PROGRAM QUICK HITS

- Iowa has made 12 consecutive postseason appearances (10 NCAA, 2 WNIT) when a postseason tournament was held. The 2020 postseason was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- The Hawkeyes have made a postseason tournament appearance in 18 of head coach Lisa Bluder's 20 seasons at the helm of the program, receiving 14 NCAA Tournament and four WNIT (2003, 2005, 2016, 2017) bids. The Hawkeyes were ranked No. 21 in the final AP Poll
- Bluder is one of eight active Division I head coaches to win 775 games or more in her career. She enters her 37th season as a head coach and 21st at Iowa in 2020-21.
- Junior Monika Czinano was named to the Preseason All-Big Ten team.
- The Hawkeyes finished the 2019-20 season ranked in the top-15 nationally in six statistical categories, including fourth in field-goal percentage (48.5), sixth in total assists (599) and assists per game (20), 11th in scoring offense (79.5), 12th in 3-point field-goal percentage (37.2), and 15th in assist turnover ratio (1.27).
- Bluder owns a 427-226 (.654) record and a 211-130 (.619) conference mark at Iowa. In her 36 seasons as a head coach, Bluder is 783-369 (.680).

- Brooks is in his fifth year as the play-by-play announcer for the Iowa women's basketball team. He has been Iowa football's sideline reporter since 2004. He has called seven different Iowa sports on radio or television.
- Lang is in her fifth year as Iowa's color commentator. She lettered at Iowa from 2002-05. Lang finished her Hawkeye career with 1,265 points and 506 rebounds. She was a two-time All-Big Ten selection.

BIG IN THE RANKS

- Five Big Ten teams are ranked on the AP Poll, including No. 9 Maryland, No. 13 Michigan, No. 15 Ohio State, No. 18 Indiana, and No. 22 Northwestern. Michigan State is receiving 15 votes and Iowa is receiving five votes.
- The conference is represented by five schools on the USA Today/WBCA Coaches Poll, including No. 9 Maryland, No. 12 Michigan, No. 15 Ohio State, No. 18 Indiana, and No. 23 Northwestern. Iowa is receiving 25 votes and Michigan State is receiving 14 votes.

SCOUTING PURDUE

- Purdue is 5-5 on the season and 2-4 in conference play, losing three consecutive games to Michigan State, Maryland, and Indiana.
- Junior Kayana Traylor and junior Brooke Moore are averaging double figures. Traylor is putting up 15.6 points and Moore averages 10.6 points per game.
- Senior Tamara Farquhar leads the Boilermakers with 7.2 rebounds per game, and redshirt senior Fatou Diagne follows, averaging 6.8 rebounds per game.

THE SERIES

- Purdue leads the all-time series, 40-33, splitting the last 10 matchups, 5-5.
- Last season, the two teams met once inside Mackey Arena. The Hawkeyes came out on top, winning 83-71.
- Junior Monika Czinano recorded 20 points and four rebounds, while sophomore McKenna Warnock added five rebounds and two points.

HAWKS ON THE SEASON

- Iowa is 8-3 on the season and 4-3 in conference play, losing its most recent contest in overtime to No. 15 Ohio State, 82-84.
- Freshman Caitlin Clark leads the Hawkeyes, averaging 25.7 points. Junior Monika Czinano and sophomore McKenna Warnock follow, averaging 19.2 and 13.1 points per game, respectively.
- Warnock leads the Hawkeyes in rebounds, averaging 9.2 per game, while Clark, Czinano, and redshirt sophomore Kate Martin follow with 6.9, 5.7, and 4.0 per game, respectively.
- Sophomore Gabbie Marshall is leading Iowa with 25 steals, Clark's 18 steals and Martin's 15 follow on the season. Against Western Illinois (Dec. 22), Marshall recorded six steals – the most from a Hawkeye this season.
- Clark recorded her first collegiate triple-double against Western Illinois, tallying 13 points, 13 rebounds, and 10 assists. Clark is the first Hawkeye to reach the accomplishment since Sam Logic against Baylor (March 27, 2015) and marks the 10th triple-double in program history, which tied the second-most in the NCAA.
- Clark has recorded four double-doubles on the season, including Western Illinois (Dec. 22), accomplishing her first career double-double against in-state opponent, Drake, with 30 points and 13 assists. The freshman's third double-double was achieved against Minnesota (Jan. 6, 2021) included a career-high 37 points and 11 rebounds, and her most recent against Ohio State included 27 points and 10 rebounds.
- Warnock has four career double-doubles, adding two this season. She recorded her third career double-double, tallying 14 points and 13 rebounds in Iowa's win over Northern Iowa and her fourth against Ohio State with 14 points and 12 rebounds.
- Czinano's field goal percentage (.929) at No. 22/23 Northwestern is a Big Ten Record with a minimum of 12 attempts in a Big Ten contest, shooting 13-of-14 against the Wildcats. On three occasions, a Big Ten women's basketball player has made 12-of-13 (.917) – the last being Indiana's Quacy Barnes on Feb. 22, 1998 against Michigan State.

