Iowa at Michigan State Postgame Notes
October 13, 2012

Iowa defeated Michigan State, 19-16, in double-overtime at Spartan Stadium. PK Mike Meyer converted field goals in each overtime period and CB Greg Castillo recorded an interception in the second overtime period to seal the win. Today was Iowa's first true road game of the season.

Today's win is No. 100 for head coach Kirk Ferentz at Iowa. He is now 100-68 as the Hawkeye head coach and 112-89 in his career.

Iowa is now 5-3 in overtime games. This is the second time the Hawkeyes and Spartans have played an overtime game. Iowa won a 34-27, double-overtime contest in Iowa City on Oct. 27, 2007. That game was also Iowa's last overtime win.

Iowa's last three games against Michigan State in East Lansing have been decided by three points. The Hawkeyes won on the final play of the game in 2009 when Ricky Stanzi connected with Marvin McNutt for the game winning touchdown. Michigan State won 16-13 in 2008.

Iowa now leads the all-time series 23-19-2. Iowa is 10-10-1 in games played at East Lansing.

Castillo's interception on the final play of the game was the only turnover forced by the Iowa defense. The Hawkeye defense has collected at least one takeaway in 70 of its last 80 games, dating back to 2006. Iowa had one turnover today (one interception). The Spartans converted the turnover into a touchdown.

PK Mike Meyer, who entered today's game ranked fourth nationally in field goals made per game, tied a career-best by converting four field goal attempts. He improved to 14-of-15 this season, making his last 13 tries and 42-of-52 for his career in field goal attempts. Meyer now has 213 points, ranking ninth in career scoring.

Meyer also converted his only PAT attempt on the day, extending his school record streak to 68.

Mark Weisman led Iowa in rushing for the fourth consecutive contest, rushing for 116 yards on 26 carries and a touchdown. Weisman has gone over 100 yards in four straight games. The sophomore has totaled 635 yards rushing on 100 carries this season.

Iowa was 3-3 in the red zone today, scoring field goals in the second and fourth quarters, along with the game-tying touchdown in the final period. The Hawkeyes have scored on 165 of the last 186 red zone possessions (109 TDs and 56 FGs), dating back to the Michigan State game in 2008. Iowa is 146-167 combined inside the red zone its last 48 games. Michigan State was 3-3 in the red zone today, scoring a TD in the first period and field goals in the second and fourth periods.

QB James Vandenberg was 19-36 for 134 yards. He has completed 396-694 pass attempts for 4,661 yards and 30 touchdowns in his career. He ranks seventh on Iowa's career passing chart.

Linebackers Anthony Hitchens (15 tackles) and James Morris (10 tackles) and lineman Joe Gaglione (11 tackles) led the Hawkeyes in tackles today. Morris has registered double-digit tackles four times this year, while Hitchens has been credited with double-digit stops the last five games. DL Joe Gaglione recorded his team-leading fourth sack of the season in the first quarter. His nine tackles are a career-high.

Connor Kornbrath punted a career-high six times for 243 yards (40.5 avg.) today, including a long of 50 yards in the third quarter. The 50-yarder is his second-longest punt of the season (51 yards vs. Northern Illinois).

Jordan Cotton had a 45-yard kickoff return in the second quarter, which helped lead to an Iowa field goal. The kickoff return was the longest of his career and the longest by a Hawkeye this season. The 45-yard return is Iowa's longest since Jordan Bernstine's 62-yard return against Indiana a year ago.

QB James Vandenberg was intercepted in Iowa territory on Iowa's first possession, marking the first time the Hawkeyes failed to score on an opening drive this season. Michigan State drove 26 yards on its opening possession and scored a touchdown. The Spartans are the fourth Hawkeye opponent to score on their opening possession this season (Iowa State, Central Michigan, UNI and Michigan State).

Today marked the first time since the season opener that the Hawkeye offensive line has allowed a sack. Michigan State's Kyler Elsworth tallied one sack in the contest.

