Hawk-Item - - Iowa's all-time leader in career receptions (174) and ranks 13th in career receiving yards (1,799)... career totals include 174 receptions for 1,799 yards and 12 touchdowns, while playing in 51 career games (33 starts)... ranked second in the Big Ten and eighth in the nation in punt returns (15.7) in 2013... first Big Ten Conference player to ever return back-to-back-punts for touchdowns and just the second player in the last decade with two punt return touchdowns in one quarter... the third player in Big Ten history with two punt return touchdowns in a game, and the first since 1983... 184 return yards in a game ranks second best all-time in the Big Ten, behind Nile Kinnick's Iowa and conference record of 201 yards on nine returns, set in 1939... had at least one pass reception in final 20 games and 48 of 51 career games, with a previous streak of 23 straight games snapped vs. Michigan State in 2013... ranked sixth in the Big Ten in receptions per game (4.3) in 2012... one of three juniors named to 2013 Leadership Group... one of two sophomores named to 2012 Leadership Group.

2014 Preseason Honors - - Named to Paul Horning Award preseason Watch List... named to CFP A Punt Returner Trophy preseason Watch List... preseason second team All-America punt returner by Phil Steele... preseason first team All-Big Ten punt returner by Phil Steele... preseason second team All-Big Ten punt returner by Athlon Sports and College Sports Madness... preseason fourth team All-Big Ten wide receiver by Phil Steele... **2014** - - Saw action in all 13 games, with nine starts... led team in receptions for third straight season, while ranking second in yards (52-517-2 TDs)... led team with eight receptions for 62 yards in 31-23 win over Northern Iowa, with long of 16 yards... led receivers with eight receptions for 70 yards in 17-13 win over Ball State, with a long of 19 yards... had three receptions for 15 yards in 20-17 loss to Iowa State... led team with five receptions for 74 yards in 24-10 win at Purdue, including 23-yard scoring reception in third period to give Iowa a 17-10 advantage... had three receptions for 66 yards in 48-7 win over Northwestern, all for first downs... had two receptions for 56 yards in 30-14 win at Illinois, including a long of 39 yards... had four receptions for 33 yards in 26-24 loss to No. 141 Wisconsin, including a 20-yard scoring reception in the third quarter... led team with six receptions in 37-34 overtime loss to Nebraska for 63 yards, with a long of 25 yards... caught three passes for 23 yards in 45-28 TaxSlayer Bowl loss to Tennessee to become Iowa's career leader in receptions (174).

2013 Honors - - Coaches Appreciation Award, Offense... first team All-Big Ten Specialist by Phil Steele, Sporting News and College Sports Madness... named first team mid-season All-American specialist by Phil Steele... named first team mid-season All-Big Ten specialist by Phil Steele and BTN.com... named CFP A national special teams Player of the Week and Big Ten Conference special teams Player of the Week after recording touchdowns on back-to-back punt returns of 83 and 63 yards vs. Western Michigan... **2013** - - played in all 13 games with 10 starts... led team in receiving with 40 receptions for 388 yards and five touchdowns... also led team in punt returns with 20 returns for 314 yards and two touchdowns... career-high nine receptions for 79 yards in 30-27 opening loss to Northern Illinois, along with 24 yards on two punt returns and two solo tackles... three receptions for 24 yards in 28-14 win over Missouri State, along with one punt return for 10 yards... seven receptions for 60 yards and one touchdown in 27-21 win at Iowa State, scoring on a 5-yard reception for the first points of the game... record-setting day in 59-3 win over Western Michigan, with four punt returns for 184 yards and two touchdowns,

along with one pass reception for six yards... scoring punt returns covered 83 and 63 yards, matching the seventh and 20th longest returns in school history... touchdown returns came on back-to-back returns in the second period following a 44-yard return in the first period... led team with six receptions for 56 yards in 23-7 win at Minnesota, along with two punt returns for 14 yards... led team with five receptions for 45 yards in 17-10 OT win over Northwestern, along with one punt return for 10 yards... recorded one reception for 22-yard touchdown in 38-14 win at Purdue to give team a 14-7 advantage in the second period and had 11 yards on two punt returns... two pass receptions for 60 yards in 38-17 win at Nebraska, including a 36-yard catch on a key third down on a field goal drive and a 24-yard scoring reception to give Iowa a 14-point lead, both in the third quarter.

