OPENING TIP

- The Hawkeyes head to Ames, Iowa, for the annual Iowa Corn Cy-Hawk Series matchup against Iowa State on Thursday. Iowa has won four of the last five meetings in the series against Iowa State.
- Following Thursday's game, three of Iowa's next four games will be at home.
- Ahoy 100. Iowa hit the century mark for the second time this season, scoring 103 points in the Nov. 29 victory over North Florida. The Hawkeyes have scored 100+ points 11 times since the start of the 2021-22 season.
- Graduate Ben Krikke and senior Tony Perkins notched Iowa's sixth and seventh 20-point scoring outputs in the win over UNF, as both players finished with 21 points. The Hawkeyes have had four different players hit the 20-point mark this season.
- Iowa has four players averaging in double figures. The team has had at least four players reach double digits in six of eight games this season.
- Krikke is leading the team with an 18.4 scoring average and he's the only Hawkeye to score in double figures in every game. The Valparaiso transfer has made a team-high 58 field goals and is shooting 60.4 percent from the floor, which are third and fourth in the Big Ten.
- Big O... freshman Owen Freeman scored a career-high 16 points on 6-of-8 shooting to go along with five rebounds, five blocks and three steals in Iowa's win over UNF. The five blocks are the most by a Hawkeye since Keegan Murray in 2019. Freeman has been named the Big Ten Freshman of the Week three times this season, tying Aaron White (2011-12) for the most honors in program history.
- Iowa is one the nation's top offensive teams, averaging 87.9 points in eight games. The Hawkeyes are tops in the Big Ten and 12th nationally. The team has scored at least 84 points in six games, including 110 points in the season opener against North Dakota.
- Iowa's newcomers have accounted for 298 points (37.3 percent of scoring) in eight games.
- Share & Take Care: Iowa has 148 assists to 71 turnovers in eight games, assisting on 59.2 percent of its field goals.
- Iowa has won 87 of its last 93 nonconference home games, dating back to 2012.
- McCaffery is six wins from becoming the winningest coach in Iowa basketball history. Tom Davis has 271 victories as Iowa's head coach. With his next Big Ten victory, McCaffery will also have the most league wins in program history.
- Iowa is one of 10 teams in the country to make the last four NCAA Tournaments and one of only three Big Ten teams to accomplish the feat (Purdue, Michigan State).

HEAD COACH FRAN McCAFFERY

Fran McCaffery, who is signed through the 2028 season, is in his 14th season as the head basketball coach at the University of Iowa and his 28th year overall as a college head coach. McCaffery has reached the 20-win plateau 11 of the previous 16 seasons.

McCaffery spent five seasons (2005-10) as the head coach at Siena, six years at UNC-Greensboro (1999-2005) and three seasons at Lehigh (1985-88) before joining the Hawkeyes.

McCaffery has nearly four decades of Division I coaching experience.

He is in his 42nd season as a collegiate coach, which includes 28 years as a head coach and 15 as an assistant. In 2022, McCaffery joined Hall of Fame coaches Rick Pitino, Bob Huggins, Eddie Sutton and Lefty Driesell as the only Division I coaches to lead teams to conference tournament titles in four or more different leagues (Big Ten, MAAC, SoCon, ECC). He is one of 14 coaches to lead at least four different Division I teams to the NCAA Tournament.

McCaffery, 64, won his 500th game as a head coach on Dec. 8, 2022 and win No. 250 at Iowa on Dec. 17, 2022. He holds a career mark of 517-355 (.593) and guided his teams to 16 postseason appearances (12 NCAA & four NIT). Iowa likely would have competed in another NCAA Tournament in 2020, if not for the NCAA canceling the postseason due to COVID-19. He is 266-178 (.599) at Iowa; the second winningest coach in program history. McCaffery led Iowa to wins in four of the last seven NCAA Tournaments (2015, 2016, 2019, and 2021).

