OPENING TIP

- The Hawkeyes head to San Diego for the Rady Children's Invitational for Thanksgiving. lowa is 3-1 overall heading into Thursday's game against Oklahoma. It is the first meeting against the Sooners since the 1987 NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 -- a 93-91 Hawkeye victory.
- lowa swept the Big Ten Conference weekly honors on Nov. 20 when Ben Krikke was selected as the Player of the Week and Owen Freeman the Freshman of the Week. It is the first time lowa has swept the awards since the 2019-20 season, and Freeman is the first Hawkeye freshman to earn the distinction in consecutive weeks.
- To no one's surprise, lowa is again one the nation's top offensive teams, averaging 95 points in its first four games. The Hawkeyes are tops in the Big Ten and eighth nationally. The team has scored at least 84 points in all four games, including 110 points in the season opener against North Dakota -- the most in an opener under head coach Fran McCaffery (sixth most in McCaffery era.)
- Three Hawkeyes -- Payton Sandfort, Patrick McCaffery and Ben Krikke (2) -- have all netted 20-point games this season. Krikke is averaging a team-high 20 points, which ranks fourth in the Big Ten. He is also second in the conference with 34 field goals and third in field goal percentage (.618).
- · lowa is "spreading the wealth" in terms of scoring. The Hawkeyes have had at least four players reach double digits in all four games, including six in double figures against North Dakota and five against Arkansas State.
- Sophomore Dasonte Bowen has 17 assists to one turnover this season to lead the nation in assist-to-turnover ratio.
- lowa's newcomers have accounted for 160 points (42.1 percent of scoring) in the first four games.
- Share & Take Care: lowa has 84 assists to 27 turnovers in the first four games, assisting on 62.7 percent of its field goals.
- lowa has won 86 of its last 92 nonconference home games, dating back to 2012.
- McCaffery is eight wins from becoming the winningest coach in Iowa basketball history. Tom Davis has 271 victories as Iowa's head coach.
- lowa is one of 10 teams in the country to make the last four NCAA Tournaments and one of only three Big Ten teams to accomplish the feat (Purdue, Michigan State).
- The Hawkeyes have placed fifth or better in the Big Ten standings in five straight and 10 of the last 11 years, and the program has won 10 or more Big Ten games in eight of the last nine seasons.
- lowa led the Big Ten and was 18th nationally in scoring offense (80.1). The Hawkeyes have led the league in scoring in seven of the last 11 seasons, including six straight years.



HEAD COACH FRAN McCAFFERY

Fran McCaffery, who is signed through the 2028 season, is in his 14th season as the head basketball coach at the University of Iowa and his 28th year overall as a college head coach. McCaffery has reached the 20-win plateau 11 of the previous 16 seasons.

McCaffery spent five seasons (2005-10) as the head coach at Siena, six years at UNC-Greensboro (1999-2005) and three seasons at Lehigh (1985-88) before joining the Hawkeyes.

McCaffery has nearly four decades of Division I coaching experience.

He is in his 42nd season as a collegiate coach, which includes 28 years as a head coach and 15 as an assistant. In 2022, McCaffery joined Hall of Fame coaches Rick Pitino, Bob Huggins, Eddie Sutton and Lefty Driesell as the only Division I coaches to lead teams to conference tournament titles in four or more different leagues (Big Ten, MAAC, SoCon, ECC). He is one of 14 coaches to lead at least four different Division I teams to the NCAA Tournament.

McCaffery, 64, won his 500th game as a head coach on Dec. 8, 2022 and win No. 250 at lowa on Dec. 17, 2022. He holds a career mark of 515-353 (.593) and guided his teams to 16 postseason appearances (12 NCAA & four NIT). lowa likely would have competed in another NCAA Tournament in 2020, if not for the NCAA canceling the postseason due to COVID-19. He is 264-176 (.599) at lowa; the second winningest coach in program history. McCaffery led lowa to wins in four of the last seven NCAA Tournaments (2015, 2016, 2019, and 2021).

