LEADING OFF

• The Hawkeyes opened the season with a 2-1 showing at the Snowbird Classic, with wins over Kent State (3-1) and Saint Joseph's (7-2) and a 10-8, back-and-forth loss to Pitt.

• Iowa is receiving votes in the latest NCBWA poll. The Hawkeyes are picked to finish fifth in the Big Ten Conference by Perfect Game and Baseball America and seventh by D1Baseball.

• Senior outfielder Ben Norman had a red hot opening weekend, batting .462 (6-of-13) out of the leadoff spot with four runs scored and four RBIs. Austin Martin is hitting .308 after three games.

• Seniors Grant Judkins, Grant Leonard, and Austin Martin were named to the Big Ten's Preseason Honors List. Those three Hawkeyes along with senior Justin Jenkins were voted team captains in January.

• Redshirt senior Grant Leonard is six saves from breaking lowa's career saves record set by Kurt Belger (1993-97). Fourteen of Leonard's 17 career saves came last season to set a single season lowa record.

• Heller is only four wins shy of 900 career victories. He has posted 607 wins at the Division I level, including 205 at lowa, with another 289 coming at Division II Upper Iowa. Heller is one of four coaches at the University of Iowa with at least 200 wins.

 The Hawkeyes are coming off a 31-24 campaign in 2019, with 10 wins over ranked opponents and a streak of six straight series wins. It was head coach Rick Heller's sixth straight 30-win season -- Iowa's longest stretch since 1979-85. Iowa has advanced to the postseason in each of Heller's six seasons, which includes two NCAA Regional appearances (2015, 2017). • The Hawkeyes will play 23 home contests at Duane Banks Field with its home opener set for March 3 against Grand View. Iowa is 91-27 at home since the start of the 2015 season.

ABOUT HEAD COACH RICK HELLER

Rick Heller has turned the University of Iowa baseball program into a perennial Big Ten Conference and NCAA contender in his first six seasons as the Hawkeyes' head coach.

Heller has injected new life into the lowa program, leading the Hawkeyes to the 204 victories -- an average of 34 wins per season -- advancing to two NCAA Regionals, and claiming the first Big Ten Tournament title in program history. The 2017 title was lowa's first since winning the regular season crown in 1990.

The Eldon, Iowa, native became the 20th head coach in program history in 2013 -- his fourth stop as a collegiate head coach. He has enjoyed stints at Iowa (2014-present), Indiana State (2009-13), Northern Iowa (1999-2009), and Upper Iowa (1987-99), Ieading all four schools to NCAA postseason play. He is one of nine coaches all-time and one of five active coaches to lead three different Division I programs to NCAA Regional play.

In 32 seasons as a head coach, Heller owns a career record of 896-699-4. He is one of two lowa head coaches to lead the program to the NCAA Tournament.

At Iowa

Under Heller's watch, lowa has advanced to the postseason in six consecutive years for the first time in program history, he has coached six All-Americans and at least one first-team All-Big Ten selection in five of his six seasons. lowa has had 21 Major League Baseball Draft picks in six seasons -- the most in a six-year stretch all-time.

Heller has also given the Hawkeyes an international flavor, taking the team to the Dominican Republic in 2016 and Taipei, Taiwan, as the United States representative at the 2017 World University Games. Heller led USA to a silver medal, as the team became the first American squad to medal in Universiade history.

USA team went 5-2 during the two-week stretch, before falling to Japan in the gold medal game. The Americans posted victories over Mexico, Russia, Korea, and two games against the Czech Republic. Junior Cole McDonald tossed a nineinning no-hitter in game one against the Czechs -- the first by a Hawkeye since 1965.

During Heller's second season, Heller guided lowa to an at-large berth into NCAA Regional play in 2015 -- a first for the program since 1990 -- and the team posted the school's first NCAA Tournament win since 1972. The Hawkeyes were the runners-up at the 2016 Big Ten Tournament before claiming the program's first tournament title in 2017 to lock up the school's second NCAA Regional appearance in three seasons.

lowa made just three NCAA Tournament appearances in its history prior to Heller's arrival.

QUICK HITTERS

• Four Hawkeyes -- Ben Norman, Austin Martin, Brendan Sher, and Zeb Adreon -- hit safely in all three games to start the season.

• Sophomore infielder Brendan Sher and senior outfielder Justin Jenkins lead Iowa in on-base percentage (.545). Sher leads the Hawkeyes in extra-base hits with two doubles.

• Junior infielder Izaya Fullard hit Iowa's first home run of the season via a three-run, go-ahead homer against Pittsburgh in the third inning. It was Fullard's first hit of the season.

 Three Hawkeyes -- Peyton Williams, Dylan Nedved, and Brayden Frazier -- made their lowa debuts. Williams started three games at first base, recording three hits and two RBIs. Nedved made two starts at third base, hitting .286 with two RBIs, and made an appearance out of the bullpen.
 Frazier pinch-hit and saw two plate appearances.
 Iowa's .980 fielding percentage is third-best in the Big Ten. The Hawkeyes' only two errors of opening weekend were throwing errors.

