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ATHLETE REGISTRATION

Meet registration will take place on directathletics.com. ***Deadline for registration is 5:00 p.m. (CT) Tuesday, April 19.*** Accepted entries will be posted on hawkeyesports.com. There is no entry fee. Open to non-collegiate competitors; contact Kate Wakenight (kathryn-wakenight@uiowa.edu) prior to entry deadline for approval.

EVENT CHECK-IN

FIELD EVENTS: Check-in for all field events takes place at the event site.

RUNNING EVENTS: Competitors are to report to the Clerk's Tent in the northwest corner of the track 20 minutes prior to their race to receive hip numbers (pg. 4). ***Coaches and athletes are strongly encouraged to share scratches ahead of time at either the Clerk's Tent or timing trailer throughout the day.***

Competitors entered in the 200m must check-in at the Clerk's Tent no later than 30 minutes prior to the scheduled 200m start to either confirm entry or scratch from the event. After the initial check-in, an announcement will be made once the 200m has been seeded. At that time, 200m competitors are required to report back to the Clerk's Tent for final check-in. Competitors will receive heat and lane assignments at final check-in.

RELAY CARDS: Completed relay cards are to be turned in at the Clerk's tent no later than 30 minutes prior to the scheduled relay start. Relay cards are provided inside team's packet.

HOSPITALITY

Complimentary hospitality for all coaches and team staff will be available on competition day inside the hospitality tent outside the southwest corner of the track (see pg. 4). Issued wristbands will be required to access hospitality area. Each team is responsible for providing their own team meals for their student-athletes. Vendors are to drop-off meals in the Softball Lot and escorted by team staff.

MEDIA / RESULTS

Results will be available on hawkeyesports.com. Live scoring will also be available on hawkeyesports.com/tracklive. To receive results electronically, please contact Brock Busick (brock-busick@uiowa.edu). The meet will be streamed on BTN+.

A media mix zone will be located near the finish line (see pg. 4). Event winners must report to the media mix zone immediately after respective event. Team media personnel are asked to assist with getting respective winner to the media mix zone.

MEDICAL SERVICES

Athletic Training will be available beginning two (2) hours prior to competition outside the northwest corner of the track (see pg. 4). An ambulance will arrive one (1) hour prior to the first event. For questions, please contact Doug West at 319-530-5173.

PACKET PICK-UP

Coaches may pick-up packets upon arrival in the southwest corner of the track, near the track shed (see pg. 4). Packets may be delivered to the hotel upon request. Competitor bibs, wristbands and parking permits will be included in team's packet. Please include team's anticipated arrival time and desired pick-up location on the 'Team Travel Form' (pg. 8).

PRACTICE / WARM-UP / CAMP AREAS

The outdoor track is open for practice after 5:00 p.m. on Friday, April 22. Please indicate team's estimated arrival time on the 'Team Travel Form' (pg. 8). The Indoor Track Facility (ITF) and the neighboring softball diagram (field #4) will be available for warm-up on Saturday, April 23. The ITF will be available beginning at 10:00 a.m. For information regarding access and parking at the ITF, please refer to page 7.

Team camp area is located outside the northwest side of the track (see pg. 4). Teams are allowed to bring their own tents.

SPIKE RESTRICTIONS / IMPLEMENT INSPECTION

Competitors are allowed to wear pyramid spike pins that are no longer than ¼" (6.4mm). Pyramid spike pins that are no longer than ⅜" (9.5mm) are allowed for the Javelin and High Jump events. Needle, Christmas tree or Omni-Light ¼" spikes are NOT allowed. Spike check will not occur for this meet.

All implements must be inspected prior to competition. Implement inspection will be available inside the shed located in the southwest corner of the track (see pg. 4). Inspection will be available starting 90 minutes prior to the start of each throwing event. Athletes will be responsible for transporting implements to the event site as nothing will be impounded once checked in.



