LEADING OFF

- The Hawkeyes opened the season going 3-0 at the Snowbird Baseball Classic in Port Charlotte, Florida. It is only the fourth time since 2006 that the Hawkeyes have opened the season with three straight wins.
- Iowa outscored the three opponents, 23-3, in the three games and the pitching staff posted a 0.96 ERA, allowing three runs on 16 hits while fanning 35.
- Sophomore Brody Brecht was named D1Baseball Pitcher of the Week, Big Ten Co-Pitcher of the Week, and Golden Spikes Performance of the Week. Brecht was perfect in his season debut and second career start throwing five innings and retiring all 15 batters he faced, including 10 via strikeout.
- Redshirt junior Kyle Huckstorf played the role of hero in the bottom of the 11th inning connecting on a walk off grand slam as the Hawkeyes defeated Indiana State, 6-2, in their season opener.
- Iowa committed just one error in the first three games of the season, giving the team a .991 fielding percentage.
- Five Hawkeyes -- Keaton Anthony, Brennen Dorighi, Huckstorf, Sam Petersen, and Raider Tello-- reached base safely in all three contests in Florida
- Seven players made their Hawkeye debuts during the opening weekend of the season in Florida.
- Saturday's matchup with No. 1 LSU is believed to be the first matchup for the Hawkeyes against the top ranked team in the country since 1972 when they faced Arizona State in the College World Series (ASU won 2-1).
- The Hawkeyes are picked as an NCAA Regional team by D1Baseball.com and are tabbed to finish in the top three of the Big Ten standings by both D1Baseball and the Big Ten coaches.
- The Hawkeyes are receiving votes in the NCBWA Top 30.

ABOUT HEAD COACH RICK HELLER

Rick Heller has turned the University of Iowa baseball program into a perennial Big Ten Conference and NCAA contender in his first seven seasons as the Hawkeyes' head coach.

Heller has injected new life into the Iowa program, leading the Hawkeyes to the 276 victories -- an average of 30.5 wins per season -- advancing to two NCAA Regionals, and claiming the first Big Ten Tournament title in program history. The 2017 title was Iowa's first since winning the regular season crown in 1990.

The Eldon, Iowa, native became the 20th head coach in program history in 2013 -- his fourth stop as a collegiate head coach. He has enjoyed stints at Iowa (2014-present), Indiana State (2009-13), Northern Iowa (1999-2009), and Upper Iowa (1987-99), leading all four schools to NCAA postseason play. He is one of nine coaches all-time and one of five active coaches to lead three different Division I programs to NCAA Regional play.

In 36 seasons as a head coach, Heller owns a career record of 966-750-4. He is one of two Iowa head coaches to lead the program to the NCAA Tournament.

At Iowa

Under Heller's watch, Iowa has advanced to the postseason in seven consecutive years for the first time in program history, he has coached nine All-Americans and at least one first-team All-Big Ten selection in eight of his nine full seasons. Heller has coached one Big Ten Player of the Year (Jake Adams), two Big Ten Pitchers of the Year (Trenton Wallace -- the first in school history -- and Adam Mazur), one Big Ten Freshman of the Year (Keaton Anthony) and Iowa has had 27 Major League Baseball Draft picks in nine seasons (29 have gone on to professional baseball).

Heller has also given the Hawkeyes an international flavor, taking the team to the Dominican Republic in 2016 and Taipei, Taiwan, as the United States representative at the 2017 World University Games. Heller led USA to a silver medal, as the team became the first American squad to medal in Universiade history.



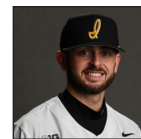

USA team went 5-2 during the two-week stretch, before falling to Japan in the gold medal game. The Americans posted victories over Mexico, Russia, Korea, and two games against the Czech Republic. Junior Cole McDonald tossed a nine-inning no-hitter in game one against the Czechs -- the first by a Hawkeye since 1965.

During Heller's second season, Heller guided Iowa to an at-large berth into NCAA Regional play in 2015 -- a first for the program since 1990 -- and the team posted the school's first NCAA Tournament win since 1972. The Hawkeyes were the runners-up at the 2016 Big Ten Tournament before claiming the program's first tournament title in 2017 to lock up the school's second NCAA Regional appearance in three seasons.

Iowa made just three NCAA Tournament appearances in its history prior to Heller's arrival.



