The Cy-Hawk Series is in its 13th season in 2016-17, being sponsored for the sixth time by Iowa Corn.

Iowa State leads the all-time series, 6-5-1. Last year's Cy-Hawk Series ended in a tie, with both school's earning 12 points.

Iowa captured the inaugural Cy-Hawk Series in 2004-05 (13-8), and won again in 2006-07 (13-8), 2008-09 (21-4), 2010-11 (15-11), and 2012-13 (17-9).

Iowa State won the competition in 2005-06 (13-8), 2007-08 (18-9), 2009-10 (16-11), 2011-12 (17-11), 2013-14 (14-11), and 2014-15 (15-11).

The series awards two points (except football, which is worth three) to the winning school in each head-to-head match-up between the two institutions. Additionally, one point is awarded to an institution if the graduation rate of its student-athletes is greater than the national average as reported each fall by the NCAA.

A commemorative Cy-Hawk Series Cup, which stands 31 inches tall and weighs 19 pounds, is displayed on the winning team's campus for an entire year after a victory. Replica cups are also presented as "traveling trophies" for individual victorious teams in the head-to-head competition.

ON THE MAT

The third-ranked University of Iowa wrestling team hosts Iowa State on Saturday in the annual Iowa Corn Cy-Hawk Series. The dual begins at 7 p.m. (CT) on Mediacom Mat at Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

Admission is \$15 for adults and \$10 for youth (high school age and younger). UI students and children five-years-old and younger are admitted free, but everyone must have a ticket.

DAN GABLE TRAVELING TROPHY

The Iowa-Iowa State wrestling rivalry introduced the Dan Gable Traveling Trophy in 2010.

In a joint collaboration, the schools announced the annual dual would be wrestled for a trophy representing Iowa State's former two-time NCAA Champion and Iowa's 15-time NCAA championship coach.

Iowa has won every meeting since the trophy's inception (6-0), including a 22-13 win at home in 2010, a 27-9 win in Ames in 2011, a 32-3 win in Iowa City in 2012, a 23-9 win in Ames in 2013, a 28-8 win in 2014, and a 33-6 win in Ames last season.

THE SERIES

Iowa leads Iowa State, 62-16-2, in the all-time series, and has won the last 12 meetings. The Hawkeyes are 31-5-1 all-time against the Cyclones in Iowa City.

Iowa State's last win in the series was 19-16 on Dec. 5, 2004, in Iowa City. Iowa has won five in a row at home, and 28 of the last 29. Overall, Iowa has won 52 of the last 56 meetings.

IOWA CORN CY-HAWK SERIES

The Cy-Hawk Series is in its 13th season in 2016-17, being sponsored for the sixth time by Iowa Corn.

The Cyclones lead the season series, 6-5, having secured wins in volleyball and men's and women's cross country. The Hawkeyes earned wins in football and soccer.

Iowa State leads the all-time series, 6-5-1, after a 12-12 tie in the series in 2015-16,

Iowa wrestling owns an 11-1 lead in the Cy-Hawk Series duals. The Cyclones won the first meeting in 2004, and Iowa has won the last 11. (Iowa has won 12 straight overall, including a meeting at the National Duals.)

IOWA NATIVES

The Hawkeyes have six native Iowans in their probable lineup, including Thomas Gilman (Council Bluffs), Phillip Laux (Brighton), Brandon Sorensen (Cedar Falls), Alex Meyer (Pleasant Hill), Cash Wilcke (Battle Creek), and Steven Holloway (West Burlington)

The Cyclones have six native Iowans in their probable lineup. Three matches -- 125, 149, and 197 -- could pit Iowa native against Iowa native.

The Hawkeyes have 19 total Iowa natives on their roster. The Cyclones have 20.

CY-HAWK EXPERIENCE

Sammy Brooks is making his fourth Cy-Hawk Series appearance. He wrestled at 184 in 2014 and 2015, and wrestled at 197 as a redshirt freshman in 2013. Brooks lost his Cy-Hawk debut to All-American Kyven Gadson, 3-2, in 2013. He defeated Lelund Weatherspoon, 9-1, at 184 pounds in Iowa City in 2014, and pinned Dane Pestano in 6:45 in 2015.

Thomas Gilman and Brandon Sorensen are making their third appearances in the series. Both wrestlers are 2-0. Gilman defeated Kyle Larson, 6-1, in 2014, and 12-3, in 2015. Sorensen defeated Gabe Moreno, 7-6, in 2014, and 11-3, in 2015.

Alex Meyer is the only other Hawkeye probable with Cy-Hawk experience. Meyer defeated Weatherspoon, 7-1, in 2015.

Cory Clark, who is not listed among Iowa's probables, is 3-0 all-time in the Cy-Hawk Series with three wins over Earl Hall (8-7 in 2013, 8-3 in 2014, 9-2 in 2015). Clark had started 32 consecutive duals before missing the South Dakota State dual on Dec. 2.

