PROGRAM QUICK HITS

- Iowa has made 10 consecutive postseason appearances (8 NCAA, 2 WNIT).
- The Hawkeyes have made a postseason tournament appearance in 16 of head coach Lisa Bluder's 17 seasons at the helm of the program, receiving 12 NCAA Tournament and four WNIT (2003, 2005, 2016, 2017) opportunities.
- Bluder is one of 10 Division I head coaches to win 700 games or more in her career. She is in her 34th season as a head coach, 18th at Iowa.
- Iowa leads the nation in assists (171) and ranks second in assist/turnover ratio (1.76) and assists per game (24.4).
- Four Hawkeyes are averaging double figures in scoring this season, while seven are averaging eight or more.
- Junior Megan Gustafson was named to the Big Ten Women's Basketball Player of the Week Honor Roll on Monday. It is the ninth honor of Gustafson's career and her third in as many weeks. Gustafson averaged 20.3 points, 12.7 rebounds, 2.0 blocks, and shot 67.4 from the field to lead Iowa to three wins in four days last week.
- Iowa's 7-0 record matches the best start for the program since 2010. Iowa finished the 2010-11 season with a 20-9 overall record and a trip to the NCAA Tournament. A win on Wednesday would give the Hawkeyes their best start since going 13-0 to begin the 2004-05 season.
- Iowa has defeated three teams – Quinnipiac, Western Kentucky, and Elon – that made the NCAA Tournament last season.
- Bluder owns a 350-202 (.634) overall record and a 168-114 conference mark at Iowa. In her 34 seasons as a head coach, Bluder is 706-344 (.672).

- Brooks is in his second year as the play-by-play announcer for the Iowa women's basketball team. He has been Iowa football's sideline announcer since 2004. He has called seven different Iowa sports on radio or television.
- Lang enters her second year as Iowa's color commentator. She lettered at Iowa from 2002-05. Lang finished her Hawkeye career with 1,265 points and 506 rebounds. She was a two-time All-Big Ten selection.

IOWA VS. THE ACC

- Iowa is 3-7 in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge.
- Iowa fell to No. 1 Notre Dame, 73-58, in Carver-Hawkeye Arena last season.
- The Hawkeyes are 16-10 all-time against ACC opponents.
- The ACC owns a 7-0-3 record against the Big Ten in the conference challenge, including a 9-5 win last season.

STARTING STRONG

- Iowa's 7-0 record matches the best start for the program since 2010. Iowa finished the 2010-11 season with a 20-9 overall record and a trip to the NCAA Tournament.

SCOUTING FLORIDA STATE

- No. 13 Florida State is 6-0 on the season. The Seminoles are 3-0 on the road.
- Florida State has wins over North Florida (109-51), Jacksonville State (75-51), Florida (84-54), Grambling State (96-53), Sacred Heart (101-52), and Samford (87-62) this season.
- Senior forward Shakayla Thomas leads the team, averaging 21.0 points per game.
- Senior center Chatrice White leads the team with 9.3 rebounds per game. White spent the first two years of her career at Illinois.
- Florida State leads the nation in rebounding margin (21.7) and scoring margin (38.2),
- The Seminoles advanced to the Elite Eight last season before falling to eventual tournament champion South Carolina, 71-64.
- Florida State leads the all-time series, 1-0. The Seminoles defeated the Hawkeyes 83-69 in Tallahassee, Florida, on Nov. 28, 2012.

GUSTAFSON EARNS 3RD STRAIGHT CONFERENCE HONOR

- Junior Megan Gustafson was named to the Big Ten Women's Basketball Player of the Week Honor Roll on Monday. It is the ninth honor of Gustafson's career and her third in as many weeks.
- Gustafson averaged 20.3 points, 12.7 rebounds, 2.0 blocks, and shot 67.4 from the field to lead Iowa to three wins in four days last week.
- The Port Wing, Wisconsin, native registered a double-double in all three contests, bringing her season total to seven and her career total to 34. She is one of two players nationally to register seven double-doubles this season.

TOTAL TEAM EFFORT

- Four Hawkeyes are averaging double figures in scoring this season, while seven are averaging eight or more.
- Four Hawkeyes average 5.2 or more rebounds per game, including Megan Gustafson (13.4), Chase Coley (5.4), Hannah Stewart (5.4), and Kathleen Doyle (5.2).
- Eight Hawkeyes have registered 10 or more assists on the season.