Since taking over the Iowa program in 2010, Iowa has earned 10 postseason tournament bids (7 NCAA, 3 NIT). McCaffery coached Iowa to a Big Ten Tournament title and 26 wins in 2022, the second-most win total in program history. McCaffery has guided seven players to first team All-Big Ten status eight of the last 10 years, including the 2020 & 2021 National and Big Ten Player of the Year, Luka Garza.

McCaffery has posted upper division finishes in 10 of the last 11 seasons at Iowa and 22 of 27 seasons as a head coach. The Hawkeyes have finished fifth or better in the Big Ten standings seven of the last nine years. He has posted 20 wins or more 11 of the last 15 seasons, including eight of the last 10 years at Iowa (2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2019, 2020, 2021, and 2022). Iowa's 205 victories between 2013-21 are the most over a 10-year span at Iowa since 1987-96 (207).

McCaffery and the Hawkeyes boast a 171-43 (.795) home record the last 13+ seasons, which includes a school-record 18 wins in 2014 and 13 consecutive victories in 2019-20. Iowa has won 14+ games in Carver-Hawkeye Arena each of the last five seasons (2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, and 2023).

McCaffery's five years at Siena were the best in its 70-year history. He led the Saints on an incredible run that ended with three straight Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference championships and NCAA Tournament appearances.

McCaffery's Saints owned a 112-51 (.687) record in his five years with the program. He guided the Saints to four consecutive 20-win seasons. McCaffery's achievements earned the head coach Siena Hall of Fame recognition in 2017.

The 2009 MAAC Coach of the Year and 2010 District I Coach of the Year is the third winningest coach, by percentage, in league history (.68-22, .756). He is the only coach to guide a MAAC program to two NCAA Tournament wins. McCaffery led his 2008 and 2009 teams to first round NCAA Tournament victories over Vanderbilt and Ohio State, respectively.

In his final two seasons at Siena, he coached the Saints to back-to-back 27-win campaigns and boasted a combined 39-3 (.929) record against MAAC opponents, which included MAAC Tournament contests.

McCaffery began his coaching career as an assistant at Penn (1982-83) and Lehigh (1983-85). After three seasons as head coach at Lehigh, he spent 11 seasons as an assistant at Notre Dame (1988-99).

McCaffery played basketball at Wake Forest his freshman year (1977-78) and concluded his playing career at Penn his final three seasons (1979-82). He earned his bachelor's degree in economics from The Wharton School (Penn) in 1982. McCaffery also earned a master of education from Lehigh in 1985.

THE SETTING

The University of Iowa men's basketball team hits the road for its second straight road contest, traveling to Ames on Thursday for an Iowa Corn Cy-Hawk Series matchup against Iowa State. The game will begin at 6:30 p.m. (CT) from Hilton Coliseum.

ON THE AIR

Radio: Thursday's game will be broadcast on the Hawkeye Radio Network with Gary Dolphin (play-by-play) and Bobby Hansen (color) on the call. The network includes more than 40 stations that blanket the state of Iowa and include portions of Illinois, Nebraska, Minnesota, Missouri and Wisconsin. The Hawkeye Radio Network includes a 60-minute pregame show.

TV: Thursday's game will be televised on ESPNU with Rich Hollenberg (play-by-play) and Jon Crispin (color) on the call.

SCOUTING IOWA STATE

- The Cyclones bring a 6-2 record into Thursday's Iowa Corn Cy-Hawk Series games. Iowa State has lost two of its last three games, falling to Virginia Tech and No. 12 Texas A&M in Kissimmee, Florida, at the ESPN Events Invitational before winning 99-80 at DePaul on Dec. 1 in a BIG EAST/Big 12 Battle.
- Iowa State is 4-0 inside Hilton Coliseum this season with its four wins coming by an average of 45.5 points.
- The Cyclones have four players averaging in double figures and six averaging at least 8.3 points. Guard Tamin Lipsey is leading the team in scoring (15.1), rebounding (6.5), assists (6.3) and steals (3.0). He is shooting 49.4 percent from the field and 36 percent from 3-point range.
- Milan Momcilovic has a team-high 21 3-pointers, while shooting 44.7 percent from long range. As a team, Iowa State only makes 6.1 3s per game and shoots 32.5 percent.

