Iowa will then travel to Evanston, IL, to face Northwestern Saturday at 7 p.m. at Welsh-Ryan Arena. ### HAWKEYE CAPTAINS

Senior outside hitter **Megan Schipper** and junior setter **Mara Hilgenberg** are Iowa's team captains for the 2009 season. Schipper leads the Hawkeyes in kills (295) and service aces (28) and ranks second in digs (281). Hilgenberg leads the Hawkeyes with 863 assists and is a third generation Hawkeye captain. Her great-uncle Wally and her uncle Jim were football team captains in 1963 and 1977, respectively.

### SCHIPPER CONTINUES HER CLIMB

Senior **Megan Schipper** currently ranks 12th on Iowa's all-time list with 1,138 career kills. She needs 16 kills to pass Dee Ann Davidson (1,153) for 11th all-time. On October 23rd, the Hawkeye captain was honored for becoming the 16th player in program history to record 1,000 career kills. The Aplington, IA, native passed the elusive number in Iowa's 3-1 win at Wisconsin (9/23). She needs five kills to reach the 300-kill mark for the third straight season. In 2007, she led the Hawkeyes with 309 kills as a sophomore. She tallied a career-high 345 kills in 2008, the second-highest total on the team (Catherine Smale, 380). This season, Schipper leads Iowa with 269 kills (3.02 kills per set).

## HAWKEYES DIG DEFENSE

Iowa ranks second the Big Ten averaging 15.07 digs per set. Senior libero **Christina Meister** leads the Big Ten with 4.44 digs per set. Since 1990, only three Hawkeyes have averaged more than four digs per set through an entire season: Pam Kavadas, 5.22 ('04); Emily Hiza, 4.74 ('06) and 4.52 ('07); Janet Moylan, 4.63 ('90). Meister has set a new bar for total digs in a season under the current 25-point rally scoring format. She has 434 total digs in 2009. Emily Hiza established the record with 419 digs in 2008, the first year of the current scoring format.

## SCHIPPER AMONG ALL-TIME LEADERS

Senior **Megan Schipper** picked up one service ace in Iowa's 3-2 win over Wisconsin to become the 10th player in program history rank among the top 20 career leaders in kills, blocks and service aces. The Hawkeye captain currently ranks 11th in career kills (1,138), 16th in career blocks (218) and 20th in career service aces (74).

## HUFFMAN AND SCHIPPER BALANCE HAWKEYES

Senior OH **Megan Schipper** and junior OH **Aimee Huffman** have kept conference defenses guessing in 2009. Attacking from opposite ends of the net, Schipper and Huffman have totaled 144 and 117 kills, respectively, in Big Ten play. This season, Schipper leads Iowa with 295 total kills while Huffman has amassed a career-high 233.

## KRIEGER KITTLE REACHES CENTURY MARK

Freshman **Emma Krieger Kittle** reached the 100-kill plateau Oct. 17 at Purdue. The freshman has totaled 141 kills this season and averages 2.0 kills per set in conference play, third best among Hawkeyes. Other current Hawkeyes to record at least 100 kills as freshmen include **Megan Schipper** (189, '06), **Aimee Huffman** (192, '07) and **Megan Eskew** (163, '07).

## HUSZ THAT GIRL

Sophomore **Mallory Husz** slapped a career-high 12 kills in Iowa's five-set win over Wisconsin on the Big Ten Network, Nov. 11. The native of Council Bluffs, IA, also stuffed a career-best seven blocks against the Badgers to help the Hawkeyes sweep the season series from Wisconsin for the first time in 15 years (1994). Husz bounced back Friday with a team-leading 10 kills in Iowa's three-set loss to Minnesota. She picked up three more blocks and tied a career high with three digs vs. the Golden Gophers. Husz has started six of Iowa's last seven contests and totaled a team leading 22 kills in the Hawkeyes' three contests against nationally ranked Illinois, Penn State and Minnesota.

## NEXT WOMAN IN

Sophomore **Paige Stevens** made her first career start against Wisconsin, Nov. 11, and finished with a career-best 52 assists in Iowa's five-set win over the Badgers. The 52 assists marked a season high for any Hawkeye individual this season. Stevens backed up her effort against Wisconsin with a career-high 11 digs vs. Minnesota, Nov. 13.

## BUMP, SET... BLOCK

Junior **Becky Walters** has crept into the top 10 conference leaders in blocks per game. The Parkersburg, IA, native ranks ninth in the Big Ten averaging 1.01 blocks per game. She leads Iowa with 81 total blocks in 2009, including 48 in conference play.

## BIG EFFORT ON THE BIG TEN NETWORK

Sophomore **Tiffany Nilges** shined on prime time television in Iowa's 3-2 win Wisconsin, Nov. 11, on the Big Ten Network. The Tripoli, IA, native picked up career highs in kills (9) and digs (8) as Iowa swept the season series from the Badgers for the first time since 1994.



## Head Coach Sharon Dingman



Sharon Dingman was hired as the eighth coach in Iowa volleyball history March 21, 2008.

The second-year head Hawkeye owns a career record of 361-246 (18 years) after leading Iowa to its most successful campaign in eight seasons in 2008. The Hawkeyes' 14 overall victories and six conference wins were the most by an Iowa Volleyball team

since 2000.

Dingman also reached a personal milestone in her inaugural Hawkeye season, recording career victory No. 350 November 14 in a five-set victory over Northwestern.

Iowa re-established a home-court advantage in Dingman's first season, posting its first winning season at North Carver since 1998 and setting a program attendance record.

