LEADING OFF

The Hawkeyes are 6-5 overall heading into their first three-game series of the season. This is lowa's first trip to California since the pandemic-shortened 2020 season. The Hawkeyes played three games at the Tony Gwynn Legacy Tournament, going 1-2 against San Diego State (L, 1-4), Arizona (W, 4-1) and San Diego (L, 5-10).
Iowa's pitching staff ranks in the top 20 in the NCAA in five different categories. The Hawkeyes are second in hits allowed per nine innings (5.22), fourth in strikeouts per nine innings (12.9), 17th in shutouts (2), 19th in WHIP (1.08) and 20th in ERA (2.56).

• The Hawkeyes are leading the Big Ten in ERA, strikeouts (141), batting average against (.167), fewest hits allowed (57) and fewest earned runs allowed (28).

• Three Hawkeyes -- Dylan Nedved, Keaton Anthony and Peyton Williams -- were named to the Frisco Baseball Classic All-Tournament Team in a vote of the media members in attendance.

• Redshirt sophomore Adam Mazur won back-to-back Big Ten Pitcher of the Week honors during the first two weeks of the season. He is the first Hawkeye pitcher to earn consecutive Big Ten Pitcher of the Week honors.

• Mazur is 2-0 with a 2.33 ERA with 21 strikeouts to three walks. He is leading the Big Ten in batting average against (.138), second in innings (19.1), tied for second in wins (2), sixth in strikeouts (21) and seventh in ERA (2.33).


• lowa is leading the Big Ten in pitching (2.56 ERA), is fourth in fielding percentage (.974) and fifth in batting (.274 average).

Redshirt freshman Keaton Anthony has hit safely in eight straight games and has reached safely in all 11 games this season. Anthony ranks in the top six in the Big Ten in five different offensive categories this season.
Seven of Iowa's 11 games have been decided by three runs or fewer. The Hawkeyes are 3-4 in such contests.
The Hawkeyes are picked as an NCAA Regional team by D1Baseball.com and Baseball America in 2022 and are tabbed to finish in the top four of the Big Ten standings. Mazur is a preseason All-Big Ten selection by Perfect Game, while RHP Marcus Morgan was tabbed as D1Baseball's Preseason Big Ten Freshman of the Year.
Iowa has advanced to the postseason in six of Heller's eight seasons (there was no Big Ten/NCAA Tournament in 2020 and no Big Ten Tournament in 2021 because of COVID). He has led the Hawkeyes to two NCAA Regional appearances (2015, 2017).

ABOUT HEAD COACH RICK HELLER

Rick Heller has turned the University of Iowa baseball program into a perennial Big Ten Conference and NCAA contender in his first seven seasons as the Hawkeyes' head coach.

Heller has injected new life into the lowa program, leading the Hawkeyes to the 246 victories -- an average of 30.5 wins per season -- advancing to two NCAA Regionals, and claiming the first Big Ten Tournament title in program history. The 2017 title was lowa's first since winning the regular season crown in 1990.

The Eldon, Iowa, native became the 20th head coach in program history in 2013 -- his fourth stop as a collegiate head coach. He has enjoyed stints at Iowa (2014-present), Indiana State (2009-13), Northern Iowa (1999-2009), and Upper Iowa (1987-99), Ieading all four schools to NCAA postseason play. He is one of nine coaches all-time and one of five active coaches to lead three different Division I programs to NCAA Regional play.

In 35 seasons as a head coach, Heller owns a career record of 936-726-4. He is one of two lowa head coaches to lead the program to the NCAA Tournament.

At Iowa

Under Heller's watch, Iowa has advanced to the postseason in six consecutive years for the first time in program history, he has coached eight All-Americans and at least one first-team All-Big Ten selection in six of his eight seasons. Heller has coached one Big Ten Player of the Year (Jake Adams), one Big Ten Pitcher of the Year (Trenton Wallace -- the first in school history) and Iowa has had 23 Major League Baseball Draft picks in eight seasons, including 21 in a six-year stretch, the most all-time.