Iowa won the toss and elected to receive. The Hawkeyes have started on offense four times (Northern Illinois, Central Michigan, Minnesota and Michigan State). The Hawkeyes have started on offense in 139-of-168 games. Iowa is 16-13 in the games it has started on defense under Ferentz.

Andrew Donnal started at right guard for the second consecutive game in place of the injured Austin Blythe. It marked Donnal's second career start.

TE Jake Duzey had his first career reception (11 yards) in the third quarter. He finished the game with two catches for 14 yards.

RB Damon Bullock, who started the first three games, and CB B.J. Lowrey, who started the first four contests, did not play in today's game due to injury.

Instant replay was used three times today.

- 1) A James Vandenberg pass that was ruled backwards on the field was overturned after replay in the second quarter.
- 2) Iowa challenged a Michigan State third-down pass that was ruled a catch. The ruling was upheld following review.
- 3) Michigan State challenged the spot of the ball in the fourth quarter. After review, it was determined that the ball would be spotted on the 35-yard line instead of the 36-yard line.

Iowa is now 9-5 during the Ferentz era in games when it has rained.

Iowa returns to Iowa City next week for a home game against Penn State in primetime. The Hawkeyes and Nittany Lions will kick-off at 7 p.m. (BTN) inside Kinnick Stadium.

MSU vs. Iowa - Saturday, Oct. 13, 2012

Iowa head coach Kirk Ferentz

Opening statement...

"Obviously just extremely proud of our football team. It was a really hard-fought game. Both teams really competed hard; I think anybody in the stadium today could have seen that. Just really proud about the way the guys hung in there against a very good football team. It was more than 60 minutes, obviously and it took basically every player out there. And outside of the turnover, you can throw all the stats out the window. It was just a hard-fought, one of those tough games."

On his team's defensive performance...

"I think they're growing, and they played extremely hard today. It seemed like they gave a pass there each direction, but outside of that I thought they really competed and, you know, we started out in adverse circumstances and held them to 3 [points], which was a positive, and I just thought they played hard all day long."

"To win on the turnover there at the end...outstanding and probably appropriate...to have an unsung guy was really the trigger guy, really triggered this all, to get his hand on the ball. It's kind of a fitting way. It gave us the chance to get the pick."

On his team's 4th quarter drive to get the game-tying touchdown...

"Again, it was a game where we weren't...at halftime, I can't even imagine what those stats looked like. Really, up until that drive; that and the last series there was series there was the story of the game because we started out 1st and 25 with not a lot of time on the clock, and we hadn't done much up to that point, so James [Vandenberg] hitting Keenan [Davis] – huge play to get us out of the hole – and then great call that 3rd and 6, might have been 3rd and whatever, and had a heck of a run by Mark Weisman, and then Mark finished it off on another good call by Greg [Davis]."

"If anybody saw the game...if you take those two plays out, otherwise we gain 100 yards. But that's football. That's just sticking with it. Mark's a tough competitor."

On the game turning in his team's favor in the 4th quarter...

"I felt the turn when it was 1st and 25, and I said 'Oh boy, that's not good.' So...huge play by James [Vandenberg] and Keenan [Davis] down the boundary. Then, that third down thing...you know we were playing for two downs there so we took a shot on the run and Mark [Weisman] not only got the first down but then really impacted the game."

"So those two plays...that gave us momentum certainly when we got the ball down inside."

On the performance of his kicker, Mike Meyer...

"Mike has...really turned the corner from a confidence standpoint, maturity standpoint from back in the spring. And just really started performing the way we all hoped he would. He's been good the prior two years, so we don't take it for granted, but boy, his execution was flawless."

On the improvement of his team and getting his 100th victory at Iowa...

"What we've tried to do is work on and focus on what's right in front of us and getting better, and that's what this game is all about, and that's what it teaches you. So you've got to have some mental toughness to do that because every day's not going to go the way you want, certainly not every play is going to go the way you want. And today was a great illustration of that."

"We had some tough circumstances but the guys hung in there and kept working, and I thought we improved during the course of the game in a lot of areas, and we're growing as a football team right now based on the last two weeks."

