OPENING TIP

- The Hawkeyes open the regular season Tuesday, hosting North Dakota in Carver-Hawkeye Arena. Iowa has won its last 12 regular season openers and are 12-1 in season openers under head coach Fran McCaffery.
- Iowa has won 83 of its last 89 nonconference home games, dating back to 2012.
- McCaffery is 11 wins from becoming the winningest coach in Iowa basketball history. Tom Davis has 271 victories as Iowa's head coach.
- The Hawkeyes return two starters and eight letterwinners from a team that won 19 games, finished fifth in the Big Ten standings and advanced to its fourth straight NCAA Tournament.
- Iowa added eight newcomers to the roster, including Valparaiso transfer Ben Krikke and Belmont transfer Even Brauns.
- Seniors Patrick McCaffery (46) and Tony Perkins (47) have combined to start 93 games (and play in 184 games) in their collegiate careers. Perkins is Iowa's top returning scorer at 12.3 points per game.
- Mr. Basketball x 2. Two of Iowa's incoming freshmen -- Brock Harding and Pryce Sandfort -- were named Mr. Basketball in their home states. Harding earned the distinction in Illinois; Sandfort in Iowa.
- Senior Tony Perkins is a preseason second-team All-Big Ten selection by THE ALMANAC, while junior Payton Sandfort is ranked as the 89th-best player nationally by the publication. Sandfort is also on the Julius Erving Award Preseason Watch List.
- Iowa is one of 10 teams in the country to make the last four NCAA Tournaments and one of only three Big Ten teams to accomplish the feat (Purdue, Michigan State).
- The Hawkeyes have placed fifth or better in the Big Ten standings in five straight and 10 of the last 11 years.
- Iowa has won 10 or more Big Ten games in eight of the last nine seasons.
- The Hawkeyes led the Big Ten and was 18th nationally in scoring offense (80.1). The Hawkeyes have led the league in scoring in seven of the last 11 seasons, including six straight years.
- Iowa has five native Iowans on the roster, two players from Illinois and New York and one player from Texas, Massachusetts, Indiana, New Jersey, Nebraska, Michigan and Canada.

HEAD COACH FRAN McCAFFERY

Fran McCaffery, who is signed through the 2028 season, is in his 14th season as the head basketball coach at the University of Iowa and his 28th year overall as a college head coach. McCaffery has reached the 20-win plateau 11 of the previous 16 seasons.

McCaffery spent five seasons (2005-10) as the head coach at Siena, six years at UNC-Greensboro (1999-2005) and three seasons at Lehigh (1985-88) before joining the Hawkeyes.

McCaffery has nearly four decades of Division I coaching experience.

He is in his 42nd season as a collegiate coach, which includes 28 years as a head coach and 15 as an assistant. In 2022, McCaffery joined Hall of Fame coaches Rick Pitino, Bob Huggins, Eddie Sutton and Lefty Driesell as the only Division I coaches to lead teams to conference tournament titles in four or more different leagues (Big Ten, MAAC, SoCon, ECC). He is one of 14 coaches to lead at least four different Division I teams to the NCAA Tournament.

McCaffery, 64, won his 500th game as a head coach on Dec. 8, 2022 and win No. 250 at Iowa on Dec. 17, 2022. He holds a career mark of 512-352 (.593) and guided his teams to 16 postseason appearances (12 NCAA & four NIT). Iowa likely would have competed in another NCAA Tournament in 2020, if not for the NCAA canceling the postseason due to COVID-19. He is 261-175 (.599) at Iowa; the second winningest coach in program history. McCaffery led Iowa to wins in four of the last seven NCAA Tournaments (2015, 2016, 2019, and 2021).

Since taking over the Iowa program in 2010, Iowa has earned 10 postseason tournament bids (7 NCAA, 3 NIT). McCaffery coached Iowa to a Big Ten Tournament title and 26 wins in 2022, the second-most win total in program history. McCaffery has guided seven players to first team All-Big Ten status eight of the last 10 years, including the 2020 & 2021 National and Big Ten Player of the Year, Luka Garza.

McCaffery has posted upper division finishes in 10 of the last 11 seasons at Iowa and 22 of 27 seasons as a head coach. The Hawkeyes have finished fifth or better in the Big Ten standings seven of the last nine years. He has posted 20 wins or more 11 of the last 15 seasons, including eight of the last 10 years at Iowa (2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2019, 2020, 2021, and 2022). Iowa's 205 victories between 2013-21 are the most over a 10-year span at Iowa since 1987-96 (207).

McCaffery and the Hawkeyes boast a 167-43 (.795) home record the last 12 seasons, which includes a school-record 18 wins in 2014 and 13 consecutive victories in 2019-20. Iowa has won 14+ games in Carver-Hawkeye Arena each of the last five seasons (2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, and 2023).

