### JIMMY V CLASSIC STORYLINES

- Iowa will be making its first-ever appearance in the Jimmy V Classic, while this will be Duke's fourth appearance in the event (1998, 2001, 2016).
- Duke leads the all-time series over Iowa, 7-1. The last time the two teams met was in the 2001 ACC/Big Ten Challenge in Chicago (Duke won 80-62). Iowa's only win over Duke came on Dec. 27, 1994 in the rainbow Classic in Honolulu (81-71).
- Kris Murray amassed 31 points, 20 rebounds, four assists, four 3-pointers, and two blocks in Iowa's last game against Georgia Tech. He is the first Hawkeye to amass 30 points and 20 rebounds in the same game since Bruce King in 1977. He is also the only NBA, WNBA, or Division I men's or women's player in the last 20 years to total 30+ points, 20+ rebounds, 4+ assists, 4+ 3-pointers, and 2+ blocks in the same game.
- Fran McCaffery is in his 27th season as a head coach and is one victory from 500. He has amassed 248 wins at Iowa; 112 at Siena; 90 at UNC Greensboro; and 49 at Lehigh.
- Kris and his brother, Keegan, are the only brothers in Division I in the last 20 years to each have a 20-point/20-rebounds performance at the same school.
- Tuesday is the third of three contests against ACC opponents over a span of 12 days. Iowa beat Clemson on Nov. 25 (74-71) and Georgia Tech on Nov. 29 (81-65).
- Iowa is tops in the country in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.97).
- Iowa boasts an 18-4 record since moving Tony Perkins to the starting lineup last year (Feb. 6).
- Iowa ranks second in the Big Ten and 12th nationally in scoring offense (86.4). The Hawkeyes have led the league in scoring five of the last nine seasons, including the last four.
- Kris Murray and Patrick McCaffery were voted to the Emerald Coast Classic All-Tournament Team. Murray averaged a double-double (10.5 points, 11 rebounds), while McCaffery led the team with a career-high 21 points in Iowa's three-point victory over Clemson.
- Iowa is the middle of six straight games against teams from Power 5 conferences.
- Kris Murray is the only Division I player over the last 25 years to have scored 95+ points, grabbed 30+ rebounds, had five or fewer turnovers, shot 60 percent from the field, and 100 percent from the foul line over any four-game span during a season. Murray accomplished the feat in the first four games earlier this month.
- Four Hawkeyes are shooting 50 percent or better from the field: Connor McCaffery (.571), Filip Rebraca (.533), Dasonte Bowen (.520), and Kris Murray (.514).
- Iowa won four games in four days to capture the 2022 Big Ten Tournament Championship, its third tournament title in program history and first since 2006.
- The Hawkeyes have won 42 games over Big Ten teams -- including conference tournament contests -- over the past three seasons, second most in the league (Illinois, 47).
- Fran McCaffery has coached a first-team All-Big Ten honoree seven of the last nine years. He has guided Iowa to 20+ wins eight of the last 10 seasons, including four-straight.

## THE SETTING

Iowa (6-1) will challenge No. 17 Duke (8-2) on Tuesday in the Jimmy V Classic. Tipoff will be approximately 8:30 p.m. (CT) at Madison Square Garden in New York. The other game featured in the basketball doubleheader is No. 2 Texas versus No. 16 Illinois, which will start at 6 p.m. (CT).

## ON THE AIR

**Radio:** Games are broadcast on the Hawkeye Radio Network. Gary Dolphin handles the play-by-play, along with color commentator Bob Hansen. The network includes more than 40 stations that blanket the state of Iowa and include portions of Illinois, Nebraska, Minnesota, Missouri and Wisconsin. The Hawkeye Radio Network coverage includes a 60-minute pregame show.

**TV:** Tuesday's contest will be televised nationally on ESPN. Dan Shulman, Dick Vitale, and Holly Rowe will call the action.

## IOWA IN THE GARDEN

Tuesday will be Iowa's 11th game at Madison Square Garden and first appearance since winning the 2018 2K Empire Classic with victories over Oregon and Connecticut.

Iowa's first appearance in the Garden was when the Hawkeyes competed in the 1999 Coaches vs. Cancer Classic, beating top-ranked Connecticut before falling to Stanford.

