In the night cap, lowa rebounded after losing the doubles point to win five of the six singles matches en route to a 5-2 victory.

STREAKIN'

Iowa's doubles duo of Pia Kranholdt and Barbora Pokorna have won three straight doubles matches to run their doubles record to 6-1 this season. It is the duo's second three-match winning streak on the year.

FRESHMAN FEVER

Freshman Chelsea Bluestein flourished in her HTRC debut, winning all three of her matches. She went undefeated in singles, picking up two straight set singles victories and partnered with Vipasha Mehra to win one doubles match.

DAI: NATIONALLY RANKED

 After winning five matches during the fall season, sophomore Daianne Hayashida earned a spot in ITA's singles rankings. The Peru native climbed in the rankings, moving from No. 109 to 85th in the first rankings of the spring season.

· Hayashida opened the spring as lowa's No. 1 singles player, where she has a teambest 5-2 singles record.

• During the fall, Hayashida advanced to the quarterfinals of the ITA Midwest Regionals and she competed in the main draw of the ITA Women's All-American Championships in September. She was the first Hawkeye to advance to the regional quarterfinals since Elise van Heuvelen in 2019.

• Iowa finished the regular season tied for fifth place in the Big Ten standings, marking the second time in three seasons that the program has placed fifth or better.

• The Cyclones have dropped three straight matches after starting the season with consecutive wins. Iowa State is 2-3 overall, which includes a ranked loss against No. 12 UCLA.

 Iowa State hosted two matches at the ITA Kickoff at the end of January, where it went 0-2, falling 4-0 to both Old Dominion and UCLA. The Cyclones also lost 6-1 at home to Old Dominion.

• The Hawkeyes have dominated the action in the all-time series, holding a 38-3 advantage.
