The No. 14 University of Iowa soccer team is set to host No. 24 Washington on Thursday at 7:30 p.m. (CT) at lowa Soccer Complex. lowa then hosts Oregon in their regular-season home finale. The game is set for a 1:00 p.m. kickoff at Iowa Soccer Complex.

SCOUTING THE HUSKIES

1 p.m.

- The Huskies sit at 8-4-2 on the season including a 5-3-0 record in the Big Ten conference. Washington is 2-3-0 in away games.
- Washington is in a tie for seventh place in the Big Ten regular season standings. They are tied with Michigan
- Washington is led by senior forward loanna Papatheodorou. Papatheodorou leads the team with seven goals and 16 points. Papatheodorou has just 19 shots on the season, scoring on seven of them (.368). The senior has four game winning goals on the year which ranks tied for fourth in the conference.
- Junior goalkeeper Mia Hamant has played in 11 of the Huskies 14 games. Hamant has allowed six goals on the season for a goals allowed average of .57. Hamant has 40 saves on the season and a save percentage of .870. Hamant's save percentage leads the conference (minimum 10 games played).
- Hamant has posted five shutouts on the season and a record of 7-3-1 when playing.
- Washington has outscored opponents 19-8 on the season. They are holding their opponents to nine shots
- lowa will be the fourth ranked opponent Washington faces this season. The Huskies are 1-2-0 against ranked opponents on the season. Washington defeated No. 5 Michigan State, 2-1, last week.

SERIES HISTORY - WASHINGTON

This is the first meeting between the two programs in school history.

SCOUTING THE DUCKS

- Oregon has a balanced offensive attack with no player have more than three goals or three assists. Haley McWhirter, Cameron Bourne, and Taylor Bryan all have three goals for the Ducks.
- Oregon is 5-8-2 on the season and 1-5-0 on the road. The Ducks are 1-5-2 in Big Ten conference play. Their lone Big Ten win came over Maryland in a 2-0 victory.
- lowa will be the fourth ranked opponent that Oregon has faced this season. Oregon is 0-2-1 against ranked opponents this year. The Ducks tied with No. 5 Michigan State, 0-0.







Dave Dilanni is in his 11th season as head coach for the University of Iowa women's soccer program. Dilanni was tabbed as the fifth coach in program history on May 17, 2014, coming to the UI following an 11-year head coaching stint at Grand Valley State.

Dilanni, a native of Ontario, Canada, has amassed a 330-93-43 career record. He guided Grand Valley State teams to three NCAA Division II national championships, nine-consecutive Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletics Conference (GLIAC) titles, seven Final Four appearances in eight seasons and 11-straight NCAA Tournament berths, while coaching 21 All-Americans.

Dilanni's .895 winning percentage was tops in NCAA Division II history. In his 11th season at Iowa, Dilanni has an 109-75-25 record. He has guided the program to three NCAA Tournament appearances and two Big Ten Tournament Championships.

In 2023, lowa finished 13-5-4, including a 6-0-1 non-conference start and a 3-4-3 record in conference play. The Hawkeyes earned the eighth and final seed to the Big Ten Tournament by a single point in the league standings before downing No. 12 Michigan State (2-1), No. 5 Penn State (1-0) and No. 12 Wisconsin (1-0) en route to their second trophy in four seasons. Iowa was the lowest seed in Big Ten history to win the conference tournament.

Following the Big Ten Tournament Title, lowa ascended to the highest major national rankings in program history, jumping to No. 14 in the College Soccer News ranking and No. 17 according to Top Drawer Soccer. Iowa finished the regular season at 30th in the RPI, earning an NCAA Tournament fifth-seed.

The Hawkeyes defeated Bucknell, 2-0, for the second NCAA Tournament victory in school history. The match was played before a program-record crowd of 2,639 at the lowa Soccer Complex.

The Hawkeye defense earned a program record 13 shutouts last season. Iowa outscored opponents 36-17 with stifling advantages in shots (307-164) and shots on goal (149-75). Defender Sam Cary ('23) and goalkeeper Macy Enneking were named first-team all-region, just the third and fourth Hawkeyes to earn that distinction.

- Goalkeeper Maddy Goldberg has played in 14 of 15 games for the Ducks. Goldberg has allowed 22 goals for a goals allowed average of 1.61. Goldberg has 62 saves for a save percentage of .738. Goldberg has posted four shutouts and is 5-8-1 on the season.
- Oregon is averaging 11.9 shots per game for 1.00 goal per game. Of their 178 shots on the season 74 have been on goal (.416).

SERIES HISTORY - OREGON

This is the first meeting between the two programs in school history.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

- Bush, Enneking and Greer were named Big Ten Players to Watch. The Hawkeyes were ranked eighth in the Big Ten Preseason Poll. Enneking is a United Soccer Coaches national preseason honoree and was named to the Mac Hermann Trophy Watch List
- **Millie Greer** (#39) and midfielder **Sofia Bush** (#87) were ranked top-100 freshmen at the end of the season by Top Drawer Soccer.
- Macy Enneking, Maggie Johnston and graduate-student Rielee Fetty were voted team captains.
- Macy Enneking, Reilee Fetty, and Sofia Bush were named mid season top 100 players by Top Drawer Soccer. Bush was No. 17, Enneking No. 59, and Fetty No. 68.
- The Hawkeyes are ranked No. 14 by the United Soccer Coaches Poll, No. 17 by Top Drawer Soccer, and currently are No. 7 on the NCAA RPI.

