### TIPOFF

- The Hawkeyes fell to 0-3 in true road games with a 99-89 road loss at USC on Tuesday night at the Galen Center in Los Angeles. Iowa rallied to within five points after being down 19 in the second half.
- Iowa has scored 80+ points in 11 consecutive games, the longest stretch since the 1988-89 season (13 straight games). Iowa has scored 80+ in all but two games this season.
- Iowa is leading nation in scoring, averaging 89.5 points per game. The team's 51.0 field goal percentage is second-best in the league (sixth in country).
- Sophomore Owen Freeman netted a career-high 23 points on 11-of-14 shooting in the road loss at USC. It was his third 20-point game this season.
- Senior Payton Sandfort, who was the Big Ten Co-Player of the Week on Jan. 13, has registered three-straight 20-point contests. He is averaging 24.3 points and five rebounds with .553/.500/.850 shooting splits during the stretch.
- In his last three second halves, Sandfort has scored 66 points (30 vs. Nebraska, 21 vs. Indiana, 15 at USC).
- The Hawkeyes rallied from 15 down in the second half to force overtime en route to a 97-87 victory over Nebraska on Jan. 7 in Iowa City. Iowa has come from behind to win four games this season when trailing in the second half.
- 30x2... junior Josh Dix (31 points, 7 3s) and Payton Sandfort (30, 6 3s) combined for 61 points and 13 3s against the Huskers as they became the first Hawkeye duo since 2022 (Jordan Bohannon (30), Keegan Murray (30), at Maryland) to both score 30+ in a single game.
- The Hawkeyes have shot better than 50 percent from the floor nine times and better than 60 percent three times, including a season-best 62.7 percent in the win over New Orleans on Dec. 15. The team is 8-1 when shooting at least 50 percent from the field.
- Sophomore Owen Freeman is third in the Big Ten and 10th nationally with a 64.3 field goal percentage. He is averaging 17.1 points (10th in Big Ten) and 6.7 rebounds per game. He is the only Hawkeye to score in double figures in every game he has played.
- The Hawkeyes have made at least eight 3-point field goals in 15 games, including 10+ in 10 contests. Iowa made 18 in the win over Southern -- the most since 2022 -- and 17 in the win over Nebraska. Iowa is tops in the Big Ten (13th nationally), averaging 10.8 per game.
- Iowa is leading the Big Ten in assists (19.8, 3rd in NCAA) and assist-to-turnover ratio (1.91, 2nd in NCAA). The team has had 20+ assists in eight games.

# HEAD COACH FRAN McCAFFERY

Fran McCaffery, who is signed through the 2028 season, is in his 15th season as the head basketball coach at the University of Iowa and his 29th year overall as a college head coach. McCaffery has reached the 20-win plateau 11 of the previous 17 seasons.

McCaffery spent five seasons (2005-10) as the head coach at Siena, six years at UNC-Greensboro (1999-2005) and three seasons at Lehigh (1985-88) before joining the Hawkeyes.

McCaffery has nearly four decades of Division I coaching experience.

He completed his 42nd season as a collegiate coach, which includes 28 years as a head coach and 15 as an assistant. In 2022, McCaffery joined Hall of Fame coaches Rick Pitino, Bob Huggins, Eddie Sutton and Lefty Driesell as the only Division I coaches to lead teams to conference tournament titles in four or more different leagues (Big Ten, MAAC, SoCon, ECC). He is one of 14 coaches to lead at least four different Division I teams to the NCAA Tournament.

McCaffery, 65, won his 500th game as a head coach on Dec. 8, 2022 and win No. 250 at Iowa on Dec. 17, 2022. He holds a career mark of 543-373 (.593) and guided his teams to 17 postseason appearances (12 NCAA & five NIT). Iowa likely would have competed in another NCAA Tournament in 2020, if not for the NCAA canceling the postseason due to COVID-19. He is 292-196 (.599) at Iowa. The 292 wins are a school record, including a record 139 Big Ten victories. McCaffery led Iowa to wins in four of the last eight NCAA Tournaments (2015, 2016, 2019, 2021).