Other appearances include two games in the 2018 Big Ten Tournament (beat Illinois and lost to Michigan); two contests in the 2014 2K Empire Classic (lost to Texas and Syracuse); two games in the 2013 Postseason NIT (beat Maryland and lost to Baylor in the championship).

## HAWKEYES BEAT GEORGIA TECH IN FINAL ACC/BIG TEN CHALLENGE CONTEST

Four Hawkeyes scored in double figures, led by Kris Murray's 31 points, in an 81-65 victory over Georgia Tech Tuesday evening in Iowa City.

- Iowa won eight of the final 10 ACC/Big Ten Challenge games, including five straight at home.
- Kris Murray recorded his fourth double-double in five games, reaching double-digit rebounds and points in the first 13:15 of the game. Murray finished the contest with 31 points and career bests in rebounds (20) and assists (4). Murray has netted 20+ points four of the last six contests.
- The last Hawkeye to total 30+ points and 20+ rebounds in a game was Bruce King versus Ohio State on Jan. 27, 1977 (31 points; 21 rebounds).
- The last time a Hawkeye pulled down 20 or more rebounds in a game was Kris' brother Keegan versus N.C. Central on Nov. 16, 2021. Tuesday's 20-rebounding performance marks the 25th time in program history that the feat was accomplished.
- Murray's 31 points and 20 rebounds are both the most by a Hawkeye in an ACC Challenge game. The 20 rebounds tie Justin Champagnie (Pitt in 2020) for the most by any player in a Challenge game and are the most by any Big Ten player.
- Connor McCaffery posted his first career double-double (10 points; 10 rebounds). The 10 rebounds are a season best for the Hawkeye senior.
- Iowa improved to 2-1 all-time against the Yellow Jackets.

## HEAD COACH FRAN McCAFFERY

Fran McCaffery, who is signed through the 2028 season, is in his 13th season as the head basketball coach at the University of Iowa and his 27th year overall as a college head coach. McCaffery has reached the 20-win plateau 11 of the last 15 seasons, including four straight.

McCaffery spent five seasons (2005-10) as the head coach at Siena, six years at UNC-Greensboro (1999-2005) and three seasons at Lehigh (1985-88) before joining the Hawkeyes.

McCaffery has nearly four decades of Division I coaching experience. He is in his 41st season as a collegiate coach, which includes 27 years as a head coach and 14 as an assistant. Last March, McCaffery joined Hall of Fame coaches Rick Pitino, Bob Huggins, Eddie Sutton and Lefty Driesell as the only Division I coaches to lead teams to conference tournament titles in four or more different leagues (Big Ten, MAAC, SoCon, ECC). He is one of 14 coaches to lead at least four different Division I teams to the NCAA Tournament.

McCaffery, 62, holds a career mark of 499-340 (.595) and guided his teams to 15 postseason appearances (11 NCAA & four NIT). Iowa likely would have competed in another NCAA Tournament in 2020, if not for the NCAA canceling the postseason due to COVID-19. He is 248-163 (.605) at Iowa; the second winningest coach in program history. McCaffery led Iowa to wins in four of the last seven NCAA Tournaments (2015, 2016, 2019, and 2021).

Since taking over the Iowa program in 2010, Iowa has earned nine postseason tournament bids (6 NCAA, 3 NIT). McCaffery coached Iowa to a Big Ten Tournament title and 26 wins in 2022, the second-most win total in program history. McCaffery has guided five players to first team All-Big Ten status six of the last eight years, including the 2020 & 2021 National and Big Ten Player of the Year, Luka Garza.

McCaffery has posted upper division finishes in nine of the last 10 seasons at Iowa and 21 of 26 seasons as a head coach. The Hawkeyes have finished fifth or better in the Big Ten standings six of the last eight years. He has posted 20 wins or more 11 of the last 15 seasons, including eight of the last 10 years at Iowa (2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2019, 2020, 2021, and 2022). Iowa's 205 victories between 2013-21 are the most over a 10-year span at Iowa since 1987-96 (207).

