• lowa kicked off the 2022-23 season with a 192-107 victory against UNI.

• The Hawkeyes tied Vanderbilt at 131 in the last home meet of the 2022-23 season.

• Six lowa athletes performed top-ten marks in program history during the Hawkeye Invitational on Dec. 1-3.

• The Hawkeyes entered the season returning seven athletes and welcoming 14 newcomers, including three transfers.

• Amongst the returners are junior divers Sarah Ballard and Claire Hartley and sophomore Makayla Hughbanks, who all qualified to compete in last season's NCAA Zone D Diving Championships.

HEAD COACH NATHAN MUNDT



Nathan Mundt is in his second season as head coach of the University of Iowa women's swimming and diving program. It is Mundt's second stint with the Hawkeyes as he served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator from 2008-16.

Mundt has more than 16 years of coaching experience, including being the head coach at Western Illinois, where he was voted the 2007 Mid-Continent Conference Women's Coach of the Year. Mundt coached 33 NCAA All-Americans during his first Hawkeye stint. He was named the seventh head coach in program history in May, 2021.

Mundt rejoined the program after serving the lowa Flyers Club (IFLY) head coach from 2016-21. Under its Club Excellence Program, USA Swimming recognized IFLY as a Silver Medal Club in 2017, a Bronze Medal Club in 2019 and 2020, and will be recognized as a Gold Medal Club in 2021 for having two 18 & Under athletes qualify for the USA Swimming Olympic Trials.

Mundt and his coaching staff were also named to the 2021 lowa Swimming, Inc., Senior Coaching Staff of the Year as voted on their coaching peers.

During his time with IFLY, Mundt had two athletes named to USA Swimming's 18 & Under World Top 100 list. He coached a 2017 U.S. Open champion in the women's 200-meter butterfly and that same athlete was named to the USA Swimming National Junior Team in 2017.

Before becoming head coach of IFLY, Mundt spent eight years as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator for the Hawkeyes from 2008-16. He helped lead the program to six top 40 finishes (men and women), while coaching 33 All-Americans, 42 NCAA qualifiers and the the team in the 1-meter dive score, posting a zone-qualifying total of 311.55 versus Illinois.

THRIVING NEWCOMERS

lowa has 28 individual wins amongst its freshmen and transfers. Denison University transfer Alix O'Brien has contributed to five of those victories, her latest coming in the 1000 free against Vanderbilt. Freshman Scarlet Martin has accounted for eight wins, also picking up a victory against Vanderbilt (100 fly). Both the TCU graduate transfer Sheridan Schreiber and freshman Sabina Kupcova also have added multiple wins as well. Kupcova accounted for two wins against Vanderbilt in the 50 and 200 free.

REPPING SLOVAKIA

Freshman and Levice, Slovakia, native Sabina Kupcova traveled to the IU Natatorium in Indianapolis to compete in the FINA World Cup. Kupcova raced in the 400 free, 200 free, and 200 individual medley for a chance to qualify for the FINA Championships.

VETERAN PRESENCE

Senior Kennedy Gilbertson contributed to a combined four individual and relay wins in lowa's final home meet of the season, and took gold in the 100 back with a B-cut 53.93 versus lowa State. Gilbertson has also headed off lowa's season-fastest 200 free, 400 free and 200 medley relay squads -- all timing top-ten in program history. Senior Aleksandra Olesiak also has a 2022-23 individual victory under her belt. The Colorado native posted first place in 200 back against UNI.

BREAKING RECORDS

The Hawkeyes broke four Glen F. Henry Pool records in the 2022-23 opener at UNI, including Schreiber's 100 breast (1:04.16), Martin's 50 free (23.55) and 100 fly (54.60), and the 400 free relay (Kupcova, Gilbertson, Pedersen, Martin).

GOING DOWN TO THE WIRE

The Hawkeyes tied SEC opponent Vanderbilt in its final meet in the CRWC Natatorium of the 2022-23 season. Iowa's relay squad of Kennedy Gilbertson, Sabina Kupcova, Molly Pedersen, and Scarlet Martin came away victorious in the 400 free relay -- the final event of the day -- to help clinch the tie.

HAWKEYE COACHING STAFF

• Nathan Mundt returned for his second stint with the Hawkeyes and is the seventh head coach in program history. The Indiana native served as an Iowa assistant coach and recruiting coordinator from 2008-16 where he coached 33 All-Americans and 42 NCAA qualifiers, helping the Hawkeyes to six top 40 NCAA finishes and 115 school records.

• Diving coach Todd Waikel entered his 10th season with the program. Waikel has coached five All-Americans during his tenure in Iowa City and 15 NCAA Championship qualifiers.

• Mona Groteguth-Garcia also returned for her second season on the Hawkeye coaching staff, joining the Hawkeyes in 2021 following a two-year stint at TCU. She helped the Horned Frogs to back-to-back third-place Big 12 Conference finishes -- the best for the program since 2012-13. Groteguth-Garcia also coached at the University of Indianapolis from 2017-19 and she swam collegiately at North Texas.

UP NEXT

The Hawkeyes will head to Ann Arbor, Mich. to compete in the Big Ten Championships on Feb. 15-18 in Canham Natatorium.
