KILLIN' IT KILIAN

- Junior Mallory Kilian blasted a solo home run on the first pitch at the Grand Canyon Invitational. The Hawkeyes went on to defeat Georgetown, 5-0.
- Kilian also recorded a personal-best two stolen bases against the Hoyas. These were the first two stolen bases of her career.
- Kilian leads lowa with a .313 batting average, a .583 slugging percentage, and a .435 onbase percentage. She has a career-high four stolen bases and a team-high three home runs.

BOGIED

- Freshman Aralee Bogar has 18 hits, 15 runs,
 11 stolen bases, and a .250 batting average during her time in black and gold.
- She also has a .333 slugging percentage and a .280 on-base percentage.
- Bogar is in the top five in the Big Ten with 11 stolen bases. She is currently a perfect 11-for-11 in stolen bases. She is the only athlete in the top five with a perfect stolen base percentage.

WOOD AT THE DISH

- Senior Allie Wood led the Hawkeyes at the plate against the 13th-ranked Sun Devils on March 14. She had two hits with a double for a .400 batting average.
- She also led lowa with a .600 slugging percentage and tied a team-high .400 onbase percentage.
- Wood hit a double and scored one run in lowa's 3-1 victory over No. 13 Arizona State.
- The Cypress, Calif. native gave lowa the advantage in its win over Wichita State, hitting her first career RBI triple to put the team up 1-0.

DOOZY DOOCY

- After a career-high 15 strikeouts and a 2-0 weekend, sophomore pitcher Allison Doocy was named co-Big Ten Pitcher of the Week on March 12.
- The final 10 outs of the game against Georgetown on March 11 came from her hand.
- This was the first pitcher of the week award for Doocy and the first time a Hawkeye has

- earned the honor since Kayla Massey on March 31, 2014.
- Doocy was also selected as the College Sports Madness Big Ten Player of the Week.
- Doocy led the Hawkeyes to victory against No.
 13 Arizona State on March 14.
- The sophomore had eight strikeouts and allowed six hits and just one walk in 7.0 innings against the Sun Devils.
- Doocy leads lowa with a 1.08 ERA and 71 strikeouts in 64.0 innings pitched.
- The Ankeny, Iowa native is third in the Big Ten with a 1.08 ERA and fifth in strikeouts (75).

SCHNEIDER GOES YARD

- Sophomore McKenzie Schneider hit her first home run of the season at the Judi Garman Classic on March 4.
- The Southlake, Texas, native sent a two-run shot deep over the right-center field wall in lowa's 3-1 win over then-No. 8 Baylor.
- The homer was the second of her career.
- Schneider hit her second home run of the season -- and the first grand slam of her career -- to lift lowa to victory over Creighton on March 17.

BESTING BAYLOR

- The Hawkeyes defeated then-No. 8 Baylor,
 3-1, in their final game at the Judi Garman Classic on March 4.
- Two of sophomore pitcher, Allison Doocy's eight strikeouts were against Baylor's Carlee Wallace, who had only struck out twice in 30 at-bats before the matchup.
- The win was lowa's first over a top 10 team since beating then-No. 4 Michigan in Ann Arbor on March 29, 2015.
- Five Hawkeyes -- Sarah Kurtz (2), Wood (2),
 Devin Cantu (1), Monteer (1), and Schneider (1) -- collected hits in the game.

COMPLETE GAMES

- Three Hawkeyes threw complete games at the Texas A&M Invitational: freshman Lauren Shaw, sohpomore Allison Doocy, and junior Erin Riding.
- On Feb. 18, Doocy (2-2) allowed just two hits in lowa's 2-1 victory over Tulsa. The Ankeny, lowa native tied a career-best 10 strikeouts in the game.
- Riding (1-0) threw a five inning run rule performance on Feb. 17 against Butler. She gave up two hits and no walks in the 8-0 win.
- Shaw wrapped up the weekend with an 11-3 triumph over Tulsa. She allowed just three runs on three hits and an error.
- Doocy also threw two complete games at the

Judi Garman Classic. She pitched a total of 15.2 innings and went 1-1 on the weekend.

