University of Iowa wrestling team competes at No. 6 Ohio State on Friday at 7 p.m. at the Covelli Center in Columbus, Ohio. The dual is televised live on BTN.

FOLLOW THE HAWKEYES

Friday's dual is televised live on BTN and available at FoxSports.com and the Fox Sports mobile app.

Iowa will make eight appearances on BTN this season, including duals against Minnesota, Purdue, Penn State, and Wisconsin, road duals at Illinois, Ohio State, and Nebraska.

The Big Ten Championships at Nebraska on March 5-6 are also televised on BTN.

THE SERIES -- OHIO STATE

Iowa leads the all-time series against Ohio State, 41-4. The schools split the first four meetings, 2-2, before Iowa rattled off 34 consecutive victories from 1967-2011. Ohio State ended the streak with a 21-9 win in 2012 at Columbus.

lowa is 18-3 all-time in Columbus. The Buckeyes won the last meeting in Columbus, 22-12, on Jan. 21, 2018.

The Hawkeyes won the last meeting, 24-10, on Jan. 24 at Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

lowa head coach Tom Brands is 9-2 all-time against Ohio State.

NATIONAL RANKINGS

The defending NCAA champion Hawkeyes opened the season ranked No. 1 in the NWCA Coaches Poll and ran their streak atop the polls to 28 straight weeks before dropping to the No. 2 spot on Jan. 11, 2022.

The 28-week stretch ranked No. 1 in the country was the longest since lowa spent 38 weeks at the top of the rankings from Jan. 15, 2008, until Feb. 23, 2010. (The poll started weekly rankings in 1997. Bi-weekly and monthly rankings started in 1960).

Since 1960, the Hawkeyes have appeared at the top spot of the national poll 220 times.

WINNING STREAKS

Iowa has won 28 straight overall and 22 straight at Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

The Hawkeyes' 28-dual winning streak is the longest active streak in the country.

lowa's 22-dual winning streak at Carver-Hawkeye Arena is its longest since winning 38 straight from 2008-12. The Hawkeyes' last loss at Carver-Hawkeye Arena was Jan. 27, 2018 (19-17 versus No. 7 Michigan).

lowa has won 27 consecutive Big Ten duals, its longest conference streak since winning 39 straight from 2007-12.

TOP 10 MATCHUPS

Friday's dual features three top 10 matchups, including 149, 165 and 174 pounds.

Max Murin climbed back into the top 10 at 149. He is ranked 10th following a pair of victories last weekend, including a 4-3 decision over No. 4 Yahya Thomas of Northwestern and a 9-3 win at Illinois. Murin faces No. 2 Sammy Sasso on Friday. Sasso won by fall (6:53) in the only previous matchup, a 2021 dual in West Lafayette, Indiana. Murin is 20-18 all-time against ranked opponents, with four wins over top-five opponents.

Top-ranked Alex Marinelli and No. 7 Carson Kharchla meet at 165 pounds. Marinelli is 42-10 all-time against ranked opponents, including a 16-10 career mark against the top 10. Friday is the first career meeting between Marinelli and Kharchla.

No. 2 Michael Kemerer takes a 46-8 career record against ranked opponents into his match with No. 7 Ethan Smith. Kemerer is 23-8 all-time against the top 10. Friday is the first career meeting between Kemerer and Smith.

TRUE FRESHMAN HISTORY

Freshman Drake Ayala made his official collegiate debut Jan. 7 against Minnesota. He became the fifth Hawkeye in the Tom Brands era to wrestle as a true freshman, and just the third to wrestle in his first year removed from high school (Spencer Lee 2018; Abe Assad 2020; Drake Ayala 2022).

Nathan Burak (2013) and Justin Stickley (2017) wrestled as true freshmen but both deferred college enrollment by one year after graduating high school.

Lee won a national title as a redshirt freshman in 2018. He supplemented Stickley in the lineup following the Midlands Championships.

Assad was named a NWCA All-American as a true freshman in 2020. He was 22-7 entering the NCAA Championships, which were eventually canceled due to covid.

Burak reached the NCAA Championships round of 12 as a freshman in 2013. He finished the season 20-17 and went on to earn three All-America honors.

