The University of Iowa wrestling team hosts No. 3 Oklahoma State on Sunday at 3:02 p.m. (CT) on Mediacom Mat inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

TICKETS

Tickets to Friday's dual are \$15 for adults and \$10 for youth 18-years-old and younger. UI students and children five and under are free, but everyone must have a ticket. Tickets are available at hawkeyesports.com/tickets, over the phone at 1-800-IA-HAWKS, or at the UI Athletics Ticket Office inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

THE SERIES

Sunday marks the 52nd all-time meeting between two schools that have combined to win 57 NCAA Championships (Oklahoma State 34, lowa 23). The Cowboys lead the all-time series 28-21-2.

Iowa had won three straight in the series before Oklahoma State's 24-11 win in Stillwater last season.

lowa owns a 12-10 series record in duals wrestled in lowa City. The Hawkeyes have won the last two meetings in lowa City, including a 24-6 win in 2014, and an 18-16 win on Nov. 14, 2015 at Kinnick Stadium.

GRAPPLE VETS

Three wrestlers in this week's probable lineups competed at the Grapple on the Gridiron at Kinnick Stadium on Nov. 14, 2015.

Oklahoma State's Dean Heil, and Iowa's Brandon Sorensen and Sam Stoll competed in front of the largest dual meet crowd in NCAA history (42,287).

Heil, ranked No. 1 at 141, defeated Logan Ryan, 7-3. Sorensen, ranked No. 3 at 149, defeated No. 8 Anthony Collica, 6-1. Stoll, who was unranked and making his collegiate debut, fell 6-1 to No. 5 Austin Marsden.

SORENSEN MAKES FOURTH APPEARANCE IN SERIES

Senior Brandon Sorensen is making his fourth appearance in the Iowa-Oklahoma State series. He is 2-1 in three previous duals. In 2015, the fifth-ranked freshman defeated No. 2 Josh Kindig, 6-1, in Stillwater, Oklahoma. As a thirdranked sophomore in the 2015-16 season opener, he defeated No. 8 Anthony Collica, 6-1, at the Grapple on the Gridiron. Last season in Stillwater, No. 2 Sorensen and No. 3 Collica traded three escapes through 11 minutes of wrestling, and when the clock expired Collica owned a two-second advantage in riding time to win 4-3 after two tiebreak periods.

Sunday is Sorensen's first lowa-Oklahoma State dual at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. He is 31-3 all-time at Carver.

Sorensen has 54 career dual starts. Sam Stoll ranks second on the team with 27 career dual starts.

NEW YEAR'S RESOLUTION... WELCOME ALL CHALLENGERS

The seventh-ranked Hawkeyes ring in the New Year with a January schedule that includes topranked Penn State, No. 2 Ohio State, No. 3 Oklahoma State, No. 8 Michigan, No. 14 Minnesota, and No. 25 Northwestern.

The Hawkeyes wrestle Oklahoma State, Michigan, Minnesota, and Northwestern at home, in that particular order.

lowa wrestles at Ohio State on Jan. 21 and at Penn State on Feb. 10. All five duals are televised by BTN.

Carver-Hawkeye Arena single dual tickets are \$15/\$10 (adult/youth) for duals against Oklahoma State (Jan. 14), Michigan, (Jan. 27), and Minnesota (Feb. 4). Northwestern tickets are \$12/\$8.

LEE AND MARINELLI IMPRESS IN DEBUTS

True freshman Spencer Lee and redshirt freshman Alex Marinelli made their Carver-Hawkeye Arena debuts Jan. 5 against Michigan State.

Lee opened the dual with a fall in 46 seconds against Kayvon Foley at 125 pounds.

Marinelli won by 24-5 technical fall at 165 nounds

Marinelli made his collegiate debut Dec. 8 at Rutgers. He has since gone 7-0 with two pins, two wins over ranked opponents, and winning the Midlands championship at 165 pounds.

Lee was 6-1 with three falls and three technical falls competing unattached this season at 125 pounds.

APPROACHING 1,000

lowa's overall dual meet record is 995-228-31 (.799) in 108 seasons. The University of Iowa would be the fourth team in NCAA history to reach 1,000 program wins (Oklahoma State, Iowa State, Oregon State).

The Hawkeyes have won 23 national titles and 35 Big Ten titles. Iowa's 54 NCAA Champions have won a total of 82 NCAA individual titles, crowning six three-time and 16 two-time champions. The Hawkeyes' 112 Big Ten champions have combined for 199 conference titles. There have been seven four-time, 18 three-time, and 30 two-time Big Ten champions from Iowa.

lowa's 154 All-Americans have earned All-America status 324 times, including 19 four-time, 37 three-time and 39 two-time honorees.

SORENSEN'S HOT START

Senior Brandon Sorensen, ranked No. 2 at 149 pounds, has opened the season with 13 straight wins, including two technical falls, three major decisions, and four falls.

This is the third straight year Sorensen opened the season with at least 13 consecutive wins. He started the 2015-16 season with 25 straight wins, a career-best winning streak, and opened last year with 17 straight wins. Sorensen is 31-3 all-time at Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

KEMERER CONTINUES PIN PARTY

Sophomore Michael Kemerer is 14-0 this season with seven pins. Kemerer had four pins all of last season in 36 matches. He has twice this season been named Big Ten Wrestler of the Week.

Five of his seven falls have come in the first period. Kemerer earned the Most Pins/Fastest Time award at the 2017 Midlands Championships. He pinned four opponents in a total of 9:54.