THIS WEEK

The University of Iowa baseball heads to Round Rock, Texas, from Feb. 24-26 for the Karbach Round Rock Classic. The Hawkeyes will face Sam Houston on Friday at 6 p.m. (CT) before squaring off against No. 1 LSU at noon on Saturday and Kansas State at noon on Sunday.

• All three games will be played at Dell Diamond, the home of the Triple-A Round Rock Express, an affiliate of the Texas Rangers.

SCOUTING SAM HOUSTON

Sam Houston enters the weekend 4-2 on the early season. They took two of three from Rhode Island opening weekend and had a dominant win over McNeese on Tuesday night before falling to Rice on Wednesday night.

• They have outscored their opponents 59-13 in four games.

• Coltin Atkinson is their likely Friday starter. In his first appearance he went 5.0 innings allowing two runs on four hits with four strikeouts.

• The Bearcats were picked to finish second in the WAC in the preseason coaches' poll.

SCOUTING NO. 1 LSU

The Tigers are 4-0 to start the season and are ranked No. 1 in all national polls.

• Their probable starter is Riley Cooper. In his first start of the season, he went 5.1 no-hit innings against Rhode Island. He struck out seven and walked two batters.

• In LSU's game against Southern, first baseman Tre' Morgan hit for the "natural cycle". On the season he is hitting .308 with a team-leading nine RBIs

• The Tigers are one of eight teams in the nation that have not committed an error.

• LSU is hitting .333 as a team, led by Gavin Dugas (.700) and Jared Jones (.600).

• LSU was picked to win the SEC in the preseason poll and four Tigers were voted preseason All-SEC.

• Tre' Morgan, Paul Skenes, Dylan Crews, and Tommy White were all named to the Golden Spikes Award Watch List and Baseball America Preseason All-American Teams.

SCOUTING KANSAS STATE

The Wildcats competed a four-game series sweep of Stephen F. Austin to open the 2023 season. They fell to Lamar in a mid week game on Wednesday.

• K-State was picked to finish seventh in the Big 12

preseason poll.

• Junior RHP, German Fajardo, is slated to get the start against Iowa. In his season debut he went 4.0 innings allowing 3 runs (2 earned) on seven hits while striking out three.

• Offensively, the Wildcats are led by Brendan Jones who is hitting .414. They have two players that have recorded double-digit RBIs thus far.

SERIES RECORDS

• This will be the first meeting all-time between Iowa and Sam Houston.

• The Hawkeyes and LSU have faced each other nine times and Iowa leads the all-time series, 5-3-1.

• Iowa won the first matchup with the Tigers, 4-3, in 1925.

• The Tigers won the last meeting, 6-3, in 1947.

• This will be the 27th all-time meeting between Iowa and Kansas State. The Wildcats lead the all time series, 17-9. Iowa won the first ever meeting between the two teams in 1979, 4-0.

• The last meeting between the two programs came in 2017 and saw a, 12-11, Hawkeye victory in 11 innings.

HUCK OPENS SEASON WITH A BANG

Redshirt junior Kyle Huckstorf played the role of hero in the bottom of the 11th inning connecting on a walk off grand slam as the Hawkeyes defeated Indiana State, 6-2, in their season opener.

• Huckstorf has hit the last two grand slams for the Hawkeyes (Indiana 5/19/22 & Indiana State 2/17/23)

• The last walk off home run for the Hawkeyes was Brett McCleary vs. Northwestern (4/26/21).

BRODY'S BIG DEBUT

Sophomore RHP Brody Brecht was perfect in his season debut not allowing a baserunner through five innings of work as the University of Iowa baseball team defeated Quinnipiac, 7-1. Brecht struck out 10-of-15 Bobcat batters while hitting 100 MPH on the radar gun.

• This was Brecht's second career start. His first came in the 2022 Big Ten Tournament against Michigan (5/29/22).

• Brecht struck out a career-high 10 batters in a career-high five innings pitched.

PITCHING STAFF SHINES

The Iowa pitching staff combined for a 0.96 ERA over opening weekend, the fourth lowest in the nation.

• The staff allowed 5.14 hits per nine innings, ranking 12th nationally, and had a 0.89 WHIP, the 15th lowest in the nation.

WINNING BASEBALL

• The Hawkeyes have posted nine consecutive winning seasons under head coach Rick Heller. For perspective, the program had just two winning seasons from 1997-2013 and five from 1990-2013.

