching at Adrenaline Volleyball Academy in 2014.

IOWA TIES

Head coach Bond Shymansky and six student-athletes -- Lauren Brobst, Reghan Coyle, Alexa Ito, Molly Kelly, Alyssa Klostermann, and Kasey Reuter -- were born and raised in the state of Iowa. Shymansky, an Iowa City native, earned his bachelor's and master's degrees from Iowa. He played men's volleyball for the UI club team as a student.