Heller has also given the Hawkeyes an international flavor, taking the team to the Dominican Republic in 2016 and Taipei, Taiwan, as the United States representative at the 2017 World University Games. Heller led USA to a silver medal, as the team became the first American squad to medal in Universiade history.

USA team went 5-2 during the two-week stretch, before falling to Japan in the gold medal game. The Americans posted victories over Mexico, Russia, Korea, and two games against the Czech Republic. Junior Cole McDonald tossed a nineinning no-hitter in game one against the Czechs -- the first by a Hawkeye since 1965.

During Heller's second season, Heller guided lowa to an at-large berth into NCAA Regional play in 2015 -- a first for the program since 1990 -- and the team posted the school's first NCAA Tournament win since 1972. The Hawkeyes were the runners-up at the 2016 Big Ten Tournament before claiming the program's first tournament title in 2017 to lock up the school's second NCAA Regional appearance in three seasons.

lowa made just three NCAA Tournament appearances in its history prior to Heller's arrival.

OF NOTE

• Nineteen players on the 2022 roster have made their Hawkeye debuts during the first three weeks of the season.

 Redshirt senior Izaya Fullard has missed the first three weeks of the season because of injury. The North Liberty, Iowa, native will be out 4-5 weeks, recovering from surgery to his hamate bone. • Fullard closed out the 2021 season riding a careerlong 27 game reached base streak. It was the longest streak by a Hawkeye in 2021.

• lowa has scored 10 or more runs in two games this season -- the first two games of the season. The Hawkeyes' 12 runs in the season-opening victory over Air Force were the most on Opening Day since 2019.

 RHP Connor Schultz, who was lowa's Saturday starter the first two weeks of the season, missed his last start with shoulder soreness.

· lowa's pitching staff has allowed four runs or fewer in nine of its 11 games and five or fewer hits in six games.

• The Hawkeyes have played errorless baseball in six games this season. Iowa is 5-1 in such contests. Senior Dylan Nedved and redshirt sophomores Adam Mazur and Peyton Williams were named Big Ten Players to Watch. The Hawkeyes were picked to finish third in a vote of the league's head coaches.

 Redshirt sophomore Peyton Williams will play with the Cotuit Kettleers in June in the Cape Cod League.

 lowa's 2022 newcomer class (transfers and freshman) is rated as the 23rd-best recruiting class in the country by D1Baseball.com.

FRISCO HONORS

Three Hawkeyes - Keaton Anthony, Peyton Williams

and Dylan Nedved -- were named to the Frisco Classic All-Tournament Team on March 6.

• Anthony hit .385 (5-of-13) in three games with three doubles, two RBIs and three runs scored. • Williams had a .333 (4-of-12) average with three extra base hits, including two home runs. The first baseman also made a key defensive play against Washington State, making a catch in foul territory before going into the stands. The play was a top-10 play for the week by D1Baseball.com. • Nedved pitched a career-long 4 2/3 innings in relief against Texas A&M. He entered in the first inning with one out and the bases loaded and got out of the jam by inducing an inning-ending double play. The right-hander allowed two unearned runs and fanned a career-high nine in the outing.

MAZUR: THE ACE

Redshirt sophomore Adam Mazur has been spectacular in his first three starts as a Hawkeye. The Minnesota native is 2-0 with a 2.33 ERA with 21 strikeouts over 19 1/3 innings.

 Mazur was named the Big Ten Pitcher of the Week on Feb. 23 and March 2. He is the first Hawkeye pitcher to earn the distinction in consecutive weeks. • The right-hander went six innings, allowing one run -- a solo home run -- over six innings in his debut against Air Force before retiring the final 16 batters he faced on Feb. 18.

• He logged a career-best 7 2/3 innings against Pepperdine on Feb. 25, allowing zero runs on three hits and fanning nine. He retired 10 straight at one point in the contest.

 Mazur carried a no-hitter into the sixth against Wichita State on March 4 and he retired 15 straight batters at one point.