Since taking over the Iowa program in 2010, Iowa has earned 11 postseason tournament bids (7 NCAA, 4 NIT). McCaffery coached Iowa to a Big Ten Tournament title and 26 wins in 2022, the second-most win total in program history. McCaffery has guided seven players to first team All-Big Ten status eight of the last 11 years, including the 2020 & 2021 National and Big Ten Player of the Year, Luka Garza.

McCaffery has posted upper division finishes in 11 of the last 12 seasons at Iowa and 23 of 28 seasons as a head coach. The Hawkeyes have finished fifth or better in the Big Ten standings seven of the last 10 years. He has posted 20 wins or more 11 of the last 16 seasons, including eight of the last 11 years at Iowa (2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2019, 2020, 2021 and 2022). Iowa's 205 victories between 2013-21 are the most over a 10-year span at Iowa since 1987-96 (207).

McCaffery and the Hawkeyes boast a 191-48 (.799) home record over the last 15 seasons, which includes a school-record 18 wins in 2014 and 13 consecutive victories in 2019-20. Iowa has won 14+ games in Carver-Hawkeye Arena in five of the last six seasons (2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, 2023).

McCaffery's five years at Siena were the best in its 70-year history. He led the Saints on an incredible run that ended with three straight Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference championships and NCAA Tournament appearances.

McCaffery's Saints owned a 112-51 (.687) record in his five years with the program. He guided the Saints to four consecutive 20-win seasons. McCaffery's achievements earned the head coach Siena Hall of Fame recognition in 2017.

The 2009 MAAC Coach of the Year and 2010 District I Coach of the Year is the third winningest coach, by percentage, in league history (68-22, .756). He is the only coach to guide a MAAC program to two NCAA Tournament wins. McCaffery led his 2008 and 2009 teams to first round NCAA Tournament victories over Vanderbilt and Ohio State, respectively.

In his final two seasons at Siena, he coached the Saints to back-to-back 27-win campaigns and boasted a combined 39-3 (.929) record against MAAC opponents, which included MAAC Tournament contests.

McCaffery began his coaching career as an assistant at Penn (1982-83) and Lehigh (1983-85). After three seasons as head coach at Lehigh, he spent 11 seasons as an assistant at Notre Dame (1988-99).

McCaffery played basketball at Wake Forest his freshman year (1977-78) and concluded his playing career at Penn his final three seasons (1979-82). He earned his bachelor's degree in economics from The Wharton School (Penn) in 1982. McCaffery also earned a master of education from Lehigh in 1985.

**THE SETTING**

The University of Iowa men's basketball team closes out its West Coast road trip, facing UCLA on Friday at 8 p.m. (CT) at Pauley Pavilion in Los Angeles. The game will be televised on FS1.

**ON THE AIR**

**Radio:** Friday's game will be broadcast on the Hawkeye Radio Network with Gary Dolphin (play-by-play) and Bobby Hansen (color) on the call. The network includes more than 40 stations that blanket the state of Iowa and include portions of Illinois, Nebraska, Minnesota, Missouri and Wisconsin. The Hawkeye Radio Network includes a 60-minute pregame show.

**Television:** Friday's game will be televised on FS1 with Guy Haberman (play-by-play) and Don MacLean (color) on the call.

