News Media Information

IOWA STADIUM is located on the west campus in the heart of the University's athletic complex. It is a few minutes drive from Interstate 80 and the Iowa City airport, about 30 minutes from the Cedar Rapids airport.

PRESS BOX at Iowa Stadium is on the west side and accessible by elevator. One of the nation's finest, it was completed 10 years ago at a cost of \$490,000 (cost to build Iowa Stadium was \$500,000 in 1929). The first deck has 89 seats for working press. The second deck contains 10 booths for radio and television. The third deck is for photographers and has additional radio booths. The fourth deck, not enclosed, is used in various ways. A pre-game lunch is served on the second deck. The press box is about 100 feet high and extends between the 25-yard lines.

PRESS TICKET requests should be directed to George Wine, sports information director. Requests should be filed early enough in advance to allow time for processing.

RADIO-TV TICKET requests should be directed to Bud Suter, athletic relations director. Requests should be filed early enough in advance to allow time for processing.

ATHLETIC OFFICES are located on the east side of the Iowa Field House. The Field House is also on the west campus, near the stadium.