Dingman came to Iowa after serving as head coach at Illinois State from 2000-07, where she compiled a 147-98 record. In 2007, Dingman led the Redbirds to their first at-large berth into the NCAA Tournament since 1997. Illinois State reached the championship match of the Missouri Valley Conference Tournament and finished with a 21-12 overall record.

Illinois State produced winning seasons in seven of the eight seasons under Dingman and never finished lower than fifth in the Missouri Valley Conference. Dingman produced 21 all-Missouri Valley Conference selections, including Player of the Year, Libero of the Year and two Freshman of the Year honorees.

Redbird teams under Dingman were also strong in the classroom. Eleven players were named to the league's scholar-athlete squad in her eight seasons. In 2004, four volleyball student-athletes earned perfect 4.00 grade-point-averages and the team recorded a 3.32 GPA.

Dingman started her head coaching career in 1991 at Auburn, where she led the Tigers to a 22-13 record in her only season at the helm. Her 1991 squad became the first Auburn volleyball team to receive votes in the national poll and Auburn's fourth place finish in the SEC that season marked the highest finish ever for Auburn at the time.

She then moved to Butler in 1992, where she served as head coach for eight seasons. Dingman led the Bulldogs to four 20 win seasons and three postseason tournaments, including an appearance in the NCAA Tournament in 1997 after capturing the Midwestern Collegiate Conference title. She was named MCC Coach of the Year in 1997 after compiling a 28-7 record.

Prior to becoming a head coach, Dingman spent seven seasons as an assistant coach at three Division I programs. After one season at Northern Michigan (1984), she assisted at Texas Tech for three seasons (1985-87). Dingman then spent three seasons at Kentucky (1988-90) and helped the Wildcats to an SEC Championship in 1988 along with three-straight regional finals appearances in the NCAA Tournament.

## IOWA IN THE ATTENDANCE GAME

The Hawkeyes rank 30th in national attendance, averaging 1,373 fans in 11 home contests. Since Head Coach **Sharon Dingman's** arrival prior to 2008 season, Hawkeye fans have been flocking to Carver-Hawkeye Arena in record numbers. Four of the top-five all-time attendance figures have been set during the Dingman era. The Hawkeyes set a school attendance record Nov. 7 vs. Penn State when 2,802 fans witnessed the Hawkeyes host the nation's top-ranked team. The record announced crowd broke the old mark of 2,191 set against Wisconsin on Oct. 13, 2007.

## NORTHWESTERN

The Wildcats are led by 10th-year Head Coach Kaylor Chan and libero Kate Nobile, Northwestern's all-time leader in digs. The senior became the first player in program history to post 2,000 career digs when the teams met in Iowa City, Oct. 23. Nobile ranks second in the Big Ten, averaging 4.42 digs per set (Meister, Iowa, 4.44). Northwestern leads the all-time series, 32-26-1. The Hawkeyes defeated Northwestern 3-0 in Iowa City, Oct. 23, and have won the last three meetings in the series. Iowa defeated the Wildcats in five sets in its trip to Evanston last season.

## ILLINOIS

The Fighting Illini are led by first-year Head Coach Kevin Hambly and OH Laura DeBruler. The junior leads Illinois with 4.51 kills per set, the second highest total in the Big Ten. Illinois leads the all-time series, 46-13. The Hawkeyes fell in straight sets to the Fighting Illini at Carver-Hawkeye Arena Oct. 24 in the only other meeting this season. Iowa has not defeated the Illini since winning 3-0 at Illinois in 2005.

## HIT IT AND WIN IT

The Hawkeyes are 12-0 when attacking at a higher percentage than their opponent this season. Conversely, Iowa's opponent has hit a higher percentage in each of the Hawkeyes' 16 losses.

## AMONG THE NATION'S BEST

Four Big Ten teams remain ranked in the top 15 of the AVCA coaches poll, including two in the top five. In addition, the Big Ten is tied for the lead among all conferences with five top-25 RPI teams and is one of just two conferences to place each of its teams in the RPI's top 90. Penn State returns as the conference champion, winner of the last two NCAA Championships and ranked atop the 2009 AVCA Coaches Poll. Other Big Ten schools ranked in the top 25 include Illinois (5), Minnesota (12) and Michigan (14).

## SECOND GENERATION

**Mara Hilgenberg's** father Jay and **Emma Krieger Kittle's** father Bruce played football together at Iowa from 1977-1980. Jay was a four-time letterwinner and went on to win Super Bowl XX with the 1985 Chicago Bears. Bruce used a redshirt in 1980 and came back as a team captain for Hayden Fry's 1981 Big Ten Championship team.

## 2009 Coaching Staff

**Sharon Dingman** is in her second season as the head Hawkeye. She is joined by second-year assistant **Jason Allen** and newcomers **Ben Boldt** and **Curt Sivertsen**.

Allen is in his second season as an assistant coach at Iowa. Allen was also promoted to the team's recruiting coordinator following the 2008 season. Allen previously served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Sam Houston State University prior to serving as the 16U head coach for the Texas Tornados club program in 2007.

Boldt is in his first season as an assistant coach at Iowa. Boldt spent the last two seasons as an assistant coach at the University of Alabama. Prior to joining Alabama, Boldt served as a staff assistant for five seasons at the University of Nebraska. In his final season, the Cornhuskers finished 33-1 en route to the 2006 NCAA Championship.

Sivertsen is in his first season at Iowa after having served the last two years as head coach of the men's and women's programs at Missouri Valley College.

**Angie Boldt** is in her second season as the Director of Volleyball Operations. She came to Iowa City in 2008 after serving as the Director of Volleyball Operations at Alabama for two seasons.
