BACK POINTS

- Iowa has won 15 straight overall and 20 consecutive Big Ten duals.
- Tom Brands is 9-0 all-time against Illinois.
- Iowa leads the all-time series 52-26-1 and has won the last nine meetings.
- Spencer Lee is 24-0 all-time in Big Ten duals and has won 25 straight overall.
- The 10 ranked wrestlers in Iowa's probable lineup have a combined career record of 144-18 in Big Ten duals.
- Iowa All-Americans and Illinois natives Abe Assad (184), Jacob Warner (197) and Tony Cassioppi (285) combined to win seven Illinois high school state championships (Assad 2, Warner 3, Cassioppi 2).



Tolono, Illinois, native Jacob Warner was a three-time state champion at Washington High School. Warner, a two-time All-American at 197, is 2-0 all-time against the Illini, including a 6-1 decision against Matt Wroblewski at the 2018 Midlands.

ON THE MAT
The top-ranked University of Iowa wrestling team hosts No. 10 Illinois on Sunday at 11 a.m. (CT) at Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

FOLLOW THE HAWKEYES
Sunday's dual is televised live on BTN and available at FoxSports.com and the Fox Sports mobile app.
Iowa will make seven appearances on BTN this season, including duals against Nebraska, Minnesota, Illinois, Ohio State, Penn State and Wisconsin, and the Big Ten Championships at Penn State on March 6-7. Starts times and the BTN Plus schedule have not yet been released.

THE SERIES — ILLINOIS
Iowa leads the all-time series 52-26-1 and has won the last nine meetings. The Hawkeyes won the last meeting, 31-8, on Jan. 25, 2019, in Champaign.
Iowa is 23-9-1 at home in the all-time series. Illinois has not won in Iowa City since Feb. 10, 2006 (24-13). That was the Illini's last win in the series.
Iowa head coach Tom Brands is 9-0 all-time against Illinois.

WINNING STREAK
Iowa has won 15 straight overall and 20 consecutive Big Ten duals. Iowa has won 17 straight at Carver-Hawkeye Arena.
The Hawkeyes' 15-dual winning streak is the second longest active streak in the country behind North Carolina State (21).
Iowa's Big Ten winning streak is its longest since winning 24 straight from 2014-17.
Iowa's 17-dual winning streak at Carver-Hawkeye Arena is its longest since winning 38 straight from 2008-12. The Hawkeyes' last loss at Carver-Hawkeye Arena was Jan. 27, 2018 (19-17 versus No. 7 Michigan).

HOME SWEET HOME
Top-ranked Spencer Lee is 19-0 all-time at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. In Lee's 19 home wins, he has five pins, eight technical falls and three major decisions. Five of the wins are against top 10 opponents.

TOP HEAVY
Iowa has 10 wrestlers ranked in the top eight of the national polls, more than any other school.
The Hawkeyes have three wrestlers ranked at the top of their respective weight class. Spencer Lee (125), Jaydin Eierman (141) and Michael Kemerer (174) are all ranked No. 1. No other school has more than one wrestler ranked No. 1 or better.

QUICK WORK
Top-ranked Spencer Lee has outscored his opponents 2-0 in three minutes and 14 seconds of mat time. Lee opened the season with a fall in one minute, 21 seconds, and ended his last match with a fall in one minute, 53 seconds. He led 6-0 in his first match and 14-0 in his second match before securing the pins.
Since the start of the 2019-20 season, Lee has outscored his 20 opponents 254-18.

TOP 10 MATCHUP -- 149 POUNDS
Fifth-ranked Max Murin faces No. 8 Michael Carr. It is the fourth matchup between the two, but the first at 149 pounds.
Murin holds a 2-1 advantage in three previous meetings, all at 141. He defeated Carr, 3-1, as a true freshman at the 2016 Midlands and won the most recent meeting, 3-1, at the 2019 Big Ten Championships. Carr's lone win was a 6-3 decision at Illinois in a 2019 dual.
Murin is 2-0 this year with two ranked wins. He is 14-12 all-time against ranked opponents. Carr is 3-1 overall in 2021.

