The Hawkeyes travel to Bloomington, IN to take on the Indiana Hoosiers in a four-game series.

HAWKEYES THIS WEEKEND • The Hawkeyes will travel to Sembower Field to take on Indiana in hopes of winning their first Big Ten series. Iowa is only two games behind a five-way tie for third place in the Big Ten, and a good weekend at Bloomington with a home series against Northwestern coming up could move them up in the conference rankings.

The Hoosiers are 3-5 in the Big Ten after going 1-3 against Illinois this past weekend.

Iowa leads the all-time series between the schools, 71-51.

SCOUTING INDIANA:

The Hawkeyes will take on Indiana this weekend in Bloomington, IN.

The Hoosiers are 3-5 in the Big Ten after going 1-3 against Illinois last weekend.

The Hoosiers are led by Josh Phegley, who is hitting a Big Ten-best and 17th nationally, .436 on the year. He has 10 doubles, 26 RBI and a .660 slugging percentage.

The doubleheader on Saturday will be broadcasted on the Big Ten Network (HD).

Iowa leads the all-time series between the schools, 71-51.

TEAM COMPARISONS:

The Hawkeyes lead the Hoosiers in hit-by-pitches, 42 to 34.

Iowa is slightly more patient at the plate, walking 95 times to Indiana's 90.

The Hoosiers lead the Hawkeyes in doubles, 52 to 45.

The two ball clubs are similar in RBI, Indiana has the advantage 152 to 137 on the year.

Iowa is more aggressive on the base path with 66 stolen bases to Indiana's 41.

Overall, the Indiana lineup is more consistent with a .325 batting average to the Black and Gold's .285.

Pitching, the two teams are similar. In earned run average, Indiana has the advantage with a 5.34 to Iowa's 5.73.

Iowa's defense is a bit more rock solid, the Hawkeyes have committed 36 errors on the year to Indiana's 56.

IOWA OFFENSE IS STREAKING:

Caleb Curry is currently on a seven-game hitting streak, which is a new season high for Curry. **Kyle Riffel** and **Justin Brauer** also have been swinging the bat well, having gone the last five games with a hit.

Justin Toole leads the team in multi-RBI games with eight, followed by Curry who has seven. **Kevin Hoef** has had 11 multi-hit games this season to lead Iowa, followed by Curry with 10 and Toole with nine.

HAWKEYES ON THE TUBE:

Saturday's match up will mark the first time Iowa baseball has been broadcasted on the Big Ten Network.

The network will broadcast one other Hawkeye game this season. The Iowa vs. Minnesota game on May 2 at Duane Banks Field will also air later this season.

SUCCESSFUL WITH RUNNERS :

Several Hawkeyes have taken advantage of baserunners this season.

Caleb Curry is hitting .473 with runners on to lead the Black and Gold. **Kurtis Muller** is hitting .833 when runners are on third, while **Justin Toole** is 43-for-69 in advancing runners. **Kevin Hoef** and **Kyle Riffel** are hitting .500 with the bases loaded.

WEARING PITCHES:

Iowa has no problem taking one for the team. The Hawkeyes have 42 hit-by-pitches on the year which is more than any other team in the Big Ten and enough to rank them 37th in the country in the category.

To lead the Black and Gold is **Kevin Hoef** with 11, followed by **Caleb Curry** and **Kyle Riffel** with six each.

DIAMOND THIEVES:

This season the Hawkeyes have out-run their opponents, going 61-for-74. Leading Iowa in steals is **Caleb Curry** with 21. Followed by **Justin Toole** and **Kyle Riffel** with 10.

Iowa ranks first in the Big Ten and fifth nationally in thefts.

YOUR OUTTA THERE:

Against the Kohawks, Wednesday, the Iowa pitching staff struck out a season-high 13 batters.

The last time Iowa posted 10-or-more strikeouts was March 16th in a 16-14 win over Rutgers.