McCaffery and the Hawkeyes boast a 153-40 (.793) home record the last 11 seasons, which includes a school-record 18 wins in 2014 and 13 consecutive victories in 2019-20. Iowa has won 14+ games in Carver-Hawkeye Arena each of the last four seasons (2019, 2020, 2021, and 2022).

McCaffery's five years at Siena were the best in its 70-year history. He led the Saints on an incredible run that ended with three straight Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference championships and NCAA Tournament appearances.

McCaffery's Saints owned a 112-51 (.687) record in his five years with the program. He guided the Saints to four consecutive 20-win seasons. McCaffery's achievements earned the head coach Siena Hall of Fame recognition in 2017.

The 2009 MAAC Coach of the Year and 2010 District I Coach of the Year is the third winningest coach, by percentage, in league history (.687). He is the only coach to guide a MAAC program to two NCAA Tournament wins. McCaffery led his 2008 and 2009 teams to first round NCAA Tournament victories over Vanderbilt and Ohio State, respectively.

In his final two seasons at Siena, he coached the Saints to back-to-back 27-win campaigns and boasted a combined 39-3 (.929) record against MAAC opponents, which included MAAC Tournament contests.

McCaffery began his coaching career as an assistant at Penn (1982-83) and Lehigh (1983-85). After three seasons as head coach at Lehigh, he spent 11 seasons as an assistant at Notre Dame (1988-99).

McCaffery played basketball at Wake Forest his freshman year (1977-78) and concluded his playing career at Penn his final three seasons (1979-82).

He earned his B.S. degree in Economics from The Wharton School (Penn) in 1982. McCaffery also earned a Master of Education from Lehigh in 1985.

## 2022-23 IOWA CAPTAINS

Iowa captains are Connor McCaffery and Filip Rebraca.

### SCOUTING DUKE

- The Blue Devils are 8-2 overall with their two losses coming to ranked opponents on neutral floors: No. 6 Kansas, 69-64, and No. 24 Purdue, 75-56.
- Tuesday will be Duke's fifth contest on a neutral floor this season (2-2).
- Duke's roster consists of seven freshmen, two sophomores, two juniors, and four graduate students.
- The Blue Devils have been one of the nation's best in rebounding margin, averaging 9.9 more rebounds than their opponents.
- Duke is currently shooting at 43 percent from the field, 30.5 percent from 3-point range, and 77 percent from the free throw line.
- Freshman center Kyle Filipowski ranks first in the ACC in double-doubles and sixth nationally (5). He recorded the first three double-doubles in the first three games of his college career. Filipowski is second in the conference and 10th nationally in rebounds (93).
- Junior guard captain Jeremy Roach returns for his junior season after being the starting point guard on the 2022 Final Four squad. Roach was named preseason first-team All-ACC. He averages 12.2 points per game and 2.4 boards.
- Head Coach Jon Scheyer is in his first year at the helm of the Blue Devils. A former Duke All-American himself, Scheyer replaces Hall of Fame head coach Mike Krzyzewski. Scheyer has been on the team's staff since the 2013-14 season.

### CLEANING THE GLASS

Through seven games, Iowa is averaging 40.3 rebounds per game, an average that ranks 36th nationally. Iowa's top rebounders are Kris Murray (10.6) and Filip Rebraca (8.0).

The Hawkeyes have averaged 40+ rebounds per game just once over the last 25 seasons; Iowa's 2013-14 squad finished the season averaging 40.3 rebounds per contest.

### STRONG START FOR PATRICK MCCAFFERY

Patrick McCaffery netted double figures in scoring 11 of the last 18 games played last season.

He made at least one trey in 12 of the last 18 games, including sinking multiple triples in six contests during that stretch.

McCaffery has carried that momentum over to his junior season, netting double figures in five of Iowa's first seven games of the season. McCaffery scored a personal-best 21 points in back-to-back games two weeks ago versus North Carolina A&T and Clemson.

### MURRAY NAMED TO PRESEASON LISTS

Junior Kris Murray has been named to the Big Ten Preseason All-Big Ten Team, the Wooden Award Top 50, and the Karl Malone Award.

