FIRST SERVE

The Hawkeyes serve up the 2010 Cy-Hawk Series hosting Iowa State Friday at 7 p.m. inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena. Admission is \$3 for adults. Kids high school age and younger and UI students with a valid school ID get in free. This will be Iowa's final home match until Oct. 1.

Head Coach Sharon Dingman: "We're going to approach this match the same way we prepare for every other team. We're going to have three good days of practice and we're going to go out Friday night and compete against a very good Cyclone volleyball team."

IOWA ON THE BTN

The Hawkeyes will make three appearances on national television this season. Each of Iowa's contests versus No. 12 Minnesota (10/6, 10/27) and the home match against Northwestern (10/30) will be televised live on the Big Ten Network. All three matches will be broadcast in high-definition.

HAWKEYE FAITHFUL

Iowa currently ranks No. 24 in national attendance after averaging 1,024 fans at the season-opening Hawkeye Challenge. The Hawkeyes ranked 23rd in national attendance a year ago and have set season attendance records in each of Dingman's first two seasons. A then-school record 2,411 showed up to watch Iowa host Iowa State in 2009.

IOWA STATE

The No. 11 Cyclones are members of the Big 12 Conference and led by fifth-year head coach Christy Johnson-Smith. The Cyclones have won six straight since a season-opening loss to No. 13 Florida. Senior Victoria Henson leads the Iowa State offense averaging 4.21 kills per set. The outside hitter recorded a match-high 17 kills in the Cyclones' 3-0 win over No. 18 Northern Iowa Wednesday night. The Hawkeyes own a 21-20 advantage in the all-time series, but Iowa State has won the last five meetings, including all four meetings since the conception of the Cy-Hawk Series. Iowa last beat the Cyclones, 3-0, in 1997.

JOHNNY FIVE IS ALIVE

Three times this season the Hawkeyes have played into the fifth and final set and each time Iowa has come out the victor. The Hawkeyes rallied from two sets down to top Southern Illinois (8/28), nearly lost a two-set advantage before topping Creighton (9/4) and rallied from a 2-1 deficit to beat Saint Louis (9/4). Iowa was 2-1 in five-set matches last season.

HUSZ HOSTING THIS BLOCK PARTY?

Junior Mallory Husz ranks sixth among her conference peers in blocks per set (1.42). Iowa's 6-0 middle blocker leads the Big Ten with eight solo blocks and has the highest single-game block total this season. Husz totaled 11 blocks in Iowa's five-set win over Southern Illinois (8/28).

FRESHMAN PICK-ME-UP

The Hawkeyes rank No. 1 in the Big Ten in digs per set (17.42) thanks in large part to freshman Bethany Yeager. Iowa's 5-7 libero ranks second in the Big Ten averaging 5.27 digs per set. Her 137 total digs leads the conference and her 33 digs against Creighton ties for the highest single-match total in the Big Ten and the sixth highest total in program history.

ACES WILD

Senior Becky Walters has served at least one ace in each of Iowa's six matches. The 6-3 middle blocker has done a lot of damage from the service line, totaling 15 aces this season, the second-highest total in the Big Ten.

STEVENS LEADS CONFERENCE IN CHARITABLE WORK

Junior Paige Stevens dished a career-high 59 assists in Iowa's 3-2 win over Creighton (9/4), the highest individual assist total in the Big Ten. Stevens' 52 assists vs. Southern Illinois (8/28) ranks as the fourth highest assist total in the conference.

HAWKEYES DOMINATE ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAMS

Marcia E. Hamilton Active Ankle Challenge

Freshman Bethany Yeager was named tournament MVP at the Marcia E. Hamilton Active Ankle Challenge in St. Louis, Mo. (Sept. 3-4). The 5-7 libero averaged 5.3 digs per set to lead Iowa to its second tournament championship in as many weekends. Junior Mallory Husz was named to the all-tournament team.

Hawkeye Challenge

Four Hawkeyes earned all-tournament honors at the 2010 Hawkeye Challenge, including Husz, who was named tournament MVP. The 6-0 middle blocker averaged 12 kills and 6.7 blocks as Iowa swept through the three-match challenge. Yeager was named the tournament's top libero after averaging 5.25 digs per set. Senior Becky Walters and junior Megan Eskew were named to the all-tournament team.



Head Coach Sharon Dingman



Sharon Dingman was hired as the eighth coach in Iowa volleyball history March 21, 2008.

In two seasons at the helm of the volleyball program, she has led the Hawkeyes to historical heights.

In 2009, Dingman helped Iowa match the best start in program history by guiding the Hawkeyes to a 6-0 start. Iowa eventually became the first team in school history to start the season 7-0 on the road.

Iowa has set season attendance records in each of Dingman's two years as head coach, including averaging a school-record 1,632 fans in 2009, the 23rd highest total in the country.

In her first season she led Iowa to its most successful campaign in eight years. The Hawkeyes' 14 overall victories and six conference wins were the most by an Iowa Volleyball team since 2000. Dingman also reached a personal milestone in her inaugural Hawkeye season, recording career victory No. 350 November 14 in a five-set victory over Northwestern.