Since taking over the lowa program in 2010, lowa has earned 10 postseason tournament bids (7 NCAA, 3 NIT). McCaffery coached lowa to a Big Ten Tournament title and 26 wins in 2022, the second-most win total in program history. McCaffery has guided seven players to first team All-Big Ten status eight of the last 10 years, including the 2020 & 2021 National and Big Ten Player of the Year, Luka Garza.

McCaffery has posted upper division finishes in 10 of the last 11 seasons at lowa and 22 of 27 seasons as a head coach. The Hawkeyes have finished fifth or better in the Big Ten standings seven of the last nine years. He has posted 20 wins or more 11 of the last 15 seasons, including eight of the last 10 years at lowa (2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2019, 2020, 2021, and 2022). lowa's 205 victories between 2013–21 are the most over a 10-year span at lowa since 1987–96 (207).

McCaffery and the Hawkeyes boast a 168-43 (.795) home record the last 12+ seasons, which includes a school-record 18 wins in 2014 and 13 consecutive victories in 2019-20. lowa has won 14+ games in Carver-Hawkeye Arena each of the last five seasons (2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, and 2023).

McCaffery's five years at Siena were the best in its 70-year history. He led the Saints on an incredible run that ended with three straight Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference championships and NCAA Tournament appearances.

McCaffery's Saints owned a 112-51 (.687) record in his five years with the program. He guided the Saints to four consecutive 20-win seasons. McCaffery's achievements earned the head coach Siena Hall of Fame recognition in 2017.

The 2009 MAAC Coach of the Year and 2010 District I Coach of the Year is the third winningest coach, by percentage, in league history (68-22, .756). He is the only coach to guide a MAAC program to two NCAA Tournament wins. McCaffery led his 2008 and 2009 teams to first round NCAA Tournament victories over Vanderbilt and Ohio State, respectively.

In his final two seasons at Siena, he coached the Saints to back-to-back 27-win campaigns and boasted a combined 39-3 (.929) record against MAAC opponents, which included MAAC Tournament contests.

McCaffery began his coaching career as an assistant at Penn (1982-83) and Lehigh (1983-85). After three seasons as head coach at Lehigh, he spent 11 seasons as an assistant at Notre Dame (1988-99).

McCaffery played basketball at Wake Forest his freshman year (1977-78) and concluded his playing career at Penn his final three seasons (1979-82). He earned his bachelor's degree in economics from The Wharton School (Penn) in 1982. McCaffery also earned a master of education from Lehigh in 1985.

The University of Iowa men's basketball team heads to San Diego for Thanksgiving to compete in the Rady Children's Invitational. The Hawkeyes open the tournament against Oklahoma on Thursday at 2 p.m. (CT) at LionTree Arena on the campus of UC San Diego.

• Iowa will face either Seton Hall or No. 23 USC on Friday at 5 p.m.

ON THE AIR

Radio: Games will be broadcast on the Hawkeye Radio Network with Jon Swisher (play-by-play) and Bobby Hansen (color) on the call. The network includes more than 40 stations that blanket the state of lowa and include portions of Illinois, Nebraska, Minnesota, Missouri and Wisconsin. The Hawkeye Radio Network includes a 60-minute pregame show.

TV: Thursday's game against Oklahoma will be televised on FS1 with Aaron Goldsmith (play-by-play) and Casey Jacobsen (analyst) on the call. Friday's game will be televised on FOX.

SCOUTING OKLAHOMA

- The Sooners, who are receiving votes in the AP Poll, bring a 4-0 record into Thursday's game, posting home victories over Central Michigan, Mississippi Valley State, Texas State and UTRGV. Oklahoma has won the four contests by an average of 33 points.
- Otega Oweh leads a group of four Sooners in double figures, averaging 15.3 points and 5.3 rebounds. He is shooting 68.6 percent from the floor.
- The Sooners have attempted 98 free throws in four games (24.5 per game), making 79.6 percent.
- Oklahoma's scoring defense ranks ninth nationally, as the Sooners allow just 55.5 points per contest.

