PROGRAM QUICK HITS

- Iowa broke the WBB all-time attendance record for a single game with 55,646 on hand for the Crossover at Kinnick exhibition against DePaul.
- Iowa advanced to its first National Championship appearance in program history in 2023.
- Iowa netted a program best 31 victories in a single season in 2023.
- Iowa won its third Big Ten Tournament title since 2019, over Ohio State which was the largest margin of victory in BTT Championship history. It was also the first time in program history that the Hawkeyes won the tournament championship in back-to-back years.
- The Hawkeyes led the country last season in field-goal percentage (51.1), scoring offense (87.3), and assists per game (20.9). They ranked in the top-10 in three additional categories, fourth in assist to turnover ratio (1.46), seventh in 3-point field goal percentage (38.0), and seventh 3-pointers per game (9.2).
- Since 2008, Bluder's teams own a 231-42 record inside of Carver-Hawkeye Arena. In that stretch, the Hawkeyes have posted three undefeated seasons at home.
- Over the last nine years, Iowa has dropped the second-fewest regular season home games in the Big Ten.
- Iowa's 2023-24 roster is comprised of two fifth-year, one graduate, one senior, five juniors, three sophomores, and two freshmen. Four Hawkeyes are Iowa natives, four from Illinois, two from Michigan, and one each from Colorado, Kansas, Nebraska, Ohio.
- Six Big Ten regular-season games will be on a nationally broadcast platform (either NBC or FOX), the most in conference history. The Hawkeyes are featured in four of the six contests – Indiana (Jan. 13/FOX), at Ohio State (Jan. 21/NBC), at Maryland (Feb. 3/FOX), Ohio State (March 3/FOX).
- Iowa has had five out of the last six Big Ten Players of the Year.
- The Hawkeyes had a nation's best six wins against AP Top 10 opponents last season.
- For the first time in the Lisa Bluder era, the Hawkeyes knocked off an AP Top 10 team in the month of November. It has only occurred one other time in school history.
- Bluder owns a 496-249 (.665) record and a 247-141 (.637) conference mark at Iowa. In her 39 seasons as a head coach, Bluder is 852-391 (.685).

The third ranked Hawkeyes will travel to Cedar Falls to take Northern Iowa on Sunday. Tipoff is set for 2 p.m. (CT) in a sold-out McLeod Center. The contest will air on ESPN+ (subscription required) and the Hawkeye Radio Network.

- Sunday's contest will air on the ESPN+, Sirius XM and on the Hawkeye Radio Network.

AUDIO COVERAGE

- Rob Brooks and Tiffany Reedy will call the action on the Hawkeye Radio Network. A link to the broadcast is available on the women's basketball schedule page on hawk-eyesports.com.
- Brooks is in his eighth year as the play-by-play announcer for the Iowa women's basketball team. He has been Iowa football's sideline reporter since 2004. Brooks has called seven different Iowa sports on radio or television.
- Reedy will begin her first full season providing color for radio with the Iowa women's basketball program.
- Reedy was four-year letterwinner from 2002-06 at Iowa and is a native of Dysart, Iowa.

THE SERIES

- This will be the 29th meeting between the two programs.
- Iowa leads the all-time series, 25-3.
- The Hawkeyes have won the last three matchups by 14 or more points.
- Iowa's last loss in the series to UNI came in Cedar Falls in 2019, 88-66.

SCOUTING NORTHERN IOWA

- UNI beat Green Bay in its season opener, 78-67, on Monday night.
- For the first time in program history, UNI women's basketball has been selected as the Missouri Valley Conference preseason favorite for the 2023-24 season. In the Tanya Warren era, the Panthers have been in the top two six times including this year's No. 1 projection.
- They return three of their starters from a season ago and seven others while bringing in three newcomers.
- Of the starters returning, guard Maya McDermott and forward Grace Boffeli were named to the MVC Preseason First team with Boffeli being awarded Preseason Player of the Year honors.
- The Panthers were led last season by Grace Boffeli in scoring (531), rebounds (303) and field goal percentage (55.3%). Maya McDermott led the way for UNI in three-pointers made (60) and assists (116), while Ryley Goebel led Northern Iowa in blocks (41) and steals (43) coming off the bench.

