Minneapolis, Minn. — The 17th-rated Hawkeyes needed 14 second-half points from forward Lynn Kennedy and another 11 from center Lisa Becker to overcome an 11-point halftime deficit and defeat Minnesota 66-63. Iowa sank just 27 percent of its first half field goal attempts including numerous layups and shots from inside the lane. While the Hawkeyes suffered, Minnesota thrived. The Gophers shot a blistering 67 percent from the field and outrebounded the Hawkeyes 26-15. Becker, who had a team-high 17 points, scored nine points during a five-minute stretch which pulled the Hawkeyes from an eight-point deficit into a 46-45 lead with 9:53 remaining. Free throws by Kennedy, Lisa Long, and Tricia Blair in the final minute helped the Hawkeyes remain unbeaten in league play.

East Lansing, Mich. — Lynn Kennedy again rescued the Hawkeyes from a slow road showing, scoring 17 points and grabbing 10 rebounds in the Hawkeyes' 60-57 women's basketball victory over Michigan State. The victory gave Iowa 4-0 Big Ten and 10-3 overall records going into the game at Michigan. Michigan State pulled into a 31-31 halftime tie then led most of the second half after Iowa took its biggest lead at 31-23. Michelle Edwards edged the Hawkeyes in front to stay, 56-55, with 1:50 remaining. Kennedy hit 7 of 11 floor shots. The Iowa defense played a major role in keeping the Hawkeyes unbeaten in league play. Iowa forced 21 MSU turnovers and was credited with 14 steals.

Ann Arbor, Mich. — Iowa finds itself in second place in the league after losing to Michigan 58-56 in Ann Arbor. It was the third sub-par outing in a row for the Hawkeyes, the No. 16 team in last week's Associated Press Top 20. Iowa's offense sputtered against Michigan and the Wolverines won the game with a pair of free throws with two seconds remaining. Michelle Edwards scored 18 points in the Hawkeye loss. The Wolverines sunk 16 of 21 from the line to Iowa's two.

Iowa City, Iowa — Junior forward Lynn Kennedy and sophomore guard Michelle Edwards combined to lead the Iowa women back into the winner's circle over troublesome Northwestern, 72-58. After the Wildcats swished their first three shots to take a 6-0 lead, Kennedy scored 10 to power a 20-8 surge that took Iowa to a 20-14 lead. Twice the Hawkeyes hiked it to 14 before going into intermission with a 34-23 advantage. The Wildcats found the range from outside during the second half and closed the gap to 49-43. Then Kennedy's six points fueled a 10-2 thrust that put Iowa in front, 59-54, and the Hawkeyes remained ahead by 10 to 14 points the rest of the way. Kennedy led Iowa with 23 points, sinking 10 of 13 floor shots. She also had a game-high 8 rebounds, 5 assists, 5 steals, and 2 blocks. Edwards tallied 21 points, 15 of them in the second half, and dished out 6 assists.

IOWA CITY, Iowa — Iowa Coach C. Vivian Stringer earned victory No. 300 as the Hawkeyes easily handed Wisconsin a 68-32 loss. With the win, Stringer joined six other coaches who have reached the 300 plateau. The Hawkeyes were plagued by poor shooting and bad passing but excelled defensively. Iowa made only 27 of 70 shots from the field for 38 percent. Defensively, Lynn Kennedy led the Hawkeyes with six steals. The Iowa team was credited with 19 steals for the game and forced 29 Badger turnovers. The Hawkeyes took advantage of poor Badger shooting to take to 33-19 halftime lead. The second half belonged to Iowa offensively as the Hawkeyes outscored Wisconsin 35-13.