SERIES HISTORY

- Thursday's game is the sixth meeting all-time between lowa and Oklahoma with the Hawkeyes leading the series, 3-2. lowa has won the last two games, including a 93-91 victory in the 1987 NCAA Tournament in a game played in Seattle.
- The Hawkeyes are 2-1 all-time against Seton Hall. lowa won 83-67 in New Jersey during the 2022-23 season in a game played as part of the Gavitt Tipoff Games.
- lowa is 5-2 all-time against future Big Ten foe USC. The Hawkeyes have won back-to-back games in the series, winning 66-55 in 1982 in lowa City and 62-61 in 1983 in Los Angeles.

LAST GAME | IOWA 88, ARKANSAS STATE 74

Graduate Ben Krikke scored a season-high 25 points to lead a group of five Hawkeyes in double figures in lowa's 88-74 victory over Arkansas State on Nov. 17. The Hawkeyes shot 46.6 percent from the field, but the team attempted just 12 3-point field goals (two makes) in the win.

McCAFFERY APPROACHES RECORD

- Head coach Fran McCaffery, who is in his 28th season as a head coach and 14th at lowa, needs eight victories to become the winningest coach in program history. (Tom Davis has 271 victories.)
- With his next Big Ten Conference win, McCaffery will also pass Davis for the most Big Ten victories in program history.

MORE NOTABLES

- lowa is receiving votes in the Coaches' Poll, coming in a tie for 43rd with one vote.
- The Hawkeyes return one starters and eight letterwinners from a team that won 19 games, finished fifth in the Big Ten standings and advanced to its fourth straight NCAA Tournament.
- lowa added eight newcomers to the roster, including Valparaiso transfer Ben Krikke and Belmont transfer Even Brauns.
- Mr. Basketball x 2. Two of Iowa's incoming freshmen -- Brock Harding and Pryce Sandfort -- were named Mr. Basketball in their home states. Harding earned the distinction in Illinois; Sandfort in Iowa.
- Senior Tony Perkins is a preseason second-team All-Big Ten selection by THE ALMANAC, while junior Payton Sandfort is ranked as the 89th-best player nationally by the publication. Sandfort is also on the Julius Erving Award Preseason Watch List.
- Iowa has five native Iowans on the roster, two players from Illinois and New York and one player from Texas, Massachusetts, Indiana, New Jersey, Nebraska, Michigan and Canada.

KRIKKE: B1G POW

Graduate student Ben Krikke averaged 24.5 points and seven rebounds in games against No. 8 Creighton and Arkansas State to earn Big Ten Player of the Week honors on Nov. 20. The forward had back-to-back 20-point games, shooting 66 percent from the field (21-of-32). He scored 24 points at Creighton and a season-high 25 points against Arkansas State, while also finishing with nine rebounds, a career-high four steals and three blocks.

• It is Krikke's first Big Ten honor and third of his career. He was a two-time MVC Player of the Week during the 2022-23 season.

FREEMAN: B1G FOW X 2

Forward Owen Freeman is the first Hawkeye to earn back-to-back Big Ten Freshman of the Week honors. He earned the distinction on Nov. 13 and Nov. 20.

• The Moline, Illinois, native averaged 11 points and three rebounds in wins over North Dakota and Alabama State before putting up 7.5 points, 2.5 blocks and two rebounds in games against No. 8 Creighton and Arkansas State.

DASONTE'S BIG DAY

Sophomore Dasonte Bowen had the best game of his career against Arkansas State, scoring a career-high 17 points, while finishing with three steals and three assists. Bowen made 4-of-5 field goals and 9-of-10 free throws in the game.

20 POINTERS

The Hawkeyes have had three players account for four 20-point games during the 2023-24 season. Junior Payton Sandfort scored 21 in the season opener against North Dakota, senior Patrick McCaffery scored 22 points against Alabama State and graduate Ben Krikke netted 24 points at No. 8 Creighton and a season-high 25 points in the win over Arkansas State.

SHARE & TAKE CARE

The Hawkeyes are leading the Big Ten and ninth nationally, averaging 21 assists per game. Iowa has had 20 or more assists in three of the four games this season, including a season-high 27 on 32 field goals in the Nov. 10 win over Alabama State.

- On the flip side, Iowa has just 27 turnovers (6.8 p/ game), fewest in the nation. The team hasn't committed more than seven turnovers in any game this season.
- lowa's 3.11 assist-to-turnover ration is leading the nation.

