PROGRAM QUICK HITS

- Iowa broke the WBB all-time attendance record for a single game with 55,646 on hand for the Crossover at Kinnick exhibition against DePaul.
- Iowa advanced to its first National Championship appearance in program history in 2023.
- Iowa netted a program best 31 victories in a single season in 2023.
- Iowa won its third Big Ten Tournament title since 2019, over Ohio State which was the largest margin of victory in BTT Championship history. It was also the first time in program history that the Hawkeyes won the tournament championship in back-to-back years.
- The Hawkeyes led the country in field-goal percentage (51.1), scoring offense (87.3), and assists per game (20.9). They ranked in the top-10 in three additional categories, fourth in assist to turnover ratio (1.46), seventh in 3-point field goal percentage (38.0), and seventh 3-pointers per game (9.2).
- Since 2008, Bluder's teams own a 230-42 record inside of Carver-Hawkeye Arena. In that stretch, the Hawkeyes have posted three undefeated seasons at home.
- Over the last nine years, Iowa has dropped the second-fewest regular season home games in the Big Ten.
- Iowa's 2023-24 roster is comprised of two fifth-year, one graduate, one senior, five juniors, three sophomores, and two freshmen. Four Hawkeyes are Iowa natives, four from Illinois, two from Michigan, and one each from Colorado, Kansas, Nebraska, Ohio.
- Six Big Ten regular-season games will be on a nationally broadcast platform (either NBC or FOX), the most in conference history. The Hawkeyes are featured in four of the six contests – Indiana (Jan. 13/FOX), at Ohio State (Jan. 21/NBC), at Maryland (Feb. 3/FOX), Ohio State (March 3/FOX).
- Iowa has had five out of the last six Big Ten Players of the Year.
- The Hawkeyes had a nation's best six wins against AP Top 10 opponents last season.
- For the first time in the Lisa Bluder era, the Hawkeyes won 15 Big Ten regular season conference games in 2022-23.
- Bluder owns a 494-248 (.664) record and a 247-141 (.637) conference mark at Iowa. In her 38 seasons as a head coach, Bluder is 850-389 (.685).

THE SERIES

SCOUTING FDU

- The Knights were picked fourth in the 2023-24 Northeast Conference Preseason Coaches Poll
- FDU looks to continue their reign of the NEC as the back-to-back regular season conference champions.
- FDU returns five from last season's squad with Mia Andrews, Abaigeal Babore, Abby Conklin, Dominique Garcia Blackwood and Allie McGinn.
- Stephanie Gaitley enters her first season leading the women's basketball program at FDU.
- The Knights went 24-8 last season, including 14 NEC victories en route to the program's second WNIT bid in as many seasons.
- After an offseason coaching change, Gaitley's staff went right to work to bring in nine new faces to the program, including three transfers with a combined six years of collegiate experience.
- Among the transfers is Teneisia Brown who spent one year on Merrimack's roster and was named to the Preseason All-NEC squad last season.

CROSSOVER AT KINNICK

- All net proceeds of the event will benefit The University of Iowa Stead Family Children's Hospital.
- The University of Iowa Athletic Department donated \$250,000 to the UI Hospital.
- Iowa broke the women's basketball all-time attendance record of 29,619 previously set by Connecticut and Oklahoma in the 2002 National Title game in San Antonio's Alamodome. The Hawkeyes had 55,646 fans inside of Kinnick Stadium.

2023 NCAA TOURNAMENT IN REVIEW

- The Hawkeyes stacked wins against 15-Seed SE Louisiana, 10-Seed Georgia, 6-Seed Colorado, 5-Seed Louisville, and 1-Seed South Carolina.
- Clark became the first player in DI women's basketball history to notch a 1,000 point and 300 assist single season. Also became the Big Ten's all-time leading scorer surpassing Megan Gustafson.
- Clark produced the first 40-point triple-double in men's or women's NCAA Tournament history against UL. (41p, 12a, 10r)
- Iowa's win versus South Carolina was the first win in program history against an AP No. 1 team.
- Iowa's 97-point performance against UL was the second-most points scored in a NCAA Tourney game in program history.
- Against L'ville and USC, Clark is the first player to net back-to-back 40-point performances in the NCAA Tourney.
- Against South Carolina, Iowa extended its program record for most wins in a single season. (31)
- Iowa fell to LSU in the most watched NCAA Women's Tournament game off all-time which netted 9.9 million viewers and 12.6 million at its peak.

2023 BIG TEN TOURNAMENT CHAMPIONS

- 2-Seed Iowa won three games in three days against Purdue, Maryland, and Ohio State.
- Clark was tabbed as the BTT MVP after picking up her fourth triple-double of the season against Ohio State in the championship. It was the first triple-double in BTT Championship history.
- Clark averaged 24.7 ppg, 10.0 apg, and 7.7 rpg.
- Czinano registered 18.3 ppg, 6.3 apg, and shot 77% from the floor including breaking the BTT record for field goal percentage in a single game against Ohio State going 11-of-12.
- It was Bluders fourth BTT Championship appearance in the last five seasons.
- Iowa helped break the BTT attendance record with over 9,505 fans inside the Target Center.
- Iowa's 105 point offensive outburst was the most points scored in a Big Ten title game ever.
- It was the first time in program history the Hawkeyes have won back-to-back BTT titles.

WHAT A SUMMER, CLARK!

