The seventh-ranked University of Iowa wrestling team hosts No. 15 Illinois on Friday at 7 p.m. (CT) at Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

Admission is \$12 for adults, \$8 for youth, and free for UI students and all children five-years-old and younger.

IOWA VS. ILLINOIS

lowa and Illinois are meeting for the 78th time in series history.

The Hawkeyes have won seven in a row and lead the all-time series, 50-26-1. Iowa is 22-9-1 against the Illini in Iowa City.

The Hawkeyes lost 21 of the first 22 meetings in the series that began in 1920, but have since won 49-of-55 with one tie (12-12 in 1952).

Illinois' last win in the series was a 24-13 victory on Feb. 10, 2006, at Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

Iowa head coach Tom Brands is 7-0 alltime against the Illini.

Illinois is coached by Jim Heffernan, a four-time All-American from 1983-87. Heffernan won the 150-pound NCAA title on Iowa's 1986 national championship team.

IOWA COACHING TREE

Illinois head coach Jim Heffernan is one of six Big Ten coaches to graduate from Iowa (Tom Brands, Iowa; Barry Davis, Wisconsin; Tony Ersland, Purdue; Duane Goldman, Indiana; Jim Heffernan, Illinois; Tom Ryan, Ohio State). Heffernan was part of three NCAA championship teams; 1983, 1985, 1986.

BIG TEN OPENERS

lowa has won 19 straight conference openers, including 11 in a row under head coach Tom Brands. Iowa's last loss in a Big Ten opener was a 25-17 defeat to Penn State to open the 1997-98 conference season.

ANOTHER TEST AT 165

Redshirt freshman Kaleb Young (165) was 3-0 in his Hawkeye debut at the Iowa City Duals. Young won his first two matches by technical fall and major decision, and won his third match, 3-2, over No. 20 Andrew Fogarty of North Dakota State.

Young got the call at 165 against Rider's fourth-ranked Chad Walsh and dropped a 5-4 decision, his first loss of the year.

If Young gets the call Friday, he will face a third straight ranked opponent. No. 2 Isaiah Martinez, a two-time NCAA champion and three-time finalist is a senior for the Illini.

Young has never faced Martinez. His teammate, 14th-ranked Alex Marinelli, lost to Martinez 14-5 in the third round of the 2016 Midlands Championships. Marinelli is also in the probable lineup.

KEMERER TEAM-HIGH 8 IN A ROW

Sophomore Michael Kemerer, ranked third by Intermat, is scheduled to face No. 17 Kyle Langenderfer. It is the first meeting between the two.

Kemerer has won eight straight, and among his last six wins, he has four wins over ranked opponents, including three ranked in the top seven.

Kemerer is 4-0 with one major decision, one technical fall, and two pins. He had four pins all of last season.

Langenderfer bumped up to 157 last season. He competed at 149 from 2014-15. He lost to Brandon Sorensen by major decision in his only two meetings (11-2, 16-4).

LAUX CRACKS NATIONAL RANKINGS

Senior Phillip Laux has cracked the national rankings for the first time in his career. Laux has a team-high six wins and is ranked No. 18 at 133 pounds by WIN Magazine.

He could move up the rankings with a win on Friday. Illinois' Dylan Duncan is ranked 15th by WIN with a record of 4-2. Laux is 0-3 all-time against ranked opponents. His sixmatch winning streak is a career-long in varsity competition, though he did win 23 straight competing unattached as a true freshman.



Tom Brands Head Coach University of Iowa, 1992

Three-time Big Ten Coach of the Year Tom Brands enters his 12th season as head wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. A 1996 Olympic gold medalist and member of wrestling's Hall of Fame, Brands is only the eighth wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. The former Hawkeye wrestler was a four-time All-American and three-time na-

tional champion (1989-92) at Iowa. He has a 196-19-1 (.908) overall and 84-7 (.923) Big Ten coaching record at Iowa, and a 213-39-1 (.841) career mark.

In 11 full seasons as Iowa's head coach, Brands has led the Hawkeyes to three NCAA and four Big Ten team titles, crowning 10 NCAA champions, 15 Big Ten champions and 61 All-Americans. Iowa has had 89 Academic All-Big Ten recipients, including a school-record 12 in 2011-12. The Hawkeyes have qualified 100 wrestlers for the NCAA Championships in the last 11 years, sending the entire 10-man lineup in 2009, 2010, 2014, and 2015. Iowa has also won or shared eight of the last 10 Big Ten regular season titles.

lowa also made another entry in the record books, setting the national collegiate dual meet attendance record of 42,287 when lowa defeated top-ranked Oklahoma State, 18-16, on Nov. 14, 2015 at the Grapple on the Gridiron at Kinnick Stadium. Iowa has led the nation in attendance in each of Brands' 11 seasons, setting an NCAA all-time attendance average of 12,166 in 2015-16.

Brands was named 2008 NWCA Coach of the Year after leading the Hawkeyes to their first NCAA team title since 2000 and their first Big Ten team title since 2004. He was named Big Ten Coach of the Year in 2008, 2009 and 2010, becoming the first coach in conference history to earn the honor in three consecutive seasons.

Brands served as head coach at Virginia Tech University for two seasons (2005-06), recording a 17-20 dual mark. In his first season with the Hokies, Brands led the team to the 2005 regular season Atlantic Coast Conference title, set a school record for dual meet wins (16) and had a school-record five wrestlers qualify for the NCAA Championships. During his tenure, Virginia Tech crowned five ACC champions and had two All-Americans. Senior heavy-weight Mike Faust was named 2006 ACC Wrestler of the Year.

Prior to taking the helm at Virginia Tech, Brands was an assistant coach at lowa for 12 seasons (1993-2004). He helped the Hawkeyes to a 177-27 dual record, seven NCAA and eight Big Ten team titles, while crowning 23 NCAA champions, 73 All-Americans and 36 Big Ten champions. He was named the National Wrestling Coaches Association Assistant Coach of the Year in 2000.

In 2004, he was one of three coaches for the U.S. Olympic freestyle wrestling team, participating in Athens, and in 2016 he was named a volunteer coach of the United States Olympic team in Rio. Brands also served as assistant coach for the U.S. Freestyle World Teams in 2001, 2002, 2003, 2013, 2014, and 2015. He was named Freestyle Coach of the Year by USA Wrestling in 2002 and 2003. He has coached a number of other U.S. teams in international competition.

As a competitor, Brands won the 1996 Olympic freestyle gold medal at 136.5 pounds in Atlanta, Georgia. He also won a gold medal at the 1993 World Freestyle Championships in Toronto, two World Cup gold medals (1994, 1995) and was the 1995 Pan American Games champion. He won four U.S. National titles (1993-96) and made four straight U.S. World or Olympic teams (1993-96). Along with his twin brother, Terry, Tom was named 1993 USA Wrestling Athlete of the Year, the 1993 John Smith Outstanding Freestyle Wrestler, and 1993 Amateur Wrestling News Man of the Year. He was inducted into wrestling's Hall of Fame in 2001.

Brands was a four-time All-American at Iowa (1989-92). During his Hawkeye career, he won three NCAA titles and was named Outstanding Wrestler of the 1992 NCAA Championships. Also a three-time Big Ten champion, Brands won 95 percent of his matches at Iowa. His career mark of 158-7-2 includes an undefeated season in 1991 (45-0).

The Sheldon, Iowa, native was born April 9, 1968. He earned his B.S. degree in physical education from Iowa in 1992. He and his wife, Jeni, have three children, Madigan, Kinsee and Tommy.