TEAM ENTRANCE / PARKING

LOADING / ENTRANCE: An area within the Softball Parking Lot, west of the competition facility, will be designated for team drop-off and pick-up (*see pg. 5*). Team vehicles must be actively loading or unloading while positioned in this area. Once unloaded, vehicles must exit the parking lot and relocate to the designated parking location.

TEAM VAN PARKING: Team passenger vehicle parking will be available in the East Gravel Parking Lot, located outside the northeast corner of the track (*see pg. 5*). A specific parking permit will be required. To receive proper parking permits, please include team's transportation plan on the 'Team Travel Form' (*pg. 8*). Parking passes will be included in team's packet. Entry into the parking lot is off of Hwy 6/Second St.

TEAM BUS PARKING: Parking is available for team buses at the Hawkeye Commuter Parking Lot. For directions and shuttle information, please refer to page 6. GPS Address: [Hawkeye Commuter Lot, Iowa City, IA 52246](#)

PUBLIC PARKING: Public parking will be available but limited within the Softball Parking Lot, off of First Ave. (*see pg. 5*). Additional public parking will be available free of charge in the Hawkeye Commuter Parking Lot (Lot 85) (*see pg. 6*). A complementary bus shuttle service will be available to and from the competition facility beginning two (2) hours prior to the first event until one (1) hour after the meet. For more information and directions to Lot 85, please refer to page 6.

TICKETS / PASS GATE

Wristbands will be required for competitors and traveling team personnel on competition day. Please indicate the quantity of wristbands needed for travel party on the 'Team Travel Form' (*pg. 8*).

Guests of the student-athletes and team personnel will be admitted via a pass list. Each student-athlete and coach is eligible for four (4) guests on competition day. Photo IDs will be required to enter via the pass gate. Please complete and return the 'Complimentary Admission List' (*pg. 9*) by Noon (CT) on Friday, April 22 to quinn-mead@uiowa.edu. The pass gate will be located at both the west and east entrances (*see pg. 4*).