NATIONALLY SPEAKING

- As a team, Iowa is ranked in top-20 nationally in seven statistical categories, including ranking third in field goal percentage (.505), fourth in scoring offense (88.9), fifth in assists per game (20), sixth in total assists (220), 18th in assist-turnover ratio (1.31), 19th in 3-point percentage (.380), and 20th in free-throw percentage (.774).
- Freshman Caitlin Clark is one of six women's basketball players to record a triple-double this season, posting 13 points, 13 rebounds, and 10 assists against Western Illinois (Dec. 22, 2020). Indiana's Grace Berger is the only women's basketball player to record two this season.
- Clark and junior Monika Czinano rank among the top 15 nationally in 12 statistical categories, including Clark ranking second in double-doubles (1), eighth in field goals made (94), ninth in assists per game (6.4), 10th in field-goal attempts (205), 11th in 3-pointers attempted (92) and 3-pointers made (34), and 12th in free-throws made (61).

RANKING BIG INDIVIDUALS

- Freshman Caitlin Clark leads the Big Ten in eight statistical categories, including points per game (25.7), total assists (70), total points (283), field goals made (94), assists per game (6.4), field goals attempted (205), 3-pointers attempted (92), and free-throws made (61).
- Clark is ranked second in five additional statistical categories, including triple doubles (1), 33-pointers made (34), 3-pointers per game (3.09), free-throw attempts (73), and double-doubles (4). She also ranks fifth in free-throw percentage (.836).
- Sophomore McKenna Warnock is leading the conference in defensive rebounds per game (7.9), ranks second in 3-point percentage (.488), rebounds per game (9.2), and total rebounds (92), and ranks fifth in 3-pointers made (20).
- Junior Monika Czinano leads the conference in field-goal percentage (.685), ranks third in field goals made (89) and total points (211), and fifth in points per game (19.2).
- Sophomore Gabbie Marshall ranks second in the conference in steals (25).

BIG STANDINGS

- As a team, the Hawkeyes are leading the Big Ten Conference in three statistical categories, including field-goal percentage (.505), total assists (220), and 3-pointers attempted (255).
- Iowa ranks second in scoring offense (88.9), assists per game (20), 3-point percentage (.380), 3-pointers made (97), 3-pointers per game (8.8), free throws made (171), and free throw attempts (221).
- The Hawkeyes rank third in free-throw percentage (.774) and rebound margin (4.5).

YOU SERIOUS, CLARK?

- Caitlin Clark recorded her first collegiate triple-double against Western Illinois (Dec. 22), tallying 13 points, 13 rebounds, and 10 assists. Clark is the first Hawkeye to reach the accomplishment since Sam Logic against Baylor (March 27, 2015) and

HEAD COACH LISA BLUDER

Lisa Bluder, the all-time winningest coach in program history, is in her 21st year as head women's basketball coach at the University of Iowa and her 37th year overall. Under her direction, the Hawkeyes have advanced to 18 postseason appearances (14 NCAA and four WNIT) in 20 seasons, including NCAA Tournament berths in 10 of the last 12 seasons. Iowa advanced to the postseason in 12 consecutive seasons (10 NCAA and two WNIT) prior to the 2020 pandemic that cut the 2019-20 season short.

- In Bluder's first year at Iowa, the 2000-01 Hawkeyes finished second in the Big Ten. The Hawkeyes knocked off Indiana, Illinois, and Purdue to win the first Big Ten Tournament crown under Bluder.

- Clark was the first Big Ten freshman to be named the ESPN National Player of the Week on Dec. 14.
- The NCAA has named Clark to the NCAA Starting five – a list of the top five women's basketball players for the week – on Dec. 9 and Dec. 30.
- Clark is nationally ranked third in field goal percentage (.505), fourth in scoring offense (88.9), fifth in assists per game (20), sixth in total assists (220), 18th in assist-turnover ratio (1.31), 19th in 3-point percentage (.380), and 20th in free-throw percentage (.774).
- In the conference, Clark leads in eight statistical categories, including points per game (25.7), total assists (70), total points (283), field goals made (94), assists per game (6.4), field goals attempted (205), 3-pointers attempted (92), and free-throws made (61). Clark ranks second in five additional statistical categories, including triple doubles (1), 33-pointers made (34), 3-pointers per game (3.09), free-throw attempts (73), and double-doubles (4). She also ranks fifth in free-throw percentage (.836).
- Clark has recorded four double-doubles, including a triple-double this season and recorded four 30-point games, including a collegiate-best 37 points in Iowa's win over Minnesota (Jan. 6).
- Clark is the only freshman since 2015-16 to put up 30 points and have at least 10 assists in a single game. At Drake, Clark tallied 30 points and 13 assists.
- Clark's 13 assists against Drake (Dec. 2) are the most from a Big Ten Freshman since Maryland's Destiny Slocum had 13 against Illinois on February 9, 2017.