McCaffery's five years at Siena were the best in its 70-year history. He led the Saints on an incredible run that ended with three straight Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference championships and NCAA Tournament appearances.

McCaffery's Saints owned a 112-51 (.687) record in his five years with the program. He guided the Saints to four consecutive 20-win seasons. McCaffery's achievements earned the head coach Siena Hall of Fame recognition in 2017.

The 2009 MAAC Coach of the Year and 2010 District I Coach of the Year is the third winningest coach, by percentage, in league history (.68-22, .756). He is the only coach to guide a MAAC program to two NCAA Tournament wins. McCaffery led his 2008 and 2009 teams to first round NCAA Tournament victories over Vanderbilt and Ohio State, respectively.

In his final two seasons at Siena, he coached the Saints to back-to-back 27-win campaigns and boasted a combined 39-3 (.929) record against MAAC opponents, which included MAAC Tournament contests.

McCaffery began his coaching career as an assistant at Penn (1982-83) and Lehigh (1983-85). After three seasons as head coach at Lehigh, he spent 11 seasons as an assistant at Notre Dame (1988-99).

McCaffery played basketball at Wake Forest his freshman year (1977-78) and concluded his playing career at Penn his final three seasons (1979-82). He earned his bachelor's degree in economics from The Wharton School (Penn) in 1982. McCaffery also earned a master of education from Lehigh in 1985.

THE SETTING

The University of Iowa men's basketball team hosts North Dakota in its regular season opener on Tuesday at 7 p.m. (CT) on Mediacom Court inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena. The game will be streamed live on B1G+.

• Tickets range from \$15-35 for adults, \$5-10 for youth and \$2 for UI students.

ON THE AIR

Radio: Games are broadcast on the Hawkeye Radio Network with Gary Dolphin (play-by-play) and Bobby Hansen (color) on the call. The network includes more than 40 stations that blanket the state of Iowa and include portions of Illinois, Nebraska, Minnesota, Missouri and Wisconsin. The Hawkeye Radio Network includes a 60-minute pregame show.

Stream: Tuesday's game will be streamed live on B1G+ -- a paid subscription service. Charlie Fox (play-by-play) and Jess Settles (color) will be on the call.

SCOUTING NORTH DAKOTA

- The Fighting Hawks went 13-20 during the 2022-23 season -- a seven win improvement over the 2021-22 campaign. UND won a Summit League Tournament game for the first time since 2020.
- UND, who is picked to finish fifth in The Summit League Preseason Coaches' Poll, returns three starters and seven total letterwinners in 2023-24. B.J. Omit, a preseason second-team All-Summit League selection, is the team's top returning scorer after averaging 12.0 points and 3.7 rebounds a season ago.
- The Fighting Hawks are led by fifth-year head coach Paul Sather, who has posted a 43-80 record in four seasons in Grand Forks. Sather spent five seasons at Black Hills State and nine at Northern State before making the jump to Division I.

SERIES HISTORY

- Tuesday's game will be the ninth meeting all-time between Iowa and North Dakota. The first game was contested in 1923 in Iowa City -- a 22-11 Hawkeye win.
- The Hawkeyes are 8-0 in the all-time series, winning the eight games by an average of 20.9 points. Iowa is 7-0 in Iowa City and 1-0 in Grand Forks.

LAST GAME | IOWA 103, QUINCY 76 (EXH.)

- Iowa trailed 16-6 over the first 5:03 before outscoring Quincy, 43-16, over the final 15 minutes.
 - o Over the final 35 minutes, Iowa outscored the Hawks, 97-60.
- Seven Hawkeyes finished in double figures in the game -- Patrick McCaffery (16), Ben Krikke (14), Payton Sandfort (13), Owen Freeman (12), Pryce Sandfort (12), Josh Dix (10) and Tony Perkins (10).

o Freeman and Krikke both had seven rebounds to lead the team as Iowa was +13 on the glass.

- Iowa had a total of 12 players score in the game.
 - o The reserves scored 44 points and the team scored 50 points in the paint.
- Iowa had 21 assists on its 34 field goals with nine different players registering at least one assist.
- The Hawkeyes shot 53.1 percent from the field (34-of-64) and made seven 3-point field goals.
- The Hawkeyes were in the bonus for the final 9:08 of the first half and 15:51 of the second.
 - o Iowa got to the free throw line 41 times in the game but made just 28-of-41 attempts.
- Iowa went on a 13-0 run in the first half, turning a two-point advantage into a 44-29 lead.
- Defensively, Iowa limited Quincy to 11 points over the final 10 minutes and 16 points over the final 15 minutes of the first half.
 - o Quincy shot 38.8 percent for the game, but 14 of their field goals came from 3-point range.