For Iowa, **Matt Mossey** and **Zach Kenyon** had four strikeouts each, while **Andrew Porter** added three.

On Deck for the Hawkeyes

The Bluejays are 22-8 on the season and 6-3 in the MVC.

Creighton swept its 16th consecutive doubleheader Wednesday, defeating North Dakota State.

To lead Creighton offensively are Steve Winkelmann and Darin Ruf. Together they account for 11 home runs, 66 RBI and 38 walks. Winkelmann leads the team in slugging percentage (.584) while Ruf leads the team in on-base percentage (.477).

The Bluejays are set to take on Wichita State in a four-game series this weekend.

The all-time series between the two schools is tied, 1-1.

The Hawkeyes ended a 20-game drought last weekend against Purdue, hitting three bombs in two games. Iowa now has five homers on the year. The last two hit by the Hawkeyes were in Florida during opening week (Freie and Geelan).

Freshman **Kurtis Muller** and junior **Kevin Hoef**, hit the Black and Gold's two homers in their lone win Saturday against Purdue. **Caleb Curry** also hit a shot to left field in Iowa's loss against Purdue Sunday.

HAWKEYES VS THE BIG TEN:

The Hawkeyes have posted a record of 714-802-7 against Big Ten teams for a .471 winning percentage. Iowa leads the all-time series with four schools. (Indiana, Northwestern, Ohio State and Purdue).

HAWKEYE SIGN EIGHT FOR 2009:

The Iowa Baseball program has signed eight recruits for next year. **Nick Brown, Sean Flanagan, Cory Glieden, Jarred Hippen, Mike McQuillan, Zach Robertson, Phil Schreiber and Chett Zeise** all signed national letters of intent to attend the University of Iowa.

Head Coach Jack Dahm



Jack Dahm is in his fifth season as head coach of the University of Iowa baseball team. He has compiled an 394-413-2 overall record and is 111-137 at Iowa. Dahm coached in his 800th career game on March 30th this year at Michigan.

Last season, Iowa took another step forward by recording its best record in 14 years with a 31-23 mark. The Hawkeyes placed fourth in the Big Ten Conference at 17-13. Iowa earned its second trip to the conference tournament in the last three years -- this after going just once the previous 15 years.

In Dahm's 14 years as a head coach, he has produced 23 first team all-conference performers, seven freshmen All-Americans and two All-Americans. In his four years at Iowa, Dahm has coached 19 all-Big Ten selections, including seven first teamers.

Before coming to Iowa City, Dahm spent 18 years as a member of the Creighton Bluejay baseball program. He left the Bluejays as the winningest coach in school history, having compiled 283 wins against 276 losses in 10 seasons as a head coach.

Twenty-seven of Dahm's players have been selected in the MLB Draft, while four have gone on to play in the major leagues. In the past three years, nine Hawkeyes have inked contracts with professional teams, including three last spring.

In the classroom, Iowa is in the 90th-percentile in the NCAAs Academic Progress Report, placing them in the top 30 baseball programs, academically. During his Iowa tenure, Dahm has seen 33 players named academic all-Big Ten, including a team-record ten players in 2006. That is the best four-year total in the history of the program.

The 41-year old Dahm and his wife, Lynn, have been married 14 years. The couple has three children - sons Casey and Tyler and daughter Lyndsey.

UTILIZING THE SAC BUNT:

The Hawkeyes lead the Big Ten in sacrifice bunts this season with 21. Leading the Black and Gold is **Kurtis Muller** with five, and **Justin Toole** with four.

BY THE NUMBERS IN THE BIG TEN:

Caleb Curry has taken the Big Ten by storm, when compared with the league's players he ranks in the top ten in: batting average (.391), on base percentage (.473), runs batted in (27), hit-by-pitches (6) and stolen bases (21).