• Mazur, who has two quality starts this season and has 21 strikeouts to three walks, has three streaks of 10 or more consecutive batters retired in three starts.

• He is leading the Big Ten in batting average against (.138), is second in innings (19.1), tied for second in wins (2), sixth in strikeouts (21) and seventh in ERA (2.33).

NEDVED JOINS ROTATION

After tossing a career-high 4 2/3 innings in relief and fanning nine against Texas A&M on March 5, senior RHP Dylan Nedved will make his first career start at UC Irvine on Saturday. The Shawnee, Kansas, native trained to be a starting pitcher in the offseason and he'll get a chance against the Anteaters. In four appearances in 2022, Nedved is 0-0 with a 1.80 ERA, allowing four runs (two earned) on five hits with 14 strikeouts over 10 innings.

B1G's BEST

The Hawkeye pitching staff has been superb through the first three weeks of the 2022 season. lowa is leading the Big Ten in five categories, including ERA (2.56), shutouts (2), fewest hits (57), fewest earned runs (28), strikeouts (141) and batting average against (.167).

• Iowa has two of the top seven single-game strikeout totals in the NCAA this season.

IN THE B1G

Redshirt freshman Keaton Anthony ranks in the top six in the Big Ten in five offensive categories. He is third in the league in OPS (1.279), tied for third in doubles (6), fourth in OBP (.542), fifth in slugging (.737) and sixth in batting average (.421).

• Peyton Williams is sixth in the league in OPS (1.179), tied for seventh in home runs (3) and tied for eighth in doubles (5).

HEAT ALERT

Freshman RHP Brody Brecht had a hot debut in his first career appearance at Duane Banks Field. The Ankeny, lowa, native hit triple digits on his first three pitches, going 101, 101 and 100 in a 1-2-3 inning against Cornell College on March 2.

KEA/PEY - TON

Redshirt freshman Keaton Anthony and redshirt sophomore Peyton Williams have given the Hawkeyes a formidable 1-2 punch in the middle of the lineup early in the 2022 season.

• Anthony is leading the team with a .421 average and six doubles and is tied for the team lead with nine RBIs. The Georgia native had a career performance in his third career game in Iowa's 11-1 victory over Ball State on Feb. 19, going 4-for-4 with two doubles, two home runs, four runs and five RBIs.

• The outfielder has hit safely in nine games and he has a team-high five multi-hit contests.

• Anthony hit .444 (4-of-9) with five runs and five RBIs in the three games at the Swig & Swine Classic and finished with a .583 on-base and 1.333 slugging percentage en route to being named the Big Ten Freshman of the Week on Feb. 23.

• Williams is second on the team with a .372 average while leading the team with three home runs and 12 runs scored. The first baseman has five doubles and nine RBIs in 11 games. The Johnson, Iowa, native has two four-hit games on the season (vs. Air Force, vs. Wichita State) and he has hit safely in six games.

• Williams hit two home runs at the Frisco Classic, including a solo shot that went 422 feet and had a 110 mph exit velocity against Washington State.

EARLY OFFENSE

• Iowa is 4-2 when scoring first this season and 5-3 when out-hitting its opponent.

OFFENSIVE NOTES

The Hawkeyes rank in the top six in the Big Ten in three offensive categories. The team is fifth in batting average (.274), sixth in doubles (25) and sixth in hits (104).
Sophomore Will Mulflur hit a solo home run for his first hit as a Hawkeye on March 2 against Cornell. He is the

sixth player to homer this season.

• Sophomore Anthony Mangano has hit safely in four straight games. The outfielder had a pinch-hit RBI single in the 6-5 win over Washington State on March 6.

• Redshirt sophomore Ben Tallman had three hits in his second career start, finishing 3-for-4 with two runs scored against Texas A&M on March 5.

IN DEFENSE

lowa boasts the fourth-best team fielding percentage in the Big Ten at .974. The Hawkeyes have committed 10 errors in 11 games, fourth-fewest in the league.
lowa's middle infielders -- Michael Seegers and Brendan Sher -- haven't committed an error in 65 chances.