SERIES HISTORY

- The Hawkeyes lead the all-time series against Iowa State, 48-28. Iowa has won four of the last five and five of the last seven in the series.
- Iowa has split its last two meetings in Ames, winning 84-68 in 2019 and losing 73-53 in 2021. The 2019 victory was Iowa's first in Hilton since 2003 in the NIT.
- Head coach Fran McCaffery is 6-6 all-time against Iowa State. Last season's 75-56 win in Carver was McCaffery's 500th career victory.

IOWA CORN CY-HAWK SERIES

- The Cy-Hawk Series is in its 19th season in 2023-24 and is being sponsored for the 11th time by Iowa Corn.
- Iowa leads the 2023-24 Iowa Corn Cy-Hawk Series, 7-6, with victories in football, women's soccer and men's wrestling. The two schools meet in women's basketball on Dec. 6 and in the swimming pool on Dec. 8 -- both in Ames.

LAST GAME | NO. 4 PURDUE 87, IOWA 68

The Hawkeyes ran into a buzzsaw in West Lafayette, falling, 87-68, against the fourth-ranked Boilermakers. Purdue built a 45-24 halftime advantage and led by as many as 35 in the second half. Iowa outscored the Boilermakers, 44-42, in the second 20 minutes. Graduate Ben Krikke led the team with 16 points and seven rebounds, while Tony Perkins was the only other Hawkeye in double figures, scoring 12. Iowa shot 38.5 percent from the field and 33.3 percent from 3-point range in the game.

MCCAFFERY APPROACHES RECORD

- Head coach Fran McCaffery, who is in his 28th season as a head coach and 14th at Iowa, needs six victories to become the winningest coach in program history. (Tom Davis has 271 victories.)
- With his next Big Ten Conference win, McCaffery will also pass Davis for the most Big Ten victories in program history.

MORE NOTABLES

- Iowa is 4-0 inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena this season and 18-3 in its last 21 home games.
- The Hawkeyes shot 50 percent or better in four straight halves in games against Seton Hall and North Florida. The team shot 63.3 percent (19-of-30) in the second half in the win over UNF -- its best shooting half of the season.
- Iowa is 3-1 this season when shooting 50 percent or better from the floor.
- Iowa has held two opponents to under 40 percent shooting this season.
- Junior Payton Sandfort has attempted 53 3-point field goals -- the most in the Big Ten. He has 18 makes -- fifth-most in the conference.
- The Hawkeyes are third in the Big Ten in free throw percentage, making 76.4 percent of their attempts this season.
- Junior Payton Sandfort has been Iowa's leading rebounder (or tied for the team lead) in six of eight games this season. The forward is averaging 7.9 rebounds per game, which rank eighth in the Big Ten.
- The Hawkeyes have earned four Big Ten weekly honors this season -- Ben Krikke (Player of the Week - 11/20) and Owen Freeman (Freshman of Week (11/13, 11/20, 12/4). Freeman is the first Hawkeye freshman to earn the award in consecutive weeks and the three honors tie Aaron White for the most in a single season in program history.
- Sophomore Dasonte Bowen has 27 assists to five turnovers this season. His 5.40 assist-to-turnover ratio is leading the Big Ten and ranks fifth nationally.
- Senior Tony Perkins is a preseason second-team All-Big Ten selection by THE ALMANAC, while junior Payton Sandfort is ranked as the 89th-best player nationally by the publication.
- The Hawkeyes have placed fifth or better in the Big Ten standings in five straight and 10 of the last 11 years, and the program has won 10 or more Big Ten games in eight of the last nine seasons.

• Iowa led the Big Ten and was 18th nationally in scoring offense (80.1). The Hawkeyes have led the league in scoring in seven of the last 11 seasons, including six straight years.

KRIKKE: BIG POW

Graduate student Ben Krikke averaged 24.5 points and seven rebounds in games against No. 8 Creighton and Arkansas State to earn Big Ten Player of the Week honors on Nov. 20. The forward had back-to-back 20-point games, shooting 66 percent from the field (21-of-32). He scored 24 points at Creighton and a season-high 25 points against Arkansas State, while also finishing with nine rebounds, a career-high four steals and three blocks.

