
11 NCAA Appearances in Last 14 Years







Big Ten Championships Success



Since 2013, the Hawkeyes have finished fourth or better at the Big Ten Championships seven times. In that span, Iowa has finished in second place three times. In 2023, Mac McClear became the first Hawkeye to win two individual Big Ten Championships in a career.





James M. Hoak Family Golf Complex

The state-of-the-art James M. Hoak Family Golf Complex is located at Finkbine Golf Course. Overlooking the sixth hole, it is the exclusive home of Iowa golf.


The facility features the 5,000 square foot Transamerica Performance Studio, highlighted by five indoor-to-outdoor hitting stations, V-1 Video Swing Analysis and Trackman technology. Players can digitally record, analyze and compare their swings and data to learn from the best in the world. The heated hitting stations open directly to the driving range and feature T-Line hitting surface enabling UI student-athletes to work on swing mechanics and full ball flight throughout the entire year, day or night.

The performance studio also includes a 3,150 square foot indoor putting and chipping green that can be modified like a natural grass green, effectively recreating outdoor putting surface conditions.

The Golf Complex includes men's and women's locker rooms, coaches' offices, team lounge and a trophy room that displays the history of Iowa golf. The new 14,000 square foot outdoor putting green, outdoor wedge range and bent grass practice area complete the facility and place it among the best in collegiate golf.

The Mike and Mary McCarty Short Game Facility officially opened in the fall of 2022, providing players with two acres of dedicated space to practice any number of short game shots they may encounter while playing competitive golf. Adjacent to the Hoak Family Golf Complex and Finkbine Golf Course, the new facility provides the Hawkeyes with two additional USGA specification greens and three bunkers located right on the University of Iowa campus.



Finkbine Golf Course

Located on the western edge of The University of Iowa campus, just walking distance from Kinnick Stadium, Carver-Hawkeye Arena and Hillcrest Residence Hall, is Finkbine Golf Course. Founded in 1953 and opened in 1955, Finkbine remains a source of great pride and beauty as the home course for the Iowa golf program.


The 7,280-yard, par-72 layout is prized by the University and Iowa City community alike. A tremendous test of golf, Finkbine was the site of the PGA Amana VIP Pro-Am for more than 20 years featuring the PGA's finest as well as national and local celebrities. In 1991, Finkbine also became the host of the Ben Hogan Tour – Hawkeye Open. Collegiately, Finkbine has been the site for the 1992 and 2002 men's Big Ten Championships, the Hawkeye Intercollegiate and the Big Four Invitational.

Built among the rolling hills and elevation changes of Iowa City, Finkbine challenges golfers of every skill level. The Robert Bruce Harris design features sloped greens and sand bunkering on 17 of the 18 holes. The signature 13th hole is an island green surrounded by water offering multiple tee boxes and two greens.

Construction for Finkbine's brand new clubhouse is underway and will be ready for the start of the 2020 season. The new club house will feature an upper level with a golf shop, dining room, grill room bar, conference room, and an outdoor terrace, and a lower level with a grab and go hospitality area, golfers' lounge, and men's and women's locker rooms.


In the fall of 2003, Finkbine renovated the entire golf course with the addition of bent grass fairways, newly grassed greens and tee complexes. The university maintains Finkbine's lush tees, fairways and greens with a state of the art irrigation system. The driving range and practice facility feature four practice greens, short game areas, sand bunkers and a two tier range.

The Iowa golf teams enjoy a dedicated 10,000 square foot practice green, two practice bunkers and two newly renovated bent grass practice tees. Offering unquestionable golf facility advantages, Finkbine Golf Course is indeed the proud home of the Hawkeyes.




BLUE TOP RIDGE

Designed by world-renowned architect Rees Jones, Blue Top Ridge is a world class golf course, offering breathtaking vistas overlooking two rivers, lakes and diverse terrain. It was voted the No. 51 "Top New Course" in 2010 by Golf Digest.


BROWN DEER

Brown Deer Golf Club is conveniently located two miles north of the University of Iowa campus. Brown Deer features water on eight holes that wind through the hills and valleys of Coralville.


AMANA COLONIES

The Amana Colonies Golf Course is a championship golf course across 300 acres of stately white oak trees and forests. The course features streams, ponds and striking scenery.


ELMCREST

ANF FALL CLASSIC

The University of Iowa men's golf team hosts the ANF Fall Classic each season at Blue Top Ridge Golf Course in Riverside, Iowa. In 2023, the Hawkeyes earned the team championship as senior Mac McClear took home medalist honors.