"As far as [this being] the 100th [career victory] or the 10th, this is a game that I'll remember for a while just because of the way the guys battled and just stuck with it."

On winning a tough game with low statistical yardage gains...

"You get into games [of this nature] where stats don't mean a lot other than protecting the football, and in this series it's been huge – at least the last 6 years – ironically we're dead even. Today we were both minus one – so...direct parallel there. But other than that, the team that turns it over the most is usually the team that loses."

His summary of the game...

"The biggest thing is just the way our guys fought right to the end because they [Michigan State] weren't going away – that was pretty obvious – but I think our guys answered the same way – they said they weren't going away either – and it's one of those games where, you know...last guy standing."

"It was a real great effort by our guys."

Iowa senior cornerback Greg Castillo

On intercepting a pass that's been tipped and has changed direction...

"It's pretty tough. That's why I really concentrated. It was hit once. I had to process it for a little bit."

On winning this game as a senior...

"It's huge now that we know that we've got momentum going into Penn State so it's going to be a tough task."

Iowa Senior Wide Receiver Keenan Davis

On the long first down catch in the fourth...

"It was just an up route and James Vandenberg threw a great ball. It was the play we had to make, luckily we made it and it gave us a spark."

On the Hawkeye victory...

"It was a great win; it was definitely a great win. I was really happy with it, it was a good spark we have in the Big Ten now. It is something to build on, a lot of stuff to learn again, hopefully we can build on it."

On the never give up mentality...

"That's one thing I love about this team, we never give up. The sidelines are always into it. Everybody is talking about nothing but positive things. You notice that and you never give up, you never really feel negative about anything. I think that is a big part of us winning today."

On the offense starting to click in the fourth quarter...

"It was just keep going, don't get down on ourselves, and go out there and move the ball. When you keep going like that, you wear defenses down. You know you keep going hard and block the perimeter, don't show them any weakness and everything will start clicking for the offense."

On the rough conditions on the field...

"It was raining but it's football. You have to go out there and play every game. Luckily we had a practice like this on Tuesday, so that Tuesday practice was a good prep for this game. The thing about Michigan State is their grass is nice so luckily it wasn't too bad. There were definitely some slips but nothing we couldn't handle."

On the importance of the milestone win for Coach Kirk Ferentz...

"Actually I just found out in the locker room. It is just a milestone of his, and it's great. He gave out three (game balls), but he got a fourth honorable mention game ball."

Iowa redshirt-freshman tight end Jake Duzey

On playing a tough game and executing at the end...

"We just kept running our plays and just kept going at it; we didn't falter, didn't step back. We kept going at it."

On the momentum shifting late in the game...

"Once we started making big plays at the end, we just kind of knew that we were in a good spot against a tough team. We like going into those tough kinds of games so the win was good for us."

Did you feel you were always in it?

"Yeah, I mean, we're never going to give up and we're going to keep going until the end and that's what happens. And that's the kind of game we like to play; just a hard fought, hard-nosed game."

On Mark Weisman's contribution to the win today...

"He's a tough running back. Obviously he's a good running back and he keeps going and never stops."

On moving up the depth chart throughout the season and getting more playing time...

"All of the tight ends are very competitive every day; we go out there and compete. We're a unit; we've all been working together and obviously we've been working very hard; everyone's working hard and we'll keep working."

On being unbeaten in the Big Ten and at the top of your division...

"It's awesome, obviously. It's cool being at the top, but we've still got six games left and we're only two games in so we've got to keep pushing and keep working. This will keep our momentum going."

On pulling out the touchdown late in the game...

"Our team never gives up and we're a hard, physical team. We're tough, we don't stop playing, all four quarters, and obviously in overtime we were able to do something."

On the thrill of winning at the end...

"Yeah, that was a great win, you know? For me personally, coming back to my home state and getting a big win; it was good. It was good for our team as well and for the future of our season."

On the outstanding performance of the defense...

"They kept fighting. They fought every single play and showed a lot of resiliency today. They play hard and we are glad to come out with the win."

On his team's performance late in the fourth quarter offensively...