**SCOUTING UCLA**

- After winning 11 of its first 13 games, UCLA has dropped four straight contests to see its record fall to 11-6 overall and 2-4 in Big Ten play.
- The Bruins have lost their last four Big Ten games by eight, 19, 18 and seven points in games at Nebraska, at home against Michigan, at Maryland and at Rutgers.
- UCLA played at Rutgers on Monday in Piscataway, falling 75-68.
- The Bruins have three players averaging in double figures and four scoring at least 8.1 points per game. Tyler Bilodeau leads the team, averaging 14.4 points and has a team-high 19 3-pointers, while Eric Dailey, Jr., averaged 11.6 points on 51.5 percent shooting.
- Kobe Johnson averages 8.1 points and a team-high 5.7 rebounds, while also having a team-best 54 assists and 34 steals. Johnson played the last three seasons at USC.
- UCLA averages 74.6 points per game, shooting 45.9 percent from the floor. The Bruins average 6.9 3s per game, shooting at a 33.2 percent clip from long range.
- The Bruins surrender just 63.4 points per game, which is tops in the Big Ten and 18th nationally. UCLA forces 17.12 turnovers per game (6th-best in the nation), while averaging 8.8 steals.

**SERIES HISTORY**

- Friday's game is the ninth in the all-time series between Iowa and UCLA, dating back to 1950. The Hawkeyes lead the series, 5-3.
- Iowa last faced the Bruins during the 1990-91 season, winning 88-71 in Iowa City.
- Iowa has lost its last three games against UCLA in Los Angeles in the 1971-72, 1973-74 and 1981-82 seasons.
- The Hawkeyes are 2-3 at UCLA all-time, including 0-3 at Pauley Pavilion.

**LAST GAME: USC 99, IOWA 89**

USC never trailed, handing Iowa a 99-89 loss on Tuesday night at the Galen Center. The Trojans build a 19 point lead with 10:51 to play before the Hawkeyes closed to within five points twice with around five minutes remaining.

- Sophomore Owen Freeman scored a career-high 23 points and grabbed six rebounds, while senior Payton Sandfort scored 20 points on 6-of-11 shooting with four 3s.
- Iowa shot 53.3 percent from the field and made 11 3-pointers, but USC finished with a 64.9 field goal percentage -- a season high by a Hawkeye opponent -- and out-rebounded Iowa, 37-20.

**MORE NOTABLES**

- Head coach Fran McCaffery has the most victories in Iowa history with 292, including a record 139 Big Ten wins.
- Graduate Drew Thelwell is 21 points shy of reaching 1,000 for his collegiate career.
- Iowa handed Indiana a 85-60 loss on Jan. 11 in Iowa City. It was the program's largest margin of victory over the Hoosiers since 1996.
- The Hawkeyes limited Indiana to a season-low 60 points. It was the lowest scoring total by a Hawkeye opponent in Big Ten play since Minnesota scored 56 on Feb. 12, 2023.
- The Hawkeyes are 10-1 at home this season and the program has won 96 of its last 103 nonconference home games, dating back to 2012.
- Iowa is second in the Big Ten and eighth nationally, averaging 16.94 fast-break points.
- The Hawkeye reserves have outscored their counterparts in 10 games. Iowa got 57 points from its reserves in the 112 point outburst against New Hampshire on Dec. 30.
- Iowa has held 13 of its 17 opponents under 50 percent shooting (and two under 40 percent), has forced at least 18 turnovers in six games and has held five opponents under 70 points. The Hawkeyes are 98-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 61 points over the past 14+ seasons.
- The Hawkeyes have had five games decided by single digits (2-3 record) and two games decided by a single possession (1-1 record).
- The Hawkeyes had a 62-point first half in the win over New Hampshire. Iowa has scored 50+ eight times in a half this season.
- Graduate Drew Thelwell won the 100th game of his collegiate career in Iowa's victory over USC Upstate on Nov. 26.