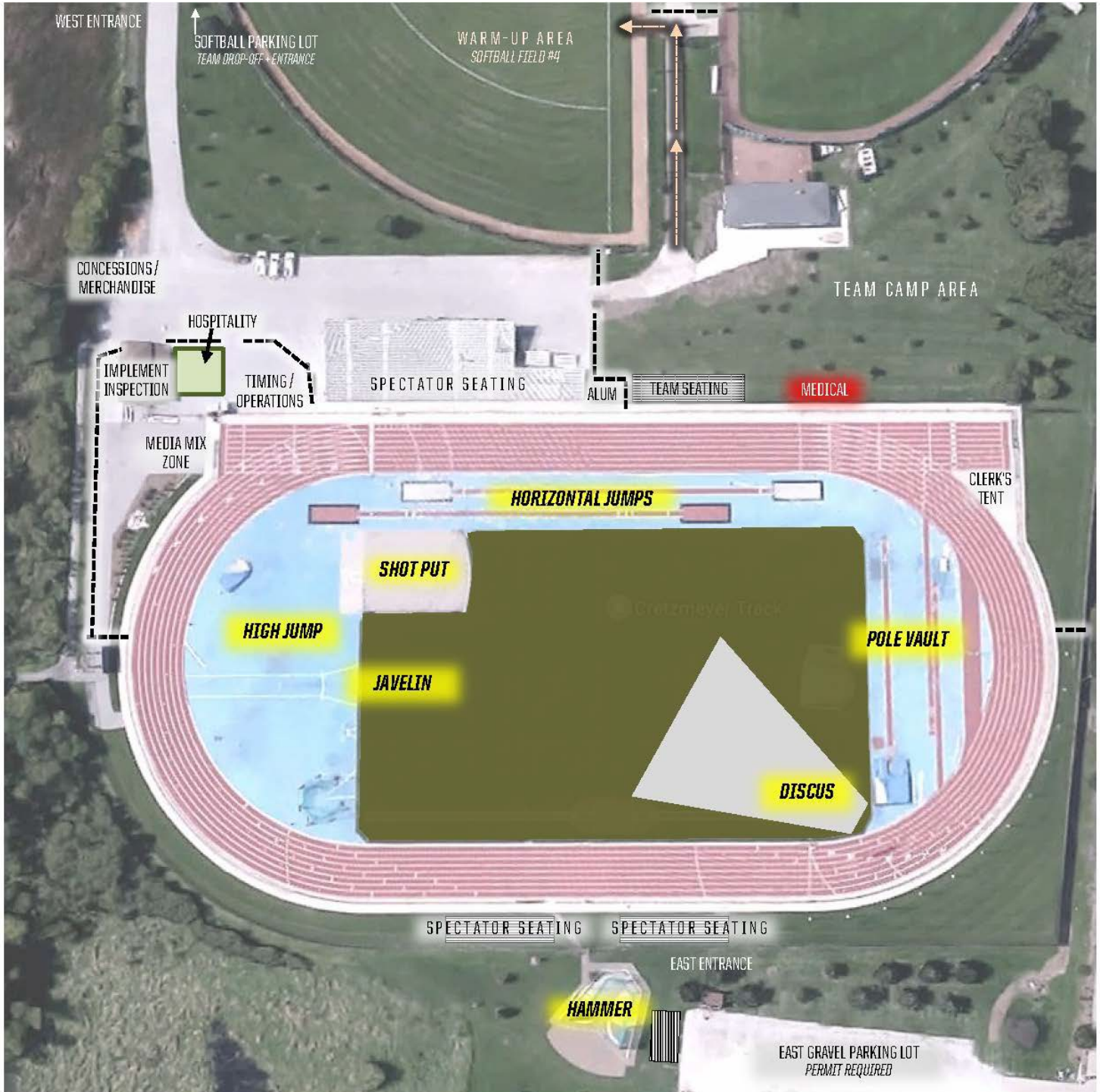
Tickets will be sold onsite on competition day. Tickets may be purchased online at www.hawkeyesports.com/tickets in advance. Adult tickets are \$5 and youth (12 and under) are free. Gates will open one (1) hour prior to the first scheduled event of the day.

The following items are *prohibited*, admission will be denied to anyone carrying such items:

- Alcoholic beverages
- Irritants, noisemakers or any disruptive device
- Outside food, beverages or coolers
- Pets or non-service animals
- Tobacco of any kind
- Weapons of any kind

PARKING / SHUTTLE SERVICE - TEAM BUSES + PUBLIC


Public parking will be available free of charge in the *Hawkeye Commuter Parking Lot (Lot 85)*, with a complementary bus shuttle service to and from the competition facility. *The bus shuttle service will begin two (2) hours prior to the first event and continue one (1) hour after the meet.*

DIRECTIONS TO LOT 85 (route indicated in teal)

GPS Address: [Hawkeye Commuter Lot, Iowa City, IA 52246](#)

Distance: 1.0 mile from the competition facility (estimated 20-minute walk)

- Head south on Mormon Trek Blvd. and continue for 0.4 miles. Turn right onto Hawkeye Park Rd. and continue for 0.6 miles. Hawkeye Commuter Parking Lot (Lot 85) will be on your right.

Complementary bus shuttles will pick-up and drop-off at the bus stop shelter in the middle of the lot (indicated as ).

