PROGRAM QUICK HITS

- The Hawkeyes finished the 2020-21 season 20-10 overall and 11-8 in Big Ten play, advancing to the Big Ten Tournament Championship game and the NCAA Sweet 16.
- The Hawkeyes finished the season ranked in the top-11 nationally in 11 statistical categories, including first in field goal percentage (51.3) and 3-point percentage (40.8), second in scoring offense (86.1), third in free-throw percentage (80.0), and fifth in assists per game (20.1).
- Head Coach Lisa Bluder and staff led Iowa to its 12th 20-win season over the last 14 seasons and 14th in Bluder's tenure.
- Freshman Caitlin Clark earned consensus first team All-America status with honors from WBCA, USBWA, and The Athletic. Associated Press named Clark to their second team.
- Clark was named National Co-Freshman of the Year by The Athletic, USBWA, and the WBCA. She was also named the Dawn Staley Award recipient – an award that goes to the best guard in women's basketball.
- In the Big Ten, Clark was named Freshman of the Year, unanimous first team All-Big Ten, unanimously selected to the all-freshman team. Junior Monika Czinano earned first team All-Big Ten honors. The pair were also named to the All-Big Ten Tournament team.
- Clark and Czinano led the country in seven statistical categories, including Czinano leading the country in shooting percentage (66.8) and Clark leading in points per game (26.6), total assists (214).
- Iowa has made 13 consecutive postseason appearances (11 NCAA, 2 WNIT) when a postseason tournament was held. The 2020 postseason was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- The Hawkeyes have made a postseason tournament appearance in 19 of head coach Lisa Bluder's 21 seasons at the helm of the program, receiving 14 NCAA Tournament and four WNIT (2003, 2005, 2016, 2017) bids, including eight Sweet 16 appearances – most recently in 2021.
- Bluder is one of six active Division I women's head coaches to win 795 games or more in her career. She completes her 37th season as a head coach and 21st at Iowa in 2020-21.
- Bluder owns a 446-238 (.652) record and a 221-135 (.621) conference mark at Iowa. In her 37 seasons as a head coach, Bluder is 802-380 (.679).

THIS WEEK

The No. 22/21 University of Iowa women's basketball team heads to Lincoln, Nebraska, on Sunday, Jan. 9 to take on the Nebraska Cornhuskers inside Pinnacle Bank Arena. Tipoff is set for 1 p.m. (CT) on FS1.

- Sunday's contest will air live on FS1. Sloane Martin (play-by-play) and Christy Winters Scott (color) are on the call.

AUDIO COVERAGE

- Rob Brooks and Jamie Cavey Lang will call the action on the Hawkeye Radio Network. A link to the broadcast is available on the women's basketball schedule page on hawkeyesports.com.
- Brooks is in his sixth year as the play-by-play announcer for the Iowa women's basketball team. He has been Iowa football's sideline reporter since 2004. Brooks has called seven different Iowa sports on radio or television.
- Lang is in her sixth year as Iowa's color commentator. She lettered at Iowa from 2002-05. Lang finished her Hawkeye career with 1,265 points and 506 rebounds. She was a two-time All-Big Ten selection.

SCOUTING NEBRASKA

- Sunday's matchup marks the 33rd meeting between the two teams. The Hawkeyes lead the series 17-15 and have won 10 of the last 13 matchups, including both matchups during the 2020-21 season.
- The Hawkeyes defeated the Huskers at Pinnacle Bank Arena, 88-81, last season. Sophomore Caitlin Clark notched 38 points to break the arena record (men's or women's).
- Nebraska is 13-1 overall and 2-1 in Big Ten play, defeating Minnesota (70-67) and No. 8 Michigan (79-58), and falling to Michigan State (69-72). The Huskers are receiving votes in the AP Poll (5) and the WBCA Coaches Poll (20).
- Three Huskers average double-figure scoring, including sophomore guard Jaz Shelley (13.6), junior guard Sam Haiby (10.5), and sophomore forward Isabelle Bourne (10.3).
- Shelly leads the Huskers with 7.1 rebounds per game, followed by freshman center/forward Alexis Markowski and junior forward Bella Cravens with 6.4 apiece.
- Shelley and Haiby average 4.6 and 4.0 assists per game.
- Shelley and sophomore guard Ashley Scoggin both rank in the top 25 nationally in 3-point percentage. Shelley ranks 14th (.463) and Scoggin sits at 25th (.44.8).
- As a team, Nebraska ranks second in scoring margin (25.4), fourth in defensive rebounds per game (31.4), 10th in field-goal percentage defense (.336) and scoring offense (82.1), 13th in assists per game (18.2) and field goal percentage (.468), 14th in rebounds per game (44.1).
- Head coach Amy Williams is in her sixth season at the helm of the Nebraska women's basketball program. Williams is 85-63 at Nebraska and was named Big Ten Coach of the Year and led the Huskers to the NCAA Tournament First Round, during her second season (2017-18).