WHAT 2 WATCH 4

- Clark needs 16 points to surpass Megan Gustafson (2,804) for Iowa's all-time scoring title.
- Clark is one triple-double away from joining Sabrina Ionescu as the only DI players to record a triple-double in four different seasons.
- Marshall needs five steals and seven 3-pointers made to cross the 200-mark in both categories. She would be the first Iowa WBB player to have 200 steals and 200 3-pointers in a career.
- Clark is five double-doubles shy of reaching the Big Ten's top-10 list for most career double-doubles in a career. (44)
- Head Coach Lisa Bluder is four wins from 500 career victories at Iowa.
- Marshall (130) and Martin (126) are eyeing Monika Czinano's games played record. (162)
- Davis needs 16 points to cross the 1,600-point mark in her career.
- Martin needs three rebounds for 500 career boards. She would be the 31st Iowa WBB player to accomplish that feat.
- Clark needs 95 assists to surpass Sam Logic to be Iowa's all-time leader in dimes.
- Stuelke is eyeing her first three game streak of scoring 10 or more points.
- Iowa is 6-3 when Clark records 40 or more points.
- Clark has 43 career games with 25+ points, 5+ assists, and 5+ rebounds. (NCAA Best)
- Martin needs 11 assists to notch 400 in her career. She would be the 10th Hawkeye to do so.

LISA BLUDER'S LEGACY

- Bluder owns 17 AP Top 10 wins which is the most in program history.
- Is the fourth active winningest coach in the country and trail's Joe Foley of Little Rock by only two games.
- Longest tenured coach in the Big Ten conference.
- All-time winningest coach in Iowa women's basketball history.
- Owens the most Big Ten conference wins in conference history.
- Has coached five out of the last six Big Ten players of the year.
- Won six Big Ten titles. (4 BTT's and 2 Regular Season)
- Coached two consensus National POYs.
- Has coached the Hawkeyes to 21 postseason appearances in 23 seasons, including NCAA Tournament berths in 13 of the last 15 seasons.
- She has led UI to the Sweet 16 (2021), Elite Eight (2019), National Championship (2023) in three out of the last four championship seasons. (Covid)

BETTER GUARD US OFF THE BUS

- Iowa has the longest active streak in the nation scoring at least 80 points per game in four consecutive seasons. Oklahoma is second with three.
- Since the start of the 2020-21 season, Iowa leads the nation with 79 games of 80+ points.
- Iowa also leads the country with 36 games of 90+ points offensively.

2023 NCAA TOURNAMENT IN REVIEW

- The Hawkeyes stacked wins against 15-Seed SE Louisiana, 10-Seed Georgia, 6-Seed Colorado, 5-Seed Louisville, and 1-Seed South Carolina.
- Clark became the first player in DI women's basketball history to notch a 1,000 point and 300 assist single season. Also became the Big Ten's all-time single season leading scorer surpassing Megan Gustafson.
- Clark produced the first 40-point triple-double in men's or women's NCAA Tournament history against UL. (41p, 12a, 10r)
- Iowa's win versus South Carolina was the first win in program history against an AP No. 1 team.
- Iowa's 97-point performance against UL was the second-most points scored in a NCAA Tourney game in program history.
- Against L'ville and USC, Clark is the first player to net back-to-back 40-point performances in the NCAA Tourney.
- Against South Carolina, Iowa extended its program record for most wins in a single season. (31)
- Iowa fell to LSU in the most watched NCAA Women's Tournament game off all-time which netted 9.9 million viewers and 12.6 million at its peak.

WHAT A SUMMER, CLARK!

- Clark, a senior from West Des Moines, Iowa, was named the 2023 Naismith and Wade Trophy winner along with the Associated Press and US-BWA Ann Drysdale Player of the Year honors. The guard is also a two-time winner of the Nancy Lieberman Point Guard Award and is the first-ever

- She was a 2022-23 first team AP All-American, USBWA All-American, WBCA All-American and All-Region honoree and first team CoSIDA Academic All-American. She was also named the Honda Sport Award winner for women's basketball.
- Clark earned a total of 19 postseason honors from the 2022-23 season.