MCCAFFERY APPROACHES RECORD

- Head coach Fran McCaffery, who is entering his 28th season as a head coach and 14th at Iowa, needs 11 victories to becoming the winningest coach in program history. (Tom Davis has 271 victories.)
- With his next Big Ten Conference win, McCaffery will also pass Davis for the most Big Ten victories in program history.

P, P & P

- The Hawkeyes return three Ps -- Patrick, Payton and Perkins -- in 2023-24. The trio have combined to start 100 games in their collegiate career and appear in 251 career games.
- Fifth-year senior Patrick McCaffery has averaged 10.5 and 9.8 points in his last two seasons. For his career, the Iowa City, Iowa, native shoots 41.9 percent from the field, averaging 8.4 points in 92 career games.
- Junior Payton Sandfort is slated for a big jump in 2023-24 after being the 2023 Big Ten Sixth Man of the Year. The Waukee, Iowa, native averaged 10.3 points, making 59 3-pointers a season ago -- second-most on the team. Sandfort is ranked as the No. 89 player nationally by THE ALMANAC.
- Senior Tony Perkins has a team-high 47 career starts as a Hawkeye and he's the team's leading returning scorer after averaging 12.3 points per game in 2022-23. The Indianapolis native is a preseason second-team All-Big Ten selection by THE ALMANAC.

SANDFORT: JULIUS ERVING WATCH LIST

Junior Payton Sandfort is one of 20 players named to the Julius Erving Small Forward of the Year Preseason Watch List -- an award that recognizes the top small forwards in men's college basketball annually.

- Sandfort is one of three players in the Big Ten on the preseason watch list.
- The forward is also listed as a potential "breakout" star by Jon Rothstein and The Athletic's CJ Moore.

WHO'S NEXT?

Head coach Fran McCaffery has coached seven players to first-team All-Big Ten selection in eight of the last 10 years.

FOREIGN IMPACT

Iowa went 3-0 during its foreign trip with victories over the Paris, Valencia and Barcelona All-Stars. The Hawkeyes averaged 127 points per game in the three victories, shooting 48.4 percent from the field and 38.2 percent from 3-point range.

- Payton Sandfort (19 points, 11 rebounds) and Ben Krikke (16.3 points, 11.7 rebounds) averaged double-doubles, while Tony Perkins (16.3 points), Dasonte Bowen (12.3 points), Brock Harding (11.3 points), Josh Dix (11 points), and Owen Freeman (10.3 points) all averaged in double figures. Freeman pulled down a team-best 12.3 rebounds per game.

IMPACT TRANSFER

The Hawkeyes added an impact transfer to the roster in Valparaiso transfer Ben Krikke. The Edmonton, Alberta, Canada, native was a first-team All-MVC selection in 2022-23 after leading the Missouri Valley Conference at 19.4 points per game overall and 21 points in conference play. Krikke shot 55.2 percent from the field and 79.6 percent from the free throw stripe, while averaging 5.9 rebounds and 2.1 assists per game.

- Krikke has scored in double figure in 82 (of 122) career games, which includes 24 20-point games. He has scored 1,596 career points (13.1 career avg.), shooting 54.1 percent from the field and 80.7 percent from the charity stripe.

WELCOME HOME

Senior Even Brauns returns to his hometown to fulfill a lifelong dream of playing for the Hawkeyes. The center spent the past three years at Belmont University in Nashville, where he played in 92 career games with 31 starts. Brauns averaged seven points and 5.3 rebounds during his junior season with the Bruins.

- Brauns played at both Iowa City Regina and Iowa City West High Schools as a prep. He was an all-state player as a senior after averaging 15.6 points and 7.3 rebounds as a senior. He played his junior season as a teammate of Patrick McCaffery.

8 NEW FACES

Half of Iowa's roster is comprised of newcomers in 2023-24, including two transfers. Ben Krikke is a graduate transfer from Valparaiso, while Iowa City native Even Brauns returns home after playing three seasons at Belmont.

- The Hawkeyes welcome five freshmen -- Ladji Dembele, Owen Freeman, Brock Harding, Spencer Hutchison and Pryce Sandfort -- and senior guard Jovone Cater. Hutchison and Cater are non-scholarship student-athletes.

MR. BASKETBALLS

Two Hawkeye freshmen -- Brock Harding and Pryce Sandfort -- were named their state's Mr. Basketball in 2023.

