(**Gary Snook**, quarterback, and **Karl Noonan**, flankerback, broke a total of 19 Big Ten and Iowa records and tied 3 during the 1964 season. These men return for their senior season in 1965).

* Ranked **third** in FORWARD PASSING, with 311 attempts, 151 completions, 14 interceptions for .486 pct., 2,062 yards and 11 touchdowns.

Karl Noonan, flankerback

* Ranked **third** in PASS-RECEIVING with 59 catches for 933 yards and 4 touchdowns.

Iowa Team

* Ranked **thirteenth** in TOTAL OFFENSE, with 584 plays for 2,861 yards in 9 games, average of 317.9 per game.

* Ranked **third** in FORWARD PASSING OFFENSE, with 32 attempts, 154 completions, 14 interceptions for .480 pct. and 2,125 yards, 11 touchdowns, average of 236.1 yards per game (9 games).
