THE SERES -- ILLINOIS

- Iowa leads the all-time series 55-26-1 and is 25-17 all-time in Champaign. The Hawkeyes have won the last 12 meetings.
- Illinois' last win in the series came on Feb. 10, 2006, in Iowa City by the margin of 24-13.
- Iowa head coach Tom Brands is 12-0 all-time against the Fighting Illini.

PREVIOUS INDIVIDUAL MEETINGS — ILLINOIS

- Drake Ayala is 1-0 all-time against Justin Cardanil having won a 7-4 decision in 2022.

THE SERIES — NORTHWESTERN

Iowa leads the all-time series, 75-7-1. Iowa has won 15 straight against Northwestern and owns an all-time mark of 35-4-1 in duals taking place in Evanston.

- Northwestern's last win in the series was a 22-19 victory in Evanston on Jan. 29, 2005.
- The Hawkeyes are 14-0 against Northwestern under head coach Tom Brands.

PREVIOUS INDIVIDUAL MEETINGS — NORTHWESTERN

- Caleb Rathjen is 0-1 all-time and this season against Sam Cartella having lost in SV1, 7-4, at the 2023 Lindenwood Open.

LAST MEET

The Hawkeyes improved to 8-0 on the season with a 34-6 victory over Purdue on Jan. 19 in Iowa City. Iowa won eight of the 10 matches including six via bonus point.

SOLDIER SALUTE CHAMPS

Iowa tallied 251.5 team points to win the 2023 team title at the Soldier Salute. It is the second straight year the Hawkeyes won the title.

- Eight Hawkeyes won individual titles at the tournament. Drake Ayala (125), Brody Teske (133), Real Woods (141), Caleb Rathjen (149), Jared Franek (157), Michael Caliendo (165), Gabe Arnold (174-Unattached) and Zach Glazier (197).

GLAZIER THE CLOSER

Zach Glazier has an 16-0 record on the season and has clinched four dual meets for the Hawkeyes.

- The senior has sealed the deal for the Hawkeyes in the Iowa State, Penn, Nebraska and Minnesota duals.

GABE

- True freshman Gabe Arnold made his dual debut for the Hawkeyes against #16 Oregon State. He picked up his first career ranked win over #11 Travis Wittlake.
- Arnold then bumped up a weight class in Iowa's win over #8 Iowa State the next week and won his match against #6 Will Feldkamp.
- Arnold was named Big Ten Wrestler of the Week for the first time in his career after defeating Feldkamp.

IOWA WINS 8 TITLES AT LUTHER OPEN

Seven Iowa wrestlers won championships in the Elite Division, including Drake Ayala (125), Jace Rhodes (133), Jared Franek (157), Michael Caliendo (165), Gabe Arnold (174), Brennan Swafford (184) and Zach Glazier (197).

- Iowa was 88-17 in the Elite Division with six of those losses against fellow Hawkeyes.
- Isaiah Fenton won the 157-pound Silver/Freshman Division.
- Arnold, Fenton, Joey Cruz and Koye Grebel all made their Hawkeye debuts.

NO. 2 IN PRESEASON POLL

The Hawkeyes were ranked second in the preseason NWCA Coaches' poll and by FLO. Iowa was ranked eighth by InterMat and WIN.

- Iowa finished second at the 2023 NCAA Championships with 82.5 points with six All-Americans. The Hawkeyes were also second at the Big Ten Championships with 134.5 points.

FRESHMAN TRACKER

Three Hawkeye freshman have competed as attached competitors during the 2023-24 season. Under new NCAA guidelines, freshmen can compete in five dates of competition during the student-athlete's initial year of collegiate enrollment without using a season of competition.

- Here is a list of competitions for Iowa's freshmen in 2023-24: Gabe Arnold (3), Isaiah Fenton (2), Koye Grebel (2), Ben Kueter (1) and Kale Petersen (1).

SOLD OUT X3

Iowa wrestling season tickets at Carver-Hawkeye Arena are sold out for a third straight season. The Hawkeyes have led the nation in attendance every year since 2006-07. Iowa set an NCAA record, averaging 14,905 fans in 2021-22.

ALL-AMERICANS

The Hawkeyes have six past All-Americans on the 2023-24 roster in Real Woods (141), Jared Franek (157), Michael Caliendo (165), Nelson Brands (174), Abe Assad (184) and Tony Cassioppi (285).

- Iowa has crowned at least one All-American in 52 consecutive tournaments, dating back to 1972.

NEWCOMERS

The Hawkeyes have 10 newcomers on the 2023-24 roster, including four transfers.

- Jared Franek was an All-American and Big 12 Champion at North Dakota State (2023). He finished fourth at 157 last season.
- Michael Caliendo was an All-American at North Dakota State a season ago. He finished seventh at 165 pounds.
- Victor Voinovich III was an NCAA qualifier for Oklahoma State at 149 pounds in 2023 after redshirting in 2022.
- Joey Cruz went 2-2 for Oklahoma before missing the remainder of the season with an ankle injury.

ARNOLD WINS PAN AMERICAN GOLD

Iowa freshman Gabe Arnold won a U20 Pan American gold medal at 79 kg in July.