- Iowa limited Rider to a single 3-point field goal on Nov. 19 in Iowa City -- the fewest 3-pointers the program has allowed in nearly a decade (0 vs. Alcorn State on Dec. 9, 2014).
- The Hawkeyes have had 10 or more steals in six contests this season. Iowa is fourth in the Big Ten, averaging 8.4 steals per game.
- Iowa had 11 blocked shots in its win over New Orleans on Dec. 15, the fifth-most in a game under McCaffery.
- The Hawkeyes have had six players hit the 20-point mark in a game this season -- Payton Sandfort (7), Josh Dix (3), Owen Freeman (3), Pryce Sandfort (1), Brock Harding (1), Drew Thelwell (1)
- Harding has 106 assists to 41 turnovers in 17 games His 6.2 assists per game are fourth in the Big Ten and 14th nationally. He has had five or more assists in 13 games and 8+ in five contests.

- Iowa has two players in the top eight in the Big Ten in assist-to-turnover ratio -- Drew Thelwell (1st, 3.92) and Brock Harding (8th, 2.59). Thelwell is fifth nationally in the category. As a team, Iowa is No. 1 in the Big Ten (2nd nationally) with a 1.91 assist-to-turnover ratio.
- Iowa went 3-0 to win the team title at the Kenny Arnold Challenge.

- Senior Payton Sandfort is rated as the No. 47 best player in the nation by ESPN.com. He is also tabbed as the 17th-best wing in college basketball by the Field of 68.

- Sandfort is tabbed as the third-best wing in the nation by College Basketball Report, Owen Freeman is rated as the fifth-best sophomore by CBR and Josh Dix is ranked as the No. 24 shooting guard by CBR.

- Sandfort currently has an 88.8 career free throw percentage (223-of-251), which is the best mark in program history. He made 18 straight free throws from Nov. 22-Dec. 21.

- Redshirt junior Carter Kingsbury was awarded a scholarship for the 2024-25 season. He was a walk-on his first three seasons.

- The Hawkeyes have won 10 or more Big Ten games in a school record six consecutive seasons. Iowa has won 10+ Big Ten games in nine of the last 10 seasons under head coach Fran McCaffery and the program has 11 Big Ten upper division finishes in the last 12 years.

- Iowa has placed fifth place or better in the Big Ten standings seven of the last 10 years.

- The Hawkeyes averaged 83.1 points per game in 2023-24 -- the third-highest scoring average during the McCaffery era. Iowa has averaged 80+ points per game in four straight seasons for the first time since 1968-72.

- Iowa led the Big Ten and ranked third nationally in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.85) last season. It was the second straight year the program has been third nationally in the category.

HIGH FLYING HAWKS

Iowa is the highest scoring offense in the nation, averaging 89.5 points. It would be the team's highest scoring average since 1988-89 (89.6 points).

- The Hawkeyes have scored 80+ points in 11 consecutive games dating back to Nov. 26. It is the longest stretch of the McCaffery era and the longest for the program since the 1988-89 season (13 straight).
- Iowa has scored 90+ points six times this season and the team has eclipsed the 100-point mark three times.
- The Hawkeyes have averaged 80+ points in each of the last four seasons.

PAYTON JOINS 1,000/500 CLUB

Senior Payton Sandfort is the 29th player in program history with 1,000+ career points and 500+ rebounds. He is the first Hawkeye since Joe Wieskamp in 2021 to join the club.

SANDFORT NAMED BIG CO-PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Senior Payton Sandfort was named the Big Ten Co-Player of the Week on Jan. 13 after averaging 26 points, six rebounds and 3.5 assists, while shooting 55.6 percent from the floor and 52.6 percent from 3-point range. He tied a career-high with 30 points (all in second half and OT) in the win over Nebraska and scored 23 (21 in the second half) in the 25-point victory over Indiana.

- It is the second Player of the Week honor of Sandfort's career.

30 X 2

Junior Josh Dix scored a career-high 31 points with seven 3-pointers and senior Payton Sandfort finished with 30 points, tying a career-high, with six 3s in Iowa's 97-87 overtime victory over Nebraska on Jan. 7 in Iowa City.

- They are the first Division I teammates each with 30 points and six 3-pointers in the same game in five years and the first high major teammates to do so since Notre Dame's Ben Hansbrough and Tim Abromaitis in 2011.