• Since Heller took over the program in 2014, only three schools -- Iowa, Indiana and Michigan -- have qualified for the Big Ten Tournament each season it has been contested. (There was no tournament in 2020 or 2021 because of COVID.)

PRESEASON HONORS

- A pair of Hawkeye sophomores received preseason All-America honors. RHP Brody Brecht was named third team All-America by Baseball America and two-way player Keaton Anthony was named second team All-America by the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association.
- Junior pitcher Ty Langenberg was named Big Ten Preseason Pitcher of the Year by both Perfect Game and D1Baseball.
- Langenberg and Anthony were named to the preseason All-Big Ten team by Perfect Game.

ROSTER BREAKDOWN

- Iowa's 39-man roster features one graduate transfer, one senior, 17 juniors, nine sophomores, two redshirt freshman and nine freshmen.
- The Hawkeyes have 17 newcomers (eight transfers), including Division I transfers in Zach Voelker (Long Beach State), and Brennen Dorighi (Wofford).
- The Hawkeye roster is made up of student-athletes from 11 states and Canada -- Iowa (23), California (2), Georgia (2), Illinois (2), Minnesota (2), Wisconsin (2), Arizona (1), Missouri (1), Montana (1), Ohio (1), Washington (1), Canada (1).
- Iowa has two sets of college teammates and four sets of high school teammates -- Kyle Huckstorf and Ben DeTaeye (Iowa Western CC); Luke Llewellyn, Casey Day and Cade Moss (Kirkwood CC); Gable Mitchell and Cade Obermueller (Iowa City High); Luke Llewellyn, Ty Langenberg and Gehrig Christensen (Urbandale); Cade Moss and Ben Wilmes (Johnston); Jack Young and Will Christophersen (Pleasant Valley).

IMPACT TRANSFERS

The Hawkeyes added two Division I transfers to their 2023 roster.

- Redshirt sophomore RHP Zach Voelker joins the Hawkeyes after a stint at Long Beach State where he had a 4-4 record in 14 appearances (seven starts) with a 6.05 ERA and 32 strikeouts.
- Voelker was a Cape Cod League All-Star in 2022 playing for the Hyannis Harbor Hawks. He went 2-2 with a 1.97 ERA in 11 games (three starts) with 23 strikeouts.
- Graduate student Brennen Dorighi joins Iowa after hitting .339 with 65 hits, nine home runs, 39 runs, and 53 RBIs at Wofford on his way to being named a first-team All-Southern Conference selection.
- Dorighi started 81 games in his four years for the Terriers hitting .318 with 101 hits, 13 home runs, and 85 RBIs.

FRESHMAN DISTINCTION

Two Hawkeyes -- Keaton Anthony and Brody Brecht -- garnered Freshman All-America honors in 2022. It was the first time since 2017 that multiple Iowa newcomers garnered freshman All-America distinction.

- Both players were honored by Collegiate Baseball. Anthony earned an additional honor from the NCBWA and D1Baseball.com, while Brecht was honored by Perfect Game.

MCGRATH AND BOE JOIN STAFF

The Hawkeyes welcomed two new coaches to the staff after Robin Lund and David Pearson left to take roles with the Detroit Tigers and Los Angeles Dodgers, respectively.

- Sean McGrath joined the Hawkeyes after three seasons coaching in the Mariners' minor league system. In 2022, he served as the pitching coach for the Seattle Mariners Double-A affiliate -- the Arkansas Travelers.
- Under McGrath, The Travers put together an ERA of 4.27, ranking second in the Texas League. The staff led the league in three categories: totaling 11 shutouts, a 1.30 WHIP and a .229 batting average against.
- Mitch Boe -- who played for the Hawkeyes from 2016-2019 -- joined the staff after spending the last two seasons as an assistant coach for Valparaiso. Boe served as the team's infield and baserunning instructor while also coaching third base.
- The Naperville, Illinois, native appeared in 193 career games, tied for the ninth-most all-time at Iowa. In 2019 the team captain was named Iowa's recipient of the Big Ten Sportsmanship Award. Boe tallied 144 hits, 28 doubles, 72 RBIs and 21 stolen bases during his Hawkeye career.

4 ALL-REGION SELECTIONS IN 2022

Four Hawkeyes earned ABCA/Rawlings All-Midwest Region honors for the 2022 season.