MARINELLI CLIMBS TO NO. 1

Senior Alex Marinelli debuted at No. 2 in the preseason polls but has since climbed to the top spot at 165.

Marinelli has entered the NCAA Championships as the No. 1 seeded wrestler in each of the last three years. He has an 88-10 career record, including a 49-1 record in duals and a 15-0 record in nonconference duals. He is 23-1 all-time at Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

BONUS POINTS OR BUST

Senior Austin DeSanto is 11-0 with a team-high seven technical falls. DeSanto has 34 career technical falls. He has scored 20 points or more in five of his 11 wins and has 26 career matches of scoring 20 points or more.

DUAL DOMINANT

The nine All-Americans in Iowa's lineup have a combined record of 314-46 (.872) in career duals, including a 191-23 (.897) mark in Big Ten duals.

Senior Jaydin Eierman is 52-5 all-time in dual competition, including a perfect 13-0 record at lowa. Eiermran is undefeated in 26 conference duals. He was 19-0 at Missouri from 2016-19 and is 7-0 since joining the Big Ten in 2020.

Senior Michael Kemerer has 49 career dual victories, including a 33-1 mark in Big Ten duals. Kemerer is 49-1 all-time in duals, with his one loss coming as a redshirt freshman in 2017. He has won 41 straight dual appearances.

Senior Alex Marinelli is 48-1 all-time in dual meets, including a 30-1 mark in Big Ten duals. He has won 15 straight dual matches.

Senior Austin DeSanto is 45-4 all-time in duals, including a 19-1 mark in the Big Ten.

HAWKEYE WRESTLING HISTORY

The Hawkeyes have won 24 national titles and 37 Big Ten titles. Iowa's 55 NCAA champions have won a total of 85 NCAA individual titles, crowning seven three-time and 16 two-time champions. The Hawkeyes' 117 Big Ten champions have combined for 207 conference titles. There have been seven four-time, 19 three-time, and 31 two-time Big Ten champions from Iowa. Iowa's 161 All-Americans have earned All-America status 352 times, including 22 four-time, 40 three-time and 41 two-time honorees.

OLYMPIC, WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP BLOODLINES

Junior Nelson Brands and freshman Wyatt Henson have Olympic bloodlines. Nelson's father, Terry, was an Olympic bronze medalist in 2000. His uncle, Tom, won Olympic gold in 1996. Terry was a World Champion in 1993 and 1995. Tom won a World Championship in 1993.

Freshman Wyatt Henson is the son of Olympic silver medalist and World Champion Sammie Henson. Sammie was a teammate of Terry Brands on the 2000 United States Olympic team. He won an Olympic silver medal in 2000 and a World Championship in 1998.

OPEN TOURNAMENT TITLES

lowa wrestlers have won 14 open tournament titles in 2021-22.

Four lowa wrestlers won championships in their respective divisions Nov. 29 at the Harold Nichols Open, including Drake Ayala (125), Wyatt Henson (141), Patrick Kennedy (165) and Aaron Costello (285).

Ayala pinned his first two opponents and won the title match by major decision to win the Freshman/Sophomore Division in his college debut.

Kennedy started the day with a pin and then won by technical fall in his next two matches in the 165-pound Open Division, capturing his first tournament title of the season.

Costello rallied off three straight wins by decision to top the 285 Open Division.

Henson was 3-0 on the day, including a 32-16 technical fall in the opening round. He improved to 12-0 this season with three tournament titles.

Redshirt freshman Cullan Schriever and freshman Henson won titles Nov. 20 at the 2021 Lindenwood Open. Schriever went 3-0 with a technical fall and a pin to win the 133-pound Gold Division. Henson won twice by fall and added a major decision to win the 141-pound Black Division.

lowa opened the 2021-22 season winning eight titles Nov. 13 at the Luther Open. Seven lowa wrestlers won championships in the Elite Division, including Jesse Ybarra (125), Austin DeSanto (133), Jaydin Eierman (141), Cobe Siebrecht (149), Kaleb Young (157), Alex Marinelli (165) and Zach Glazier (197).

True freshman Wyatt Henson won the 141-pound Silver/Freshman division, rolling up three technical falls and a major in the finals.