- Dix made 10-of-14 field goals, including 7-of-10 3s, and had six rebounds, seven assists, four steals and one block, becoming the first major conference player to finish with at least that stat line since LSU's Ben Simmons on Dec. 2, 2015. He is only the 12th Division I player with at least that stat line in the last 20 years.

- Dix was on the court for all but 22 seconds in the 45 minute tilt against the Huskers.

- After a scoreless first half, Sandfort finished with 30 points (27 in the second half alone) on 8-of-15 shooting, making 6-of-10 3s and 8-of-9 free throws. He also had six rebounds and four assists. The point total matched his career-high set during last year's NIT First Round game against Kansas State.

**PATIENT PAYTON**

In back-to-back home games in January, senior Payton Sandfort got cooking in the second half in wins over Nebraska and Indiana.

- He scored 27 points in the second half (30 in the second half and OT) in the win over Nebraska, making 8-of-15 field goals, six 3s and eight free throws to match a career high.
- Against Indiana, Sandfort scored 21 of his game-high 23 points, making 7-of-12 field goals (four 3s) and was 5-for-5 from the free throw line.
- This trend started in Ann Arbor when he scored 16 of his 19 points in the two-point road loss on Dec. 7. He also scored 15 points in the second half in the road loss at USC on Jan. 14.

**POINTS-ASSISTS DUBS**

Sophomore Brock Harding collected his second points-assists double-double of the season (third of his career) in Iowa's 85-60 win over Indiana on Jan. 11. He finished the game with 10 points and 10 assists.

- It was Harding's third career 10+ assist game, which is tied for the sixth-most in program history.
- Harding's three career points-assists double-doubles are tied for the fourth most in program history along with Ronnie Lester and Andre Woolridge. He trails Jordan Bohannon (7), B.J. Armstrong (5) and Jeff Horner (5) in the record books.

**BIG SHOT JOSH**

Junior Josh Dix made a catch-and-shoot 3-pointer from 33 feet with 0.8 seconds remaining to give Iowa an 80-79 victory over Northwestern on Dec. 3 in Iowa City. It was the first career buzzer beater in Dix's basketball career.

- It was Iowa's first buzzer beater since 2019 when Joe Wieskamp and Jordan Bohannon shot the Hawkeyes to back-to-back wins over Rutgers and Northwestern.
- Dix's shot was ESPN SportsCenter's No. 1 Play of the Day on Dec. 3.

**MISSING HAWKEYES**

The Hawkeyes have been battling the injury bug this season as the team has had at least one player officially out in all but four games. The list includes: Seydou Traore (6), Cooper Koch (3), Chris Tadjio (3), Riley Mulvey (2), Owen Freeman (2), Even Brauns (1), Josh Dix (1) and Drew Thelwell (1).

- Cooper Koch was sidelined for a second time prior to the Jan. 7 game against Nebraska. He is out indefinitely.

**SPLASH BROTHERS + JD**

Brothers Payton and Pryce Sandfort and junior Josh Dix have been deadly from 3-point range this season. The trio have combined to make 116 3-point field goals in Iowa's first 17 games.

- Payton has a team-high and Big Ten-best 47 3-pointers, while Dix has made 36 3s (9th) and Pryce 33 (12th). Payton averages 2.76 3-point field goals per game.

**OWWWWEN**

Sophomore Owen Freeman had a 20th birthday to remember when he returned to his hometown of Moline and produced a 21-point, 11-rebound double-double in Iowa's neutral site victory over Washington State. Freeman made 9-of-15 field goals, which were a career-high.