TOP 10 MATCHUP -- 285 POUNDS
No. 3 Tony Cassioppi faces No. 5 Luke Loffman. Cassioppi in the first career meeting between the two.
Cassioppi is 1-1 this year with one ranked win and a loss to No. 1 Gable Steveson. Loffman is 4-0 with a pair of wins over ranked opponents.
Cassioppi is 10-4 all-time against ranked opponents, with three losses to Steveson and a third to Michigan's Mason Paris.

TRUE TEST

Iowa freshmen Bretli Reyna and Patrick Kennedy are listed in Iowa's probable lineup. Kennedy made his collegiate debut Jan. 15 and fell, 7-4, to No. 4 Mikey Labriola of Nebraska. Both wrestlers competed in "extra" matches on Jan. 22 at Minnesota.

Kennedy is the third true freshman in the last four seasons to wrestle in a varsity dual for Iowa. Spencer Lee pulled his redshirt and entered the lineup Jan. 15, 2018, and pinned Michigan State's Rayvon Foley in 46 seconds. Lee went on to win the 2018 NCAA title.

On Jan. 10, 2020, Abe Assad removed his redshirt and defeated Indiana's Jake Hinz, 6-2. Assad finished the season 22-7, was seeded 11th at the NCAA Championships and earned All-America honors. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, no wrestler will lose a season of eligibility in the 2021 wrestling season.

NEW KID IN TOWN

Senior Jaydin Eierman is 2-0 in his young career as a Hawkeye. Eierman won by 8-4 decision against No. 7 Chad Red on Jan. 15 in his Hawkeye debut. He improved to 27-12 all-time against ranked opponents. He defeated Marco Polanco by 22-9 major decision Jan. 22 at Minnesota.

Eierman transferred to Iowa in 2020 from the University of Missouri, where he was a three-time All-American. Eierman placed fifth at the NCAA Championships as a freshman, fourth as a sophomore and third as a junior in 2019. He used an Olympic redshirt in 2019-20. Eierman has a career record of 91-11. He was the 2019 MAC Wrestler of the Year and 2017 MAC Freshman of the Year.

HAWKEYES AND CARVER-HAWKEYE ARENA

Iowa is 113-12 (.904) at Carver-Hawkeye Arena since Tom Brands took over the program prior to 2006-07. The Hawkeyes are 263-25 (.913) all-time at Carver-Hawkeye Arena since moving from the UI Field House in 1983. Iowa was 7-0 at home in 2019-20, completing its 22nd undefeated season in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

Carver-Hawkeye Arena has hosted two United States Olympic Team Trials, four Big Ten Championships (1983, 1994, 2005, 2016) and four NCAA Championships (1986, 1991, 1995, 2001). The Hawkeyes have won five tournament titles on their home mat, including the 1983 and 1994 Big Ten Championships, and the 1986, 1991 and 1995 NCAA Championships.

In 2018, the University of Iowa hosted the UWW World Cup, an international dual tournament featuring eight of the top countries in the world.

LEE EARNS BIG TEN WEEKLY HONORS

Senior Spencer Lee was recognized on consecutive weeks as Big Ten Co-Wrestler of the Week. Lee first earned the honor on Jan. 19. Lee after opening the 2021 season with a first-period fall against Indiana's 11th-ranked Liam Cronin on Jan. 15. Lee led 6-0 before securing the fall in one minute, 21 seconds. Lee was honored one week later after pinning Minnesota's ninth-ranked Mitch McKee in 1:53. Lee led 14-0 before securing that fall. The pins were No. 22 and 23 of Lee's career, his 17th and 18th in the first period.

