- » The Huskies return three of their top five scorers from last season's squad in Brooke Stonebraker (Versailles, Ohio/Versailles), Sidney McCrea (Cedar Rapids, Iowa/Prairie) and Brooke Blumenfeld (Northbrook, III./Glenbrook North). Stonebraker was named to the Mid-American Conference's Preseason All-MAC Second Team.
- » NIU also returns guard Chelby Koker (Racine, Wis./Shoreland Lutheran) for her sixth year after missing the 2023-24 season due to injury. Koker has been an All-MAC selection three times in her career. In 2023 Koker was named to the All-MAC Second Team after averaging 15.4 points and 3.4 assists per game.

- » The Hawkeyes have won the last three matchups dating back to 2007.

- » Iowa women's basketball ranked second nationally in total attendance with a total of 238,620 fans in Carver-Hawkeye Arena a year ago.
- » lowa has been ranked in the national attendance top 10 each of the past five seasons with fans (2024, 2023, 2022, 2021, 2019).
- » By seasons end, the Hawkeyes will have tied or broken the Big Ten Conference single-season attendance average record in three straight seasons.

WELCOME TO THE SHOW

- Iowa welcomes six newcomers to the 2024-25 roster. Iowa has only had five or more new student-athletes on three occasions since 2010. (2011-12, 2012-13, and 2016-17)
- » Villanova transfer, Lucy Olsen was the NCAA's third leading scorer last season, and ESPN's No. 4 overall transfer available following the 2023-24 season.
- The Hawkeyes also brought in five players that make up the ninth-rated class by ESPN.com: No. 40 Ava Heiden, No. 58 Aaliyah Guyton, No. 64 Teagan Mallegni, No. 91 Taylor Stremlow, and Miss Iowa Basketball, Callie Levin.
- » For the first time in program history, UI had signed four ESPN top-100 prospects.

- Olsen was third in the country in scoring (23.3 ppg) last season behind Caitlin Clark and USC's JuJu Watkins. She scored over 20 points in 25 games last year, including surpassing 30 points in 10 of those games, with a career-high of 40 points against Temple.
- The Collegeville, Pennsylvania native was named an Honorable Mention All-American by the Associated Press. Olsen also highlighted the All-Big East by earning first team accolades and the Most Improved Player Award last season.

BIG TEN PRESEASON HOOPLA

- Lucy Olsen and Hannah Stuelke were named Preseason First Team All-Big Ten by the coaches and the media on Sept. 26, 2024.
- Stuelke returns to the Hawkeyes after a pair of successful campaigns. During her sophomore season, she earned Second Team All-Big Ten honors from the coaches and media. Stuelke averaged 14.0 ppg while shooting better than 62-percent from the field. As freshman, she earned Sixth Player of the Year honors.
- Despite a white hot finish to her junior season, captain Sydney Affolter was not apart of any preseason lists. Affolter earned spots on the Big Ten's All-Tournament Team and Albany 2 All-Regional squad in 2023-
- lowa, USC, and UCLA were the only programs with two student-athletes on the Preseason All-Big Ten Team.
- Iowa was the only squad with two players on the All-Big Ten Team but wasn't selected to finish in the top 5 of the conference.

DID YOU KNOW?

- Junior Hannah Stuelke became the fifth Hawkeve since 2009 to have 650+ points and 350+ rebounds by the end of their sophomore seasons. (Ally Disterhoff, Caitlin Clark, Megan Gustafson, and Jamie Printy)
- Stuelke put together one of the most prolific performances in Iowa WBB history against PSU on Feb. 8, 2024. She set the Carver-Hawkeye Arena record for points (47), field goals (17), field goal attempts (20), and free throw attempts (21). The next week, Caitlin Clark broke her arena record with 49 points against Michigan on Feb. 15, 2024.
- Junior Taylor McCabe became the second Hawkeye since 2009 to shoot better than 40% from 3-point range and make a minimum of 20. (McK-
- Iowa is the fourth team in conference history to win three straight Big Ten Tournament titles. (Maryland, Ohio State and Purdue)

SHARING THE ROCK

- lowa is the only team in the country to average 19.5+ assists per game in seven consecutive seasons.
- The Hawkeyes have averaged 20+ assists per game in every year dating back to 2017 besides the 2021-22 season. (19.6)
- In three of the last 4 seasons, Iowa has had the single season leader in assists nationally.
- Dating back to 2012, UI has had eight Big Ten assist champions. (3x -Sam Logic, 1x - Kathleen Doyle, 4x - Caitlin Clark)
- Assist per game totals by season; 2017-18: 21.4, 2018-19: 21.5, 2019-20: 20.0, 2020-21: 20.1, 2021-22: 19.6, 2022-23: 20.9, and 2023-24: 20.8.



- Of the original Big Ten members, Iowa is first in the conference with five WNBA Draft picks since 2019.
- The Hawkeyes also leads the Big Ten's original members with 19 selections in the draft since its inception 1997.
- The 2024 WNBA Draft was the first draft since 1998 lowa has multiple studentathletes taken.
- Former Hawkeye guard, Caitlin Clark was the first rookie since 2008 to be named to the All-WNBA First Team.

