OFFENSE

Offensively: working on shot selection more: Calls her team unselfish

- Want to work on good vs. great shots
 - 30-22: push tempo
 - 22-8: patience
 - 8-0: be deadly
- KRYPTONITE: Live ball TO
- Defensive improvements have been big: playing **pack-line defense**: Packs the middle of the paint to make it hard to score inside
 - **Emphasis on**: help defense, ball pressure, getting into passing lanes, pushing ball to middle (no baseline drives)
 - Don't want to get beat by post players
 - **Pros**: Force outside shots, difficult to score in post, limits dribble penetration
 - **Cons**: Can be exploited by great outside shooting, requires great closeouts/teamwork
 - Great for teams who have size but lack athleticism
 - Works well vs. teams who don't have great shooters
 - Last year, Lady Lions LAST in BIG in point allowed per game: 76.2
