BIG TEN AWAITS

The Iowa Hawkeyes travel to Madison, WI, Wednesday to open the Big Ten season at the Wisconsin Badgers. The match starts at 7 p.m. in the Wisconsin Field House. Iowa continues Big Ten play Saturday at Minnesota when the Golden Gophers host the Hawkeyes at 7 p.m. from the Sports Pavilion in Minneapolis, MN.

Head Coach Sharon Dingman: *"Starting the conference schedule with four straight road games is a very challenging way to open the Big Ten season. However, of our 12 matches thus far, nine have been on the road. We should have an understanding of how to manage the travel and prepare for competition."*

ON THE BIG TEN NETWORK

The Iowa vs. Wisconsin Big Ten opener will be broadcast live on the Big Ten Network at 7 p.m. Jay Wilson will handle the play-by-play while Elizabeth Moreau adds color commentary.

HISTORICAL HAWKEYES

The Hawkeyes opened the 2009 campaign with seven straight road wins to become the first team in program history to start 7-0 away from home. Prior to Iowa's 3-0 over Binghamton, the Hawkeyes were one of three Iowa teams to start the season 6-0 away from home (1978, 1988).

HAWKEYES DIG DEFENSE

Led by senior libero **Christina Meister**, the Hawkeyes rank first in the Big Ten and 15th nationally in digs per set (17.36). Meister was named Big Ten Defensive Player of the Week after her performance at the Green Bay Classic (Sept. 4-5). Meister tied a school-record with 36 digs vs. Central Michigan to become the first Hawkeye to earn a Big Ten weekly honor since 2006 when her sister, Melanie Meister, took home the award on offense. Meister leads the Big Ten with an average of 4.81 digs per set.

IOWA IN THE ATTENDANCE GAME

Iowa ranks 25th in national attendance after averaging 1,275 fans at the 2009 Hawkeye Challenge. Iowa opened the season (Sept. 11) vs. Iowa State in front of 2,111 fans, the second-largest crowd in program history (2,191, Wisconsin, 10/13/07).

HAWKEYE SCHEDULE

Iowa opens Big Ten play with four-straight road contests. It's the first time since 1992 the Hawkeyes have opened the conference season with four road matches. Eleven of Iowa's 32 contests are against 2008 NCAA Tournament qualifiers. They include Iowa State, Minnesota (2), Penn State (2), Michigan (2), Purdue (2) and Illinois (2).

HAWKEYE CAPTAINS

Senior outside hitter Megan Schipper and junior setter Mara Hilgenberg are Iowa's team captains for the 2009 season. Schipper leads the Hawkeyes in kills (151) and service aces (18) and ranks second in digs (141). Hilgenberg leads the Hawkeyes with 427 assists and is a third generation Hawkeye captain. Her great-uncle Wally and her uncle Jim were football team captains in 1963 and 1977, respectively.

SECOND GENERATION

Mara Hilgenberg's father Jay and **Emma Krieger Kittle**'s father Bruce played football together at Iowa from 1977-1980. Jay was a four-time letterwinner and went on to win Super Bowl XX with the 1985 Chicago Bears. Bruce used a redshirt in 1980 and came back as a team captain for Hayden Fry's 1981 Big Ten Championship team.

WISCONSIN

The Badgers are led by 11th-year Head Coach Pete Waite and senior OH Brittney Dolgner, a 2007 second-team all-American. The Hawkeyes trail the all-time series 40-18-1. The teams split the season series a year ago, with each team defending its own home floor. Iowa's 3-0 win over the Badgers in the Big Ten opener snapped the Hawkeyes' 26-match losing streak to Wisconsin.

MINNESOTA

Ranked ninth nationally by the AVCA Coaches Poll, the Golden Gophers are led by 14-year Head Coach Mike Hebert and junior MB Lauren Gibbemeyer, who earned all-tournament honors at last weekend's Pioneer Classic and leads Minnesota with 65 total blocks. The Gophers own a 27-game winning streak vs. Iowa and lead the all-time series, 53-12. Iowa's last win vs. Minnesota came in 1995, a 3-1 win in Iowa City. The Hawkeyes have not won in Minneapolis since defeating the Gophers, 3-2, in 1990.



Head Coach Sharon Dingman



Sharon Dingman was hired as the eighth coach in Iowa volleyball history March 21, 2008.

The second-year head Hawkeye owns a career record of 358-234 (18 years) after leading Iowa to its most successful campaign in eight seasons in 2008. The Hawkeyes' 14 overall victories and six conference wins were the most by an Iowa Volleyball team since 2000.

Dingman also reached a personal milestone in her inaugural Hawkeye season, recording career victory No. 350 November 14 in a five-set victory over Northwestern.

Iowa re-established a home-court advantage in Dingman's first season, posting its first winning season at North Carver since 1998 and setting a program attendance record.