IOWA SWEEPS PUERTO RICO CLASSIC

- The Hawkeyes registered three wins in four days to finish the Puerto Rico Classic with a perfect 3-0 mark.
- Three Hawkeyes averaged double figures in scoring throughout the tournament, including junior Megan Gustafson (20.3), redshirt freshman Alexis Sevillian (13.0), and sophomore Makenzie Meyer (10.0).
- Gustafson led the team in rebounding, averaging 12.7 per game, while junior Hannah Stewart chipped in 7.0 per contest.
- Iowa shot an impressive 51.1 percent from the field during the three-game span and 34.7 percent from 3-point range. Iowa averaged 80.3 points per game and 24.7 assists per contest.

SHARING IS CARING

- Iowa leads the nation in assists (171) and ranks second in assist/turnover ratio (1.76) and assists per game (24.4).
- The Hawkeyes have registered 23 assists or more in six of its seven contests this season.
- Iowa leads the Big Ten Conference in assists (171), assists per game (24.4), and assist/turnover ratio (1.76).
- Junior Tania Davis leads the team and ranks 24th nationally in assists (38), while sophomore Makenzie Meyer's 37 assists ranks 28th.
- Eight Hawkeyes have registered 10 or more assists on the season, including Davis (38), Meyer (37), sophomore Kathleen Doyle (24), junior Hannah Stewart (19), redshirt freshman Alexis Sevillian (15), sophomore Amanda Ollinger (11), senior Chase Coley (10), and redshirt junior Carly Mohns (10).

HEAD COACH LISA BLUDER

Lisa Bluder (pronounced BLUE-dir), the all-time winningest coach in program history, enters her 18th season as head coach at the University of Iowa and her 34th season as a college head coach in 2017.

Under her direction, the Hawkeyes have advanced to 16 postseason appearances (12 NCAA and four WNIT) in 17 seasons, including NCAA Tournament berths in eight of the last 10 seasons.

Bluder, the 2015 Carol Eckman Award winner, has posted a 350-202 (.634) record at Iowa and her career record stands at 706-344 (.672). Bluder surpassed Hall of Famer C. Vivian Stringer (269 wins) as the all-time winningest coach in program history on Feb. 10, 2014, as the Hawkeyes defeated Northwestern, 90-84.

Bluder, 1-of-10 active Division I coaches with 700 or more wins, is a three-time Big Ten Coach of the Year (2001, 2008 and 2010) and two-time WBCA Regional Coach of the Year (2001 and 2008). She has guided Iowa to a winning record in 16 of her 17 years, including 11 upper-division finishes in the challenging Big Ten Conference. Bluder, who ranks second among Big Ten coaches all-time in league victories (168), has led Iowa to 10 20-win seasons in her 17 years, including eight of the last 10 years.

Bluder has coached numerous players to different awards in her 17 years in Iowa City. She has mentored 20 players to 49 All-Big Ten honors, including 14 first team picks, 16 second, 11 third and eight honorable mention selections. She has also had two Big Ten Freshman of the Year award winners, two Big Ten Sixth Player of the Year recipients, nine members of the Big Ten All-Freshman team, and three players named to the Big Ten All-Defensive team, with Kachine Alexander earning the honor twice.

Five players during Bluder's tenure have earned a total of seven Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) all-region team accolades and six players have earned a total of 11 honorable mention All-America honors. Bluder coached her first consensus All-American in Samantha Logic, who earned the honor after being named a WBCA Division I Coaches All-American, USBWA All-American, ESPN Second Team All-American, and Third Team Associated Press All-American.

With Bluder on the Iowa sidelines, student-athletes have been named Academic All-Big Ten 86 times, including a program-best eight honorees in 2011 and 2012. Bluder has also mentored three Academic All-Americans in Ally Disterhoft (2015, 2016, 2017), Logic (2015), and Lindsey Meder (2001, 2002). Disterhoft was also named Academic All-America of the Year in 2015 and 2016.

In her 10 years at Drake, Bluder brought great success and tradition to the Bulldog program and established herself as one of the top coaches in the country. She led Drake to five 20-plus win seasons in her last six years, including five postseason appearances. She guided the Bulldogs to eight Missouri Valley Conference Tournament appearances, reaching the semifinals six times and winning the tournament four times. Bluder was also named the Conference Coach of the Year three times at Drake.

Bluder began her coaching career at St. Ambrose, where she coached six successful seasons, building the Bees into a NAIA powerhouse. During her tenure at St. Ambrose, Bluder guided the Bees to four straight national tournaments, including two consecutive Final Four appearances. The 1990 St. Ambrose team was ranked No. 1 and Bluder was named the NAIA Converse Coach of the Year.

A graduate of Linn-Mar High School in Marion, Iowa, Bluder was a three-year starter at Northern Iowa. She graduated from UNI in 1983 with a bachelor's degree in marketing.