(HAWK)EYES ON THE SEASON

- The Hawkeyes are 7-4 overall and 1-1 in Big Ten play, falling most recently to Northwestern (Jan. 6), 77-69.
- Sophomore Caitlin Clark leads Iowa, averaging 24.7 points, 8.1 rebounds and 6.6 assists per game. Clark's 24.7 points per game rank second in the country, while she ranks fifth nationally in assists per game (6.6), 10th in free throws made (67), 19th in defensive rebounds per game (7.5) and is the only Division I women's basketball player to tally two triple-doubles this season.
- Clark, junior McKenna Warnock and freshman Addison O'Grady have each tallied double-doubles this season. Clark has tallied five on the season, including two triple-doubles, while Warnock and O'Grady have each registered one.
- Senior Monika Czinano and Warnock average 18.1 and 12.5 points per game, respectively. The pair also

- average 7.4 (Warnock) and 5.2 (Czinano) rebounds per game.
- Czinano ranks ninth in the nation in field goal percentage (.628).
- Redshirt junior Kate Martin ranks second on the team, averaging 2.5 assists per game.
- Junior Gabbie Marshall, Martin and Clark have tallied 18, 17 and 17 steals, respectively.
- Iowa leads the country in free-throw percentage (.852), ranks 11th in assists per game (18.5), 15th in field-goal percentage (.467), 16th in scoring offense (79.9), 18th in defensive rebounds per game (30.2), 30th in assist turnover ratio (1.15) and 45th in scoring margin (14.7).

RANKED AMONG THE TOP

- The Associated Press released its women's basketball poll on Jan. 2, ranking the University of Iowa 22nd nationally.
- This week's poll is P. Sue Beckwith, MD, Iowa Women's Basketball Head Coach Lisa Bluder's 103rd week ranked in the AP Top 25 Poll – 101 at Iowa, twice at Drake.
- The WBCA ranked the Hawkeyes No. 21 in the coaches' poll on Jan. 4.

TRIPLE-DOUBLE TROUBLE

- Sophomore Caitlin Clark led the Hawkeyes to their first Big Ten win of the season with a team-high, 24 points against Michigan State (Dec.5). She added 12 assists and 10 rebounds to register her second triple-double of the season and the third of her career.
- The West Des Moines, Iowa, native is the second active NCAA Division I student-athlete to record three in their career – Indiana's Grace Berger also has three career triple-doubles.
- Clark's third triple-double makes her the second Hawkeye in program history to record three or more triple doubles – former Hawkeye Sam Logic tallied six in her career.
- Clark's triple-double against Michigan State is also the first for a Hawkeye against a Big Ten opponent since Logic had 18 points, 10 rebounds and 11 assists at Purdue (Feb. 16, 2014).

FIVE-FOR-FIVE

- Iowa returns all five starters from the 2020-21 season, including Caitlin Clark, Monika Czinano, Gabbie Marshall, Kate Martin and McKenna Warnock.
- Clark and Czinano led the country in seven statistical categories, including Czinano ranking first in field-goal percentage (66.8) and Clark leading in points per game (26.6) and total assists (214). The pair tallied the most and second-most made field goals with Clark downing 266 shots taken and Czinano tallying 254.
- Warnock led the Hawkeyes and ranked second in the Big Ten in rebounds, pulling down 232 on the season.
- Martin assisted 120 baskets to rank sixth in the Big Ten and 30th in the nation.
- Marshall tallied 57 steals to rank third in the Big Ten.

THE BIG COUNT CONTINUES

- Sophomore Caitlin Clark was named Big Ten Women's Basketball Co-Player of the Week, the conference announced Jan. 3.
- The honor is the 24th of her career. Earlier this season, Clark earned Big Ten Player of the Week (Dec. 6) and Honor Roll (Nov. 15). As a freshman she tallied a Big Ten-best 13 Freshman of the Week honors, a Big Ten-Freshman record five Player of the Week honors and four Player of the Week Honor Roll nods.