Five-time Big Ten and three-time NWCA Coach of the Year Tom Brands is in his 16th season as head wrestling coach at the University of Iowa in 2021-22. A 1996 Olympic gold medalist and member of wrestling's Hall of Fame, Brands is only the eighth head wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. The former Hawkeye wrestler was a four-time All-American and three-

time national champion (1989-92) at lowa. He has a 246-23-1 (.912) overall and 117-10 (.919) Big Ten coaching record at lowa. He has a 263-43-1 (.857) career mark and a 118-12 (.907) record at Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

In 15-plus seasons as lowa's head coach, Brands has led the Hawkeyes to four NCAA and six Big Ten team titles, crowning 13 NCAA champions, 23 Big Ten champions and 89 All-Americans. Iowa has had 142 Academic All-Big Ten recipients, including a school-record 17 in 2019-20. The Hawkeyes have qualified 138 wrestlers for the NCAA Championships in the last 15 years, sending the entire 10-man lineup in 2010, 2014, 2015, 2020 and 2021. Iowa has won or shared the Big Ten regular season title 12 times in Brands' 15 seasons.

The program set the national collegiate dual meet attendance record of 42,287 when No. 3 lowa defeated top-ranked Oklahoma State, 18-16, on Nov. 14, 2015 at the Grapple on the Gridiron at Kinnick Stadium. lowa has led the nation in attendance every year since Brands became head coach in 2006-07, setting an NCAA all-time attendance average of 12,568 in 2019-20.

Brands has been named NWCA National Coach of the Year three times. He was first honored in 2008 after leading the Hawkeyes to their first NCAA team title since 2000. He was recognized in 2020 when the top-ranked Hawkeyes won Big Ten regular season and tournament championships and entered the NCAA Championships as the favorite to win the team title. The tournament was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. He most recently won the award in 2021 when lowa won Big Ten and NCAA team titles.

Brands was named Big Ten Coach of the Year in 2008, 2009, 2010, 2020 and 2021. He is the only coach in program history to earn the award five times.

Brands served as head coach at Virginia Tech University for two seasons (2005-06), recording a 17-20 dual mark. In his first season with the Hokies, Brands led the team to the 2005 regular season Atlantic Coast Conference title, set a school record for dual meet wins (16) and had a school-record five wrestlers qualify for the NCAA Championships.

Prior to taking the helm at Virginia Tech, Brands was an assistant coach at lowa for 12 seasons (1993-2004). He helped the Hawkeyes to a 177-27 dual record, seven NCAA and eight Big Ten team titles, while crowning 23 NCAA champions, 73 All-Americans and 36 Big Ten champions. He was named the National Wrestling Coaches Association Assistant Coach of the Year in 2000.

In 2004, he was one of three coaches for the U.S. Olympic freestyle wrestling team, participating in Athens, and in 2016 he was named a volunteer coach of the United States Olympic team in Rio. Brands also served as assistant coach for the U.S. Freestyle World Teams in 2001, 2002, 2003, 2013, 2014, and 2015. He was named Freestyle Coach of the Year by USA Wrestling in 2002 and 2003. He has coached a number of other U.S. teams in international competition.


As a competitor, Brands won the 1996 Olympic freestyle gold medal at 136.5 pounds in Atlanta, Georgia. He also won a gold medal at the 1993 World Championships in Toronto, two World Cup gold medals (1994, 1995) and was the 1995 Pan American Games champion. He won four U.S. National titles (1993-96) and made four straight U.S. World or Olympic teams (1993-96). Along with his twin brother, Terry, Tom was named 1993 USA Wrestling Athlete of the Year, the 1993 John Smith Outstanding Freestyle Wrestler, and 1993 Amateur Wrestling News Man of the Year. He was inducted into wrestling's Hall of Fame in 2001.

Brands was a four-time All-American at Iowa (1989-92). During his Hawkeye career, he won three NCAA titles and was named Outstanding Wrestler of the 1992 NCAA Championships. Also a three-time Big Ten champion, Brands won 95 percent of his matches at Iowa. His career mark of 158-7-2 includes an undefeated season in 1991 (45-0).

The Sheldon, Iowa, native was born April 9, 1968. He earned his B.S. degree in physical education from Iowa in 1992. He and his wife, Jeni, have three adult children, Madigan, Kinsee and Tommy.