- Arnold dominated en route to the top of the podium, outscoring his opponents, 33-0.
- Redshirt freshman Bradley Hill earned a silver medal at 125 kg.

WHEN IN ROME

Junior Patrick Kennedy and seniors Abe Assad and Real Woods earned medals at the Sassari City Matteo Pellicone Memorial in Rome, Italy, on June 9-10.

- Kennedy won a gold medal, competing at 74 kg, while Assad and Woods both earned silver medals.

WORLD TEAM TRIALS

Six University of Iowa wrestlers placed at the 2023 U23 and U20 World Team Trials.

- Gabe Arnold was runner-up at 79 kg, Aiden Riggins was fifth at 74 kg, Jace Rhodes was sixth at 61 kg and Bradley Hill finished seventh at 125 kg in the U20 Division. In the U23 bracket, Cullan Schriever (61 kg) and Caleb Rathjen (70 kg) both finished third.

CAMBUS SHUTTLE

Free parking is available in the Hancher Auditorium Parking Lot on dates where no performances are scheduled. When the Hancher Auditorium Lot is available, complimentary Cambus shuttles to Carver-Hawkeye Arena will begin 90 minutes prior to the start of the meet and run until one (1) hour following the conclusion of the meet. The Hancher lot will be unavailable for shuttle service on Jan. 19 due to Hancher show.

PARKING UPDATE

More than 100 parking spaces from Lots 75N and 75S are now unavailable due to utilities preparation work in support of the future water tower. The project is expected to conclude in the spring of 2025.

- Public parking for all events is still available in the following areas: Lot 52, Lot 43W, Lot 65, Ramp 3, Newton Road Ramp, Hancher and Lot 49. For women's basketball games, the unaffected areas of Lot 75 remain available for public parking. Permitted parking in Lots 46, 40 and 33 for all events -- and in Lot 75N for men's basketball and men's wrestling -- remain unchanged.

- Fans are encouraged to arrive early to allow extra time to park and commute to Carver-Hawkeye Arena. Fans are reminded to park in designated locations for athletic events, and to not block sidewalks with their vehicles or park in areas marked for UIHC patient parking.

TV TIME

Nine Iowa duals will be televised during the 2023-24 season. The Hawkeyes will have seven duals televised on BTN, one on FS1 and one on ESPN.

- Iowa's BTN appearances include home duals against Minnesota (7 p.m., CT), Purdue (7 p.m.), Penn State (8 p.m.) and Wisconsin (1 p.m.) and road duals at Nebraska (6 p.m.), Illinois (8 p.m.) and Michigan (7:30 p.m.)

- The Hawkeyes' away dual against Iowa State will be televised on ESPN and the road dual against Oklahoma State will be televised on FS1.

HAWKEYE WRESTLING HISTORY

The Hawkeyes have won 24 national titles and 37 Big Ten titles. Iowa's 55 NCAA Champions have won a total of 85 NCAA individual titles, crowning seven three-time and 16 two-time champions.

- The Hawkeyes' 118 Big Ten champions have combined for 210 conference titles. There have been nine four-time, 18 three-time and 31 two-time Big Ten champions from Iowa.

- Iowa's 163 All-Americans have earned All-America status 363 times, including three five-time, 25 four-time, 38 three-time and 41 two-time honorees.

ACADEMIC ALL-BIG TEN

Fourteen Hawkeyes were among the 45 University of Iowa student-athletes named to the 2022-23 Big Ten Winter Academic All-Conference Team. The 14 honorees are tied for the second most in program history.

- To be eligible for Academic All-Big Ten selection, students must be on a varsity team, as verified by being on the official squad list as of March 1 for winter sports, who have been enrolled fulltime at the institution for a minimum of 12 months and carry a cumulative grade-point average of 3.0 or higher.

- Iowa wrestling's Academic All-Big Ten honorees include Drake Ayala, Drew Bennett, Nelson Brands, Tony Cassioppi, Zach Glazier, Joe Kelly, Patrick Kennedy, Charles Matthews, Max Murin, Cullan Schriever, Leif Schroeder, Cobe Siebrecht, Brennan Swafford and Jacob Warner.

NCAA TROPHIES

The Hawkeyes earned a team trophy at the NCAA Championships for the 14th time in the last 15 championships. Iowa has won 14 team trophies in head coach Tom Brands' 16 seasons. (The 2020 season, in which Iowa was favored, was cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic).

- Iowa has won 48 team NCAA trophies in program history and have 68 top 10 finishes. The Hawkeyes have been the NCAA runner-up seven times.

HAWKEYES AND CARVER-HAWKEYE ARENA

Iowa is 131-13 (.907) at Carver-Hawkeye Arena since Tom Brands took over the program prior to 2006-07. The Hawkeyes are 281-26 (.914) all-time at Carver-Hawkeye Arena since moving from the UI Field House in 1983. Iowa went 8-0 in Carver last season.