- Clark, a senior from West Des Moines, Iowa, was named the 2023 Naismith and Wade Trophy winner along with the Associated Press and US-BWA Ann Drysdale Player of the Year honors. The guard is also a two-time winner of the Nancy Lieberman Point Guard Award and is the first-ever three-time winner of the Dawn Staley Award.
- She was 2022-23 first team AP All-American, USBWA All-American, WBCA All-American and All-Region honoree and first team CoSIDA Academic All-American. She was also named the Honda Sport Award winner for women's basketball.
- She was most recently named the 93rd James E. Sullivan Award winner at the New York Athletic Club.
- Clark earned a total of 19 postseason honors from the 2022-23 season.

HIGHLY TOUTED HAWKS

- After Iowa's win in the BTT Championship, the Hawkeyes were No. 2 in AP Poll which was the highest since 1994.
- Iowa has 314 appearances in the AP Poll and the Hawkeyes rank 23rd for all-time appearances.

CIAO BELLA!

- The Hawkeyes went 3-0 during its foreign trip over Team Slammers, KK Tresnjevka 2009, and the Croatian All-Stars.
- Iowa averaged 110 points per game and had an average win margin of 68

- Iowa shot 40% from deep as a team over the three-game span.
- Clark and Stuelke led the Hawks in scoring with 56 and 47 points respectively.
- The team visited the Amalfi Coast, Dubrovnik, Naples and Split on the trip that spanned from Aug. 4-16.
- The Big Ten Network followed the team on the tour and its first episode of the *B1G Trip* is already out. The second and third episode will debut soon.

COURT OF DREAMS

- Season tickets for the 2023-24 University of Iowa women's basketball team are officially sold out.
- Six of Iowa women's basketball eight sellout crowds inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena have happened in the last two seasons, with the other two coming in 1985 and 1988.
- Iowa has been ranked in the national attendance top 10 each of the past four seasons with fans (2023, 2022, 2021, 2019). The No. 2 ranking last season is the highest in the Lisa Bluder era. (11,143)
- Iowa City's first round attendance last year was higher than nine of the 16 sites' first/second round combined attendance figure.
- Iowa City owns four of the top 10 second round, single session attendance numbers in NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship history.

(HAWK)EYES ON LAST SEASON

- Iowa defeated 23 opponents by double figures this year.
- In the Big Ten, the Hawkeyes led the conference in eight statistical categories; assist to tournament ratio, assists per game, field goal percentage, free throws made per game, defensive rebounds per game, points per game, 3-point field goal percentage, and 3-point field goals made per game.
- The Hawkeyes led the country in field-goal percentage (51.1), scoring offense (87.3), and assists per game (20.9). They ranked in the top-10 in three additional categories, fourth in assist to turnover ratio (1.46), seventh in 3-point field goal percentage (38.0), and seventh 3-pointers per game (9.2).
- Caitlin Clark was the only player in the country averaging more than 26 ppg, 7.0 rpg, and 7.0 apg. Since 2009, Clark has averaged more than 25 ppg, 5 apg, and 5 rpg in all three seasons as Hawkeye, only one other player has accomplished that feat. (Anastasia Hayes, Middle Tennessee)
- Caitlin Clark tied Elena Delle Donne for the fastest NCAA Division I women's basketball player to score 2,000 career points in her 75th career game.
- Clark was the first Iowa men's or women's basketball player to eclipse more than 2,000 points, 550 assists, 520 rebounds, 110 steals, and 40 blocks in a career.
- Clark's points and assists equaled to 57% of Iowa's offensive output.
- Clark passed Oregon's Sabrina Ionescu for most career games with 25+ points, 5+ rebounds, and 5+ assists. (41)
- Iowa set a new field goal percentage record against conference foes. (.527)
- Iowa's 87.6 points per game this regular season is the best in program history.
- Iowa has made 313 three-pointers this season, setting a Big Ten Conference record and eclipsing the prior mark set by Ohio State (300 in 2017-18).
- Iowa leads the nation in points per game, assists per game, and field goal percentage.
- Lisa Bluder picked up her 850th career win over South Carolina in the National Semifinals of the NCAA Tournament.
- Iowa snapped South Carolina's 42-game winning streak.
- At 11,143 fans per game this season, Iowa has unofficially broken the Big Ten Conference single-season attendance average record (it will become official when the final NCAA statistics and attendance reports are issued after the season). The previous conference mark was held by Wisconsin, which averaged 10,455 fans in 1997-98. Iowa also averaged 11,660 fans during conference games this season, finishing second in Big Ten history behind only Wisconsin (12,474 in 1997-98).

SCHEDULE NOTES

- The Hawkeyes will play five weekend home games against Big Ten competition (three Saturday, two Sunday). Saturday games inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena come against Minnesota (Dec. 30), Indiana (Jan. 13) and Nebraska (Jan. 27). Iowa is scheduled to be home the final two Sundays of the regular season (Feb. 25 & March 3).
- The Hawkeyes will play on Super Bowl Sunday for the second straight season and eighth time in nine years. Iowa will play at Nebraska on Sunday, Feb. 11.
- The Big Ten Tournament will return to the Target Center in Minneapolis, March 6-10, 2024.
- Six Big Ten regular-season games will be on a nationally broadcast platform (either NBC or FOX), the most in conference history. The Hawkeyes are featured in four of the six contests – Indiana (Jan. 13/FOX), at Ohio State (Jan. 21/NBC), at Maryland (Feb. 3/FOX), Ohio State (March 3/FOX).