It marks the fourth straight season that one or more Hawkeyes have been selected to the preseason all-conference squad, voted upon by a selected panel of media. Joe Wieskamp was selected in 2019 and 2020, Luka Garza was tabbed the Big Ten Preseason Player of the Year in 2020, while Kris' twin brother Keegan was recognized in 2021. Keegan was also the recipient of the 2022 Karl Malone Award.

Murray is averaging a team-best 21 points per game this season, he has made 22-of-26 from the free throw line, and ranks tops on the squad averaging 10.6 rebounds per outing. Murray has increased his scoring average by 11.3 points per game this season compared to last year. His scoring average of 21 points per contest is second best in the Big Ten and 14th nationally.

He was Iowa's leading scorer (9.7) and rebounder (4.3) off the bench last season. He improved his scoring average by 9.1 points and rebounding average by 3.7 per outing. The native of Cedar Rapids, Iowa, was second on the team in 3-point percentage (.397), blocks per game (0.9) and field goals made (124), third in offensive (1.6) and defensive (2.7) rebounds per contest, and fourth in steals (0.8) per game. Murray made at least one 3-pointer in a team-best 17 consecutive games (Jan. 22-March 13). His 31 blocks and 43 triples rank seventh and eighth, respectively, by a Hawkeye sophomore.

### LEADER OF THE PACK

Connor McCaffery is Iowa's career leader in assist-to-turnover ratio, amassing a 3.42 ratio in 141 career games (424 assists; 124 turnovers), nearly 1.0 above second-place Andre Banks (2.53).

His assist-to-turnover ratio last year was 5.0, while he ranked fourth nationally in 2021 with a 3.73 ratio. In 2020, he led the country with a 4.6 ratio.



### **ANOTHER SIXTH YEAR PLAYER**

After six seasons and multiple broken records, Jordan Bohannon has exhausted his collegiate eligibility. Bohannon is the program's career leader in four statistical categories: assists (704), 3-pointers made (455), games played (179), and free throw percentage (.887, 370-417). His 455 triples are the most in Big Ten history and 192 more than any other Hawkeye.

Connor McCaffery decided to utilize his COVID bonus year and return for his sixth season with the Hawkeyes.

McCaffery is averaging 5.4 points and 3.6 rebounds per game, and has made 9-of-15 (.600) from 3-point range this season. He posted his first career double-double in Iowa's last outing versus Georgia Tech (10 points; 10 rebounds).

### **IOWA SCHEDULE NOTES**

- Iowa will play back-to-back conference road games four times.
- The Hawkeyes have a stretch of four straight home contests in December (ISU, Wisconsin, SE Missouri State and Eastern Illinois).
- Iowa has seven weekend home contests (three on Saturdays and four on Sundays), including six against Big Ten foes. The Hawkeyes have home games inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena on a Saturday or Sunday four of the final six weekends of the regular season.
- The Hawkeyes have a stretch of four of five league home games in early January. Iowa will host Indiana (Jan. 5), Michigan (Jan. 12), Maryland (Jan. 15) and Northwestern (Jan. 18).
- Iowa is scheduled to play at Penn State on New Year's Day. The Hawkeyes have played on New Year's Day 10 previous times, most recently in 2017, versus Michigan in Iowa City. Prior to 2017, Iowa's last New Year's Day contest was in 1946 versus Saint Louis. The last time the Hawkeyes played a road game on New Year's Day was at Toledo in 1940.
- Iowa has three trips to the Tri-State Area, traveling to New Jersey twice (Nov. 16 at Seton Hall and Jan. 8 at Rutgers) and New York once (Dec. 6 versus Duke at Madison Square Garden).
- Iowa will play on Super Bowl Sunday for the fourth straight season and sixth time in eight years, playing its only regular season game against Minnesota in Minneapolis on Feb. 12.
- Five of Iowa's final eight league games will be on the road.

### **IOWA WINS 4 GAMES IN 4 DAYS. WIN BIG TEN TOURNAMENT TITLE**

Iowa outscored ninth-ranked Purdue 12-4 over the final 2:45 to post a 75-66 triumph and capture the program's third Big Ten Tournament championship in Indianapolis.