- Harding, who scored 1,889 points in his prep career, earned Illinois Mr. Basketball honors after averaging 18.4 points and 5.7 assists at Moline High School. He is the first Western Big Six player to earn the distinction since 2011 (Chasson Randle, Stanford). Other recent past winners include: Braden Huff, E.J. Liddell, Jalen Brunson, Jabari Parker and Jahliil Okafor.
- Harding is the second Mr. Basketball in the state of Illinois to become a Hawkeye, joining Ed Horton (1985-89).
- Sandfort earned Iowa's Mr. Basketball honors after averaging 24.9 points, 11 rebounds, 2.8 assists, 2.7 blocks and 1.7 steals at Waukee Northwest High School. The forward led Class 4A in points, blocks, field goals made, 3-pointers made, free throws made and defensive rebounds.
- Sandfort is the first Mr. Basketball to join the Hawkeye program since Joe Wieskamp, who earned the distinction in 2018.

FAMILY BUSINESS

Iowa will have a set of brothers on the roster for the fifth straight year in 2023-24. Payton and Pryce Sandfort follow Connor and Patrick McCaffery, who were Hawkeye teammates from 2019-23.

TEAMMATES AGAIN

- Patrick McCaffery and Even Brauns reunite after being prep teammates at Iowa City West High School. Brauns spent the past three seasons at Belmont University.
- Payton and Pryce Sandfort were teammates at Waukee High School. Pryce played his final two prep seasons at Waukee Northwest High School.
- Brock Harding and Owen Freeman remain teammates in Iowa City. The duo won a state title at Moline High School in 2023.
- Dasonte Bowen and Carter Kingsbury were teammates at the Brewster Academy in New Hampshire.

BACK-TO-BACK FIRST ROUNDERS

The Hawkeyes have had a first round NBA Draft pick in consecutive seasons for the second time in program history.

- Keegan Murray was selected fourth overall by the Sacramento Kings -- the highest pick in program history -- during the 2022 NBA Draft and Kris Murray was taken 23rd overall in the 2023 NBA Draft by the Portland Trailblazers.
- John Johnson was selected by Cleveland in 1970 and Seattle picked Fred Brown in 1971. (B.J. Armstrong and Roy Marble were both first round picks in the 1989 NBA Draft.

HAWKEYE FASTBREAKS

- Iowa is 145-29 when scoring 80 points or more, the last 13 seasons. The Hawkeyes are 94-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 61 points, the last 13 years.
- Iowa made more free throws (495) than its opponents attempted (472) during the 2022-23 season. The Hawkeyes have only once before accomplished the feat over the last 25 years (2018-19).

IOWA SCHEDULE NOTES

- Iowa will open the regular season with three of its first four games at home, including two straight to start the year.
- Iowa will open its Big Ten slate at Purdue (Dec. 4) for the second time in three seasons. The Hawkeyes hosted the Boilermakers in 2020-21 and traveled to West Lafayette in 2021-22.
- Iowa will travel to Ames, Iowa, to face Iowa State in the Iowa Corn Cy-Hawk Series matchup on Dec. 7 before hosting Michigan in the second December Big Ten game on Dec. 10.
- The Hawkeyes will play back-to-back conference road games twice during the regular season.
- Iowa will play six weekend home games (three Saturday, three Sunday) -- all six against Big Ten foes. The team has home weekend games inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena twice in February and in the regular season finale.
- The Hawkeyes will also play five Friday home games, including two against Big Ten competition -- Nebraska (Jan. 12) and Ohio State (Feb. 2).
- Iowa has a stretch of seven home games over a 10-game span from Dec. 10-Jan. 24. That includes a stretch of four of five league home contests in early January, hosting Rutgers (Jan. 6), Nebraska (Jan. 12), Purdue (Jan. 20) and Maryland (Jan. 24).
- The Hawkeyes will play on Super Bowl Sunday for the fifth straight season and seventh time in nine years. The Hawkeyes will host Minnesota in Iowa City on Feb. 11.
- Seven of Iowa's final 12 Big Ten games will be played on the road.
- The Big Ten Tournament will be held in Minneapolis from March 13-17.
- Iowa will host Quincy in an exhibition on Oct. 30 before opening the season against North Dakota on Nov. 7.

IOWA HISTORY

Iowa has played 2,941 games since beginning basketball in 1902. Iowa's overall record is 1,739-1,202 (.591). Iowa's 1,739 wins are 38th most among Division I programs. That includes a 1,111-381 (.745) record in home games, a 628-821 (.433) record in contests away from Iowa City, an 826-821 (.502) mark in Big Ten games and a 515-155 (.769) record in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

IOWA VS. RANKED TEAMS

Iowa went 3-2 against AP ranked opponents in 2023. The Hawkeyes beat No. 15 Indiana and No. 20 Iowa State at home, and No. 15 Indiana on the road at Assembly Hall. Iowa fell at No. 1 Purdue and versus No. 15 Duke at Madison Square Garden.