BIG TIME FRESHMAN

- Freshman Addison O'Grady earned her first Big Ten Weekly honor on Jan. 3.
- O'Grady's first Big Ten weekly honor came after registering her first career double-double in the Hawkeyes' win over Evansville (Jan. 2).
- The Aurora, Colorado, native tallied season-best points (14) and rebounds (12), shot 70 percent from the field and blocked two shots.

THEY'RE KIND OF A BIG DEAL

- Sophomore Caitlin Clark was named Preseason Big Ten Player of the Year by the coaches and earned unanimous Preseason All-Big Ten honors, joining junior Monika Czinano on the Preseason All-Big Ten team, the conference office announced Oct. 26
- During her freshman campaign, Clark averaged 26.6 points, 7.1 assists, and 5.9 rebounds per game in 30 games, setting the Iowa freshman record with 26.6 points per game recording the fourth-highest single season points per game in Iowa history. Clark was the 2020-21 NCAA Division I scoring leader and was named Big Ten Freshman of the Year, while earning unanimous All-Big Ten honors.
- Czinano, a two-time All-Big Ten selection, earns the second preseason honor of her career. The Watertown, Minnesota, native finished last season leading the country in shooting percentage (66.8) and ranked second nationally, shooting 254 of 380 from the field behind Clark.
- As a junior, Czinano averaged 19.3 points and 5.8 rebounds per game on the season. She scored in double figures during 28 contests, tabbing 11 20-point games – nine against conference opponents.

PLAYER OF THE YEAR WATCH, X2

- Sophomore Caitlin Clark was named to the Wooden Award Midseason Top-25 list on Jan. 5.
- Clark and senior Monika Czinano were named to the Preseason Naismith Award, Wade Trophy and John R. Wooden Award watch lists, the Women's Basketball Coaches Association and Los Angeles Athletic Club, respectively, announced Nov. 9.
- The Naismith Award list currently features 50 student-athletes and will be trimmed to 30 in February. Ten different conferences are represented on the prestigious watch list. Clark and Czinano are two of eight Big Ten student-athletes included.
- The Wade Trophy – now in its 45th year – is the oldest and most prestigious national player of the year award in college women's basketball. It is named in honor of the late,

P. SUE BECKWITH, MD, HEAD COACH LISA BLUDER

Lisa Bluder is in her 22nd year as the P. Sue Beckwith, MD, Head Women's Basketball Coach. The position was endowed in 2021 by P. Sue Beckwith, MD, one of UI athletics' most generous supporters. Sue Beckwith was a four-year letter winner with Iowa Women's Basketball (1976-1980) and has earned three UI degrees; 1980 BS, 1984 MD, and 2015 MBA.



As the all-time winningest coach in program history, the Hawkeyes have advanced to 19 postseason appearances (15 NCAA and four WNIT) in 20 seasons, including NCAA Tournament berths in 11 of the last 13 seasons. Iowa advanced to the postseason in 13 consecutive seasons (11 NCAA and two WNIT) when a postseason tournament was held. The 2020 pandemic cut the 2019-20 season short, resulting in the sole missed tournament season.

BIG TEN CHAMPIONSHIPS

- In 2008, Iowa won a share of the Big Ten regular season championship, it's ninth in school history. The Hawkeyes won a Big Ten-season-best, eight-straight games during league play.
- In Bluder's first year at Iowa, the 2000-01 Hawkeyes finished second in the Big Ten. The Hawkeyes knocked off Indiana, Illinois, and Purdue to win the first Big Ten Tournament crown under Bluder.

legendary Delta State University head coach Lily Margaret Wade, who won three consecutive national championships with the Lady Statesmen. First awarded in 1978 by the American Alliance for Health, Physical Education, Recreation and Dance (AAHPERD), now known as SHAPE America, the Wade Trophy has been presented to the WBCA NCAA Division I National Player of the Year since 2001. The list currently includes 30 student-athletes.

- The 2022 John R. Wooden Award Women's Player of the Year is voted on by nearly 1,000 voters, following the midseason, late season and National Ballot lists before ranking 10 of the final 15 student-athletes prior to the NCAA Tournament. The Wooden Award All-American Team™ will be announced the week of the "Elite Eight" round of the NCAA Tournament. The winner of the 2022 John R. Wooden Award will be presented by Wendy's following the NCAA Tournament in April. There are 50 athletes currently on the list.
- The Big Ten Conference led the Wade Trophy list with 10 honorees, including Clark, Czinano, Indiana's Grace Berger and Ali Patberg, Maryland's Diamond Miller and Ashley Owusu, Michigan's Leigh Brown and Naz Hillmon, Michigan State's Nia Clouden, and Northwestern's Veronica Burton. All but Patberg were also named to the Wooden Award Watch List. Berger, Burton, Clark, Czinano, Clouden, Hillmon, Miller and Owusu were included on the Naismith list.