INDOOR TRACK FACILITY

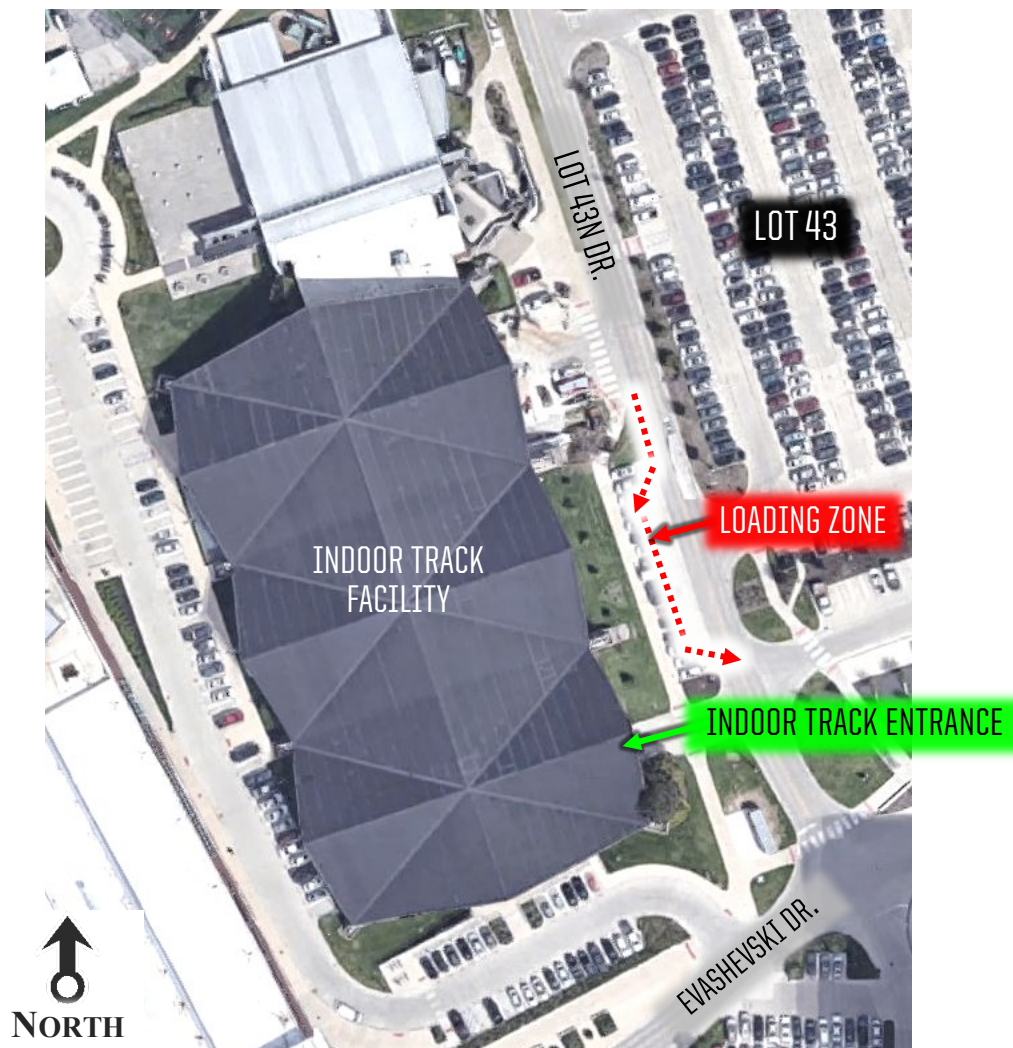

- Head east on Hwy 6/Second St. At the intersection of Second St. and Hawkins Dr., turn right onto Hawkins Dr. Continue on Hawkins Dr. for about 0.5 miles then turn right onto Lot 43N Dr. at the second stop light. The facility will be on the right-hand side of the street, south of the baseball facility.

LOADING ZONE: The bus loading zone is located on the east side of the Indoor Track Facility, between Lot 43N Dr. and the facility. Team buses are to drop-off in designated area (indicated in **RED** on diagram), just off to the west side of Lot 43N Dr. **Buses must pull into the empty stalls and off of the street**, please do not drop-off on the street.

PASSENGER VEHICLE PARKING: Parking will be free of charge in Lot 43 on Saturday, April 23. Parking Lot 43 is located directly outside the east side and south end of the Indoor Track Facility.

ENTRANCE: To access the indoor track, enter through the double doors located outside the southeast corner of the facility. The doors used to enter the indoor track are to the left of the garage door (indicated in **GREEN** on diagram).