GET IT AND GO

The Hawkeyes are 17th in the nation in fastbreak points, averaging 19.50 points per game.

DISTRIBUTING GUARDS

lowa's three primary point quards -- Dasonte Bowen, Brock Harding and Josh Dix -- have a combined for 40 assists to nine turnovers over the first four games.

- Bowen has 17 assists and a single turnover in 94 minutes. Harding has 17 assists and seven turnovers in 40 minutes and Dix has six assists to one turnover in 75 minutes.
- Add in senior Tony Perkins and Iowa's point guards have 50 assists to 13 turnovers on the year.
- Harding had 14 assists (seven in each game) in his first two collegiate games in just 25 minutes.
- Bowen is leading the Big Ten (and ranks second nationally) in assist-to-turnover ratio at 17.00.

3 IS FOR ME

The Hawkeyes have made 29 3-point field goals in four games, averaging 7.3 makes per contest. Ten different players have made at least one 3-pointer.

- lowa made a season-high 12 3-point field goals (on 24 attempts) against North Dakota in the season
- Junior Payton Sandfort has a team-leading nine 3-balls (in 27 attempts) to lead the team. The forward made four 3-pointers against Alabama State -- his seventh career game with four or more 3s.

PAYTON'S STRONG START

Junior Payton Sandfort is tied for second on the team in scoring and is leading the team in rebounding to open the season, averaging 14 points and 8.8 rebounds in 22.7 minutes.

- Sandfort notched his eighth career 20-point game in the opener, scoring 21 points against North Dakota. He scored 10 of lowa's first 16 points and 13 of 21 to open the game. He also had nine rebounds.
- He tallied his first career double-double, finishing with 17 points and a career-high 12 rebounds against Alabama State. Late in the first half, he scored 12 points in a span of 111 seconds, including a four-point play.
- Sandfort has scored in double figures in three of the team's four games this season.

P-MAC: 2-2

Senior Patrick McCaffery netted his sixth career 20-point game against Alabama State, making 7-of-12 field goals en route to a 22-point outing. The forward scored eight of lowa's first 12 points and 10 of the first 16 over the first 7 1/2 minutes.

- McCaffery is averaging 14 points -- second-best on the team -- on 58.1 percent shooting in four games. He is also made 18-of-23 attempts from the free throw stripe -- the most makes and attempts on the team.
- The Iowa City, Iowa, native is one of three Hawkeyes (Ben Krikke, Tony Perkins) to reach double figures in every game.

PERFECTO

Payton Sandfort opened his junior season by making his first 12 free throws. He is 13-of-14 for the season, making 92.9 percent of his attempts.

• For his career, the Waukee, lowa, native is an 88.8 percent free throw shooter, making 79-of-89 career attempts.

STRONG NEWCOMER DEBUTS

lowa's newcomers have accounted for 160 points -- 42.1 percent of the team's scoring -- in the first four games of the season.

- Graduate transfer Ben Krikke has reached double figures in all four games, where he is averaging a team-best 20 points on 61.8 percent shooting. The Valpo transfer 24 points (on 11-of-18 shooting) at No. 8 Creighton and finished with a season-high 25 points and nine rebounds in the win over Arkansas State. They were Krikke's first two 20-point games as a Hawkeye and the 25th and 26th such games of his career.
- Freshman Owen Freeman is averaging 9.3 points and 2.5 rebounds, while swatting a team-best six shots.
- Freshman Ladji Dembele is averaging 4.5 points and 2.0 rebounds. His four 3-pointers are tied for the second-most on the team.

AT THE LINE

The Hawkeyes get to the free throw line early and often under head coach Fran McCaffery and the team routinely makes more free throws than its opponents attempt.

- Iowa has made five more free throws made (83) than its opponents have attempted (78) through four games.
- The team has made more free throws than its opponent has attempted in three of the four games this season.
- The Hawkeyes are averaging 20.8 makes at the free throw line this season -- ninth-most in the country.
- lowa attempted a season-high 46 free throws (made 32) against Arkansas State. The 46 attempts are the third-most in the McCaffery era.

10 DEEP

The Hawkeyes have 10 players averaging double-digit minutes in the first four games of the season.

