Iowa corraled Texas 55-17 in the inaugural Freedom Bowl with the aid of a record-setting passing exhibition by Chuck Long. The 55 points was the highest point total ever recorded in bowl history. Long led the assault on Texas, completing 29 of 39 passes for 461 yards and six touchdowns, all school records. The victory ran Iowa's season record to 8-4-1, marking the fourth straight year that Iowa had won at least eight games and made a bowl appearance.
