



# HAWKEYE HITS

## THIS WEEK

The University of Iowa softball team travels to Fullerton, California, for the Judi Garman Classic on Friday-Sunday. The Hawkeyes open the weekend against Stanford on Friday at 2:30 p.m. (CT). Iowa will face the host Titans at 9:30 p.m. to finish the opening day of tournament play. Saturday, the Hawkeyes take on Cal Poly at 2 p.m. and UL Lafayette at 7:30 p.m. Iowa wraps up action Sunday at 11 a.m. against Baylor.

## + .300

Four Hawkeyes hit .300 or better at the Texas A&M Invitational from Feb. 16-18. Junior Mallory Kilian led the Hawkeyes at the plate with a .455 average. Senior Sarah Kurtz followed, hitting .417, while sophomore Brooke Rozier hit .400. Freshman Aralee Bogar rounded out the group, hitting .353.

## COMPLETE GAMES

- Three Hawkeyes threw complete games at the Texas A&M Invitational: freshman Lauren Shaw, sophomore Allison Doocy, and junior Erin Riding.
- On Friday, Doocy (2-2) allowed just two hits in Iowa's 2-1 victory over Tulsa. The Ankeny, Iowa native tied a career-best 10 strikeouts in the game.
- Riding (1-0) threw a five inning run rule performance on Saturday against Butler. She gave up two hits and no walks in the 8-0 win.
- Shaw wrapped up the weekend with an 11-3 triumph over Tulsa on Sunday. She allowed just three runs on three hits and an error.

## BOGIED

- Aralee Bogar had three hits, three runs, four stolen bases, and a .250 batting average in her first four games in black and gold. She also had a .333 slugging percentage and a .308 on-base percentage.
- In week two action, Bogar improved to six hits, four runs, and a .353 batting average.
- She is currently tied for 21st in the nation with seven stolen bases in nine games played.

## STANFORD

- Stanford (10-7) is hitting .394 as a team with 17 doubles, eight triples, and eight home runs. The Cardinal have scored 87 runs while posting a .371 on-base percentage.
- Alyssa Horeczko is hitting a team-leading .421 with a pair of triples. She has scored 15 runs and has seven RBIs.
- Teaghan Cowles leads the nation as the toughest athlete to strikeout. The Cardinal has struck out just once in 58 at bats. She holds a .379 batting average with four doubles, two

triples, seven RBIs, and 13 runs.

- Montana Dixon leads the team with three home runs and 20 RBIs. She is hitting .340 and has scored 11 runs.
- Stanford has a 2.49 team ERA over 112.2 innings.
- Maddy Dwyer has pitched 63.2 innings and has a 0.99 ERA. She has five complete games and two shutouts. Dwyer has collected strikeouts 40 against 15 walks.
- In 37 innings, Kiana Pancino has a 2.46 ERA and 26 strikeouts in 10 appearances including two complete games.

## FULLERTON

- Tournament host Cal State Fullerton owns a 6-8 record on the season.
- The Titans fell to California (3-0) and Arizona St. (7-3) in their final matchups at the Mary Nutter Classic last weekend.
- In 14 games, Fullerton has 56 runs on 89 hits.
- Taylor Dockins has pitched 34.1 innings. She owns a 2.24 ERA.
- Ari Williams leads the Titans at the plate, batting .342 with 13 hits in 38 at bats. She's knocked eight RBIs and has scored six runs.
- Taylor Dockins has pitched 34.1 innings and has a 2.24 ERA. She has three complete games with 16 strikeouts and just seven walks.

## CAL POLY

- Cal Poly is 7-7 overall after splitting a pair games with Stanford at the Mary Nutter Classic last weekend.
- Chelsea Convisar leads Cal Poly with 17 hits, 11 runs, and a .362 batting average. She has collected two doubles, two triples, one home run, and five RBIs.
- In the circle, Lindsey Chalmers has 23 strikeouts and a 3.61 ERA over 33.0 innings pitched.

## UL LAFAYETTE

- UL Lafayette (11-3) is hitting .301 as a team with 13 doubles, three triples, and five home runs.
- The Ragin Cajuns have scored 77 runs while posting a .367 on-base percentage.
- Alissa Dalton is hitting a team leading .426 with a pair of doubles and one home run. She has scored 13 runs and knocked in 11 runs.
- Brittany Rodriguez has collected 10 runs on 15 hits with a .375 batting average.
- Summer Ellyson has pitched 48.1 innings and has a 1.59 ERA. She has four complete games and one shutout while striking out 46 against 16 walks.