THEY'RE KIND OF A BIG DEAL

- Freshman Caitlin Clark is the second Big Ten freshman to win both awards – Big Ten Player of the Week and Freshman of the Week – three times, in a season. The first to accomplish the milestone was Minnesota's Amanda Zahui during the 2013-14 season.
- Clark has accumulated nine weekly honors this season – three Player of the week honors and six Freshman of the Week honors..
- Sophomore McKenna Warnock earned her second Big Ten honor of her career, the conference announced on Jan. 4. Her first was a Freshman of the Week honor, on Jan. 27, 2020.
- Clark averaged 24.5 points, five rebounds, five assists, and 1.5 steals in a pair of Big Ten matchups against Rutgers and Illinois. In Iowa's win over Rutgers, 90-84, Clark scored 12 of the Hawkeyes' final 21 points. She followed up her Rutgers performance by scoring 21 points in 26 minutes of play at Illinois.
- Warnock played solid games against Rutgers and Illinois, averaging 18 points, eight rebounds, and two assists. From the field, she shot 72.2 percent and from 3-point range, she shot 69.2. The Marshall, Wisconsin, native recorded a career-high five 3-pointers against the Scarlet Knights, knocking down four in the first quarter.
- Clark swept the Big Ten Women's Basketball Player and Freshman of the Week awards for the third time on Dec. 28.

THE CAITLIN CLARK AWARD

- Freshman Caitlin Clark has been named Freshman of the Week six times this season – the most recent was announced on Jan. 11. Clark has been awarded the Freshman honor every week that the Hawkeyes have had a contest.
- The West Des Moines, Iowa, native averaged 22.5 points, 6.5 rebounds, and 6.5 assists in a pair of Big Ten matchups against Minnesota and Northwestern. In Iowa's win over Minnesota, Clark recorded her third-career double-double, scoring a career-high 37 points and pulled down 11 rebounds. Against Northwestern, she added eight assists and eight rebounds.
- Clark averaged 24.5 points, five rebounds, five assists, and 1.5 steals in a pair of Big Ten matchups against Rutgers and Illinois. In Iowa's win over Rutgers, 90-84, Clark scored 12 of the Hawkeyes' final 21 points. She followed up her Rutgers performance by scoring 21 points in 26 minutes of play at Illinois.
- Clark registered her first career triple-double against Western Illinois on Dec. 22, tallying 13 points, 13 rebounds, and 10 assists. She filled her stat line, adding three steals and a block in the matchup with the Leathernecks. Clark's triple-double was the first from a Hawkeye since Sam Logic against Baylor (March 27, 2015) and the 10th in program history.
- Clark averaged 34.5 points, seven rebounds, five assists, 1.5 steals, and a block against No. RV/24 Iowa State and Michigan State. In Iowa's comeback win over Iowa State, Clark made the game-winning shot with 22 seconds remaining on a deep, step-back 3-pointer, giving the Hawkeyes their fifth-consecutive win over the Cyclones. She scored 34 points, pulled in seven rebounds, dished out six assists, and registered two steals against the in-state rivals. Against Michigan State, Clark posted a career-high 35 points and two blocks, and added seven rebounds, four assists, and a steal to fill her stat line.
- Clark averaged 26.5 points, nine assists, four rebounds, and 2.5 steals in the Hawkeyes wins over Drake and Wisconsin. In Iowa's in-state bout versus Drake, Clark tallied 30 points, 13 assists, four steals, three rebounds, and a block. Against Wisconsin, she posted 23 points, five assists, five rebounds, and a steal.
- Clark scored 27 points, pulled down eight rebounds, dished out four assists, registered three steals, and was a perfect 4-for-4 from the free-throw line - believed to be the best debut for a Hawkeye freshman. Clark's 27 points are the most in a Big Ten debut since Maryland junior Eleanna Christinaki had 32 points in a win over Coppin State (Dec. 20, 2017). Her 27 points are believed to be the most in a Big Ten freshmen debut since Illinois' Robin Precacely had 27 points against Illinois State (Dec. 1, 1992).

- With X games left in the regular season, Caitlin Clark is XX points away from breaking onto the freshman all-time scoring list. Former Hawkeye Jennie Lillis is ranked 10th with 333 points as a freshman (2001-02).

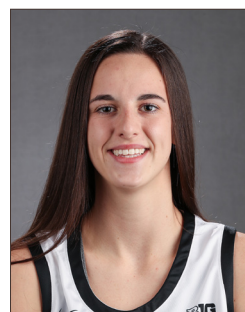