AP NUGGETS

- » Iowa has 333 appearances in the AP Poll.
- » Since 2000, Iowa has won 18 games against AP Top 10 teams.
- » Iowa is 37-71 all-time against AP Top 10 teams.
- » Iowa is 103-157 all-time against AP Top 25 teams.
- » Iowa is 13-9 against AP Top 10 teams since 2020.
- » Jan Jensen has either coached or played for a team featured in 152 AP Poll appearances. 150 at Iowa and two at Drake.

NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK

- » Ava Heiden is the program's first Oregonian and was the No. 5 post prospect in ESPN's position rankings.
- » Heiden is the highest ranked post Jan Jensen has ever coached.
- » Aaliyah Guyton comes from a fantastic pedigree, her father played basketball for Indiana and the Chicago Bulls. Her mother played for the Phoenix Mercury and th Brazilian National Team.
- » Guyton was a four star prospect and was the No. 1 rated player in Illinois.
- » Teagan Mallegni and Taylor Stremlow both hail from the state of Wisconsin.
- » Mallegni's parents both played sports at Division III power-house UW-Whitewater.
- » Callie Levin was the 2024 Gazette, USA Today, SB Live, and Sports Illustrated Iowa Basketball Player of the Year.

WELL, WHERE DID THEY END UP?

- » Caitlin Clark was selected by the Indiana Fever with the first overall pick in the WNBA Draft. Clark is the first Hawkeye ever to be selected as the overall top pick
- » Kate Martin was selected by the Las Vegas Aces in the Second Round with the 18th pick of the WNBA Draft. She was the fifth Hawkeye to be drafted into the WNBA since 2019, following Kathleen Doyle, Megan Gustafson, Monika Czinano, and Clark.
- » 19 Hawkeyes have been drafted or signed in the WNBA since the league originated in 1997.
- » Gabbie Marshall was accepted in Occupational Therapy school at North Carolina in Chapel Hill.
- » Sharon Goodman, a two-time winner of the Elite 90 Award (4.0 GPA) at the Final Four will finish classes this spring and forego her final season of eligibility.
- Molly Davis was injured in Iowa's Senior Day win over Ohio State and was not able to compete the rest of the season. She is a graduate assistant for the women's basketball program at Evansville.
- » Graduate Assistant, Will McIntire landed a job within the conference at Rutgers. The Iowa City native, was named the Director of Scouting and Technology this summer.

AUDIO COVERAGE

- » Rob Brooks and Kathryn Reynolds call the action on the Hawkeye Radio Network.
- » Brooks is in his ninth year as the play-by-play announcer for the Iowa women's basketball team. He has been Iowa football's sideline reporter since 2004. Brooks has called seven different Iowa sports on radio or television.
- Reynolds was a member of the University of Iowa's Women's Basketball coaching staff for six seasons, serving as the director of basketball operations from 2017-19 before being promoted to the role of director of player development from 2019-23.
- » In that time with Reynolds, the team won two Big Ten Conference Championships, had two Elite 8 berths, and one National Championship appearance.



Jensen, who helped guide Iowa to 22 postseason appearances, including 18 NCAA Tournaments, will enter her 25th year as a Hawkeye coach in 2024-25. Jensen was instrumental in mentoring the Hawkeyes to five Big Ten Tournament titles, including three straight, and sharing two regular season conference championships. Jensen and the Hawkeyes advanced to back-to-back National Championships (2023, 2024), and made the Elite Eight three times (2019, 2023, 2024) and the Sweet 16 five times (2015, 2019, 2023, 2024).

She began her coaching career at her alma mater in 1993 as an assistant to Coach Bluder, winning four MVC Tournament and three regular season championships (1997, 1998, 2000) on the Drake coaching staff.

Jensen quickly gained attention for her recruiting prowess and development of post players. Jensen and the Hawkeye recruiting classes consistently rank among the nation's elite. Since arriving in Iowa City, she has been integral in attracting top recruits to the University of Iowa, including McDonald's All-Americans (Samantha Logic, Lindsay Richards, Johanna Solverson and Caitlin Clark) and developing and maintaining consensus All-Americans Samantha Logic, Megan Gustafson, Kathleen Doyle and Caitlin Clark. Gustafson (2019) and Clark (2023, 2024) were ultimately voted the Naismith Player of the Year.

Coach Jensen is a native of Kimballton, Iowa, and played her college ball under Coach Bluder at Drake University, earning a bachelor's degree in public relations in 1991, followed by a master's degree in higher education in 1996. As a senior, she led the nation in scoring and was the Gateway Conference Most Valuable Player, a Kodak Honorable Mention All-American, a member of the All-Gateway team, and the GTE Academic All-American Player of the Year. She currently ranks fourth on Drake's all-time scoring list, sixth in field goal percentage and eighth in rebounds, and is one of only two Drake players to have her number retired in the Knapp Center. After college, Coach Jensen played professionally in the European Professional Basketball League for BTV-Wuppertal in Germany, winning the German Cup.

Off the court, Coach Jensen has been involved in the United Way of Johnson County and was recognized as the United Way of Johnson County Volunteer of the Year. She was also a recipient of the Corridor Business Journal Forty Under 40 Award and was named a recipient of the `Women of Influence' Award by the Corridor Business Journal.

"I have been so blessed to have enjoyed an incredible ride with Lisa. That ride started when I was her player and continued for 33 years as I had the privilege to work along-side of her. I can't thank Lisa enough for her mentorship, leadership, and most of all her friendship. I am so proud of all we accomplished and grateful for all the memories we created," Jensen said.