Dingman came to Iowa after serving as head coach at Illinois State from 2000-07, where she compiled a 147-98 record. In 2007, Dingman led the Redbirds to their first at-large berth into the NCAA Tournament since 1997. Illinois State reached the championship match of the Missouri Valley Conference Tournament and finished with a 21-12 overall record.

Illinois State produced winning seasons in seven of the eight seasons under Dingman and never finished lower than fifth in the Missouri Valley Conference. Dingman produced 21 all-Missouri Valley Conference selections, including Player of the Year, Libero of the Year and two Freshman of the Year honorees.

Redbird teams under Dingman were also strong in the classroom. Eleven players were named to the league's scholar-athlete squad in her eight seasons. In 2004, four volleyball student-athletes earned perfect 4.00 grade-point-averages and the team recorded a 3.32 GPA.

Dingman started her head coaching career in 1991 at Auburn, where she led the Tigers to a 22-13 record in her only season at the helm. Her 1991 squad became the first Auburn volleyball team to receive votes in the national poll and Auburn's fourth place finish in the SEC that season marked the highest finish ever for Auburn at the time.

She then moved to Butler in 1992, where she served as head coach for eight seasons. Dingman led the Bulldogs to four 20 win seasons and three postseason tournaments, including an appearance in the NCAA Tournament in 1997 after capturing the Midwestern Collegiate Conference title. She was named MCC Coach of the Year in 1997 after compiling a 28-7 record.

Prior to becoming a head coach, Dingman spent seven seasons as an assistant coach at three Division I programs. After one season at Northern Michigan (1984), she assisted at Texas Tech for three seasons (1985-87). Dingman then spent three seasons at Kentucky (1988-90) and helped the Wildcats to an SEC Championship in 1988 along with three-straight regional finals appearances in the NCAA Tournament.

AMONG THE NATION'S BEST

The Big Ten is widely recognized as one of the nation's premier conferences. Penn State returns as the conference champion, winner of the last two NCAA Championships and ranked atop the 2009 AVCA Coaches Poll. Other Big Ten schools ranked in the top 25 include Michigan (8), Minnesota (9), Illinois (15) and Michigan State (16).

- The Big Ten led the nation in attendance in 2008 and has been the national leader on six occasions in the last 12 years, including three of the past five seasons.
- The Big Ten has sent three or more teams to NCAA regionals on 14 occasions, including each of the past seven years.
- Big Ten volleyball players have been named all-America by the AVCA over 100 times since 1984.
- The Big Ten accumulated 10 or more wins in each of the last six NCAA Championships.
- Big Ten teams have combined to reach the NCAA semifinals on 15 occasions.
- The Big Ten owns a .616 overall record in NCAA competition and has posted a record of .500 or better in each of the past 18 NCAA tournaments.

BIG IN '08

Iowa volleyball made significant strides and put together the most successful campaign in recent memory in 2008, including:

- six conference wins, most since 2000 (11)
- 14 overall wins, most since 2000 (15)
- seven-match win streak (fourth-longest streak in school history)
- won 15-consecutive sets, longest since 1990 (22)
- winning record at North Carver (7-6), first time since '98
- set school-record for average attendance (1,146)
- recorded five of the ten largest crowds in program history
- Dingman recorded career win No. 350 vs. N'western (11/14)
- snapped 18-match conference road losing streak
- snapped 39-match losing streak to Ohio State (3-1)
- snapped 26-match losing streak to Wisconsin (3-0)

IOWA ON THE BTN

The 2009 Hawkeyes will make two appearances on the Big Ten Network this season. Iowa will open the Big Ten season at Wisconsin Wednesday, Sept. 23. The contest will be aired live at 7 p.m. CT. The rematch between the Hawkeyes and Badgers, Wednesday, Nov. 11, will be broadcast live from Carver-Hawkeye Arena at 7 p.m. CT. Both matches will be broadcast in high-definition.

2009 Coaching Staff

Sharon Dingman is in her second season as the head Hawkeye. She is joined by second-year assistant **Jason Allen** and newcomers **Ben Boldt** and **Curt Sivertsen**.

Allen is in his second season as a assistant coach at Iowa. Allen was also promoted to the team's recruiting coordinator following the 2008 season. Allen previously served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Sam Houston State University prior to serving as the 16U head coach for the Texas Tornados club program in 2007.

Boldt is in his first season as an assistant coach at Iowa. Boldt spent the last two seasons as an assistant coach at the University of Alabama. Prior to joining Alabama, Boldt served as a staff assistant for five seasons at the University of Nebraska. In his final season, the Cornhuskers finished 33-1 en route to the 2006 NCAA Championship.

Sivertsen is in his first season at Iowa after having served the last two years as head coach of the men's and women's programs at Missouri Valley College.

Angie Boldt is in her second season as the Director of Volleyball Operations. She came to Iowa City in 2008 after serving as the Director of Volleyball Operations at Alabama for two seasons.
