Bob is of French-Irish descent . . . he also was a versatile baseball player in high school: pitcher, first base, and outfield . . . 6-1 and 19 years old . . . born 10-3-47.

**\*\*PAUL USINOWICZ**—Has been Iowa's tight end for most of the last two seasons . . . last year he was used some at tackle when injuries sidelined many interior linemen . . . was an all-state football player at Pompton Lakes, N.J., and also competed in track . . . earned top honors in math and science in high school and has been an outstanding engineering student at Iowa . . . 6-2 and 210 . . . born 3-26-46.

**GENETH WALKER**—He finished spring drill as No. 2 defensive left end . . . sophomore from Tuscaloosa, Ala., Druid High School . . . 195 pounds and 6-2 . . . wants to study computer science . . . an all-stater in high school and member of senior

honor society . . . nickname is Gino . . . says his greatest thrill was being awarded a student-athlete scholarship by The University of Iowa . . . born 3-15-48.

**\*\*TONY WILLIAMS**—One of most versatile Hawkeye players and the 1967 captain . . . as a soph he earned everyone's respect with his toughness as a defensive back and last year he took over the tailback duties for Ray Nagel . . . now he's back in the defensive backfield and he will be one of Big Ten's best . . . wherever he plays he always gives 100 per cent and he is a hitter . . . two-time all-stater from Davenport West and on the all-American team in 1963 . . . 5-11 and 182 . . . born 7-4-46.

**\*STEVE WILSON**—Earned letter as defensive back in 1966 . . . finished spring ball as Iowa's safety . . . was an all-state quarterback at Rock Island, Ill., and he and Al Bream teamed up for a devastating air attack . . . also excelled in track and was second in high hurdles in state meet as a senior . . . at Iowa he has high jumped for the Hawks' track team . . . 6-1 and 169 . . . born 5-1-47.