- Adam Mazur was a first-team all-region honoree, while Peyton Williams, Keaton Anthony and Ben Beutel all earned second-team honors.

5 HAWKEYES MOVE ON TO MLB

The Hawkeyes had four players selected in the 2022 Major League Draft -- the most for the program since 2018. Iowa also had a fifth player sign as an undrafted free agent.

- Iowa's three top 10 round picks are the most in a single draft in program history.
- Adam Mazur became Iowa's highest draft pick since 1990 when he was selected with the 53rd pick in the second round by the San Diego Padres. He was the highest picked Hawkeye since Tim Costo in 1990.
- Peyton Williams was chosen in the seventh round (218th pick) by the Toronto Blue Jays.
- Dylan Nedved was picked in the ninth round (270th pick) by the San Diego Padres.
- Duncan Davitt was selected in the 18th round (554th pick) by the Tampa Bay Rays.
- Ben Beutel signed as an undrafted free agent with the Chicago White Sox.

B1G HONORS

- Keaton Anthony earned Big Ten Freshman of the Year, second-team All-Big Ten and Big Ten All-Freshman Team honors. Anthony is the program's second Big Ten Freshman of the Year, joining C.J. Thieleke in 1994.
- Brody Brecht joined Anthony on the Big Ten All-Freshman Team. They were Iowa's first honorees since 2011.

OF NOTE

- Twenty-two of Iowa's 55 games in 2022 were decided by two runs or fewer. The Hawkeyes went 13-9 in such contests.
- Head coach Rick Heller won his 250th game as Iowa's head coach in the Hawkeyes' 6-5 victory over St. Thomas on March 21 and his 950th game on April 17 against Minnesota. Heller is third all-time on the program's career wins list.
- Iowa scored 10 or more runs in 12 games last season. The Hawkeyes had 22 games with 10 or more hits with 16 coming from April 9 through the end of the season.
- Iowa's pitching staff allowed three runs or fewer in 32 of its 55 games and five or fewer hits in 23 contests. The Hawkeyes had five shutouts to lead the Big Ten.
- The Hawkeyes played errorless baseball in 21 games last season. Iowa went 20-1 in such contests. The team didn't commit an error in a stretch of five games from April 16-23.
- Head coach Rick Heller is 32-33 against ranked opponents during his Hawkeye tenure. Iowa has posted at least one win over a ranked foe in each of the last eight seasons.

THE NORM -- 3-0

- The Hawkeyes posted their 30th victory of the 2022 season in the 12-2 victory at Michigan State on May 14. It was the seventh time in the Rick Heller era that the program has won 30 or more games.
- Iowa has had 30 or more wins in each of the "non-COVID" seasons under Heller (2020 and 2021 were altered because of the pandemic).

MR. DOUBLE

- In 2022 Redshirt freshman Keaton Anthony finished fourth in the Big Ten with 22 doubles, which ranked 34th nationally. The doubles total are the second-most in a single season in program history, trailing only John Knapp's 24 doubles in 1986.
- Anthony hit his first double of the 2023 season vs. Quinnipiac (2/19)

RANKED OPPONENTS; RANKED WINS

- Iowa went 3-2 against ranked foes last season, going 1-1 against No. 12 Texas Tech on March 20 in Iowa City and 2-1 at No. 8 Rutgers on April 22-24.
- The team's road win over the Scarlet Knights was its first over a top 10 ranked team since 2018 (No. 7 Michigan) and its first road series win over a ranked foe since 2019 (No. 19 Oklahoma State).
 - Head coach Rick Heller has defeated at least one ranked foe in each season as Iowa's head coach.