- Freeman notched his second double-double, finishing with 18 points and 11 rebounds against Utah State on Nov. 22. He made 9-of-12 field goals and had three blocks. His third double-double came in a beat down of Indiana, when he finished with 16 points, 12 rebounds, four blocks and three steals. He was 8-of-13 from the floor in the win.
- Freeman scored a career-high 23 points, making 11-of-14 field goals and grabbed six rebounds at USC on Jan. 14. His 11 field goals matched a career-best.
- The Moline, Illinois, native has three double-doubles this season -- ranking 13th in the Big Ten -- and eight in his career. He also has five career 20-point games.
- In 15 games (he missed the South Dakota and New Hampshire games), Freeman is tied for the team lead in scoring (17.1), while leading the team in rebounds (6.7) and blocks (33). He is the only Hawkeye to reach double figures in every game he has played.
- Freeman ranks 11th in the Big Ten in scoring (17.1) and 14th in rebounding (6.7). He is third in the league (10th nationally) in field goal percentage (.643), fifth in field goals (110) and second in blocks (33).
- Freeman has shot 60 percent or better from the field in 12 of his 15 games, including 83.3 percent (10-of-12) against New Orleans on Dec. 15 in Iowa City.
- Defensively, Freeman has had three or more blocks in eight games, including a season-high four swats in back-to-back wins over Nebraska and Illinois. He has 20 blocks over his last seven games.

**P\$\$\$\$**

Senior Payton Sandfort has reached double figures in 15 games this season, including posting a team-high seven 20-point contests. He is tied for the team lead in scoring (17.1) and is second in rebounding (5.6), while averaging 3.4 assists and 2.76 3-point field goals per game.

- The Waukee, Iowa, native had his best game of the season in the Jan. 7 home win over Nebraska, tying a career-high with 30 points, making 8-of-15 field goals with six 3-pointers and finishing with six rebounds and four assists. All of his points came in the second half and in overtime.

- He followed it up with a 21-point second half (23 points of the game) in the win over Indiana, making 7-of-12 field goals with four 3-pointers. He also had six rebounds and three assists.
- Sandfort notched his third straight 20-point game, finishing 6-of-11 from the floor with four 3-pointers in the road loss at USC on Jan. 14.
- He scored 24 points, making 8-of-14 field goals (two 3s) and all six free throws in the neutral site win over Utah. He also had a team-high eight rebounds.
- Sandfort has two career 30-point games, 25 career 20-point contests and six career double-doubles.
- He is 10th in the league in scoring (17.1), eighth in field goals (94), first in 3-pointers (47) and first in 3-point attempts (131) this season.

#### JD = EFFICIENT

Josh Dix was one of the most efficient players in the Big Ten as a sophomore and he has continued that trend in 2024-25. The Council Bluffs, Iowa, native averages 14.5 points, while shooting 55.7 percent from the field, 46.8 percent from 3-point land and 87 percent from the free throw line. He has the highest field goal percentage by a guard in the Big Ten.

- Dix has landed in double figures in 14 games this season with one 30-point and three 20-point contests. He also averages 2.8 assists per game with three contests with five or more helpers.
- The guard had the best game of his career in the Jan. 7 win over Nebraska, finishing with a career-high 31 points, six rebounds, seven assists, four steals and one block. He made 10-of-14 field goals, including a career-best seven 3-pointers. He followed it up with four more 3s in the home win over Indiana on Jan. 11.
- Dix scored 22 points on 9-of-16 shooting (three 3s) and had six rebounds in 38 minutes in Iowa's 80-79 win over Northwestern on Dec. 3. He hit a buzz-beater with 0.8 seconds remaining on the clock.
- Dix has seven career 20 point games.

#### PRYCE'S FAST START

Sophomore Pryce Sandfort posted career-highs in scoring, field goals, 3-pointers and rebounds in consecutive games against East Texas A&M and Southern to open the 2024-25 season. The Waukee, Iowa, native made his first eight field goals en route to a 22-point outing in Iowa's win over Southern on Nov. 7. He made 8-of-10 field goals in the game with six 3-pointers.