• lowa's reserves have scored 30 or more points in two games, averaging 29.7 points per game.

IMPACT TRANSFER

The Hawkeyes added an impact transfer to the roster in Valparaiso transfer Ben Krikke. The Edmonton, Alberta, Canada, native was a first-team All-MVC selection in 2022-23 after leading the Missouri Valley Conference at 19.4 points per game overall and 21 points in conference play. Krikke shot 55.2 percent from the field and 79.6 percent from the free throw stripe, while averaging 5.9 rebounds and 2.1 assists per game.

- Krikke is leading the team with a 20.0 scoring average in four games. He has made eight or more field goals in three of the four contests and 10 or more in two games, including 11 field goals (on 18 attempts) in the road game at No. 8 Creighton.
- For his career, Krikke has scored in double figure in 86 (of 126) career games, which includes 26 20-point games. He has scored 1,674 career points (13.3 career avg.), shooting 54.4 percent from the field and 79.6 percent from the charity stripe.

P.P&P

- The Hawkeyes return three Ps -- Patrick, Payton and Perkins -- in 2023-24. The trio have combined to start 112 games in their collegiate career and appear in 263 career games.
- Fifth-year senior Patrick McCaffery has averaged 10.5 and 9.8 points in his last two seasons. For his career, the lowa City, lowa, native shoots 42.4 percent from the field, averaging 8.6 points in 96 career games.
- Junior Payton Sandfort is slated for a big jump in 2023-24 after being the 2023 Big Ten Sixth Man of the Year. The Waukee, Iowa, native averaged 10.3 points, making 59 3-pointers a season ago -- second-most on the team. Sandfort is ranked as the No. 89 player nationally by THE ALMANAC.
- Senior Tony Perkins has a team-high 51 career starts as a Hawkeye and he's the team's leading returning scorer after averaging 12.3 points per game in 2022-23. The Indianapolis native is a preseason second-team All-Big Ten selection by THE ALMANAC.

SANDFORT: JULIUS ERVING WATCH LIST

Junior Payton Sandfort is one of 20 players named to the Julius Erving Small Forward of the Year Preseason Watch List -- an award that recognizes the top small forwards in men's college basketball annually.

- Sandfort is one of three players in the Big Ten on the preseason watch list.
- The forward is also listed as a potential "breakout" star by Jon Rothstein and The Athletic's CJ Moore.

WHO'S NEXT?

Head coach Fran McCaffery has coached seven players to first-team All-Big Ten selection in eight of the last 10 years.

FOREIGN IMPACT

lowa went 3-0 during its foreign trip with victories over the Paris, Valencia and Barcelona All-Stars. The Hawkeyes averaged 127 points per game in the three victories, shooting 48.4 percent from the field and 38.2 percent from 3-point range.

• Payton Sandfort (19 points, 11 rebounds) and Ben Krikke (16.3 points, 11.7 rebounds) averaged double-doubles, while Tony Perkins (16.3 points), Dasonte Bowen (12.3 points), Brock Harding (11.3 points), Josh Dix (11 points), and Owen Freeman (10.3 points) all averaged in double figures. Freeman pulled down a team-best 12.3 rebounds per game.

WELCOME HOME

Senior Even Brauns returns to his hometown to fulfill a lifelong dream of playing for the Hawkeyes. The center spent the past three years at Belmont University in Nashville, where he played in 92 career games with 31 starts. Brauns averaged seven points and 5.3 rebounds during his junior season with the Bruins.

• Brauns played at both lowa City Regina and lowa City West High Schools as a prep. He was an all-state player as a senior after averaging 15.6 points and 7.3 rebounds as a senior. He played his junior season as a teammate of Patrick McCaffery.

8 NEW FACES

Half of lowa's roster is comprised of newcomers in 2023-24, including two transfers. Ben Krikke is a graduate transfer from Valparaiso, while lowa City native Even Brauns returns home after playing three seasons at Belmont.

• The Hawkeyes welcome five freshmen — Ladji Dembele, Owen Freeman, Brock Harding, Spencer Hutchison and Pryce Sandfort — and senior guard Jovone Cater. Hutchison and Cater are non-scholarship student-athletes.