BEST GUARD IN THE NATION? WE THINK SO

- Sophomore Caitlin Clark was named to the Nancy Lieberman Point Guard of the Year Preseason Watch List, the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame announced on Oct. 25.
- The list is comprised of 20 student-athletes who are the early front-runners for the 23rd annual Nancy Lieberman Award that recognizes the best point guard in women's basketball. The list is chosen based on their floor leadership, playmaking, and ball-handling skills.
- Clark is joined by four Big Ten student-athletes, including Indiana's Ali Patberg, Maryland's Ashley Owusu, Michigan's Amy Dilk, and Northwestern's Veronica Burton.
- During her freshman campaign, Clark averaged 26.6 points, 7.1 assists, and 5.9 rebounds per game in 30 games, setting the Iowa freshman record with 26.6 points per game (men's or women's), recording the fourth-highest points per game in single-season in Iowa history (men's or women's), and was the 2020-21 NCAA Division I scoring leader (men's or women's).
- The West Des Moines, Iowa, native was named co-Freshman of the Year and first team All-America by The Athletic, USBWA, and WBCA after leading the nation in total assists (214), total points (799), points per game (26.6), field goals made (266), 3-pointers made (116), and ranked second in assists per game (7.1) and 3-pointers per game (3.87). In early August, Clark won her third gold medal with USA Basketball and was named the FIBA U19 World Cup Most Valuable Player. The USA Team Captain amassed 100 points, 39 assists, 37 rebounds, seven steals, and six blocks in seven contests.

CENTER OF ATTENTION

- Senior Monika Czinano was one of 20 student-athletes named to the Lisa Leslie Center of the Year Preseason Watch List – named after the three-time All-American and 1994 National Player of the Year – the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame announced Oct. 29. The annual award, in its fifth year, recognizes the top centers in women's NCAA Division I college basketball.
- Czinano finished last season leading the country in shooting percentage (66.8) and ranked second nationally to teammate Caitlin Clark in made baskets, draining 254-of-380 shots from the field.
- The Watertown, Minnesota, native averaged 19.3 points and 5.8 rebounds per game on the season. She scored in double figures during 28 contests, tabbing 11 20-point games – nine against conference opponents.
- Iowa's Megan Gustafson became the second recipient of the award in 2019 and the first Hawkeye.

MAKING HISTORY

- Sophomore Caitlin Clark was named to the Associated Press Preseason All-America team on Oct. 26.
- Clark is the first Iowa Women's Basketball player named a preseason AP All-American. She joins Baylor's Nalyssa Smith, UConn's Paige Bueckers, Kentucky's Rhyne Howard and South Carolina's Aliyah Boston.
- During her freshman campaign, the West Des Moines, Iowa, native averaged 26.6 points, 7.1 assists, and 5.9 rebounds per game in 30 games. Clark was named co-Freshman of the Year and first team All-America by The Athletic, USBWA and WBCA – second-team All-America by Associated Press – leading the nation in total assists (214), total points (799), points per game (26.6), field goals made (266) and 3-pointers made (116), and ranked second in assists per game (7.1) and 3-pointers per game (3.87).

GOLD MEDALIST, X3

- Sophomore Caitlin Clark won her third gold medal with Team USA as they defeated Australia, 70-52, in the FIBA U19 World Cup Final.
- Clark was named the FIBA U19 World Cup Most Valuable Player.
- Clark scored nine points, dished out eight assists, tallied eight rebounds, and recorded a block in the victory over Australia.
- The USA team captain registered 100 points (14.3 ppg), 39 assists (5.6 apg), 37 rebounds (5.3 rpg), seven steals, and six blocks in seven U19 World Cup Games, helping Team USA win its ninth FIBA Women's U19 World Cup gold medal.

ROSTER AT A GLANCE

- The Hawkeye roster includes student-athletes from Colorado, Illinois (3), Indiana, Iowa (4), Michigan, Minnesota, Ohio and Wisconsin.
- Iowa consists of three seniors, three juniors, four sophomores and three freshmen.
- 10-of-13 Hawkeyes measure at six-feet or taller with the tallest standing at 6-feet-4.
- The Hawkeyes returned nine athletes from the 2020-21 Sweet 16 team and added four newcomers, including Iowa State transfer Kylie Feuerbach, who helped the Cyclones advance to the second round of the NCAA Tournament.