Other Hawkeyes who rank well in the conference include: **Justin Toole** is second in runs batted in (26), **Kevin Hoef** leads the league in hit-by-pitches (11), is tenth in on-base percentage (.455) and is fifth in runs scored (27). **Kyle Riffel** is fourth in the league in hit-by-pitches (6) and **Kurtis Muller** is tied for third in sac flies (3) and leads the league in sac bunts (5). **Andrew Porter** is tied for first in appearances (16).

COE COLLEGE SUMMARY:

Iowa took advantage of five Coe errors in a 7-2 victory over the Kohawks at Duane Banks Field Wednesday night. Only three of Iowa's seven runs were earned. This was the first time the intrastate teams faced off in just over 20 years; the last time being in 1987 under former Head Coach Duane Banks. In the win, Iowa advances to 9-17 and Coe falls to 15-10. In the win, the Hawkeyes scattered 11 hits and the pitching staff picked-up a season-high 13 strikeouts. Seven different Hawkeyes recorded a hit in the contest, including redshirt sophomore **Nick Muhlenbruch** who recorded a double with his first Hawkeye hit.

Zach McCool, Kyle Riffel, Caleb Curry and **Wes Freie** collected multiple hits Wednesday. Freie was 2-for-4 with a run scored, Curry was 2-for-3 with two runs and a pair of stolen bases, Riffel was 2-for-4 with an RBI and a run scored and McCool was 2-for-5 with an RBI and a stolen base.



CURRY RECEIVES HONOR:

Senior **Caleb Curry** received *CollegeBaseballHub.com's* Heartland Hitter of the Week honor for his performance against Rutgers.

Curry went 8-for-13 with seven RBI, two walks and three runs scored in the series.

BIG TEN PLAYERS OF THE WEEK:

Wes Freie was named Big Ten Player of the Week on March 4. In addition, **Brock Alberts** earned co-Pitcher of the Week accolades, sharing the honor with Phil Isaksson.

Freie had a stellar weekend helping lead Iowa to a 2-1 record, including a 6-3 upset win over fifth-ranked Vanderbilt, at the Music City Classic in Nashville, TN. The first baseman, who was named tournament MVP, was 9-for-12 with a double, home run, two RBI and two walks. The junior led the Black and Gold against No. 5 Vanderbilt, going a perfect 4-for-4 with an RBI.

Alberts had a great season debut in Iowa's come-from-behind win over Xavier Feb. 29. The senior right hander threw five and one-third innings in relief for the win. He allowed no runs, scattered five hits with no walks and struck out a career-high 10 of the 21 batters he faced.

2008 MUSIC CITY CLASSIC ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM:

After going 2-1 at the tournament and upsetting Vanderbilt, the Hawkeyes received six of the 12 spots on the all-tournament team, including the MVP.

Hawkeyes honored were: **Justin Toole** at second, **Kevin Hoef** at shortstop, **Kyle Riffel** in the outfield, **Caleb Curry** in the outfield and **Wes Freie** as utility and MVP.

BIG TEN NETWORK SCHEDULE:

THE ASSISTANT COACHES:

Head Coach **Jack Dahm** is assisted by coach **Ryan Brownlee** and coach **Nick Zumsande**, along with volunteer coach **Kris Welker** and Director of Baseball **Matt Haddy**.

Ryan Brownlee enters his fifth season as Iowa's hitting, infield instructor and recruiting coordinator.

As hitting coach, Brownlee saw the team's batting average vault 55 points from 2005 to 2007 (.269 to .324). Additionally, the team also scored more runs (273 to 401) had more RBIs (249 to 345) and walks (152 to 245) during that time span. **Nick Zumsande** enters his fifth year as the Iowa pitching coach.

Under Zumsande's guidance, the Hawkeye pitching has had a pitcher named first team all-Big Ten three of the last four years, and a pitcher named all-conference in each of his four years.

Kris Welker is in his second year as the team's volunteer assistant. Welker works with the Iowa catchers and outfielders, prepares scouting reports and coaches first base.