- The Hawkeyes (2001, 2022) joined Michigan (2017, 2018) as the only schools to win Big Ten Tournament titles twice by winning four games in four days.
- All-American Keegan Murray was named the Big Ten Tournament Most Outstanding Player, while Murray and Jordan Bohannon were named to the all-tournament team.
- Murray broke the record for most points (103) and field goals made (38) in a single Big Ten Tournament, surpassing the previous mark of 92 points and 34 field goals made by Ohio State's Duane Washington Jr. in 2021.
- Both Iowa's men's and women's basketball teams won the Big Ten Tournament title in the same year for a second time (2001 and 2022).

### **VALUING THE BASKETBALL**

The Hawkeyes were tops in the country in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.74); fourth in fewest turnovers per game (9.2); and seventh in turnover margin (4.4) last season.

Through seven games, Iowa has a 1.97 assist-to-turnover ratio, which is tops in the country. Iowa averages 9.3 turnovers per game, which ranks sixth nationally.

### **BACK-TO-BACK-TO-BACK**

Iowa became the first school to have a men's basketball player lead the Big Ten in scoring three straight seasons since Purdue from 1968-70.

Iowa's Luka Garza led the conference in scoring average in 2020 (26.2 ppg) and 2021 (21.9 ppg). Keegan Murray led the league in 2022, averaging 23.5 points per game in all games. Murray finished the 20-game league schedule as the Big Ten's leading scorer, averaging 22.8 points per contest.

Purdue legend Rick Mount led the Big Ten in scoring in 1968 (29.7 ppg), 1969 (35.2 ppg), and 1970 (39.4 ppg).

### **HAWKEYE FASTBREAKS**

- The Hawkeyes rank No. 22 in KenPom's rankings, including No. 2 in adjusted offensive efficiency and No. 74 in adjusted defensive efficiency.
- Redshirt senior Connor McCaffery and redshirt junior Patrick McCaffery are one of 22 father/coach and son/player duos in Division I in 2022-23. Of the 22 schools, Iowa and Michigan are the only programs with a father/coach and two sons on the roster.
- Iowa has won 81 of its last 86 nonconference home games, dating back to 2012.
- The Hawkeyes boasted a 15-3 record in home games in 2021-22. Iowa has won 14+ home contests each of the last four years.
- Iowa is 135-28 when scoring 80 points or more, the last 13 seasons. The Hawkeyes are 92-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 61 points, the last 12 years.
- Six Hawkeyes are Iowa natives, two hail from Illinois, two are international (Serbia and England), and one each from New York, Nebraska, Massachusetts, Michigan, and Indiana. Iowa's average height is 6-foot-5.
- After his historic season, Keegan Murray was selected by the Sacramento Kings with the fourth pick in the 2022 NBA Draft, the highest selection by a Hawkeye in program history.
- Iowa has been a top five seed in the last three B1G Tournaments.
- Iowa has won 10 or more Big Ten games seven of the last eight seasons.
- Iowa posted its ninth upper division Big Ten finish in the last 10 seasons. The Hawkeyes have finished fifth or better in the regular season standings six of the last eight years.
- The Hawkeyes have been ranked in the final AP Poll each of the last three years: No. 16 in 2022; No. 8 in 2021; No. 25 in 2020. The last time Iowa has been ranked in the final AP Poll three consecutive seasons was 1987 (#6), 1988 (#17) and 1989 (#14).
- Iowa won 26 games last season, the second most single season total in program history (30 in 1987).
- Keegan Murray became Iowa's single-season scoring leader (822 points). After going 117 years without a player scoring 700 points in a single season, the Hawkeyes have had a player score over 700 points in each of the last three seasons: Luka Garza scored 740 in 2020 and 747 in 2021.
- After his historic season, Keegan Murray was selected by the Sacramento Kings with the fourth pick in the 2022 NBA Draft, the highest selection by a Hawkeye in program history.
- Iowa has qualified for six NCAA tournaments over the last eight completed seasons (2014-16, 2019, 2021, 2022) and nine postseason tournaments over the last 10 completed seasons (6 NCAA; 3 NIT). The 2020 postseason was canceled due to COVID-19.
- Iowa won 68 games combined over the last three seasons (20 in 2020; 22 in 2021; 26 in 2022). The 68 victories are the fourth most over a three-year stretch in program history and most since winning 77 contests from 1987-89.

