## HEAD COACH JEFF GARBUTT, SR.

Jeff Garbutt was named the fourth head coach in the history of the University of Iowa rowing program in October 2021.

In Garbutt's first season as Iowa's head coach, the Hawkeyes placed 5th at the Big Ten Championships - the program's best finish since 2019. During the season, a program record four boats were honored with the Big Ten Boat of the Week award.

Garbutt was an assistant coach on the lowa staff for seven years from 2013-20. During that time, he helped lowa reach heights the program had not seen before, qualifying for the NCAA Championships three consecutive years from 2017-19 and reaching No. 7 in the national rankings in 2018, the highest in program history. He returns to lowa City from La Salle University, where he led the men's and women's rowing programs from 2020-21.

Garbutt was on staff in 2017 and 2018 when Iowa was named College Rowing Coaches Association Region 4 Staff of the Year. In 2017, Iowa broke a 16-year NCAA Championship drought and placed 12th nationally. The following year, the Hawkeyes placed a program-best fourth in the Big Ten and set a school scoring record at NCAA's, putting up 69 points and placing 11th.

- lowa recorded a program-high four Big Ten Boat of the Week honors during the 2022 championship season.
- The Hawkeye's placed fifth at the 2022 Big Ten Championships the program's best finish since 2019.
  Junior Hailey Mercuri represented her home country of Canada in the U23 World Rowing Championships during July in Varese, Italy.
- Senior Molly Rygh was a Big Ten Sportsmanship Honoree recipient at the 2022 Big Ten Championships.
- lowa's roster represents a total of six countries and nine states, including 39 athletes from lowa.
- Iowa's coaching staff includes Associate Head Coach Megan Fitzpatrick, and Assistant Coaches Katie Thurstin and Lowell McNicholas.

#### **CLIMBING THE RANKS**

lowa was ranked T-19th for the first time since 2021 in the Pocock CRCA Poll. The Hawkeyes spent 10 weeks receiving votes throughout the course of the 2022 spring season. There are five teams ranked from the B1G.

#### LAST TIME OUT: B1G INVITATIONAL

lowa's Varsity Eight beat No. 18 Tennessee's and No. 19 Alabama's 1V8 last Friday and Saturday in Sarasota, Florida. The Hawkeyes had the most first and second place finishes with seven, which was the best from teams within the Big Ten conference.

#### SCOUTING KANSAS/OKLAHOMA

The Hawkeyes will face another high level opponent in the Kansas Jayhawks and Oklahoma Sooners. KU was recieving votes in the CRCA Pocock Poll. This will be Kansas' first action since the Sunshine State Invite which was hosted by UCF on March 31-April 1, 2023.
