NFCA Tournament Notes

- lowa is 1-0 all-time vs. eighth-ranked Alabama. The Hawkeyes won the only meeting in the series, 4-3, in 1999 at the USF Speedline Invitational in Tampa, FL.
- lowa is 1-0 all-time vs. Maryland. The Hawkeyes won the only meeting in the series, 3--0, in 1999 at the USF Speedline Invitational in Tampa, FL.
- Iowa is 1-3 all-time vs. Arkansas. The Hawkeyes fell to the Razorbacks, 2-1, at the Metrodome Tournament in the 2010 season opener.
- Saturday's 3 p.m. contest vs. N.C. State will be the first softball meeting between the two schools.
- Iowa is 0-2 all-time vs. 11th-ranked Georgia Tech. The Yellow Jackets won the latest meeting, 6-0, in 2007. The Hawkeyes played at Georgia Tech in the 2009 NCAA Regionals but the two teams did not meet.

Carmo, Carmo, Carmo, Carmo, Carmody

Junior Chelsey Carmody hit 7-for-14 with two homeruns and seven RBI at last week's Littlewood Classic. The Missouri native had just two career homeruns entering 2010 but has blasted four long-balls through the first nine games of the season. Her 13 hits are tied for the fourth most in the Big Ten and her 27 total bases are the second-highest total in the conference.

Lindsey at the Bat

Senior Lindsey Digmann has hit safely in seven of Iowa's nine games this season. The Marion, IA native leads Iowa in runs scored (7) and is tied for the team lead with 13 hits, the fourth highest total in the Big Ten. She also leads the Hawkeyes with four stolen bases in four attempts.

lowa's eight position players have started every game at their respective positions this season. Around the horn, lowa's iron-women include Liz Watkins (C), Katie Brown (1b), Chelsey Carmody (2b), Katie Keim (SS), Lindsey Digmann (3b), Jenny Schuelke (LF), Johnnie Dowling (CF) and Taylor Leichsenring (RF).

Head Coach Gayle Blevins



Gayle Blevins is in her 23rd season as the head coach of the lowa softball program and she has established herself as one of the nation's premier coaches.

In 1999, Blevins was the 17th inductee into the NFCA Hall of Fame. She was also inducted into the Indi-

ana University Hall of Fame in 2005.

In her 23 seasons at lowa, Blevins has guided the Hawkeyes to four College World Series berths, 16 NCAA Tournament appearances and four Big Ten Championships. She is lowa's all-time winningest coach with a record of 926-420-3 (.688)

Blevins is the second-winningest coach in Division I softball with a career record of 1226-568-5 (.683). She has been named the National Coach of the Year twice (1986 and 1991) and the Big Ten Conference Coach of the Year three times (1989, 1997 and 2000).

Rookie Start, Veteran Effort

After dropping the season-opener for the first time in five seasons, freshman Chelsea Lyon pitched lowa to its first 'W' of 2010 with a veteran performance.

In her collegiate debut, Lyon allowed just five hits in six-plus innings while collecting the win in the Hawkeyes' 2-1 victory over Western Illinois.

Opponents in the Polls

Seven lowa opponents are ranked in both the *USA Today*/NFCA Top 25 and ESPN.com/USA Softball Top 25 preseason polls.

Michigan (4/4), UCLA (5/3), Arizona State (7/10), Alabama (9/7), Georgia Tech (11/8), Ohio State (17/16) and Northwestern (23/22) are all ranked.

Three-for-Four

The Hawkeyes return three of their top four hitters from a 2009. Senior Katie Brown, junior Chelsey Carmody and sophomore Liz Watkins hit .337 collectively in 168 combined games.

Road Warriors

lowa is scheduled to play its first 26 games away from lowa City. The Hawkeyes open the home portion of their schedule with a doubleheader against South Dakota Mar. 20 at Pearl Field.

The Hawkeyes ran up an impressive 31-13 record outside of lowa City last season, including a 13-9 mark in true road contests and an 18-4 record in neutral site games.

Shuffling the Deck

The Hawkeyes have shifted around the diamond since 2009. Lindsey Digmann has moved from left field to third base. Katie Keim has rotated around the diamond, moving from third base to shortstop, while Katie Brown saw action on the mound and at first base during the Hawkeyes' opening weekend.

Now Batting for Iowa

The Hawkeyes welcome eight newcomers to the 2010 roster. Juniors Stephanie Ochoa and Sarah Spiering hit campus after two celebrated careers at the Junior College level.

The Hawkeyes have six freshmen on this year's roster, including lowa natives Ashley Akers, Johnnie Dowling, Sam Valentine and Ashley Vanderloo. Oklahoma native Chelsea Lyon and Oregon native Jordan Goschie round out the freshmen class.

Metrodome All-Tournament Honors

Juniors Chelsey Carmody and Jenny Schuelke were named to the all-tournament team at last weekend's Metrodome Tournament. Carmody batted .400 with a homerun and a pair of RBI while Schuelke hit .385 and belted the game-winning homerun in lowa's 2-1 victory over Western Illinois.

Returning Award Winners

Sophomore Liz Watkins was given three awards at the 2009 softball banquet; Most Improved, Coaches and Peg Augspurger Hawkeye Heart award.

Sophomore Katie Keim shared the Most Improved award with Watkins. Seniors Katie Brown and Amanda Zust shared the team's Golden Glove award.