MR. BASKETBALLS

Two Hawkeye freshmen -- Brock Harding and Pryce Sandfort -- were named their state's Mr. Basketball in 2023.

- Harding, who scored 1,889 points in his prep career, earned Illinois Mr. Basketball honors after averaging 18.4 points and 5.7 assists at Moline High School. He is the first Western Big Six player to earn the distinction since 2011 (Chasson Randle, Stanford). Other recent past winners include: Braden Huff, E.J. Liddell, Jalen Brunson, Jabari Parker and Jahlil Okafor.
- Harding is the second Mr. Basketball in the state of Illinois to become a Hawkeye, joining Ed Horton (1985-89).
- Sandfort earned lowa's Mr. Basketball honors after averaging 24.9 points, 11 rebounds, 2.8 assists, 2.7 blocks and 1.7 steals at Waukee Northwest High School. The forward led Class 4A in points, blocks, field goals made, 3-pointers made, free throws made and defensive rebounds.
- Sandfort is the first Mr. Basketball to join the Hawkeye program since Joe Wieskamp, who earned the distinction in 2018.

FAMILY BUSINESS

lowa will have a set of brothers on the roster for the fifth straight year in 2023-24. Payton and Pryce Sandfort follow Connor and Patrick McCaffery, who were Hawkeye teammates from 2019-23.

TEAMMATES AGAIN

- Patrick McCaffery and Even Brauns reunite after being prep teammates at lowa City West High School. Brauns spent the past three seasons at Belmont University.
- Payton and Pryce Sandfort were teammates at Waukee High School. Pryce played his final two prep seasons at Waukee Northwest High School.
- Brock Harding and Owen Freeman remain teammates in Iowa City. The duo won a state title at Moline High School in 2023.
- Dasonte Bowen and Carter Kingsbury were teammates at the Brewster Academy in New Hampshire.

BACK-TO-BACK FIRST ROUNDERS

The Hawkeyes have had a first round NBA Draft pick in consecutive seasons for the second time in program history.

- Keegan Murray was selected fourth overall by the Sacramento Kings the highest pick in program history during the 2022 NBA Draft and Kris Murray was taken 23rd overall in the 2023 NBA Draft by the Portland Trailblazers.
- John Johnson was selected by Cleveland in 1970 and Seattle picked Fred Brown in 1971. (B.J. Armstrong and Roy Marble were both first round picks in the 1989 NBA Draft.

HAWKEYE FASTBREAKS

- lowa is 148-30 when scoring 80 points or more, the last 13+ seasons. The Hawkeyes are 94-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 61 points, the last 13 years.
- lowa made more free throws (495) than its opponents attempted (472) during the 2022-23 season. The Hawkeyes have only once before accomplished the feat over the last 25 years (2018-19).

IOWA HISTORY

lowa has played 2,945 games since beginning basketball in 1902. lowa's overall record is 1,742-1,203 (.591). lowa's 1,742 wins are 38th most among Division I programs. That includes a 1,114-381 (.745) record in home games, a 628-822 (.433) record in contests away from lowa City, an 826-821 (.502) mark in Big Ten games and a 518-155 (.769) record in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

Head coach Fran McCaffery and the University of Iowa men's basketball program signed two student-athletes to National Letters of Intent on Nov. 8.

COOPER KOCH (pronounced KOTCH) Forward, 6-8, 205 Peoria, III. Metamora Township High School

- Transferred from Peoria Notre Dame to Metamora High School for his senior season
- Selected to the 2023 adidas Eurocamp in Treviso, Italy

- Rated as the No. 71 player nationally by On3, No. 14 power forward and No. 2 player in Illinois
- Ranked as the No. 51 player nationally by 247Sports and the No. 8 power forward in the class
- Earned Illinois Basketball Coaches Association 3A firstteam all-state honors as a junior after averaging 18.6 points and eight rebounds, 3.5 assists and 2.2 steals
- Was AP second-team all-state in 2022-23 and first-team All-Big 12 Conference honoree

- Named Most Valuable Player of the White Team at the BioSteel All-Canadian Games after posting a double-double (25 points, 16 rebounds)