## BAYLOR

- Baylor is 9-0, including two wins against top-25 teams: No. 24 RV McNeese State (7-1) and No. 9 Alabama (2-1).
- The Bears have 62 runs on 94 hits in 9 games.
- Three Baylor student-athletes are hitting .500 or better on the season: Jessie Scroggins (.548), Carlee Wallace (.522), and Nicky Dawson (.500).
- Taylor Dockins has pitched 28 innings in the circle and owns a .50 ERA. She has three complete games and one shutout while collecting 39 strikeouts against eight walks.

## HEAD COACH MARLA LOOPER

Marla Looper is in her seventh season at the helm of the University of Iowa softball program in 2017. Looper owns a 151-215-1 overall record and a 62-97 mark in Big Ten play since the 2011 season.

In 2017, earned a berth in the conference tournament, marking the program's 20th Big Ten Tournament appearance and tying Michigan for the conference lead in appearances.

The Hawkeyes also earned the Community Service Award at the Golden Herkys, the annual award ceremony for the University of Iowa athletics department. The softball team completed approximately 750 hours of community service, more than any other Iowa team.

Iowa excelled in the classroom during the 2016-17 academic year, with seven Hawkeyes earning Academic All-Big Ten honors in the spring. Kurtz was also named a Big Ten Distinguished Scholar.

Under Looper's guidance in 2016, Kaitlyn Mullarkey collected a team-high nine home runs, which tied for eighth in single-season home runs in program history. Mullarkey currently ranks tied for 15th in program history with 15 career home runs.



In 2015, Looper led the Hawkeyes to their deepest Big Ten Tournament run since 2008. After earning the No. 10 seed with an 8-15 conference record (19-40 overall), the Hawkeyes overcame a three-run deficit against seventh-seeded Rutgers to win the opening round of the tournament on May 7. The Hawkeyes then upset the nationally ranked Gophers with a 2-0 victory to secure Iowa's third win over a ranked opponent on the season (No. 17 UC, No. 4 Michigan). After falling behind early in its semifinal game against third-seeded Nebraska, Iowa rallied to come within three runs, but fell short of a comeback as the Huskers notched the 9-6 victory.

Looper collected her 100th career victory in the 2014 season finale. On the season, Iowa posted 16 wins -- nine in conference action and three over ranked opponents (16-30-1).

In 2013, Looper's third year with the Hawkeyes, the squad amassed 30 wins (30-24), which was the most wins for the program since a 42-16 record in 2009. Iowa posted six wins over ranked opponents.

During her second season with the Hawkeyes in 2012, Looper led the team to a runner-up finish in the Big Ten -- the program's highest finish since winning the league title in 2003. Iowa dropped two of its first three conference series before winning five straight to close out the season. It was the first time the team had won five straight series since the 2004 season.

Iowa entered the final weekend with a conference title within reach, but it could not close the gap with Michigan despite taking 2-of-3 games at Minnesota. The Hawkeyes finished with a 27-26 overall record and a 16-8 mark in conference play in 2012. The Hawkeyes finished second in the Big Ten in pitching (2.31 ERA) and third in fielding (.967). The squad turned 26 double plays during the course of the season to rank sixth nationally in double plays per game (.49).

Looper guided the Hawkeyes to a 27-24 overall and a 9-11 Big Ten record in her first season in Iowa City in 2011. The first-year head coach led the UI to a pair of six game winning streaks in her opening campaign and a tournament title at the Stetson Classic.

Iowa opened Big Ten Conference play strong with an 8-3 record. Among the victories was a 4-2 triumph at No. 1 Michigan. The win, which pushed the overall mark to 26-16, was Iowa's first over a No. 1 ranked opponent since the 2005 season and the first over a ranked foe since 2008.

Looper's Hawkeyes were on the verge of completing a series sweep in Ann Arbor before the Wolverines rallied from a 2-0 deficit in the bottom of the seventh inning to claim the victory.

A pair of Hawkeyes earned All-Big Ten recognition at the conclusion of the season. Liz Watkins was tabbed as a second team selection, while Katie Keim earned third team accolades.

Looper took over the reigns of the Iowa program after serving as an assistant coach at the University of Texas for 11 seasons (1999-2010). Looper helped lead the Longhorns to three College World Series appearances (2003, 2005 and 2006) and nine NCAA Tournament berths.