• It is Krikke's first Big Ten honor and third of his career. He was a two-time MVC Player of the Week during the 2022-23 season.

FREEMAN: BIG FOW X 3

Forward Owen Freeman is the first Hawkeye to earn back-to-back Big Ten Freshman of the Week honors and he has been recognized three times this season (Nov. 13, Nov. 20, Dec. 4), tying Aaron White for the most in a single season in program history.

• The Moline, Illinois, native averaged 11 points and three rebounds in wins over North Dakota and Alabama State before putting up 7.5 points, 2.5 blocks and two rebounds in games against No. 8 Creighton and Arkansas State. He scored 16 points on 6-of-8 shooting and had five rebounds, five blocks and three steals in a win over North Florida.

CONSISTENT KRIKKE

Graduate Ben Krikke is the only Hawkeye to reach double figures in every game this season. The Canada native is leading the team, averaging 18.4 points on a team-best 60.4 percent shooting.

• Krikke ranks in the top 10 in the Big Ten in five categories -- third in field goals (58), fourth in field goal percentage (.604), fifth in points (147), seventh in free throws (30) and eighth in scoring average (18.4).

• He has shot 60 percent or better from the field in four games and he has two games with 10 or more field goals. He made 8-of-10 field goals (80 percent) in the win over Seton Hall on Nov. 24.

• He has a team-high three 20-point games. He scored 24 points (11-of-18 shooting) at No. 8 Creighton and a season-high 25 points (10-of-14 FG), nine rebounds and four steals in the win over Arkansas State. Against UNF, Krikke scored 21 points (5-of-9) shooting -- 17 in the second half -- and went 11-for-11 from the free throw line.

• Krikke is the first Hawkeye to go perfect from the free throw line (at least 10 makes) since Jordan Bohannon (10-for-10) in 2019.

PAYTON'S STRONG START

Junior Payton Sandfort is second on the team in scoring and is leading the team in rebounding to open the season, averaging 13.6 points and 7.9 rebounds in 25.1 minutes.

• Sandfort has two 20 point games, giving him nine such games in his career. He scored 21 points against North Dakota in the season opener, netting 10 of Iowa's first 16 points and 13 of 21 to open the game. He also had nine rebounds.

• The forward scored a season-high 22 points on 7-of-14 shooting with four 3-pointers in the neutral site win over Seton Hall. He also grabbed nine rebounds.

• Sandfort tallied his first career double-double, finishing with 17 points and a career-high 12 rebounds against Alabama State. Late in the first half, he scored 12 points in a span of 111 seconds, including a four-point play.

• Sandfort has scored in double figures in six of the team's eight games this season.

BIG O

Freshman Owen Freeman has been a steady contributor as Iowa's top reserve in the front court. The Illinois native is averaging 9.8 points on 60 percent shooting. He has a team-high 16 blocks to go along with nine steals.

• Freeman has reached double digits in three games, including scoring a career-high 16 points on 6-of-8 shooting in the win over North Florida. He had five rebounds, five blocks (three in the matter of seconds on a single possession) and three steals in the game. His block effort was the No. 4 play of the day on SportCenter's Top 10 plays.

• His five blocks were the most for the program since Keegan Murray had five blocks against Longwood in 2021.

• Freeman has three or more blocks in three games this season and five or more rebounds twice. He is fifth in the Big Ten and 37th nationally with 16 blocks.

TP SHINES

Playing with a heavy heart following the death of his grandmother earlier in the week, senior Tony Perkins delivered his best game of the season in Iowa's 103-78 victory over North Florida on Nov. 30. The Indianapolis native scored 21 points on 8-of-10 shooting with two of his field goals coming from 3-point range. He scored 12 points before the game was eight minutes old.

• Perkins has reached double figures in seven of eight games this season, including two 15+ point contests. He is third on the team with a 12.8 scoring average, while being second on the team in rebounding (5.3), tied for second on the team in steals (9) and third in assists (20).