Spanning 7,432 yards, Blue Top Ridge was named the top course in the state of Iowa in 2022 by IowaGolf.com. Located 15 minutes from Iowa City in Riverside, Iowa, the par-72 course is a Rees Jones design. The ANF Fall Classic plays host to many of the top programs around the Midwest.



HAWKEYE INVITATIONAL

The 2023 Hawkeye Invitational marks the 30th edition of Iowa’s longest-running home event, hosted annually at Finkbine Golf Course in Iowa City, Iowa-- the home of the Hawkeyes!

Last season, Iowa earned its 17th team championship in the tournament’s history, led by a medalist-finish from senior Mac McClear. The Hawkeyes have won three of the last four team titles at the event.

Iowa calimed the inagural team championship in 1970, as well as the next seven in a string lasting through 1981. Other champions include Wisconsin, Kent State, Western Illinois and Kansas. The Hawkeye Invitational has hosted a number of different schools and has been played in a variety of formats, but two things have remained the same: historic Finkbine Golf Course has always been its home and many of the Midwest’s best teams have been showcased. Attendance is free and encouraged!

CALUSA CUP

The University of Iowa men's golf team will host the fourth-annual Calusa Cup in Naples, Florida, at the Caluse Pines Golf Club, in early April. The three-day, 54-hole tournament features one of the top fields in collegiate golf each season.

THE COURSE:

Golf Digest ranks Calusa Pines the No. 93 course in the United States and fifth in the state of Florida for 2023. The Hurdzan-Fry design features iconic perched greens, providing an added challenge in the short game for even skilled players. The Calusa Cup is the only collegiate event hosted by the prestigious club. It is one of the most unique courses in south Florida and has some of the firmest, fastest Bermuda fairways and greens in Florida.



Head Coach

10th Season

Alma Mater: Iowa



Tyler Stith heads into his tenth season as head coach at the University of Iowa after being named Iowa head coach on Aug. 22, 2014. Stith, a former assistant coach and student-athlete at Iowa, previously served as an assistant coach at Minnesota from 2011-14.

During Stith's tenure as head coach of the Iowa men's golf program, the Hawkeyes have finished in the top four of the Big Ten Championships five times, advanced to five NCAA Regionals, and totaled three or more top-three tournament finishes in six of nine seasons.

Stith heads a program that has advanced to 11 of the last 14 NCAA Regionals, which ranks third among Big Ten programs during that span. Iowa has advanced to the NCAA Championships three times since 2009.

In nine seasons, Stith has coached 16 All-Midwest Region selections, 13 All-Big Ten selections, two academic All-Americans, 18 academic All-Big Ten selections, two Big Ten Player of the Year honorees, one Les Bolstad Trophy award winner, and three Big Ten Championship medalist performances.

This past season, Stith's Hawkeyes earned two team championships at the Iowa Fall Classic and the Hawkeye Invitational. Senior Mac McClear was medalist in each of those outings, as well as at the Big Ten Championships, becoming Iowa's first two-time Big Ten Champion as well as the winningest Hawkeye since 1976 with five collegiate victories. Three of Iowa's five Big Ten medalist performances have been won with Stith at the helm. The Hawkeyes tied for fifth as a team at the Big Ten Championships, which were cut short to just 36 holes due to weather concerns during the third round.

Iowa won its 17th team championship at the Hawkeye Invitational in the event's 29-season history. Other notable outings included a tie for fourth place at the Wake Forest Invitational, where McClear tied for second and senior Ronan Kleu tied for ninth in a loaded field of competition at Pinehurst No. 2. The Hawkeyes also hosted the Calusa Cup, one of the premier events of the 2022 regular season; Iowa welcomed eight ranked programs, including four of the Golfstat

top-five ranked teams, to Calusa Pines Golf Club.

McClear advanced as an individual to the NCAA Regional competition in Las Vegas. He earned All-Big Ten Second Team recognition, the third conference postseason honor of his historic Hawkeye career. In the classroom, Iowa was recognized for posting the top Spring and Fall team GPA of 2022 among Hawkeye men's athletics programs.

In 2022, Stith directed Iowa to three top-six finishes as four different Hawkeyes placed inside the leaderboard top 10 on nine occasions. Under Stith's direction, juniors Garrett Tighe and Mac McClear placed second and fifth, respectively, at the Hawkeye Invitational, where Iowa finished runner-up as a team. McClear and teammate Ronan Kleu each earned bids to compete individually at NCAA Regionals, where McClear tied for 14th at 214 (-2) after 54 holes. Both McClear and Kleu earned second team All-Big Ten honors, while sophomore Callum Macfie was recognized with the Big Ten Sportsmanship Award. The Hawkeyes placed third at Big Ten Match Play, where they defeated Minnesota (4-1), two-seed Northwestern (3-2), and top-seeded Purdue (tie-breaker) with one loss against Michigan State (4-1). Iowa finished seventh as a team at the Big Ten Championships, where four Hawkeyes placed inside the top 27 on the leaderboard.