Kemerer is 14-0 for the second straight season. He opened his redshirt freshman year with 19 consecutive wins.

FINISH STRONG

The Hawkeye 197 and 285-pounders have a combined record of 24-0 with 14 wins by bonus points. Cash Wilcke, the sophomore 197-pounder, is riding a career-best 13-match winning streak. He has two major decisions, one technical fall, and two falls. He is also 2-0 in overtime. Wilcke won 197-pound title at the Midlands Championships.

Stoll has won a career-best 11 straight matches to open the season. Stoll won the 285-pound title at the Midlands Championships, and has six falls among his 11 wins.

HAWKEYES AT HOME

The Hawkeyes are 245-24 all-time at Carver-Hawkeye Arena since moving from the UI Field House in 1983. The Hawkeyes have recorded 20 undefeated seasons in Carver-Hawkeye Arena, the most recent in 2012-13 (9-0).

Carver-Hawkeye Arena has hosted two United States Olympic Team Trials, four Big Ten Championships (1983, 1994, 2005, 2016), and four NCAA Championships (1986, 1991, 1995, 2001). The Hawkeyes have won five tournament titles on their home mat, including the 1983 and 1994 Big Ten Championships, and the 1986, 1991 and 1995 NCAA Championships. Carver-Hawkeye Arena hosts the 2018 UWW World Cup on April 7-8, 2018.

Three-time Big Ten Coach of the Year Tom Brands enters his 12th season as head wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. A 1996 Olympic gold medalist and member of wrestling's Hall of Fame, Brands is only the eighth wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. The former Hawkeye wrestler was a four-time All-American and three-time na-

tional champion (1989-92) at lowa. He has a 200-19-1 (.911) overall and 88-7 (.926) Big Ten coaching record at lowa, and a 217-39-1 (.841) career mark.

In 11 full seasons as Iowa's head coach, Brands has led the Hawkeyes to three NCAA and four Big Ten team titles, crowning 10 NCAA champions, 15 Big Ten champions and 61 All-Americans. Iowa has had 89 Academic All-Big Ten recipients, including a school-record 12 in 2011-12. The Hawkeyes have qualified 100 wrestlers for the NCAA Championships in the last 11 years, sending the entire 10-man lineup in 2009, 2010, 2014, and 2015. Iowa has also won or shared eight of the last 10 Big Ten regular season titles.

lowa also made another entry in the record books, setting the national collegiate dual meet attendance record of 42,287 when lowa defeated top-ranked Oklahoma State, 18-16, on Nov. 14, 2015 at the Grapple on the Gridiron at Kinnick Stadium. Iowa has led the nation in attendance in each of Brands' 11 seasons, setting an NCAA all-time attendance average of 12,166 in 2015-16.

Brands was named 2008 NWCA Coach of the Year after leading the Hawkeyes to their first NCAA team title since 2000 and their first Big Ten team title since 2004. He was named Big Ten Coach of the Year in 2008, 2009 and 2010, becoming the first coach in conference history to earn the honor in three consecutive seasons. Brands served as head coach at Virginia Tech University for two seasons (2005-06), recording a 17-20 dual mark. In his first season with the Hokies, Brands led the team to the 2005 regular season Atlantic Coast Conference title, set a school record for dual meet wins (16) and had a school-record five wrestlers qualify for the NCAA Championships. During his tenure, Virginia Tech crowned five ACC champions and had two All-Americans. Senior heavy-weight Mike Faust was named 2006 ACC Wrestler of the Year.

Prior to taking the helm at Virginia Tech, Brands was an assistant coach at Iowa for 12 seasons (1993-2004). He helped the Hawkeyes to a 177-27 dual record, seven NCAA and eight Big Ten team titles, while crowning 23 NCAA champions, 73 All-Americans and 36 Big Ten champions. He was named the National Wrestling Coaches Association Assistant Coach of the Year in 2000.

In 2004, he was one of three coaches for the U.S. Olympic freestyle wrestling team, participating in Athens, and in 2016 he was named a volunteer coach of the United States Olympic team in Rio. Brands also served as assistant coach for the U.S. Freestyle World Teams in 2001, 2002, 2003, 2013, 2014, and 2015. He was named Freestyle Coach of the Year by USA Wrestling in 2002 and 2003. He has coached a number of other U.S. teams in international competition.

As a competitor, Brands won the 1996 Olympic freestyle gold medal at 136.5 pounds in Atlanta, Georgia. He also won a gold medal at the 1993 World Freestyle Championships in Toronto, two World Cup gold medals (1994, 1995) and was the 1995 Pan American Games champion. He won four U.S. National titles (1993-96) and made four straight U.S. World or Olympic teams (1993-96). Along with his twin brother, Terry, Tom was named 1993 USA Wrestling Athlete of the Year, the 1993 John Smith Outstanding Freestyle Wrestler, and 1993 Amateur Wrestling News Man of the Year. He was inducted into wrestling's Hall of Fame in 2001.

Brands was a four-time All-American at Iowa (1989-92). During his Hawkeye career, he won three NCAA titles and was named Outstanding Wrestler of the 1992 NCAA Championships. Also a three-time Big Ten champion, Brands won 95 percent of his matches at Iowa. His career mark of 158-7-2 includes an undefeated season in 1991 (45-0).

The Sheldon, Iowa, native was born April 9, 1968. He earned his B.S. degree in physical education from Iowa in 1992. He and his wife, Jeni, have three children, Madigan, Kinsee and Tommy.