P-MAC: 2-2

Senior Patrick McCaffery netted his sixth career 20-point game against Alabama State on Nov. 10, making 7-of-12 field goals en route to a 22-point outing. The forward scored eight of Iowa's first 12 points and 10 of the first 16 over the first 7 1/2 minutes.

• McCaffery is averaging 11.5 points -- fourth-best on the team -- on 46.9 percent shooting in eight games and he has made 25-of-32 attempts from the free throw stripe.

• The Iowa City, Iowa, native has scored in double digits in six of eight games this season. He has two games scoring 15 or more points.

DASONTE'S BIG DAY

Sophomore Dasonte Bowen had the best game of his career against Arkansas State on Nov. 17, scoring a career-high 17 points, while finishing with three steals and three assists. Bowen made 4-of-5 field goals and 9-of-10 free throws in the game.

• Bowen has landed in double figures in two games in 2022-23.

• The Boston native has been one of Iowa's best distributors. He has three or more assists in six contests and has played clean basketball (not committing a turnover) four times. He is leading the Big Ten and ranks fifth nationally with a 5.40 assist-to-turnover ratio.

20 POINTERS

The Hawkeyes have had four players account for seven 20-point games during the 2023-24 season -- Ben Krikke (24 at Creighton, 25 vs. Arkansas State, 21 vs. UNF), Payton Sandfort (21 vs. UND, 22 vs. Seton Hall), Patrick McCaffery (22 vs. Alabama State) and Tony Perkins (21 vs. UNF).

SHARE & TAKE CARE

The Hawkeyes are leading the Big Ten and rank 11th nationally, averaging 18.5 assists per game. Iowa has had 20 or more assists in four games this season, including a season-high 27 on 32 field goals in the Nov. 10 win over Alabama State.

- Iowa is 3-1 this season when handing out 20 or more assists.
- On the flip side, Iowa averages 8.9 turnovers per game -- second-fewest in the Big Ten and 10th nationally. The team has committed 10 or fewer turnovers in five games (3-2 record).
- Iowa's 2.08 assist-to-turnover ratio is leading the Big Ten and ranks third nationally.

DISTRIBUTING GUARDS

Iowa's primary ball handlers--Dasonte Bowen, Brock Harding, Tony Perkins and Josh Dix -- have a combined for 83 assists to 25 turnovers in eight games.

- Bowen has a team-high 27 assists to five turnovers, Harding has 23 assists to eight turnovers, Perkins has 20 assists to 10 turnovers and Dix has 13 assists to two turnovers.
- Harding had 14 assists (seven in each game) in his first two collegiate games in just 25 minutes.
- Bowen is leading the Big Ten (and ranks fifth nationally) in assist-to-turnover ratio at 5.40.

3 IS FOR ME

The Hawkeyes have made 54 3-point field goals in eight games, averaging 6.8 makes per contest. Ten different players have made at least one 3-pointer.

- Iowa is 3-0 when making at least eight 3-point field goals this season.
- Iowa made a season-high 12 3-point field goals (on 24 attempts) against North Dakota in the season opener.
- Junior Payton Sandfort has a team-leading 18 3-balls (in 53 attempts) to lead the team. (He is the only Hawkeye with 10 or more 3-point field goals.) The forward has two games with four or more 3-pointers this season and eight such games in his career.

FREEBIES

Payton Sandfort opened his junior season by making his first 12 free throws. He is 19-of-20 for the season, making 95 percent of his attempts.

- For his career, the Waukee, Iowa, native is an 89.5 percent free throw shooter, making 85-of-95 career attempts.

AT THE LINE

The Hawkeyes get to the free throw line early and often under head coach Fran McCaffery and the team routinely makes more free throws than its opponents attempt.

- Iowa has made 19 more free throws (149) than its opponents have attempted (130) through eight games.
- The team has made more free throws than its opponent has attempted in six of the eight games this season.
- The Hawkeyes are averaging 18.6 makes at the free throw line this season -- 23rd-most in the country.
- Iowa attempted a season-high 46 free throws (made 32) against Arkansas State. The 46 attempts are the third-most in the McCaffery era.
- The Hawkeyes are 4-0 this season when attempting 20 or more free throws

IT'S THE NEWCOMERS

Iowa's newcomers have accounted for 298 points -- 37.3 percent of the team's scoring -- in the first eight games.