Head Coach

University of Iowa, 1992

Four-time Big Ten and two-time NWCA Coach of the Year Tom Brands is in his 15th season as head wrestling coach at the University of Iowa in 2020-21. A 1996 Olympic gold medalist and member of wrestling's Hall of Fame, Brands is only the eighth head wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. The former Hawkeye wrestler was a four-time All-American and three-time national champion (1989-92) at Iowa. He has a 233-23-1 (.908) overall and 110-10 (.915) Big Ten coaching record at Iowa. He has a 250-43-1 (.851) career mark and a 113-12 (.904) record at Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

In 14 completed seasons as Iowa's head coach, Brands has led the Hawkeyes to three NCAA and five Big Ten team titles, crowning 12 NCAA champions, 19 Big Ten champions and 82 All-Americans. Iowa has had 129 Academic All-Big Ten recipients, including a school-record 17 in 2019-20. The Hawkeyes have qualified 128 wrestlers for the NCAA Championships in the last 14 years, sending the entire 10-man lineup in 2010, 2014, 2015, and 2020. Iowa has won or shared the Big Ten regular season title 10 times in Brands' 14 seasons.

Iowa set the national collegiate dual meet attendance record of 42,287 when Iowa defeated top-ranked Oklahoma State, 18-16, on Nov. 14, 2015 at the Grapple on the Gridiron at Kinnick Stadium. Iowa has led the nation in attendance in each of Brands' 14 seasons, setting an NCAA all-time attendance average of 12,568 in 2019-20.

Brands has twice been named NWCA National Coach of the Year. He was first honored in 2008 after leading the Hawkeyes to their first NCAA team title since 2000 and their first Big Ten team title since 2004. He was later recognized in 2020, when the top-ranked Hawkeyes won Big Ten regular season and tournament championships and entered the NCAA Championships as the favorite to win the team title. The tournament was canceled due to the CO-

VID-19 pandemic.

Brands was named Big Ten Coach of the Year in 2008, 2009, 2010, and 2020. He is the only coach in program history to earn the award four times.

Brands served as head coach at Virginia Tech University for two seasons (2005-06), recording a 17-20 dual mark. In his first season with the Hokies, Brands led the team to the 2005 regular season Atlantic Coast Conference title, set a school record for dual meet wins (16) and had a school-record five wrestlers qualify for the NCAA Championships.

Prior to taking the helm at Virginia Tech, Brands was an assistant coach at Iowa for 12 seasons (1993-2004). He helped the Hawkeyes to a 177-27 dual record, seven NCAA and eight Big Ten team titles, while crowning 23 NCAA champions, 73 All-Americans and 36 Big Ten champions. He was named the National Wrestling Coaches Association Assistant Coach of the Year in 2000.

In 2004, he was one of three coaches for the U.S. Olympic freestyle wrestling team, participating in Athens, and in 2016 he was named a volunteer coach of the United States Olympic team in Rio. Brands also served as assistant coach for the U.S. Freestyle World Teams in 2001, 2002, 2003, 2013, 2014, and 2015. He was named Freestyle Coach of the Year by USA Wrestling in 2002 and 2003. He has coached a number of other U.S. teams in international competition.

As a competitor, Brands won the 1996 Olympic freestyle gold medal at 136.5 pounds in Atlanta, Georgia. He also won a gold medal at the 1993 World Championships in Toronto, two World Cup gold medals (1994, 1995) and was the 1995 Pan American Games champion. He won four U.S. National titles (1993-96) and made four straight U.S. World or Olympic teams (1993-96). Along with his twin brother, Terry, Tom was named 1993 USA Wrestling Athlete of the Year, the 1993 John Smith Outstanding Freestyle Wrestler, and 1993 Amateur Wrestling News Man of the Year. He was inducted into wrestling's Hall of Fame in 2001.

Brands was a four-time All-American at Iowa (1989-92). During his Hawkeye career, he won three NCAA titles and was named Outstanding Wrestler of the 1992 NCAA Championships. Also a three-time Big Ten champion, Brands won 95 percent of his matches at Iowa. His career mark of 158-7-2 includes an undefeated season in 1991 (45-0).

The Sheldon, Iowa, native was born April 9, 1968. He earned his B.S. degree in physical education from Iowa in 1992. He and his wife, Jeni, have three adult children, Madigan, Kinsee and Tommy.
