# **HEAD COACH JEFF GARBUTT, SR.**

Jeff Garbutt was named the fourth head coach in the history of the University of Iowa rowing program in October 2021.

In Garbutt's first season as lowa's head coach, the Hawkeyes placed 5th at the Big Ten Championships - the program's best finish since 2019. During the season, a program record four boats were honored with the Big Ten Boat of the Week award.

Garbutt was an assistant coach on the lowa staff for seven years from 2013-20. During that time, he helped lowa reach heights the program had not seen before, qualifying for the NCAA Championships three consecutive years from 2017-19 and reaching No. 7 in the national rankings in 2018, the highest in program history. He returns to lowa City from La Salle University, where he led the men's and women's rowing programs from 2020-21.

Garbutt was on staff in 2017 and 2018 when lowa was named College Rowing Coaches Association Region 4 Staff of the Year. In 2017, lowa broke a 16-year NCAA Championship drought and placed 12th nationally. The following year, the Hawkeyes placed a program-best fourth in the Big Ten and set a school scoring record at NCAA's, putting up 69 points and placing 11th.

- lowa's roster represents a total of six countries and nine states, including 39 athletes from lowa.
- lowa's coaching staff includes associate head coach Megan Fitzpatrick, and assistant coaches Katie Thurstin and Lowell McNicholas.

#### **CLIMBING THE RANKS**

lowa received a total of 90 votes in the latest edition of the CRCA Pocock Poll, nearing in on the national top-20 ranking. The Hawkeyes spent 10 weeks receiving votes throughout the course of the 2022 spring season.

#### **GREAT COMPETITION**

The Hawkeyes will face another slew of high-level opponents at the B1G Invitational - where eight of the nation's top-20 teams will be racing (#2 Duke, #6 Brown, #11 Ohio State, #13 Michigan, #15 SMU, #18 Tennessee, #19 Alabama, #20 Indiana).