As a senior, Welker earned third team all-Big Ten honors, helping Iowa to a third-place finish in the Big Ten and a trip to the conference tournament. He led the team with a .354 batting average, 46 RBIs and 16 doubles. Welker also received the Bob Oldis, Jr MVP Award.

Matt Haddy is in his third season as the Director of Baseball Operations for the University of Iowa.

He assists the coaching staff with the day-to-day operations and administrative areas of the program. Haddy also serves as the travel coordinator and director of Hawkeye Baseball Camps.

SAME FACES, NEW PLACES:

When you look around the diamond this season, your eyes don't deceive you. There are several familiar faces in the lineup playing different positions. Junior **Kevin Hoef** moved from third base to shortstop, while senior **Caleb Curry** moved to center field from left field.

SCHEDULE STRENGTH:

Iowa will play one of its toughest schedules in 2008 as it will face nine teams that advanced to the NCAA Tournament last season. The Hawkeyes will welcome NCAA Tournament teams Minnesota, Nebraska and Ohio State to Iowa City and will take on Albany, Creighton, Michigan, Rutgers, Stetson and Vanderbilt on the road. Iowa will face three teams in conference action that advanced to the NCAA Tournament.

LAST SEASON:

Iowa posted a 31-23 record in 2007, the Hawkeyes placed fourth in the Big Ten Conference at 17-13, and earned their second trip to the conference tournament in the last three years -- this after going just once the previous 15 years.

During the season, Iowa defeated five teams (Nebraska, Fresno State, Ohio State, Minnesota and Michigan) that reached the NCAA Tournament. The Hawkeyes also posted a 12-game winning streak, which is the second-longest in school history. Included in the streak was a school-record 10-game Big Ten winning streak.

HAWKEYES HIT THE CLASSROOM:

In October, the Iowa baseball team was awarded the 2007 NCAA Public Recognition Award for being in the 90% percentile of Academic Progress Report (APR) for baseball.

THE 30-WIN CLUB:

The Hawkeyes' 31 wins in 2007 were the most under Coach Jack Dahm, in his career at Iowa, and the most at Iowa since 1993. The 1993 squad posted a 32-20 record under Duane Banks.

DUANE BANKS FIELD:

Every year the UI Department of Athletics makes improvements to Banks Field. The baseball program is very excited about the installation off 500 stadium chair back seats behind home plate. This major installation should be completed late this year.

O'Rourke Out:

Senior pitcher **Casey O'Rourke** has ended his collegiate career for medical reasons following his bout with testicular cancer in 2006. He will remain on the squad as a student assistant.

O'Rourke had 11 appearances and seven starts last season. He pitched 32.2 innings and had an 8.54 ERA. The native of Williamsburg, IA, was named to the academic all-conference team last year.

2008 UNITY COUNCIL:

The Unity Council is a group elected by their teammates to communicate internally with the coaches on behalf of their teammates. This years council includes: senior **Ben Geelan**, junior **Kevin Hoef**, junior **Justin Toole**, sophomore **Tyson Blasser**, sophomore **Michael Jacobs** and freshman **Kurtis Mueller**.

WHISTLIN' RAY:

Of all the members of the Hawkeye baseball program, the longest tenured is "**Whistlin'" Ray Gilmore**, who serves as Iowa's official scorekeeper. Gilmore started as a batboy in 1978, and has since served as manager, public address announcer and unofficial mascot for Iowa Baseball.

Iowa's record since Gilmore joined the program is 842-767-3.

IN MEMORY OF ROSE GILMORE:

Iowa Baseball lost a true Hawkeye January 23, 2008. Long time supporter **Rose E. Gilmore** (mother of Ray Gilmore) lost her battle with cancer at the age of 77.

Rose was an Iowa City native who retired from the University of Iowa Hospitals and Clinics in 1996 after 19 years of dedication.

Rose also served as a Captain in the US Army and was an avid Hawkeye and Cubs fan.