Iowa re-established a home-court advantage in Dingman's first season, posting its first winning season at North Carver since 1998 and setting a program attendance record.

Dingman came to Iowa after serving as head coach at Illinois State from 2000-07, where she compiled a 147-98 record. In 2007, Dingman led the Redbirds to their first at-large berth into the NCAA Tournament since 1997. Illinois State reached the championship match of the Missouri Valley Conference Tournament and finished with a 21-12 overall record.

Illinois State produced winning seasons in seven of the eight seasons under Dingman and never finished lower than fifth in the Missouri Valley Conference. Dingman produced 21 all-Missouri Valley Conference selections, including Player of the Year, Libero of the Year and two Freshman of the Year honorees.

Dingman started her head coaching career in 1991 at Auburn, where she led the Tigers to a 22-13 record in her only season at the helm. Her 1991 squad became the first Auburn volleyball team to receive votes in the national poll and Auburn's fourth place finish in the SEC that season marked the highest finish ever for Auburn at the time.

She then moved to Butler in 1992, where she served as head coach for eight seasons. Dingman led the Bulldogs to four 20 win seasons and three postseason tournaments, including an appearance in the NCAA Tournament in 1997 after capturing the Midwestern Collegiate Conference title. She was named MCC Coach of the Year in 1997 after compiling a 28-7 record.

Prior to becoming a head coach, Dingman spent seven seasons as an assistant coach at three Division I programs. After one season at Northern Michigan (1984), she assisted at Texas Tech for three seasons (1985-87). Dingman then spent three seasons at Kentucky (1988-90) and helped the Wildcats to an SEC Championship in 1988 along with three-straight regional finals appearances in the NCAA Tournament.

DEEP IN THE HEARTLAND

The Hawkeyes have four incoming freshmen on the roster, including three from the Lone Star State. Freshmen Bethany Yeager (Brenham, TX), Chante' Thompson (Hurst, TX) and Rachael Bedell (Plano, TX) all come from the state of Texas. The trio is joined by freshman Nikki Dailey (Franklin, WI). Iowa's freshmen quartet represents a 2010 recruiting class that earned Highest Honorable Mention by PrepVolleyball.com.

HISTORY IN THE MAKING

For the first time in program history, the Iowa volleyball team started 3-0 in consecutive seasons. Iowa swept through the Hawkeye Challenge to post its 3-0 record this year. In 2009, the Hawkeyes matched the best start in program history by winning their first six matches. The Hawkeyes 5-1 start matches the second-best start in program history. Only the 1978, 1988 and 2009 teams started the season with a better record (6-0).

HAWKEYE SCHEDULE

The Hawkeyes will close the non-conference portion of their schedule with a Sept. 19 date at Northern Illinois. Iowa will open the conference season on the road at Michigan and Michigan State. Fourteen of Iowa's 29 matches are against 2009 NCAA Tournament qualifiers. They include Iowa State, Saint Louis, Illinois (2), Michigan (2), Michigan State (2), Ohio State (2) and Penn State (2).

HAWKEYE CAPTAINS

Senior Becky Walters and junior Megan Eskew will serve as team captains for the 2010 season. Walters, a fifth-year senior from Parkersburg, IA, recorded a career-best 181 kills in 2009, the third highest total on the team. Eskew missed 2009 with a knee injury but returned to the court with a bang by earning all-tournament honors at the season-opening Hawkeye Challenge.

HUFFMAN SIDELINED

Senior Aimee Huffman continues to rehab from a right shoulder injury and will miss the 2010 season. Huffman was an Academic all-Big Ten honoree in 2009 and was expected to be Iowa top returning scorer. Last season, the Poth, TX native ranked among the team leaders in kills (second), assists (third), blocks (third) and digs (third). Huffman started the first 26 games of 2009 before missing the final six matches due to illness. She was named MVP of two preseason tournaments and earned all-tournament honors at last year's Hawkeye Challenge.

2010 Coaching Staff

Sharon Dingman enters her third season as the head Hawkeye. She is joined by assistants **Jason Allen** and **Ben Boldt**.

Allen is in his third season as an assistant coach at Iowa. Allen was also promoted to the team's recruiting coordinator following the 2008 season. Allen previously served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Sam Houston State University prior to serving as the 16U head coach for the Texas Tornados club program in 2007.

Boldt enters his second season as an assistant coach at Iowa. Before joining the Hawkeyes, Boldt spent two seasons as an assistant coach at the University of Alabama. Prior to joining Alabama, Boldt served as a staff assistant for five seasons at the University of Nebraska. In his final season, the Cornhuskers finished 33-1 en route to the NCAA Championship.

Angie Boldt is in her third season as the Director of Volleyball Operations. She came to Iowa City in 2008 after serving as the Director of Volleyball Operations at Alabama for two seasons.

Curt Sivertsen is in his second season as a volunteer assistant. Sivertsen assists with all practice activities is the primary statistical operator of the Data Volley program.