SOUTH DAKOTA STATE

- The Jackrabbits are 14-9 overall. The team is currently on a four game win streak after competing at the USF-Under Armour Showcase.

HEAD COACH MARLA LOOPER

Marla Looper is in her seventh season at the helm of the University of lowa softball program in 2017. Looper owns a 163-225-1 overall record and a 62-97 mark in Big Ten play since the 2011 season.



The Hawkeyes also earned the Community Service Award at the Golden Herkys, the annual award ceremony for the University of Iowa athletics department. The softball team completed approximately 750 hours of community service, more than any other Iowa team.

lowa excelled in the classroom during the 2016-17 academic year, with seven Hawkeyes earning Academic All-Big Ten honors in the spring. Kurtz was also named a Big Ten Distinguished Scholar.

Under Looper's guidance in 2016, Kaitlyn Mullarkey collected a team-high nine home runs, which tied for eighth in single-season home runs in program history. Mullarkey currently ranks tied for 15th in program history with 15 career home runs.

In 2015, Looper led the Hawkeyes to their deepest Big Ten Tournament run since 2008. After earning the No. 10 seed with an 8-15 conference record (19-40 overall), the Hawkeyes overcame a three-run deficit against seventh-seeded Rutgers to win the opening round of the tournament on May 7. The Hawkeyes then upset the nationally ranked Gophers with a 2-0 victory to secure lowa's third win over a ranked opponent on the season (No. 17 UCF, No. 4 Michigan). After falling behind early in its semifinal game against third-seeded Nebraska, lowa rallied to come within three runs, but fell short of a comeback as the Huskers notched the 9-6 victory.

Looper collected her 100th career victory in the 2014 season finale. On the season, lowa posted 16 wins -- nine in conference action and three over ranked opponents (16-30-1).

In 2013, Looper's third year with the Hawkeyes, the squad amassed 30 wins (30-24), which was the most wins for the program since a 42-16 record in 2009. lowa posted six wins over ranked opponents.

During her second season with the Hawkeyes in 2012, Looper led the team to a runner-up finish in the Big Ten — the program's highest finish since winning the league title in 2003. lowa dropped two of its first three conference series before winning five straight to close out the season. It was the first time the team had won five straight series since the 2004 season.

lowa entered the final weekend with a conference title within reach, but it could not close the gap with Michigan despite taking 2-of-3 games at Minnesota. The Hawkeyes finished with a 27-26 overall record and a 16-8 mark in conference play in 2012. The Hawkeyes finished second in the Big Ten in pitching (2.31 ERA) and third in fielding (.967). The squad turned 26 double plays during the course of the season to rank sixth nationally in double plays per game (.49).

Looper guided the Hawkeyes to a 27-24 overall and a 9-11 Big Ten record in her first season in Iowa City in 2011. The first-year head coach led the UI to a pair of six game winning streaks in her opening campaign and a tournament title at the Stetson Classic.

lowa opened Big Ten Conference play strong with an 8-3 record. Among the victories was a 4-2 triumph at No. 1 Michigan. The win, which pushed the overall mark to 26-16, was lowa's first over a No. 1 ranked opponent since the 2005 season and the first over a ranked foe since 2008.

Looper's Hawkeyes were on the verge of completing a series sweep in Ann Arbor before the Wolverines rallied from a 2-0 deficit in the bottom of the seventh inning to claim the victory.

A pair of Hawkeyes earned All-Big Ten recognition at the conclusion of the season. Liz Watkins was tabbed as a second team selection, while Katie Keim earned third team accolades.

Looper took over the reigns of the lowa program after serving as an assistant coach at the University of Texas for 11 seasons (1999-2010). Looper helped lead the Longhorns to three College World Series appearances (2003, 2005 and 2006) and nine NCAA Tournament berths.