IOWA BY THE NUMBERS

• lowa returns five starters, its designated hitter, 2/3 of its starting rotation, 11 total pitchers, and 22 letterwinners in 2020.

• Offensively, the Hawkeyes return 71.7 percent (180-251) of their RBIs, 69.5 percent (347-499) of their hits, 69 percent (20-29) of their home runs, 68.8 percent (64-93) of their doubles, 64.4 percent (38-59) of their stolen bases, and 63.7 percent (179-281) of their runs.

• lowa returns its top returning hitter Izaya Fullard (.307 avg., 61 hits) and its top RBI producer (34), doubles hitter (12), and stolen base (14) threat in Ben Norman.

• The Hawkeyes have 94.4 percent (18-19) of the team's saves, 67.9 percent (329 1/3-484 2/3) of innings pitched, 67.7 percent (21-31) of wins, and 67.4 percent (304-451) of strikeouts returning.

BACK IN CALI

• It will be lowa's first trip to California since 2007 when the Hawkeyes played six games. Iowa faced Fresno State four times and Dallas Baptist twice, going 2-4.

• Senior infielder Matthew Sosa is lowa's only California native. From Whittier, California, Sosa played two years at East Los Angeles Community College. Sosa's hometown is 110 miles from San Diego.

RISE TO THE OCCASION

• Four of lowa's next six games are against ranked opponents (Baseball America rankings).

• Iowa will face No. 22 Arizona in this weekend's Tony Gwynn Legacy Tournament. The following weekend, the Hawkeyes will face No. 18 North Carolina State, No. 19 North Carolina, and No. 17 Duke at the CambriaCollegeClassic.

• The Hawkeyes went 10-3 against top-30 opponents last season.

NORMAN THE LEADOFF MAN

• In Ben Norman's first three seasons, he spent most his time in the middle of the batting order. To start the season, the senior outfielder has moved to the leadoff spot and he has set the tone for lowa's offense.

• On top of hitting .462, Norman never struck out in 14 plate appearances and stole two bases during the opening weekend.

Norman's highlight was going 4-for-4 to tie a career high for hits and reaching base five times on his birthday in Iowa's 7-2 win over Saint Joseph's.

LOOK WHO'S BACK

Redshirt sophomores Jack Dreyer and Ben Probst returned to the mound in a big way after missing a majority of last season with arm injuries.
As lowa's Friday night starter, Dreyer pitched a dominant five innings, earning the win in lowa's 3-1 Opening Day win over Kent State. The southpaw from Johnston, lowa, struck out eight batters and only walked one, while facing only three

batters over the minimum. Early in the game, Dreyer sat down nine consecutive batters with six straight punch outs.

• Probst made his first appearance in the ninth inning of lowa's 7-2 win over Saint Joseph's. The right-handed pitcher from Urbandale, lowa, didn't allow a hit or run, while recording two strikeouts in his return. He also topped out at 97 MPH on the radar gun, making him one of 13 players nationally to throw 96 or higher during the opening weekend.

ROTATION NOTES

Iowa's starting rotation, that lost Friday-night starter Cole McDonald (6-3, 3.54 ERA) to the MLB Draft last season, will feature LHP Jack Dreyer, RHP Grant Judkins, and RHP Duncan Davitt for the second straight week.
The three starting pitchers combined to go 2-0, with 17 strikeouts in 13 innings, while limiting hitters to a .143 BAA over opening weekend. Dreyer and Judkins each went five innings to earn the win. Davitt lasted three innings in a no-decision.

• LHP Cam Baumann, who made 14 starts in Dreyer's absence, but missed practice time due to mono, RHP Drew Irvine, RHP Hunter Lee, and LHP Trenton Wallace, are the next starters in line.

THE GRANT LEONARD FILE

• After going a perfect 14-for-14 in save chances with a 3.37 ERA in 34 2/3 innings as a junior, redshirt senior Grant Leonard racked up three preseason accolades: second-team preseason All-America by the NCBWA, third-team preseason All-America by Collegiate Baseball, and he is one of 70 players in the country selected to the NCBWA Stopper of the Year Watch List. Leonard is rated as the 20th-best relief pitcher in the nation by D1Baseball.

• In his first appearance of the season, Leonard struck out two batters to earn his first save of the season, moving into a tie for fourth all-time in carer saves.

• Leonard's 14 saves last season were a single season record.

Heller won his 200th game at Iowa on May 1 in a victory over Western Illinois. • The Hawkeyes have won 30 or more games in each of Heller's six seasons as the helm of the program. It's a first for the team since winning 30 or more in seven straight seasons from 1979-85.

• Heller has led the Hawkeyes to two NCAA Regional appearances; the program had three regional appearances in its history prior to his arrival.

• Heller is fourth in school history in career wins with 204 at lowa, including the second (41) and fifth-most (39) in school history.

• Heller led lowa to its first Big Ten Tournament title in 2017 -- the first conference title since 1990 -- and he guided the Hawkeyes to the Big Ten Tournament title game in consecutive seasons. Iowa has advanced to the league tournament in six straight years for the first time in program history.
