Game 8: Iowa 65 (15 AP), Penn State 63 (6 AP)
 Carver-Hawkeye Arena, Iowa City
 December 8, 1985

Iowa City — Iowa shot 63 percent from the field in the second half — and limited Penn State to a success rate of just 34 percent — en route to a 65-63 upset victory over the sixth-ranked Lady Lions. The Hawkeyes stretched a one-point halftime lead to a 53-40 margin by outscoring Penn State 22-10 during the first 10 minutes of the second half. Iowa then held on as an 11th hour comeback by the Lady Lions fell short. Lisa Becker's perfect seven-of-seven performance from the field was just one of several keys to what Coach C. Vivian Stringer called, "The biggest win in the history of the Iowa program." Iowa won despite having starting forward Lisa Long and starting guard Tricia Blair on the bench with injuries. Michelle Edwards, nursing a tender left ankle, played only two minutes. Iowa limited Penn State's all-American guard, Suzie McConnell, to just four field goals in 16 attempts.

Ames — Iowa's frontline of Lisa Becker, Lynn Kennedy, and Jolynn Schneider scored 27 points on 14 of 23 shooting from the field to lead the Hawkeyes to a 63-57 victory over a very much improved Iowa State team. Iowa stretched a one-point halftime lead into a 12-point cushion before needing free throws from Pam Williams, Schneider, and Michelle Edwards in the final 57 seconds to secure the win.

Iowa City — A career-high 18 points by Pam Williams — 14 of which coming in the first half alone — and a 12-point, 13-rebound performance by Lynn Kennedy weren't enough as the 14th rated Hawkeyes and C. Vivian Stringer lost for the third straight time to intrastate rival Drake, this time by a 64-63 count. The Hawkeyes took their first lead of the second half, 57-56, when Shanda Berry sank a jumper in the lane. However, sink points by Julie Fitzpatrick, the game's leading scorer with 23 points, during the final 1:54 provided the Bulldogs with the victory. Fitzpatrick's winning points came from the free throw line after she was fouled by Tracy Washington on an inbounds play with 17 seconds remaining. Washington had provided the Hawkeyes with a 63-62 lead just five seconds earlier when she dropped in a layup.

Iowa City — The Hawkeyes, idle for more than three weeks, bursted from the starting gate in their Big Ten Conference opener, running an improved Purdue Boilermaker team out of Carver-Hawkeye Arena with a convincing 79-52 victory. Lisa Becker's 16 points was tops among the 12 Hawkeyes who scored. Lynn Kennedy added 12, Michelle Edwards 11 and Lisa Long 10. Iowa outrebounded the much shorter Boilermakers 51-24. Becker also was Iowa's top rebounder. The junior center pulled down nine caroms while Kennedy grabbed eight. The game marked the return of starters Long, Edwards, and Blair. All three were hampered by injuries during the month of December.

Iowa City — Iowa's defense forced 34 turnovers and grabbed 16 steals to lead the Hawkeyes to their second straight Big Ten Conference win, a 74-57 thumping of Illinois. The game was marred by 50 fouls and 47 turnovers — as well as some 28 missed free throws. However, Iowa regrouped to lead at halftime 31-24 and outscored Illinois 19-4 during the first nine minutes of the second half to put the game away. Lisa Long came off the bench to lead the Hawkeyes in scoring with 16 points. Lynn Kennedy added 10 points and a game-high nine rebounds. Twelve of 14 of the Hawkeyes scored, including Shanda Berry who had a career-high seven points in 30 minutes of court time.

Minneapolis, Minn. — The 17th-rated Hawkeyes needed 14 second-half points from forward Lynn Kennedy and another 11 from center Lisa Becker to overcome an 11-point halftime deficit and defeat Minnesota 66-63. Iowa sank just 27 percent of its first half field goal attempts including numerous layups and shots from inside the lane. While the Hawkeyes suffered, Minnesota thrived. The Gophers shot a blistering 67 percent from the field and outrebounded the Hawkeyes 26-15. Becker, who had a team-high 17 points, scored nine points during a five-minute stretch which pulled the Hawkeyes from an eight-point deficit into a 46-45 lead with 9:53 remaining. Free throws by Kennedy, Lisa Long, and Tricia Blair in the final minute helped the Hawkeyes remain unbeaten in league play.

East Lansing, Mich. — Lynn Kennedy again rescued the Hawkeyes from a slow road showing, scoring 17 points and grabbing 10 rebounds in the Hawkeyes' 60-57 women's basketball victory over Michigan State. The victory gave Iowa 4-0 Big Ten and 10-3 overall records going into the game at Michigan. Michigan State pulled into a 31-31 halftime tie then led most of the second half after Iowa took its biggest lead at 31-23. Michelle Edwards edged the Hawkeyes in front to stay, 56-55, with 1:50 remaining. Kennedy hit 7 of 11 floor shots. The Iowa defense played a major role in keeping the Hawkeyes unbeaten in league play. Iowa forced 21 MSU turnovers and was credited with 14 steals.