BRANDS 11, IOWA STATE 0

University of Iowa head coach Tom Brands is 11-0 all-time against Iowa State. During that stretch, the Hawkeyes have won by an average of 15.6 points per dual, outscoring Iowa State, 286-125. The slimmest margin of victory over the last 10 meetings was an 18-16 win in Ames in 2009. The largest margin of victory was a 32-3 win in Iowa City in 2012.

LAST MEETING: IOWA 33, IOWA STATE 6 (November 29, 2015)

AMES, Iowa -- The second-ranked University of Iowa wrestling team defeated No. 17 Iowa State, 33-6, at Hilton Coliseum in the Iowa Corn Cy-Hawk Series.

The Hawkeyes won for the 12th consecutive time in the series and retain possession of the Dan Gable Traveling Trophy.

The Hawkeyes dominated the home team in the final five bouts, scoring 26 of the final 28 takedowns and closing the dual with five straight wins, including two major decisions and two falls.

Sammy Brooks built a 22-8 lead before turning Dane Pestano at 6:45 for his third fall of the season at 184, and Sam Stoll made his Cy-Hawk debut with a pin in 3:30 against Quean Smith at 285.

Nathan Burak totaled nine takedowns in his 22-8 dismantling of Duke Egli at 197, and Thomas Gilman, typically Iowa's leadoff man, closed the dual with a 12-3 major decision against Kyle Larson at 125.

That action happened on the heels of a first half that saw Iowa State hold an 8-5 advantage in takedowns.

The Hawkeyes wrestled 19 minutes before scoring their first takedown. The dual was tied 3-3 when Brandon Sorensen got to the legs of 15th-ranked Gabe Moreno in the third period at 149. Sorensen piled on three takedowns in the final 1:24 and used two nearfall points to win, 11-3.

It was Iowa's second of three wins against top 20 wrestlers. Fourth-ranked Alex Meyer scored a pair of takedowns and rode No. 13 Lelund Weatherspoon for three and one-half minutes to win 7-1 at 174, and second-ranked Cory Clark opened the dual with a 9-2 win against No. 7 Earl Hall at 133.

It was Clark's fifth win in five career meetings with Hall, and this one came without a takedown. Clark trailed 2-0 in the opening minute before scoring the final nine points with a pair of escapes and six nearfall points.

Iowa led 10-6 at intermission behind Clark, Sorensen, and Edwin Cooper, Jr.'s 6-2 win at 157. Iowa State's only victories were decisions at 141 and 165. Logan Ryan lost 6-1 to Dante Rodriguez, and Patrick Rhoads fell 10-9 to No. 11 Tanner Weatherman at 165.

CY-HAWK SERIES DRAWS A CROWD

Four of the top five wrestling crowds at Carver-Hawkeye Arena have gathered for the Iowa-Iowa State dual.

The Hawkeyes and Cyclones set a then-NCAA attendance record when 15,955 witnessed top-ranked Iowa defeat Iowa State, 20-15, on Dec. 6, 2008. Iowa assistant coach Ryan Morningstar, ranked No. 9 in the country at 165, upset Iowa State's second-ranked Jon Reader, 2-0, in front of the packed house.

The Cyclones have been involved in 19 of the top 25 crowds at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. The Hawkeyes are 17-1-1 in those duals.

NEW YEAR'S RESOLUTION... WELCOME ALL CHALLENGERS

The third-ranked Hawkeyes ring in the new year with a schedule that includes top-ranked Oklahoma State, No. 2 Penn State, and No. 4 Ohio State. Iowa will wrestle all three opponents in that order, beginning Jan. 15 at Oklahoma State. The Nittany Lions visit Carver-Hawkeye Arena on Jan. 20, and one week later the Buckeyes are in town for a Friday night dual on Jan. 27.

Single dual tickets are \$15/\$10 (adult/youth) for duals against Iowa State (Dec. 10), Penn State (Jan. 20), and Ohio State (Jan. 27).

HAWKEYE WRESTLING HISTORY

Iowa's overall dual meet record is 978-226-31 (.799) in 107 seasons. The Hawkeyes have won 23 national titles and 35 Big Ten titles. Iowa's 53 NCAA Champions have won a total of 81 NCAA individual titles, crowning six three-time and 16 two-time champions. The Hawkeyes' 111 Big Ten champions have combined for 197 conference titles. There have been seven four-time, 18 three-time, and 29 two-time Big Ten champions from Iowa.

Iowa's 154 All-Americans have earned All-America status 319 times, including 18 four-time, 36 three-time and 40 two-time honorees.

LIGHT HEAVYWEIGHTS

Seniors Thomas Gilman and Cory Clark are both ranked No. 1 at 125 and 133 pounds, respectively.

Both wrestlers placed runner-up at the 2016 NCAA Championships and both have opened the 2016-17 season with undefeated records. Gilman is 7-0 with five falls and two technical falls. Clark is 7-0 with four pins and a technical fall. Collectively, Gilman and Clark are 167-23 (.878) all-time.