LANGENBERG STEPS UP

After missing the Corpus Christi weekend with forearm tightness, sophomore Ty Langenberg returned in a big way at the Frisco Classic. The right-hander pitched a career-high 5 2/3 innings in relief against Washington State on March 6, allowing two runs on three hits and fanning a career-high eight.

• Langenberg is 2-0 with a 1.93 ERA in two appearances. He has 12 strikeouts to one walk over 9 1/3 innings.

FRONTLINE TRANSFERS

lowa added a pair of Friday night starters to the 2022 roster as transfers in RHP Adam Mazur (South Dakota State) and RHP Connor Schultz (Butler).

• Mazur, who was tabbed as a first-team All-Big Ten selection by Perfect Game, went 3-9 with a 5.50 ERA in 16 starts in two seasons with the Jackrabbits. The Minnesota native had a breakout season in the Cape Cod League, going 3-0 with a 1.55 ERA in six starts en route to Cape Cod All-League honors.

 Mazur is rated as the No. 89 player on MLB.com's top-100 draft prospects, while being the No. 2 draft prospect in Big Ten and No. 61 nationally by D1Baseball.com.

• Schultz is a graduate pitcher from Butler University where he went 13-9 with a 3.79 ERA in four collegiate seasons. The Cedar Falls, Iowa, native was a first-team All-Big East selection in 2019 and was the Big East Preseason Pitcher of the Year in 2020. Schultz battled hip injuries in each of the past two seasons.

FRESHMEN PHENOMS

The Hawkeyes signed a pair of high-end pitchers in freshman right-handers Brody Brecht and Marcus Morgan. Brecht is from Ankeny, Iowa; Morgan is from Iowa City. • Brecht is rated as the top incoming recruit in the Big Ten and No. 9 nationally by Perfect Game, while being tabbed as the No. 4 impact recruit in the Big Ten by D1Baseball. com.

• Morgan was named D1Baseball.com's Preseason Big Ten Freshman of the Year and the top impact freshman in the league.

• Morgan is the first freshman to be in the starting rotation to start the season under head coach Rick Heller. (LHP Jack Dreyer started four games (late in the season) during his true freshman season in 2018.)

NEDVED NAMED TO CLOSER OF THE YEAR WATCH LIST

Senior Dylan Nedved has been named to the NCBWA Closer of the Year Watch List for the 2022 season. The Kansas native went 4-1 with a 4.19 ERA with nine saves over 20 appearances last season. The nine saves ranked second in the Big Ten Conference.

#HELLERBALL

 Head coach Rick Heller recorded his 900th career win against Grand View in a 15-2 victory on March 3, 2020, at Duane Banks Field

• Heller is one of nine coaches all-time to lead three different NCAA Division I teams to regional play.

• The Hawkeyes won 30 or more games in each of Heller's six full seasons as the helm of the program. It's a first for the team since winning 30 or more in seven straight seasons from 1979-85.

• Heller has led the Hawkeyes to two NCAA Regional appearances; the program had three regional appearances in its history prior to his arrival.

• Heller is third in school history in career wins with 246 at lowa, including the second (41) and fifth-most (39) in school history.

• Heller led Iowa to its first Big Ten Tournament title in 2017 -- the first conference title since 1990 -- and he guided the Hawkeyes to the Big Ten Tournament title game in consecutive seasons. Iowa has advanced to the league tournament in six straight years for the first time in program history.

• Heller has coached at least one first-team All-Big Ten selection in six of his first eight seasons, and has 21 Major League Baseball Draft picks in seven seasons -- the most in a six-year stretch in school history.

Iowa had a school-record six All-Big Ten selections in 2015 and five in 2017. The Hawkeyes have had 26 All-Big Ten honorees in eight seasons under Heller.
Iowa has posted winning streaks of nine games (in 2015)

and eight games (in 2017) -- the longest streaks for the program since 2012.