- Carver-Hawkeye Arena has hosted two United States Olympic Team Trials, four Big Ten Championships (1983, 1994, 2005, 2016) and four NCAA Championships (1986, 1991, 1995, 2001). The Hawkeyes have won five tournament titles on their home mat, including the 1983 and 1994 Big Ten Championships, and the 1986, 1991 and 1995 NCAA Championships.

- In 2018, the University of Iowa hosted the UWW World Cup, an international dual tournament featuring eight of the top countries in the world.

CHASING THE HAWKEYES

Gary Kurdelmeier led Iowa to its first NCAA Championship in 1975, and in the 49 years since, the Hawkeyes have accumulated 24 team titles, more than any other school -- Penn State (11), Oklahoma State (7), Minnesota (3), Iowa State (2), Ohio State (1) and Arizona State (1).

TOM BRANDS

Head Coach

University of Iowa, 1992

Five-time Big Ten and three-time NWCA Coach of the Year Tom Brands completed his 17th season as head wrestling coach at the University of Iowa in 2022-23. A 1996 Olympic gold medalist and member of wrestling's Hall of Fame, Brands is only the eighth head wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. The former Hawkeye wrestler was a four-time All-American and three-time national champion (1989-92) at Iowa. He has a 273-25-1 (.912) overall and 130-12 (.914) Big Ten coaching record at Iowa. He has a 290-45-1 (.861) career mark and a 131-13 (.907) record at Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

In 17 seasons as Iowa's head coach, the Sheldon, Iowa, native has led the Hawkeyes to four NCAA and six Big Ten team titles, crowning 13 NCAA champions, 26 Big Ten champions and 100 All-Americans. Iowa has had 170 Academic All-Big Ten recipients, including a school-record 17 in 2019-20. The Hawkeyes have qualified 158 wrestlers for the NCAA Championships in the last 17 years, sending the entire 10-man lineup in 2010, 2014, 2015, 2020, 2021, 2022 and 2023. Iowa has won or shared the Big Ten regular season title 12 times in Brands' 17 seasons.

The program set the national collegiate dual meet attendance record of 42,287 when No. 3 Iowa defeated top-ranked Oklahoma State, 18-16, on Nov. 14, 2015 at the Grapple on the Gridiron at Kinnick Stadium. Iowa has led the nation in attendance every year since Brands became head coach in 2006-07, setting an NCAA all-time attendance average of 14,905 in 2021-22.

Brands has been named NWCA National Coach of the Year three times. He was first honored in 2008 after leading the Hawkeyes to their first NCAA team title since 2000. He was recognized in 2020 when the top-ranked Hawkeyes won Big Ten regular season and tournament championships and entered the NCAA Championships as the favorite to win the team title. The tournament was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. He most recently won the award in 2021 when Iowa won Big Ten and NCAA team titles.

Brands was named Big Ten Coach of the Year in 2008, 2009, 2010, 2020 and 2021. He is the only coach in program history to earn the award five times.

Brands served as head coach at Virginia Tech University for two seasons (2005-06), recording a 17-20 dual mark. In his first season with the Hokies, Brands led the team to the 2005 regular season Atlantic Coast Conference title, set a school record for dual meet wins (16) and had a school-record five wrestlers qualify for the NCAA Championships.

Prior to taking the helm at Virginia Tech, Brands was an assistant coach at Iowa for 12 seasons (1993-2004). He helped the Hawkeyes to a 177-27 dual record, seven NCAA and eight Big Ten team titles, while crowning 23 NCAA champions, 73 All-Americans and 36 Big Ten champions. He was named the National Wrestling Coaches Association Assistant Coach of the Year in 2000.

In 2004, he was one of three coaches for the U.S. Olympic freestyle wrestling team, participating in Athens, and in 2016 he was named a volunteer coach of the United States Olympic team in Rio. Brands also served as assistant coach for the U.S. Freestyle World Teams in 2001, 2002, 2003, 2013, 2014, and 2015. He was named Freestyle Coach of the Year by USA Wrestling in 2002 and 2003. He has coached a number of other U.S. teams in international competition.

As a competitor, Brands won the 1996 Olympic freestyle gold medal at 136.5 pounds in Atlanta, Georgia. He also won a gold medal at the 1993 World Championships in Toronto, two World Cup gold medals (1994, 1995) and was the 1995 Pan American Games champion. He won four U.S. National titles (1993-96) and made four straight U.S. World or Olympic teams (1993-96). Along with his twin brother, Terry, Tom was named 1993 USA Wrestling Athlete of the Year, the 1993 John Smith Outstanding Freestyle Wrestler, and 1993 Amateur Wrestling News Man of the Year. He was inducted into wrestling's Hall of Fame in 2001.

Brands was a four-time All-American at Iowa (1989-92). During his Hawkeye career, he won three NCAA titles and was named Outstanding Wrestler of the 1992 NCAA Championships. Also a three-time Big Ten champion, Brands won 95 percent of his matches at Iowa. His career mark of 158-7-2 includes an undefeated season in 1991 (45-0).

The Sheldon, Iowa, native was born April 9, 1968. He earned his B.S. degree in physical education from Iowa in 1992. He and his wife, Jeni, have three adult children, Madigan, Kinsee and Tommy.
