THIS WEEK

The University of Iowa men's and women's cross country teams return to action after an off week, following the Dirksen-Greeno Invite. The Hawkeyes hit the road for the second time this season as they travel to Cloumbia, Missouri, for the Gans Creek Classic at the Gans Creek Cross Country Course on Friday. The men's 8,000-meter race begins at 9 a.m. (CT) with the women's 6,000 meters to follow at 9:45 a.m. (CT).

IN THE RANKINGS

The University of Iowa men's cross country team is ranked No. 12 in the USTFCCCA Midwest Region week three poll, and the Hawkeye women head into the weekend ranked ninth in the region. In the USTFCCCA Week Three National rankings, Wisconsin sits atop the Big Ten men's side as the nation's 14th-ranked squad, and is joined in the top 30 by four additional Big Ten squads. Six Big Ten women's teams occupy spots in the national top 30, led by Minnesota at No. 7.

GANS CREEK CROSS COUNTRY COURSE

The Gans Creek Cross Country Course opened on Sept. 27, 2019. Located on the south side of Columbia, Missouri, the 320-acre park is a state-of-the-art facility. Course features include a 500-meter starting chute, an irrigated 10-meter wide running surface and an elevated viewing area for spectators. The course is set to host the 2021 SEC Championships.

LAST TIME OUT...

The Hawkeye women claimed the Division I team title at the Dirksen-Greeno Invite on Sept. 18, edging out Nebraska by a 38-41 margin in the 5K race. The trio of Kelli Tosic, Emma Gordon and Booke McKee finished 6-7-8 to lead lowa to the win. Freshmen Lauren McMahon and Miriam Sandeen rounded out scoring for the Hawkeyes, finishing 10th and 12th, respectively. On the men's side, sophomore Nick Trattner led the way for the second-consecutive race to open the season for Iowa, finishing sixth in the Division I 8K race to help the Hawkeyes to a third-place team finish. Senior Noah Healy finished eighth for his second top-10 finish of the season, while Kal Lewis (25th), Ian Geisler (26th) and Jeff Roberts (28th) rounded out the scoring for the Hawkeyes.

TRATTNER MAKING HISTORY

Nick Trattner is the first underclassmen in over a decade to lead the Hawkeye men for the first two races of the season since Jeff Thode in 2010. Trattner finished third at the Hawkeye Invite and sixth at the Dirksen-Greeno Invite. Thode brought home one third place finish and one victory during those two races and went on to lead the Hawkeyes in every race that season. Thode is one of the most decorated Hawkeves in history, recording two individual National Championship appearances and one All-American honor in 2010 placing 30th.



MEN'S TOP RUNNERS

Senior Noah Healy is back for his fourth cross country season with the Hawkeyes. In 2019, Healy was lowa's second finisher at the Midwest Regional, running a collegiate-best 10K in 31:58. Healy has started his 2021 campaign with a pair of top-eight finishes at the Hawkeye Invite and Dirksen-Greeno Invite. Sophomore Max Murphy will look to build upon a top-55 finish at the Big Ten Championship in his freshman campaign. Sophomore Nick Trattner finished second at the 2021 Hawkeye Invite on Sept. 3 to lead Iowa to a team win in the season opener, and was the leading Hawkeye again at the Dirksen-Greeno Invite on Sept. 18, finishing sixth in the 8K-race.

WOMEN'S TOP RUNNERS

Junior Gabby Skopec returns for her third cross country season at Iowa. At the Big Ten Championships in 2020, Skopec was the top finisher for the Hawkeyes, running the 6K in 21:15 – good for a spot in the top 50. Sophomore Kelli Tosic finished 61st in the same race in 22:06 – a freshman at the time, it was the first race of Tosic's career. Tosic was the team's top finisher on Sept. 3 at the Hawkeye Invite, and again on Sept. 18 at the Dirksen-Greeno Invite, helping the Hawkeyes to a team win in Lincoln. Junior Leah Kralovetz was an All-Region honoree in 2019 after a 16th-place finish. The junior was the top finisher for the Hawkeyes in three races that season.

HAWKEYE NEWCOMERS

The University of Iowa cross country team added 16 student-athletes to its 2021 roster. Six men join the Hawkeyes: Will Arbanas, Jack Gschwendtner, Isaac Hartman, Blake Hayden, Colin Hill and Yohana Yual. On the women's side, the ten new Hawkeyes include Laney Fitzpatrick, Jaiden Itson, Kaitlin Knape, Lauren McMahon, Sarah Murphy, Miriam Sandeen, Lillian Schmidt, Chloe Skidmore, Sam Strauss, and Kathryn Vortherms.

HAWKEYE STATE

Of the 30 women on Iowa's roster, 21 hail from the Hawkeye State. Seven additional states, including Wisconsin (2), Illinois, Indiana, Michigan, Minnesota, Kansas, and Texas are represented, as well as Japan. On the men's side, four of the 17 members are from Iowa. Illinois is represented by 7 student-athletes, while Wisconsin is the home of three Hawkeyes. Missouri, New York and New Jersey are each represented with one student-athlete.

NEXT UP FOR THE HAWKEYES

The Hawkeyes head to Peoria, Illinois, to compete at the Bradley Pink Classic on Friday, Oct. 15, with racing set to gun at 1:30 p.m. (CT).
