HEAD COACH JEFF GARBUTT, SR.

Jeff Garbutt was named the fourth head coach in the history of the University of Iowa rowing program in October 2021.

Garbutt was an assistant coach on the Iowa staff for seven years from 2013-20. During that time, he helped Iowa reach heights the program had not seen before, qualifying for the NCAA Championships three consecutive years from 2017-19 and reaching No. 7 in the national rankings in 2018, the highest in program history. He returns to Iowa City from La Salle University, where he led the men's and women's rowing programs from 2020-21.

Garbutt was on staff in 2017 and 2018 when Iowa was named College Rowing Coaches Association Region 4 Staff of the Year. In 2017, Iowa broke a 16-year NCAA Championship drought and placed 12th nationally. The following year, the Hawkeyes placed a program-best fourth in the Big Ten and set a school scoring record at NCAA's, putting up 69 points and placing 11th.

The University of Iowa rowing team travels to Camden, New Jersey, to race in an Ivy League-Big Ten Conference double dual against Harvard and Yale at Cooper River Park on Saturday. Michigan State is also representing the Big Ten Conference

EVENT SCHEDULE

Iowa competes against Yale during the first session beginning at 7 a.m. (CT). The Hawkeyes face Harvard in the second session beginning at 11:10 a.m.

THE COMPETITION

Iowa is competing with its first and second varsity eight crews, its first and second varsity four crews, and one novice eight crew. The Hawkeyes are receiving votes (11) in the March 16 CRCA national poll. Iowa will face a Yale team ranked No. 11 by the CRCA. Harvard is receiving votes (10).

ABOUT THE HAWKEYES

- Jeff Garbutt is in his first year as Iowa's head coach for Iowa. Garbutt was an assistant for the Hawkeyes from 2013-2020.
- Iowa's new coaching staff includes associate head coach Megan Fitzpatrick, and assistant coaches Katie Thurstin and Lowell McNicholas.
- The Hawkeyes bring back 42 rowers from the 2020-21 season, as well as the addition of 22 freshmen.
- Iowa returns to competition for the first time since the Jayhawk Jamboree on Oct. 23, 2021, where the Hawkeyes finished first in both the Varsity 4 and 8.

QUOTING COACH GARBUTT

"With winter training and spring break behind us, I am ready to finally get to our racing season. The team has done a great job adapting to our new routines and has put in the work to be race ready. We have a great blend of experience levels that are starting to figure things out. As with many schools in our region, I am excited to see how we progress each week with more opportunity to get to row. We will race 17 out of the top 20 schools this spring and have one of the most challenging schedules in college rowing. Our staff has done a fantastic job with the squad, and I can't wait to see the hard work pay off."