LAST WEEK

The Hawkeyes opened last week hosting Wisconsin at home where they dropped their first Big Ten game of the season, losing to Wisconsin 2-1. Iowa got on the board first with a penalty kick from graduate student Maggie Johnston, her second goal of the season. Wisconsin then converted on a penalty kick of their own to tie the game at 1-1 in the 73rd minute. Wisconsin then took the lead in the 76th minute that would go on to be the game winning goal. Iowa then hit the road and traveled to Piscataway, N.J. to take on No. 15 Rutgers who was yet to lose a Big Ten game. Iowa's Sophia Bush opened the scoring with a goal in the 34th minute to give Iowa a 1-0 advantage. Senior Meike Ingles then added to the Hawkeye lead in the 49th minute to push the Hawkeye lead to 2-0. The goal was assisted by Elle Otto.

DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS

- lowa held a six-game shutout earlier this season, which was a program record for consecutive shutouts.
- lowa has allowed just eight goals so far this season. The current record for least goals allowed in a season is 16 in 2020.
- lowa has posted 8 shutouts this season. The program record for most shutouts in a season is 12 set by Macy Enneking in 2023.

A KEEPER!

Macy Enneking has started all five years at lowa, anchoring the team to two NCAA Tournament appearances and a pair of conference tournament championships.

- Enneking is the first Hawkeye named to the Mac Hermann Trophy Watch List and the first lowa player featured on the United Soccer Coaches Players to Watch List.
- -Enneking has 29.5 career shutouts, passing former Hawkeye Hannah Clark (2012-15), to become the school's all-time leader in shutouts.
- Enneking needs one victories to tie the all-time school's record for career victories, currently being held by former Hawkeye Claire Graves (2016-19).
- Enneking became the first Hawkeye to win Big Ten Goalkeeper of the Week three times in a career and the first Hawkeye to win the award in back-to-back weeks.
- Enneking has 7.5 shutouts on the season which ranks tied for 4th in the single season record books. Enneking currently holds the number one spot on the record book for most shutouts in a season when she had 12 last season. Enneking needs 1.5 shutouts to move to 3rd in the single season records and 2.5 to move to second.
- Enneking's 11 victories this season also ranks tied for fourth in the single season record book. Hannah Clark also leads that with 15 victories in 2013.

A SPECIAL SEASON

- The Hawkeyes are in third place the Big Ten. The lowest Big Ten regular season finish in program history came in 2019 when the Hawkeyes finished third. The Hawkeyes have never won the Big Ten regular





season. The last time the Hawkeyes finished top four in the conference was 2021.

- The Hawkeyes No. 9 ranking last week was the highest ranking in program history.
- At 11-1-3 the Hawkeyes are off to the best start in program history. The Hawkeyes record for most victories in a season came in 2013 and 2019 when lowa won 15 games.

SINCE 2019, IOWA...

- Won both Big Ten Tournament Championships in program history (2021, 2023)
- Won each of two NCAA Tournament victories in program history
- Made three of four NCAA Tournament appearances in program history
- Has earned 10 postseason wins
- Has posted 49 shutouts
- Defeated ten ranked opponents, seven top-15 opponents and two top-five opponents
- Saw Coach Dilanni surpass 300 career wins and become the winningest coach in program history
- Set a new home attendance record (2,629); the overtime win over Bucknell was the first NCAA Tournament game hosted at the lowa Soccer Complex

SHARING THE WEALTH

- 11 Hawkeyes have scored goals in the 2024 season. Berit Parten (6), Maya Hansen (5), Meike Ingles (5), Sofia Bush (4), Berkely Binggeli (2), Maggie Johnston (2), Kenzie Roling, Lauren Geczik, Elle Otto, Rielee Fetty, and Millie Greer all have one goal this season. Of the 29 goals scored this season, 15 have come from newcomers.
- 11 different Hawkeyes have assists this season. Meike Ingles leads the team with four. Sofia Bush, Kenzie Roling, and Lauren Geczik all have three. Elle Otto and Rielee Fetty each have two while five other Hawkeyes have one.

FRESHMAN SENSATION

- Berit Parten was named a mid season top 100 freshman by Top Drawer Soccer. Parten was ranked No. 26 on the list. Parten leads lowa in goals (6), shots (39), and shots on goal (20).
- Parten was named Big Ten Freshman of the Week earlier this season. Parten was the 12th Hawkeye to be named Freshman of the Week and the first Hawkeye to win the award since **Kenzie Roling** in 2021.

2 FOR THE MONEY

lowa's record is 53-2-3 in its last 58 games when scoring two goals or more, which dates back to October of 2017. The Hawkeyes are 10-0 this year in multi-goal games.

90 TRACKER

Miah Schueller, Millie Greer, and Maggie Johnston played all 90 minutes vs. Wisconsin. Sofia Bush, Eva Pattison, Greer, Johnston all registered 90 minutes against No. 15 Rutgers.

The Hawkeyes travel to Minneapolis to take on Minnesota on Oct. 27th. The game is set for a 1:00 p.m. (CT) kick off and will be streamed on B1G+ (subscription required).