OUR GEORGIA PEACH

- Redshirt freshman Keaton Anthony had a breakout season in his first season of collegiate baseball (2022). The outfielder, who was honored a school record six times as the Big Ten Freshman of the Week, hit .361 (73-of-202) with 22 doubles, 14 home runs, 55 RBIs and 46 runs scored en route to Freshman All-America, Big Ten Freshman of the Year and second-team All-Big Ten and all-region honors.
- The Georgia native hit safely in 44 games and reached safely in 50 contests this season. He had a team-best 22 multi-hit games.
 - Anthony ranked in the top 10 in five Big Ten categories, sitting third in slugging (.678) and OPS (1.183), tied for fourth in doubles (22), sixth in batting average (.361) and 10th in OBP (.455).
 - In league games, Anthony tied for fourth in home runs (10), fifth in slugging (.768), tied for sixth in RBIs (30) and seventh in OPS (1.193).
 - Twelve of Anthony's 14 home runs came in his final 25 games. He hit a three-run blast in Iowa's 16-2 road win at Milwaukee on April 12, hit a two-run homer in the series opener against Minnesota (4/15) and homered in back-to-back games in the series win over Purdue (5/7-8).
 - He connected on his 11th homer -- a grand slam -- in the series finale at Michigan State and he hit a blast in three straight games in the sweep of Indiana. His 14 home runs were the most by a Hawkeye freshman since Brad Carlson hit 21 in 1999.
 - Anthony had a career day in his third career game in Iowa's 11-1 victory over Ball State on Feb. 19, going 4-for-4 with two doubles, two home runs, four runs and five RBIs.
 - Anthony earned six Big Ten Freshman of the Week honors

LANGENBERG --> WEEKEND ROTATION

After starting the 2022 season in the bullpen, sophomore Ty Langenberg settled into the weekend rotation as the Hawkeyes' Sunday starter. He made 12 straight Sunday starts, finishing the season with a 7-2 record and a 3.71 ERA. The Urbandale, Iowa, native allowed 60 hits, 28 runs (26 earned) and fanned 74 over 63 innings.

- Langenberg won his final two starts of the season, tossing five shutout innings in a 2-1 victory over Indiana on May 21. He scattered four hits and fanned four. In the Big Ten Tournament, Langenberg allowed three runs on three hits and fanned five in an elimination game victory over Penn State.
- Langenberg's fifth win came after tossing a career-long seven innings in the series-clinching win over Purdue on May 8. He allowed one run on five hits and fanned seven en route to being named the Big Ten Pitcher of the Week on May 11.
- Langenberg's fourth win came after tossing 5 2/3 shutout innings at Michigan on April 3. He scattered five hits and had a career-high 11 strikeouts.
- He had 34 strikeouts (10 vs. Texas Tech, 7 vs. Central Michigan, 11 at Michigan, 6 vs. Illinois) in four starts from March 20-April 10. He had eight or more Ks in three appearances last season.
- Langenberg ranked in the top eight in the Big Ten in six categories. He was tied for second in fewest runs allowed (28), tied for fourth in wins (7), tied for sixth in fewest earned runs (26), eighth in fewest walks (23), ninth in ERA (3.71) and tied for ninth in fewest hits allowed (60).

ONE OF THE B1G's & NATION'S BEST

- The Hawkeye pitching staff was superb in 2022, leading the Big Ten in ERA (3.72), shutouts (5), strikeouts (609), fewest hits allowed (374), fewest runs allowed (246), fewest earned runs (202) and batting average against (.210).
- The Hawkeyes gave up just 374 hits over 489 1/3 innings with just 109 going for extra bases.
 - Iowa ranked in the top 17 nationally in five categories, sitting second in hits allowed per nine innings (6.88), third in strikeouts per nine innings (11.2), fourth in ERA (3.72), 11th in WHIP (1.29) and 17th in shutouts (5).
 - Iowa's starting pitchers went 21-11 with a 4.06 ERA, fanning 270 over 244 innings. Opponents hit just .217.

LIMITING 1Bs

- In 2022 the Hawkeyes allowed five or fewer hits in 23 games.
- Iowa posted a one-hitter against Air Force on Feb. 18 -- the first for the program since 2019 (vs. Simpson, 7-2 win).
- Iowa had eight games, allowing three or fewer hits. The Hawkeyes had five games allowing two or fewer hits.

HEAT ALERT

Freshman RHP Brody Brecht had a blazing debut in his first career appearance at Duane Banks Field in 2022. The Ankeny, Iowa, native hit triple digits on his first three pitches,

going 101, 101 and 100 in a 1-2-3 inning against Cornell College on March 2.

- Brecht hit 100 or higher on the radar gun 37 times in 2022 (in games where Trackman data was available).
- In 2022 Brecht had 25 strikeouts and allowed just one earned run (on five hits) over his final 10 relief appearances, spanning 13 2/3 innings, giving him 44 Ks over 22 2/3 innings this season. He went 1-4 with a 3.18 ERA in 17 appearances and he gave up just one extra base hit.

