THIS WEEK

The University of Iowa rowing team will begin the season in Merritt Island, Florida, facing Southern Methodist on March 4 and 7. The pair of races are scrimmages.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

- The Hawkeyes 2020 spring season was cancelled last March due to the global COVID-19 pandemic.
- Thursday will be the first time Iowa competes on the water since a scrimmage at Old Dominion on March 1, 2020. That is 368 days without rowing for the Hawkeyes.

2019 RECAP

- Iowa's 1V8 placed third at the 2019 Big Ten Championships, helping Iowa to qualify for its third consecutive NCAA Championship appearance.
- At nationals, the 1V8 finished ninth overall for the highest finish by an Iowa boat in program history.
- Iowa had three finishes inside the top sixteen at the 2019 NCAA Championship
 - Eve Stewart - I Eights Petite Final - 9th - 06:15.619
 - Nina Lawrence - Fours C Final - 15th - 07:17.531
 - Rachel Canon - II Eights C Final - 16th - 06:32.721

2020 ROSTER BREAKDOWN

- The Hawkeyes roster this year features girls from four countries: USA (50), Canada (3), England (2), Italy (1).
- 13 different states are represented on the Iowa roster.

HEAD COACH ANDREW CARTER



Andrew Carter was named the third head coach in program history for the University of Iowa rowing program in July 2013.

Carter has led Iowa to the NCAA Championships in each of the last three seasons, securing just the third and fourth championship appearances in school history. The Hawkeyes have improved one spot in the conference standings in each of Carter's five years at the Big Ten Championships.

During his coaching career, Carter has earned more than 50 championship medals, and over the last 15 years, he has coached nine All-Americans and 41 National Scholar-Athletes.