2012 - - Started all 12 games at wide receiver and has started 14 straight overall... led team in receptions (52) and shared team lead in receiving yards (571)... had one rushing attempt for 15 yards... started at wide receiver in 18-17 win over Northern Illinois... led team with six receptions vs. NIU, totaling 31 yards, matching career-best for receptions... started at wide receiver in 9-6 loss to Iowa State, collecting one reception for 10 yards... started at wide receiver in 27-16 win over Northern Iowa as offense gained 429 yards total offense... career-high 101 receiving yards on five catches vs. UNI, including a career-long of 51 yards to set up third quarter touchdown... started at wide receiver in 32-31 loss to Central Michigan... five receptions for 65 yards and one touchdown vs. CMU... scoring grab covered 10 yards to concluded Iowa's opening drive of the game... started at wide receiver in 31-13 win over Minnesota as offense gained 374 yards total offense... two receptions for 14 yards vs. Minnesota... started at wide receiver in 19-16 win at Michigan State... matched career-high with six receptions at MSU, gaining 42 yards... started at wide receiver in 38-14 loss to Penn State... four receptions for 42 yards vs. PSU... started at wide receiver in 28-17 loss at Northwestern... led team with career-best seven receptions at Northwestern for 46 yards... started at wide receiver in 24-21 loss at Indiana... led receivers with career-best seven receptions for 131 yards and one score at Indiana... scored on 24-yard reception in first quarter... also added one rushing attempt for 15 yards... started at wide receiver in 27-24 loss to Purdue... led team with 63 receiving yards on four catches vs. Purdue... started at wide receiver in 42-17 loss at Michigan, recording two receptions for seven yards... started at wide receiver in 13-7 loss to Nebraska, recording three receptions for 19 yards.

2011 Honors - - Named to Big Ten Conference all-Freshman team by BTN.com... **2011** - - saw action in 13 games, with one start... 30 receptions for 323 yards and three touchdowns, while also averaging 20.5 yards on four KO returns... had four receptions for 23 yards in triple-overtime loss at Iowa State, including first career touchdown reception to give Iowa a 7-0 advantage... collected four receptions for 76 yards and two touchdowns in 31-27 win over Pittsburgh... touchdown receptions covered 25 and 22 yards, both in fourth quarter, for Iowa's final two scored in comeback win... collected six receptions for 82 yards in 45-17 win over Louisiana-Monroe, with a long of 23 yards... recorded three receptions for 21 yards in 13-3 loss at Penn State... had five receptions for 35 yards in 22-21 loss at Minnesota... recorded one reception for eight yards on a fourth down conversion to keep scoring drive alive in 24-16 win over 13th-ranked Michigan... had one reception for 10 yards in 20-7 loss at Nebraska, along with 82 yards on four KO returns.

High school honors - - Named first team all-state as a senior after earning third team honors as a junior... was all-North offensive MVP as well... first team all-County and all-Catholic League as a junior and senior... **Career** - - holds school records for receiving yards in a game (177), punt return yards in a game (103), career touchdown receptions (20), longest

reception (93) and career receiving yards (1,525)... helped prep team post three-year record of 21-11, earning three straight appearances in state playoffs... had 43 receptions for 745 yards and 10 touchdowns as a senior, along with 14 KO returns for 314 yards and 12 punt returns for 199 yards... collected 34 receptions for 610 yards and nine touchdowns as a junior, along with 199 yards and two scores on 10 punt returns and 262 yards on 13 KO returns... had 170 yards and one touchdown on 16 receptions as a sophomore... earned three varsity letters as wide receiver and defensive back and four basketball letters.