In 2021, Stith earned Big Ten Coach of the Year honors following an impressive campaign. Under Stith's direction, Iowa achieved five top-five finishes, including two tournament championships at the Spartan Collegiate at Sea Island and the Hawkeye Invitational. Iowa's victories mark the first time since the 2014 season that the program won multiple team titles in the same season. Fifth-year senior Alex Schaake and sophomore Mac McClear also combined for three individual championships, the most for the Hawkeyes since the 2013 season.

Stith led Iowa to runner-up finishes at both the Big Ten Match Play and the Big Ten Championships, as the Hawkeyes qualified for the program's 11th NCAA Regionals appearance since 2009. Stith also coached Schaake and McClear to remarkable seasons, with Schaake being named Big Ten Co-Player of the Year and McClear earning the conference's only unanimous first-team All-Big Ten honors following his medalist finish at the Big Ten Championships. McClear became Iowa's second Big Ten Champion under Stith's direction, while Schaake closed out his career as the most decorated player in program history. In five years under Coach Stith's tutelage, Schaake is the only Hawkeye to be voted Big Ten Player of the Year twice (2019, 2021), only athlete to earn all-conference postseason honors four times, and one of three Hawkeyes to win the Hawkeye Invitational multiple times. Schaake is also one of only two players to win the Nebraska Amateur Championship four consecutive years (2016-19).

In 2020, the Hawkeyes recorded three top-six finishes, including a third-place finish at the Notre Dame Fighting Irish Classic. Stith coached Schaake and Gonzalo Leal Montero to five top-25 finishes a piece with 71.6 and 71.9 18-hole stroke averages, respectively. Under Stith's direction, Jake Rowe fired in his career low 18-hole score (70) in the second round of the Puerto Rico Classic. The 2020 season was canceled by the Big Ten Conference and NCAA on March 12, due to concerns of coronavirus (COVID-19).

In his fifth season, Stith led Iowa to five top-five finishes, including the Hawkeye Invitational title with a school record shattering 54-hole score of 809 (-43), topping the previous mark by 24 strokes, while also setting a school record for 18-holes with a first round score of 262 (-22). Stith also helped coach Schaake to five top-10 finishes, earning Men's Big Ten Golfer of the Year and the Les Bolstad award for leading the Big Ten with a 70.81 stroke average, along with being named a unanimous All-Big Ten First Team honoree. Benton Weinberg was named a second-team All-Big Ten selection.

In his fourth season, Stith directed Iowa to three top-three finishes, including a third-place finish at the Big Ten Championships. Stith also helped mentor Schaake to six top-20 finishes, including placing in the top-five four times, and an individual berth at NCAA Regionals.

Stith captured his first tournament title as head coach of the Hawkeyes in the fall of his second year, guiding Iowa to a team title at the GolfWeek Conference Challenge. Raymond Knoll claimed co-medalist honors with a 54-hole total of 205 (-11; 66, 67, 72) — the lowest three-round total in program history. In his first season as head coach at Iowa, Stith guided the Hawkeyes to their seventh straight NCAA Regional. Iowa finished sixth at the event, one stroke behind eventual national champion LSU. Sophomore Carson Schaake led the Hawkeyes to a second-place finish at the 2015 Big Ten Championships after earning co-medalist honors and becoming the first Hawkeye to win the event since Brad Klapprott in 1992. Schaake and fellow sophomore Raymond Knoll earned All-Big Ten honors in addition to garnering PING All-Region honors.

Sixth Season

Alma Mater: Lander University



Charlie Hoyle enters his sixth season as University of Iowa assistant men's golf coach. Hoyle helps lead a Hawkeye program that has finished fifth or better at eight of the last ten Big Ten Championships and appeared in 11 of the last 14 NCAA Regionals (ranks third among conference programs).

Hoyle is part of a staff under head coach Tyler Stith that has led Iowa to the top four of the Big Ten Championships five times, advanced to five NCAA Regionals, and totaled three or more top-three tournament finishes in six of nine seasons. Three of Iowa's five Big Ten medalist performances have been won with Coach Stith at the helm.

This past season, Hoyle helped lead the Hawkeyes to two team championships at the Iowa Fall Classic and the Hawkeye Invitational. Senior Mac McClear was medalist in each of those outings, as well as at the Big Ten Championships, becoming Iowa's first two-time Big Ten Champion as well as the winningest Hawkeye since 1976 with five collegiate victories. The Hawkeyes tied for fifth as a team at the Big Ten Championships, which were cut short to just 36 holes due to weather concerns during the third round.