AP NUGGETS

- Iowa's preseason ranking ties for the highest preseason ranking in program history. (1994)
- Iowa has 314 appearances in the AP Poll and the Hawkeyes rank 23rd for all-time appearances.
- Iowa is 34-70 all-time against AP Top 10 teams.
- Iowa is 98-154 all-time against AP Top 25 teams.
- Clark is 10-8 against AP Top 10 teams in her career.

COURT OF DREAMS

- Season tickets for the 2023-24 University of Iowa women's basketball team are officially sold out.
- Eight of Iowa women's basketball's 10 sellout crowds inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena have happened in the last three seasons, with the other two coming in 1985 and 1988.
- Iowa has been ranked in the national attendance top 10 each of the past four seasons with fans (2023, 2022, 2021, 2019). The No. 2 ranking last season is the highest in the Lisa Bluder era. (11,143)
- Iowa City's first round attendance last year was higher than nine of the 16 sites' first/second round combined attendance figure.
- Iowa City owns four of the top 10 second round, single session attendance numbers in NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship history.
- At 11,143 fans per game last season, Iowa has unofficially broken the Big Ten Conference single-season attendance average record (it will become official when the final NCAA statistics and attendance reports are issued after the season). The previous conference mark was held by Wisconsin, which averaged 10,455 fans in 1997-98. Iowa also averaged 11,660 fans during conference games this season, finishing second in Big Ten history behind only Wisconsin (12,474 in 1997-98).

CROSSOVER AT KINNICK

- The University of Iowa Athletic Department donated \$250,000 to the UI Hospital.
- Iowa broke the women's basketball all-time attendance record of 29,619 previously set by Connecticut and Oklahoma in the 2002 National Title game in San Antonio's Alamodome. The Hawkeyes had 55,646 fans inside of Kinnick Stadium.

(HAWK)EYES ON LAST SEASON

- Caitlin Clark was the only player in the country averaging more than 26 ppg, 7.0 rpg, and 7.0 apg. Since 2009, Clark has averaged more than 25 ppg, 5 apg, and 5 rpg in all three seasons as Hawkeye, only one other player has accomplished that feat. (Anastasia Hayes, Middle Tennessee)
- Caitlin Clark tied Elena Delle Donne for the fastest NCAA Division I women's basketball player to score 2,000 career points in her 75th career game.
- Clark was the first Iowa men's or women's basketball player to eclipse more than 2,000 points, 550 assists, 520 rebounds, 110 steals, and 40 blocks in a career.
- Iowa set a new field goal percentage record against conference foes. (.527)
- Iowa's 87.6 points per game this regular season is the best in program history.
- Iowa has made 313 three-pointers this season, setting a Big Ten Conference record and eclipsing the prior mark set by Ohio State (300 in 2017-18).
- Iowa was the only team in the country to have two players average 6.5 ppg, shoot 60% from the floor, and 3.5 rpg. (Monika Czinano & Stuelke)

SCHEDULE NOTES

- The Hawkeyes will play five weekend home games against Big Ten competition (three Saturday, two Sunday). Saturday games inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena come against Minnesota (Dec. 30), Indiana (Jan. 13) and Nebraska (Jan. 27). Iowa is scheduled to be home the final two Sundays of the regular season (Feb. 25 & March 3).
- The Hawkeyes will play on Super Bowl Sunday for the second straight season and eighth time in nine years. Iowa will play at Nebraska on Sunday, Feb. 11.
- The Big Ten Tournament will return to the Target Center in Minneapolis, March 6-10, 2024.
- Six Big Ten regular-season games will be on a nationally broadcast platform (either NBC or FOX), the most in conference history. The Hawkeyes are featured in four of the six contests – Indiana (Jan. 13/FOX), at Ohio State (Jan. 21/NBC), at Maryland (Feb. 3/FOX), Ohio State (March 3/FOX).