## FRAN McCAFFERY CONTINUES TO WIN

- With Iowa's Big Ten Tournament win last March, McCaffery joined Hall of Fame coaches Rick Pitino, Bob Huggins, Eddie Sutton and Lefty Driesell as the only Division I coaches to lead teams to conference tournament titles in four or more different leagues.
- Fran McCaffery has guided Iowa to 20 wins or more in eight of the last 10 seasons. He has led Iowa to Big Ten upper division finishes nine of the last 10 years. Iowa, Michigan State, and Wisconsin have each recorded a Big Ten-best nine first division finishes since 2013.
- Fran McCaffery has coached a first-team All-Big Ten honoree seven of the last nine seasons. He has guided Iowa to 20+ wins seven of the last nine seasons and fifth place or better finishes in the Big Ten six of the last eight years.

### IOWA HISTORY

Iowa has played 2,915 games since beginning basketball in 1902. Iowa's overall record is 1,724-1,191 (.591). Iowa's 1,724 wins are 36th most among Division I programs. That includes a 1,101-377 (.745) record in home games, a 623-814 (.433) record in contests away from Iowa City, an 814-813 (.501) mark in Big Ten games and a 505-151 (.770) record in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

### STAFF CHANGES

Fran McCaffery has a couple changes to his staff following last season. Assistant Coach Kirk Speraw retired and Assistant Coach Billy Taylor left for a head coaching position at Elon. Replacing Speraw and Taylor are Courtney Eldridge and Matt Gatens. Eldridge was on staff the previous six seasons, most recently as director of player development and recruiting director. Gatens is a former Hawkeye and most recently was an assistant coach at Drake.

Tristan Spurlock, who played basketball at UCF, is the new Director of Player Development. Al Seibert's title changed to Chief of Staff, while Kyle Denning is now the team's Director of Operations.

### IOWA AND THE V FOUNDATION PARTNER FOR CANCER RESEARCH

The University of Iowa is partnering with the V Foundation for Cancer Research on the 16th annual V Week for Cancer Research. Concluding on Dec. 11, this year's V Week includes a variety of activities and fundraising opportunities across ESPN and the V Foundation channels. The effort is named after Jim Valvano, the legendary North Carolina State University basketball coach and ESPN commentator whose life was ultimately taken by cancer.

Iowa, along with seven other universities taking part in the Jimmy V Classic, will raise funds to support cancer research, including at UI Holden Comprehensive Cancer Center and the Adolescent and Young Adult Cancer Program.

The Adolescent and Young Adult (AYA) Cancer Program specializes in addressing the individual needs of young people ages 13-39 as they navigate their cancer journey. This program is a joint effort between University of Iowa Stead Family Children's Hospital and Holden Comprehensive Cancer Center.

The program provides specialized nursing and counselor support, pain and palliative care, fertility and reproductive health, and survivorship planning geared toward patients in this age range. The AYA Cancer Program gives patients access to the latest treatment options by developing and researching new clinical trials specifically designed to help AYA patients.

Throughout V Week, ESPN and the V Foundation will highlight stories from cancer survivors, including Patrick McCaffery, who battled thyroid cancer at the age of 14 and is a member of the Hawkeye men's basketball team. "I will continue to be an advocate and role model for cancer research," said McCaffery. "Anything you can do with Jimmy V's name attached is special. I'm forever grateful to play on the big stage of the Jimmy V Classic and embody Jim's 'Don't give up. Don't ever give up' mantra."

Viewers can join the fight through a variety of initiatives including:

- The 28th Annual Jimmy V Classic (Dec. 4 and 6): This year, eight teams will take the court for the men's and women's Jimmy V Classic on ESPN. The men's event will take place on December 6 at Madison Square Garden with back-to-back games beginning with Illinois vs. Texas followed by Iowa vs. Duke. Event proceeds benefit cancer research.
- The Inaugural Jimmy V Classic Challenge (Nov. 29 through Dec. 9): The Jimmy V Classic is being taken to another level this year as all eight schools participating in the Jimmy V Classic will collectively raise dollars for cancer research. The money raised will be split 50/50 between V Foundation funded grants and local research initiatives supported by each school and approved by the V Foundation.