Iowa won its 17th team championship at the Hawkeye Invitational in the event's 29-season history. Other notable outings included a tie for fourth place at the Wake Forest Invitational, where McClear tied for second and senior Ronan Kleu tied for ninth in a loaded field of competition at Pinehurst No. 2. The Hawkeyes also hosted the Calusa Cup, one of the premier events of the 2022 regular season; Iowa welcomed eight ranked programs, including four of the Golfstat top-five ranked teams, to Calusa Pines Golf Club.

McClear advanced as an individual to the NCAA Regional competition in Las Vegas. He earned All-Big Ten Second Team recognition, the third conference postseason honor of his historic Hawkeye career. In the classroom, Iowa was recognized for posting the top Spring and Fall team GPA of 2022 among Hawkeye men's athletics programs.

In 2022, Hoyle helped coach Iowa to three top-six finishes as well as a number of individual accomplishments. Hawkeyes Mac McClear and Ronan Kleu each earned second team All-Big Ten recognition, as well as bids to compete individually at NCAA Regionals in Norman, Oklahoma. Those two were among four Iowa golfers to combine for nine top-10 finishes on the season, including a strong showing at the Hawkeye Invitational where junior Garrett Tighe and McClear finished second and fifth, respectively. The Hawkeyes placed third at Big Ten Match Play, where they defeated Minnesota (4-1), two-seed Northwestern (3-2), and top-seeded Purdue (tie-breaker) with one loss against Michigan State (4-1). Iowa finished seventh at the Big Ten Championships as a team, where four Hawkeyes placed inside the top 27 on the leaderboard.

In 2021, Hoyle helped lead Iowa to five top-five finishes, including two tournament wins at the Spartan Collegiate

at Sea Island and the Hawkeye Invitational. Iowa's victories marked the first time since the 2014 season, that the program won multiple team titles. Fifth-year senior Alex Schaake and sophomore Mac McClear also combined for three individual championships, the most for the Hawkeyes since the 2013 season. Iowa finished runners-up at both the Big Ten Match Play and the Big Ten Championships, and the qualified for NCAA Regionals. Hoyle helped mentor McClear to a Big Ten Championship and unanimous first-team All-Big Ten honors, as well as helping Schaake earn Big Ten Co-Player of the Year accolades for the second time in Hoyle's tenure.

In his second season, Hoyle helped direct the Hawkeyes to three top-six finishes, including a third-place finish at the Notre Dame Fighting Irish Classic. Hoyle helped coach Schaake and Gonzalo Leal Montero to five top-25 finishes a piece with 71.6 and 71.9 18-hole stroke averages, respectively. With help from Hoyle, Jake Rowe recorded his career low 18-hole score (70) in the second round of the Puerto Rico Classic. The 2020 season was canceled by Big Ten Conference and NCAA on March 12, due to concerns of coronavirus (COVID-19).

In his first year, Hoyle helped coach Iowa to a national ranking, another NCAA Regionals appearance and five top-five finishes, including the Hawkeye Invitational title with a school shattering record 54-hole score of 809 (-43), topping the previous mark by 24 strokes. Hoyle helped coach Schaake to five top-10 finishes, earning Men's Big Ten Golfer of the Year and the Les Bolstad award for leading the Big Ten with a 70.81 stroke average, along with being named a unanimous All-Big Ten First Team honoree. Benton Weinberg was named a second-team All-Big Ten selection. Hoyle was also instrumental in Leal Montero's success, walking with the Hawkeye rookie providing guidance during his rounds throughout the season.

His coaching career began in August of 2011, after being hired as Lander's men's and women's assistant golf coach. While assisting the men's team, he helped lead the Bearcats to two team wins and recruited and coached six men's all-conference players, three NCAA PING All-Regional players, two conference freshman of the year, and two NCAA All-Americans.

As the women's assistant, Hoyle recruited and coached seven women's all-conference players, two NCAA PING All-Regional players, two conference freshman of the year, and one NCAA All-American. Hoyle also helped guide the women's team to an impressive nine team wins.

A native of Lancashire, England, Hoyle played at Lander University in South Carolina from 2006-2010, where he recorded three second-place individual finishes and seven team victories. Hoyle was a two-time NCAA PING All-Region selection and a two-time All-Peach Belt selection, while being voted Lander's Most Valuable Player by his teammates in 2009.

After graduating in 2011 with a bachelor's degree in physical education/exercise studies, he competed professionally, winning 10 events across various mini-tours in the U.S, while also competing in the PGA Tour's Q-School. Hoyle's playing career stretched to Europe on the PGA Europro Tour and other mini-tours.