- Graduate transfer Ben Krikke has reached double figures in all eight games, where he is averaging a team-best 18.4 points on 61.4 percent shooting.
- Freshman Owen Freeman is averaging 9.8 points and 3.6 rebounds, while swatting a team-best 16 shots. He is shooting 60 percent from the floor.

10 DEEP

The Hawkeyes have 10 players averaging double-digit minutes in the first eight games of the season.

- Iowa's reserves have scored 30 or more points in two games, averaging 24.8 points per game.

IMPACT TRANSFER

The Hawkeyes added an impact transfer to the roster in Valparaiso transfer Ben Krikke. The Edmonton, Alberta, Canada, native was a first-team All-MVC selection in 2022-23 after leading the Missouri Valley Conference at 19.4 points per game overall and 21 points in conference play. Krikke shot 55.2 percent from the field and 79.6 percent from the free throw stripe, while averaging 5.9 rebounds and 2.1 assists per game.

- Krikke is leading the team with a 18.4 scoring average in eight games with a team-best three 20-point contests. He has made eight or more field goals in four contests and 10 or more in two games, including 11 field goals (on 18 attempts) in the road game at No. 8 Creighton.
- For his career, Krikke has scored in double figure in 90 (of 130) career games, which includes 27 20-point games. He has scored 1,741 career points (13.4 career avg.), shooting 54.5 percent from the field and 79.9 percent from the charity stripe.

P, P & P

- The Hawkeyes return three Ps -- Patrick, Payton and Perkins -- in 2023-24. The trio have combined to start 124 games in their collegiate career and appear in 275 career games.
- Fifth-year senior Patrick McCaffery has averaged 10.5 and 9.8 points in his last two seasons. For his career, the Iowa City, Iowa, native shoots 42.4 percent from the field, averaging 8.6 points in 100 career games.

• Senior Tony Perkins has a team-high 55 career starts as a Hawkeye and he's the team's leading returning scorer after averaging 12.3 points per game in 2022-23. The Indianapolis native is a preseason second-team All-Big Ten selection by THE ALMANAC.

SANDFORT: JULIUS ERVING WATCH LIST

Junior Payton Sandfort is one of 20 players named to the Julius Erving Small Forward of the Year Preseason Watch List -- an award that recognizes the top small forwards in men's college basketball annually.

- Sandfort is one of three players in the Big Ten on the preseason watch list.
- The forward is also listed as a potential "breakout" star by Jon Rothstein and The Athletic's CJ Moore.

WHO'S NEXT?

Head coach Fran McCaffery has coached seven players to first-team All-Big Ten selection in eight of the last 10 years.

FOREIGN IMPACT

Iowa went 3-0 during its foreign trip with victories over the Paris, Valencia and Barcelona All-Stars. The Hawkeyes averaged 127 points per game in the three victories, shooting 48.4 percent from the field and 38.2 percent from 3-point range.

- Payton Sandfort (19 points, 11 rebounds) and Ben Krikke (16.3 points, 11.7 rebounds) averaged double-doubles, while Tony Perkins (16.3 points), Dasonte Bowen (12.3 points), Brock Harding (11.3 points), Josh Dix (11 points), and Owen Freeman (10.3 points) all averaged in double figures. Freeman pulled down a team-best 12.3 rebounds per game.

WELCOME HOME

Senior Even Brauns returns to his hometown to fulfill a lifelong dream of playing for the Hawkeyes. The center spent the past three years at Belmont University in Nashville, where he played in 92 career games with 31 starts. Brauns averaged seven points and 5.3 rebounds during his junior season with the Bruins.

- Brauns played at both Iowa City Regina and Iowa City West High Schools as a prep. He was an all-state player as a senior after averaging 15.6 points and 7.3 rebounds as a senior. He played his junior season as a teammate of Patrick McCaffery.

