Iowa City, Iowa — The Hawkeyes made good on their vow to "shut 'em down and blow 'em out" Friday night. The halftime announcement of Ohio State's first loss in 37 Big Ten games helped ignite a 19-0 Hawkeye rampage in the first 7:20 of the second half, and they coasted home to a 63-42 triumph over the Wolverines. In avenging its 58-56 upset loss at Ann Arbor, 16th-ranked Iowa advanced its record to 9-2, 16-5 overall. The Hawkeyes' Michelle Edwards and Tricia Blair combined for 30 points, 18 and 12 respectively. Lynn Kennedy contributed 11 points and seven rebounds, forward Lisa Long had a game-high 10 rebounds in the 26 minutes she played.

Madison, Wis. — Michelle Edwards scored 16 points, Lynn Kennedy 15, and Lisa Long 14 to lead 14th-ranked Iowa to a 61-47 win over Wisconsin. Iowa trailed 30-29 at halftime and took its first lead of the game, 41-40 on a Kennedy goal with 8:50 left to play. The Hawkeyes opened a 54-42 lead, then outscored the Badgers 10-2 to open a 55-44 advantage with 3:13 left in the game. Edwards had six points in the burst, Kenney the other four. The Hawkeyes shot 52 percent from the field in the second half. Long, who scored 10 points in the second half, grabbed a game-high 12 rebounds. The Badgers outrebounded the Hawkeyes, 38-33, as they sought to slow Iowa's transition game.

Evanston, Ill. — Michelle Edwards scored 23 points to spark 14th-ranked Iowa to a 69-66 overtime win over inspired Northwestern. Edwards' jump shot with one second left in regulation tied the score 60-60, and sent the game into overtime. Junior forward Lisa Long added 19 points, 13 in the second half, and 11 rebounds. Kennedy's free throw off a foul by Northwestern's Laura Wiesen gave the Hawkeyes a 68-64 advantage, their biggest lead of the game. The Hawkeyes managed to let the Wildcats go to the free throw line only three times in the second half, scoring just twice.

Iowa City, Iowa — With center Lisa Becker and forward Lisa Long combining for 21 of its first 23 points, 13th-ranked Iowa shattered "the Ohio State barrier" and climbed into a tie with the Buckeyes for the Big Ten Conference basketball lead. A Carver-Hawkeye Arena crowd of 10,424, seventh largest in women's basketball history, saw Iowa hand Ohio State its first defeat of the season by a margin of more than four points. Iowa's first 23 points gave the Hawkeyes a 10-point lead with 10:06 left in the half. They were on top at intermission, 42-29. The Hawkeyes hit a sizzling 69 percent from the field in the first half, 64.2 percent overall. Iowa's biggest lead was 14 points, twice in the first half and at 50-36 four minutes into the second. Ohio State cut the margin to 67-62 with 2:59 remaining, but the Hawkeyes put the game away with an 8-2 run. Becker was presented with the game ball after her second goal of the night gave her 1,000 career points.

Iowa City, Iowa — The Iowa women held Indiana scoreless in the final four minutes and 25 seconds of the game, breaking from a 49-47 lead to a 63-47 victory. A crowd of 3,410 watched the game at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. Iowa pushed its overall record to 21-5 to become the winningest Hawkeye team in the 12 seasons of women's basketball at Iowa. The Hawkeyes were flat during the first half and were outplayed by the Hoosiers who had a 23-22 halftime edge. Iowa improved in the second half, ending up with 47.5 percent for the game. Michelle Edwards led Iowa scoring with 22 points and Lisa Becker added 12 and pulled down 10 rebounds. Tracy Washington connected from outside for 10 points. Long's 10 rebounds moves her into third place on Iowa's career rebounding list with 545.

Champaign, Ill. — Balanced scoring, torrid second-half shooting and a 13-point advantage at the free throw line gave Illinois the firepower to upset 12th-ranked Iowa and destroy the Hawkeyes' hopes for a share of the Big Ten title. Iowa was led in scoring by sophomore guard Michelle Edwards' 16 points. Lisa Long scored 14 during the 20 minutes she played. Lisa Becker chipped in 13 before fouling out with more than four minutes left. The Illini took the lead for keeps, 35-33, just two minutes into the second half on Jenny Middeler's lay-in. Iowa pulled within four, 53-49, when Edwards followed her own miss, but then the Hawkeyes' comeback bid stopped.

West Lafayette, Ind. — Four Hawkeyes scored in double figures to lead the Iowa women's basketball team to a 80-63 drubbing of Purdue in the regular season finale for both teams. Lisa Long finished the contest with a personal season high of 21 points. Lynn Kennedy added 19, Michelle Edwards 14 and Lisa Becker 11. Long and Kennedy each scored 13 points and grabbed five rebounds during the second half as Iowa stretched its 35-28 halftime margin to 18 points on three occasions. Iowa used a 10-3 spurt during the first six minutes of the second stanza to break the game open. Long scored six of the Hawkeyes' points as she began to assert herself in the lane. Iowa shot a blistering 74 percent during the second half en route to its second highest scoring output of the season.