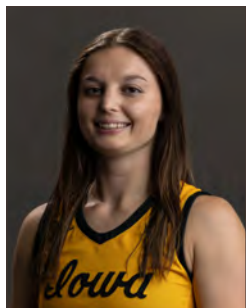

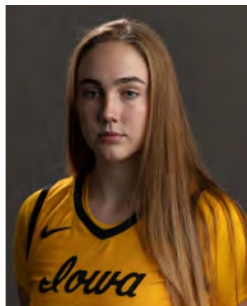

Caitlin Clark Notes

- Clark has scored 20 or more points in 87 of her 102 career games, which is the most in Iowa women's basketball history. Megan Gustafson is second in Iowa WBB history. (75/135)
- Since 2020-21, Clark has registered four 40-points performances against AP Top 10 teams. All other men or women's basketball players have not done once.
- Iowa is 6-3 when Clark records 40 or more points in her career. Clark has registered 40 or more points in three out of her last five games. (Louisville, South Carolina, and Virginia Tech)
- She has registered 40+ points, 5+ assists, and 5+ rebounds five times in her career and three times against AP Top 25 opponents. Since her career began, the rest of Division I has three such games, period.
- 44 career double-doubles, needs five to crack the Big Ten's all-time top-10 list.
- Clark has 43 career games with +25 points, +5 assists, and +5 rebounds which is the most in NCAA WBB history.
- In Clark's 100th game against South Carolina, she netted the most points by a Division I men's or women's basketball player in that time span. Since the 1999-2000 season, only four players have scored 2,500 points. (Elena Delle Donne, Keydren Clark, Steph Curry)
- Clark had 191 points and 60 assists in the 2023 NCAA Tournament.
- Clark broke the NCAA Tournament title record for most made 3-point field goals. (8)
- She became the first player in Division I women's basketball history to record more than 1,000 points and 300 assists in the same season. Clark has 161 points and 52 assists in this NCAA Tournament. Since 2000, it's one of six instances of a player having 150 points and 50 assists in ANY 5-game span. All six of those belong to Clark.
- Eclipsed 2,000 career points in her 75th career game, which ties her for the fastest NCAA Division I women's basketball player to do so. (Elena Delle Donne). She is the fourth Hawkeye women's basketball player to score 2,000 points and is the seventh Iowa men's or women's basketball player to score 2,000 points. She eclipsed 2,500 career points at the University of Iowa, only the second player in school history to do so.
- Has a streak of scoring in double figures an astounding 92 games, which is a NCAA Division I best.
- Clark also broke the Big Ten single season record for most points (1,055).
- Earned BIG Player of the week on Feb. 27, Feb. 6, Jan. 17, Dec. 5, Dec. 12, and earned Co-BIG Player of the Week on Jan. 30 to mark her 18th weekly award, which is the third-most in BIG history. She has garnered weekly honors six times this season which is a conference-best.
- Clark is the second player in Big Ten women's basketball history to have registered more than 2,000 points, 550 assists, 520 rebounds, 110 steals, and 40 blocks in a career.
- 11 career triple-doubles, setting a new Big Ten record for most triple-doubles in a career and ties for second-best in NCAA women's basketball history.
- Clark is the first player in NCAA Tournament history to record a 40-point triple-double.
- Clark's 41-point performance against Louisville on March 26 ties for the third most in NCAA Tournament Regional Final history. Clark has registered back-to-back 40-point performances. Clark is the second player to score 40 points or more in an NCAA Women's Final Four game. (National or Semis)
- Clark is the only player since 2000 with 30 points per game, 10 assists per game, and 50% field goal percentage over a five-game span.
- Clark netted a 3-point basket in 60 straight games. She hit at least one 3-pointer in 102 career games.
- Set a Big Ten Tournament career record with 86 career assists in her 11 tournament games to date (2021-23).
- Set a Big Ten Tournament championship game record with 17 assists and tied the record with five made three-pointers. The 17 assists were also the second-most in a Big Ten Tournament game.
- Clark's triple-double against Ohio State in the Big Ten Tournament is the third in Big Ten Tournament history and first in the championship game.