8 NEW FACES

Half of Iowa's roster is comprised of newcomers in 2023-24, including two transfers. Ben Krikke is a graduate transfer from Valparaiso, while Iowa City native Even Brauns returns home after playing three seasons at Belmont.

- The Hawkeyes welcome five freshmen -- Ladji Dembele, Owen Freeman, Brock Harding, Spencer Hutchison and Pryce Sandfort -- and senior guard Jovone Cater. Hutchison and Cater are non-scholarship student-athletes.

MR. BASKETBALLS

Two Hawkeye freshmen -- Brock Harding and Pryce Sandfort -- were named their state's Mr. Basketball in 2023.

- Harding, who scored 1,889 points in his prep career, earned Illinois Mr. Basketball honors after averaging 18.4 points and 5.7 assists at Moline High School. He is the first Western Big Six player to earn the distinction since 2011 (Chasson Randle, Stanford). Other recent past winners include: Braden Huff, E.J. Liddell, Jalen Brunson, Jabari Parker and Jahlil Okafor.

- Harding is the second Mr. Basketball in the state of Illinois to become a Hawkeye, joining Ed Horton (1985-89).

- Sandfort earned Iowa's Mr. Basketball honors after averaging 24.9 points, 11 rebounds, 2.8 assists, 2.7 blocks and 1.7 steals at Waukee Northwest High School. The forward led Class 4A in points, blocks, field goals made, 3-pointers made, free throws made and defensive rebounds.

- Sandfort is the first Mr. Basketball to join the Hawkeye program since Joe Wieskamp, who earned the distinction in 2018.

FAMILY BUSINESS

Iowa will have a set of brothers on the roster for the fifth straight year in 2023-24. Payton and Pryce Sandfort follow Connor and Patrick McCaffery, who were Hawkeye teammates from 2019-23.

TEAMMATES AGAIN

- Patrick McCaffery and Even Brauns reunite after being prep teammates at Iowa City West High School. Brauns spent the past three seasons at Belmont University.
- Payton and Pryce Sandfort were teammates at Waukee High School. Pryce played his final two prep seasons at Waukee Northwest High School.
- Brock Harding and Owen Freeman remain teammates in Iowa City. The duo won a state title at Moline High School in 2023.
- Dasonte Bowen and Carter Kingsbury were teammates at the Brewster Academy in New Hampshire.

Head coach Fran McCaffery and the University of Iowa men's basketball program signed two student-athletes to National Letters of Intent on Nov. 8.

- Keegan Murray was selected fourth overall by the Sacramento Kings -- the highest pick in program history -- during the 2022 NBA Draft and Kris Murray was taken 23rd overall in the 2023 NBA Draft by the Portland Trailblazers.
- John Johnson was selected by Cleveland in 1970 and Seattle picked Fred Brown in 1971. (B.J. Armstrong and Roy Marble were both first round picks in the 1989 NBA Draft.

HAWKEYE FASTBREAKS

- Iowa is 150-30 when scoring 80 points or more, the last 13+ seasons. The Hawkeyes are 94-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 61 points, the last 13 years.
- Iowa made more free throws (495) than its opponents attempted (472) during the 2022-23 season. The Hawkeyes have only once before accomplished the feat over the last 25 years (2018-19).

IOWA HISTORY

Iowa has played 2,949 games since beginning basketball in 1902. Iowa's overall record is 1,744-1,205 (.591). Iowa's 1,744 wins are 38th most among Division I programs. That includes a 1,115-381 (.745) record in home games, a 629-824 (.433) record in contests away from Iowa City, an 826-822 (.502) mark in Big Ten games and a 519-155 (.769) record in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

IOWA VS. RANKED TEAMS

The Hawkeyes are 0-2 against AP ranked opponents in 2023-24, dropping road games at No. 8 Creighton in the Gavitt Tipoff Games and at No. 4 Purdue.

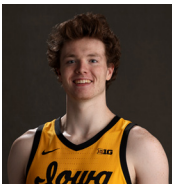
