The Illinois Fighting Illini are 29-23 overall and 7-7 in Big Ten play. The Fighting Illini host Bradley Thursday before traveling to Iowa Citv.

Illinois brings a powerful offense to Pearl Field. The Fighting Illini lead the nation in team home runs with 82 long balls in 52 games played. They also lead the nation in home runs per game with 1.58.

Both Angelena Mexicano and Shanna Diller have 16 home runs to lead the Illini offense. Lana Armstrong is batting .372 with 14 home runs and Makenzie Smith has 10 home runs

Vicky Brown is 16-9 with a 3.59 earned run average and has a team best 97 strikeouts. Ashley Wright is 10-11 with a 3.77 earned run average.

lowa leads the all-time series, 9-6.

CLEANING UP THE BIG TEN STANDINGS

lowa can wrap up the No. 4 seed in next week's Big Ten Tournament with one win over Illinois this weekend. If lowa were to lose both games against Illinois, they could finish anywhere from fifth to seventh, depending on other results across the Big Ten.

Ohio State can claim the regular season title with two wins over Penn State. Northwestern finished conference play last weekend and could take the regular season championship if Ohio State loses one game to the Nittany Lions.

SUMMER-TIME IN EVANSTON

Junior **Summer Downs** batted .600 (3-5) in the two-game series at Northwestern. She also had two putouts, five assists and did not commit an error in 13 innings played at third base.

LEADERS IN CONFERENCE PLAY

Four Hawkeyes are batting above .300 in Big Ten play.

Junior **Summer Downs** is batting .383 (18-47) and leads the team with five doubles. She also has three home runs and 13 RBI.

Sophomore **Erin Riemersma** is batting .360 (18-50) and has a team-best 14 runs scored. Riemersma has three home runs, seven doubles and seven RBI.

Junior **Emily Nichols** has a .327 (17-52) batting average and has belted a team-high four home runs and 16 RBI.

Sophomore **Colleen McGlaughlin** is batting .319 (15-47) with three doubles.

HEIDGERKEN HEATING UP


Senior **Mindy Heidgerken** combined for one home run, three hits and three RBI in game two against Northwestern and last Sunday's game against Western Illinois.

WEIL NAMED BIG TEN PITCHER OF THE WEEK

Sophomore pitcher **Brittany Weil** was named Big Ten Pitcher of the Week for her efforts during lowa's five-game road trip March 28-April 1. This was the first time Weil earned the award.

Weil picked up five wins with a 0.78 ERA in 27 innings. She collected 27 strikeouts and helped lowa to a 4-0 record in the opening weekend of Big Ten play.

HITTING STREAK SNAPPED

Junior **Emily Nichols**' school and Big Ten record hitting streak was snapped at the Capital Classic March 16. Nichols failed to collect a hit against Mercer, ending her streak at 28 games.

NICHOLS BREAKS HOME RUN MARK

Junior **Emily Nichols** broke Iowa's career home run record with a two-run home run against Indiana on March 31. Nichols' home run cleared the center field fence and gave Iowa a 9-0, six-inning win over the Hoosiers.

Nichols passed former Hawkeye Alicia Gerlach, who hit 29 career home runs from 1999-02. Nichols currently has 32 career home runs.

Ackerson No-Hits Howard in Season Opener

Junior **Stephanie Ackerson** took full advantage of her first career start in the circle, tossing a five-inning no-hitter in Iowa's season opener against Howard. The Clive, IA, native allowed only four Howard baser-unners and struck out five.

Prior to the start against Howard, Ackerson had only thrown 11 innings in relief.

THE HEAD HAWKEYE... Gayle Blevins is in her 20th season as the head coach of the lowa softball program and she has established herself as one of the nation's top coaches. In 1999, Blevins was the 17th inductee into the NFCA Hall of Fame and was also inducted into the Indiana University Hall of Fame in 2005. In her 19 seasons at lowa, Blevins has guided the Hawkeyes to 14 NCAA Tournament appearances and four Big Ten Championships. She is lowa's all-time winningest coach with a record of 835-380-3 (.687).

Her career record in 26 years of coaching is 1,135-528-5 (.682). Blevins has been named the National Coach of the Year twice (1986 and 1991) and the Big Ten Conference Coach of the Year three times (1989, 1997 and 2000).