The Hawkeyes are one of three schools to have two top-rated wrestlers according to InterMat. The others include Penn State (Zain Retherford 149, Jason Nolf 149) and Ohio State (Bo Jordan 174, Kyle Snyder 285). Both schools visit Carver-Hawkeye Arena in January.

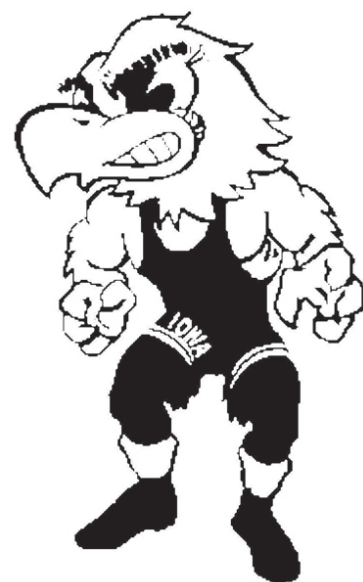

Tom Brands Head Coach University of Iowa, 1992

Three-time Big Ten Coach of the Year Tom Brands is in his 11th season as head wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. A 1996 Olympic gold medalist and member of wrestling's Hall of Fame, Brands is only the eighth wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. The former Hawkeye wrestler was a four-time All-American

and three-time national champion (1989-92) at Iowa. He has a 183-17-1 (.913) overall and 77-6 (.928) Big Ten coaching record at Iowa, and a 200-37-1 (.842) career mark.

In 10 full seasons as Iowa's head coach, Brands has led the Hawkeyes to three NCAA and four Big Ten team titles, crowning nine NCAA champions, 13 Big Ten champions and 56 All-Americans. Iowa has had 80 academic all-Big Ten recipients, including a school-record 12 in 2011-12. The Hawkeyes have qualified 91 wrestlers for the NCAA Championships in the last 10 years, sending the entire 10-man lineup in 2009, 2010, 2014, and 2015. Iowa has also won or shared eight of the last nine Big Ten regular season titles.

Iowa also made another entry in the record books, setting the national collegiate dual meet attendance record of 42,287 when Iowa defeated top-ranked Oklahoma State, 18-16, on Nov. 14, 2016 at the Grapple on the Gridiron at Kinnick Stadium. Iowa has led the nation in attendance in each of Brands' 10 seasons, setting an NCAA all-time attendance average of 12,166 in 2015-16.

Brands was named 2008 NWCA Coach of the Year after leading the Hawkeyes to their first NCAA team title since 2000 and their first Big Ten team title since 2004. He was named Big Ten Coach of the Year in 2008, 2009 and 2010, becoming the first coach in conference history to earn the honor in three consecutive seasons.

Brands served as head coach at Virginia Tech University for two seasons (2005-06), recording a 17-20 dual mark. In his first season with the Hokies, Brands led the team to the 2005 regular season Atlantic Coast Conference title, set a school record for dual meet wins (16) and had a school-record five wrestlers qualify for the NCAA Championships. During his tenure, Virginia Tech crowned five ACC champions and had two All-Americans. Senior heavy-weight Mike Faust was named 2006 ACC Wrestler of the Year.

Prior to taking the helm at Virginia Tech, Brands was an assistant coach at Iowa for 12 seasons (1993-2004). He helped the Hawkeyes to a 177-27 dual record, seven NCAA and eight Big Ten team titles, while crowning 23 NCAA champions, 73 All-Americans and 36 Big Ten champions. He was named the National Wrestling Coaches Association Assistant Coach of the Year in 2000.

In 2004, he was one of three coaches for the U.S. Olympic freestyle wrestling team, participating in Athens, and in 2016 he was named a volunteer coach of the United States Olympic team in Rio. Brands also served as assistant coach for the U.S. Freestyle World Teams in 2001, 2002, 2003, 2013, 2014, and 2015. He was named Freestyle Coach of the Year by USA Wrestling in 2002 and 2003. He has coached a number of other U.S. teams in international competition.

As a competitor, Brands won the 1996 Olympic freestyle gold medal at 136.5 pounds in Atlanta, Georgia. He also won a gold medal at the 1993 World Freestyle Championships in Toronto, two World Cup gold medals (1994, 1995) and was the 1995 Pan American Games champion. He won four U.S. National titles (1993-96) and made four straight U.S. World or Olympic teams (1993-96). Along with his twin brother, Terry, Tom was named 1993 USA Wrestling Athlete of the Year, the 1993 John Smith Outstanding Freestyle Wrestler, and 1993 Amateur Wrestling News Man of the Year. He was inducted into wrestling's Hall of Fame in 2001.

Brands was a four-time All-American at Iowa (1989-92). During his Hawkeye career, he won three NCAA titles and was named Outstanding Wrestler of the 1992 NCAA Championships. Also a three-time Big Ten champion, Brands won 95 percent of his matches at Iowa. His career mark of 158-7-2 includes an undefeated season in 1991 (45-0).

The Sheldon, Iowa, native was born April 9, 1968. He earned his B.S. degree in physical education from Iowa in 1992. He and his wife, Jeni, have three children, Madigan, Kinsee and Tommy.