SEEGS AT THE TOP

Since seeing his batting average dip to a season-low .242 on March 15, sophomore Michael Seegers was one of the Hawkeyes' most consistent hitters in 2022.

- In the 40 games from then on, the Wisconsin native hit .303 (50-of-165) with his 50 hits ranking second on the team. Seegers drove in 27 and has scored 34 runs during the stretch. Iowa went 28-12 in the 40 contests.
- Seegers hit safely in 29 of the 40 games with 15 multi-hit games, including two four-hit contests at Michigan on April 2 and a 4-for-5, four RBI game in game two against Indiana on May 20. Seegers set a program record, drawing five walks in the series-opening win against the Hoosiers on May 19.
- Seegers hit .286 (65-of-227) with 31 RBIs and 43 runs scored as Iowa's leadoff hitter. He batted leadoff in all but three games this season, where he hit safely in 37 games and reached base safely in 45 contests.
- As good as Seegers was offensively, he was just as good defensively. The Hawkeye shortstop had just four errors in 55 games, where he had a .980 fielding percentage.

ON THE OFFENSIVE

- The Hawkeyes scored 358 runs in 55 games, averaging 6.5 runs per contest in 2022. Iowa had 12 games with 10 or more runs and 24 games with 10 or more hits.
- Iowa went 23-8 when scoring first last season and 27-8 when out-hitting its opponent.
- The team went 24-4 when scoring six or more runs.
- The Hawkeyes outscored opponents, 104-96, over the first three innings and 112-73 over the final three innings (including extras).

TEAM CAPTAINS

Graduate student Brennen Dorigi, redshirt senior Jared Simpson, redshirt junior Brayden Frazier, and juniors Ty Langenberg and Michael Seegers were voted team captains for the 2023 season.

DON'T COUNT 'EM OUT

- The Hawkeyes have overcome deficits to win 78 games since the start of the 2017 season and posted 16 walk-offs. Thirty-four of those victories have come with Iowa trailing or being tied entering or through seven innings. 21 have come in the final at-bat.
- Iowa has overcome deficits in one games this season, winning that contest.

BANKS MAGIC

- The Hawkeyes are 121-40 at home since the start of the 2015 season.
- Iowa won 19 games in 2019, the third-most in a single-season in school history, trailing only the 22 wins in 1977 and 20 wins in 2018.
- Iowa has 17 walk-off victories at Duane Banks Field since the start of 2015.

#HELLERBALL

- Head coach Rick Heller recorded his 900th career win against Grand View in a 15-2 victory on March 3, 2020, at Duane Banks Field. The Iowa native won his 950th career game on April 17, 2022, against Minnesota.
- The Hawkeyes won 30 or more games in each of Heller's seven full seasons as the helm of the program. It's a first for the team since winning 30 or more in seven straight seasons from 1979-85.
- Heller has led the Hawkeyes to two NCAA Regional appearances; the program had three regional appearances in its history prior to his arrival.
- Heller is third in school history in career wins with 276 at Iowa, including the second (41), fifth (39) and eighth-most (36) wins in a single-season in school history.
- Heller led Iowa to its first Big Ten Tournament title in 2017 -- the first conference title since 1990 -- and he guided the Hawkeyes to the Big Ten Tournament title game in consecutive seasons. Iowa advanced to the league tournament in six straight years for the first time in program history.
- Heller has coached at least one first-team All-Big Ten selection in seven of his nine (full seasons), and has 27 Major League Baseball Draft picks in nine seasons (29 players have gone on to play professional baseball).
- Heller had three players drafted in the top 10 rounds of the 2022 MLB Draft -- a first in program history. That included Adam Mazur, who was the 53rd pick overall (San Diego) -- the highest pick by a Hawkeye since 1990.
- Iowa had a school-record six All-Big Ten selections in 2015 and five in 2017. The Hawkeyes have had 30 All-Big Ten honorees in nine seasons under Heller.
- Heller has coached one Big Ten Player of the Year (Jake Adams), two Big Ten Pitcher of the Years (Trenton Wallace, Adam Mazur) and one Big Ten Freshman of the Year (Keaton Anthony) during his time as a Hawkeye.

• Iowa has posted winning streaks of nine games (in 2015) and eight games (in 2017) -- the longest streaks for the program since 2012.