COLEY'S TURNAROUND

- After scoring in double figures once last season, senior Chase Coley has scored 10 or more points in three contests this season.
- Coley netted 20 points in Iowa's win over Northern Illinois on Nov. 15 – her most points since scoring 20 against Michigan on March 3, 2016.
- The Minneapolis native has scored eight or more points four times this season, and registered four or more rebounds on four occasions.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE MACHINE

- Junior Megan Gustafson has 34 double-doubles in her Hawkeye career, including double-doubles in 12 of her last 15 games.
- Last season, Gustafson broke a program record with 18 double doubles on the season.
- Gustafson is one of two players nationally to register seven double-doubles this season.
- As of Wednesday, Nov. 29, it has been 251 days since Megan Gustafson finished a game without a double-double.

SEVILLIAN STEPS IN

- Redshirt freshman Alexis Sevillian ranks second on the team, averaging 13.6 points per game.
- Sevillian has scored in double figures in six of Iowa's seven contests this season.
- The Goodrich, Michigan, native has netted 3-or-more 3-pointers five times this season.
- Sevillian led the team in scoring with a career-best 21 points on 5-of-6 shooting from 3-point range against Elon on Nov. 25 in Fort Lauderdale, Florida.

LOCKED IN AT THE LINE

- Iowa leads the Big Ten and ranks 12th nationally in free throw percentage (79.2).
- Iowa was a perfect 15-for-15 from the line against Northern Illinois on Nov. 15.
- The Hawkeyes made 17-of-19 (89.5 percent) from the line against Quinnipiac, including 10-of-11 in the fourth quarter.
- Iowa shot 92.0 percent from the line against Western Kentucky. The Hawkeyes were a perfect 8-for-8 in the fourth quarter and overtime period.

STEWART MAKES AN IMPACT

- Junior Hannah Stewart is averaging 8.1 points and 5.4 rebounds off the bench for the Hawkeyes this season.
- The Minot, North Dakota, native has netted a career-high 13 points twice this season (Northern Illinois, Morgan State).
- In Iowa's win over Elon, Stewart set career-highs in rebounds (9) and blocks (4).
- Stewart leads the team in steals, averaging 1.4 per contest.

STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

- Iowa has defeated three teams – Quinnipiac, Western Kentucky, and Elon – that made the NCAA Tournament last season.
- Seven of Iowa's nonconference opponents made the 2017 NCAA Tournament, including Quinnipiac, Western Kentucky, Elon, Florida State, Iowa State, Northern Iowa, and Drake.
- Florida State is ranked No. 13 in the latest AP Poll. The Hawkeyes received 17 votes in the poll.

CLIMBING THE CAREER CHARTS

- Junior Megan Gustafson's 1, 129 career points ties for 30th all-time (Lisa Anderson, 80-84.). She needs one point to tie Johannah Solverson (02-05, 08) for 29th all-time and eight to tie Jolette Law (86-90) for 28th.
- Gustafson has 662 rebounds in her career. She currently ranks 15th all-time and needs 29 boards to tie Lisa Becker (83-87) for 14th all-time.

MEYER'S CAREER DAY

- Sophomore Makenzie Meyer netted a career-high 21 points on 8-of-12 shooting from the field against Western Michigan on Nov. 19.
- Meyer scored a career-high five 3-pointers and was 5-for-8 from behind the arc.
- She also dished out four assists and added a block in 27 minutes of action.

THE CENTURY MARK

- For the first time in school history, Iowa scored 100 or more points in back-to-back contests on Nov. 11 and Nov. 15.
- Iowa scored 104 points in an overtime win against Western Kentucky on Nov. 11, before netting 105 against Northern Illinois on Nov. 15.
- Iowa's scoring average of 97.3 ranks third in the Big Ten Conference and 13th in the nation.



DOUBLE THE DOUBLE-DOUBLE

- Junior Megan Gustafson and Tania Davis each registered double-doubles in Iowa's win over Northern Illinois on Nov. 15.
- Gustafson led the team with 22 points and 11 rebounds. It marked the 30th double-double of her career and her third of the season.
- Davis registered 12 points and a career-high 10 rebounds to record her second career double-double. Davis also chipped in seven assists in the contest.

700 CLUB

- Head coach Lisa Bluder collected her 700th victory on Nov. 10 against Quinnipiac.

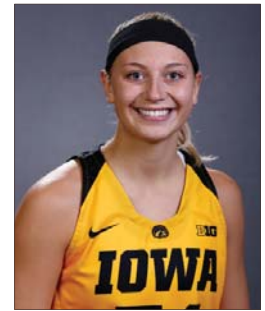