- Sandfort had the best league game of his career on Dec. 7 at Michigan, making 6-of-10 field goals (three 3-pointers) in 28 minutes. He scored 10 points in the first half.
- On the year, he is averaging nine points -- sixth on the team -- shooting 48.2 percent from the field and 40.2 percent from long range. He has been in double figures eight times this season.
- He has made 3+ 3-pointers in six games and has made at least one triple in 13 contests.

#### HEY SEY

After missing the final two games prior to the holiday break, sophomore Seydou Traore returned to action Dec. 30 against New Hampshire to produce his best game as a Hawkeye.

- The Bronx, New York, native made 6-of-10 field goals en route to 14 points -- his highest point total as a Hawkeye. He also had a team-best six assists, three blocks and three rebounds in 20 minutes of court time.
- Traore, who has missed six games because of injury this season, has reached double digits in three games, where he averages 5.8 points on 45.3 percent shooting.

#### BROCK'S BREAKOUT

Sophomore Brock Harding has scored in double figures in eight games this season, where he is averaging 9.6 points, 6.2 assists and 1.9 steals, while shooting 44.9 percent from the field and 39.2 percent from 3-point range.

- Harding scored a career-high 20 points on 9-of-15 shooting) and had 10 assists and four steals against USC Upstate to record his second career double-double. It was Harding's first career 20 point contest and second career game with 10+ assists.
- He tallied his second double-double of the season (third of his career), finishing with 10 points and 10 assists in the Jan. 11 win over Indiana.
- He is the only player in the nation to have a 20-point, 10-assist, 4-steal game this season and one of 25 to have a 20-point, 10-assist double-double.
- He was a bright spot in a neutral site loss against Utah State, scoring 19 points on 8-of-15 shooting with a career-best three 3-pointers. He also had five assists and four steals in 33 minutes.
- The 2023 Illinois Mr. Basketball is fourth in the Big Ten in assists (6.2), seventh in steals (1.88) and eighth in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.59).
- He has at least five assists in 13 of the team's 17 games and eight or more five times. Defensively, Harding has had at least one steal in 14 games and 3+ in six contests.

#### MR. THELWELL

Graduate guard Drew Thelwell has been a valuable addition to the Iowa backcourt, averaging 10.6 points, 3.2 assists, 2.3 steals and 2.4 rebounds per game as a Hawkeye. He is shooting 55.1 percent from the field and 41.9 percent from long range.

- The Florida native has been in double digits in 10 games this season, including scoring a season-high 25 points -- one off his career high -- in a road game at Wisconsin. He made 9-of-14 field goals and three 3-pointers in the game.
- Since moving into the starting lineup on Dec. 12 against Iowa State, Thelwell is averaging 13.7 points, three rebounds, 3.3 assists and 2.3 steals, while shooting 57.4 percent from the field and 50 percent from 3-point range.

- He missed the Jan. 7 game against Nebraska because of injury.
- Thelwell has five games with three or more steals and eight games with 2+ steals. He is second in the Big Ten with 36 steals. Thelwell had a career-high six steals (five in the first half alone) in the win over Indiana.
- The six steals are the most in a game by a Hawkeye since Joe Toussaint in 2021 and tied for the second most in a game under Fran McCaffery.
- As a distributor, Thelwell has five games with 4+ assists and is third on the team with 51 assists (against 13 turnovers). His 3.92 assist-to-turnover ratio is tops in the Big Ten and fifth nationally.

**ONE MORE PASS**

- The Hawkeyes have had 20+ assists in eight games this season, including a season-high 28 in the win over New Orleans on Dec. 15.
- Iowa has assisted on 59.7 percent of its field goals this season (336-of-563). Four Hawkeyes have 40 or more assists this season.
  - The Hawkeyes are leading the Big Ten and rank third nationally, averaging 19.8 assists per game. Iowa is also leading the Big Ten and rank second nationally with a 1.91 assist-to-turnover ratio.

**CHERISH THE ROCK**

The Hawkeyes have had 10 or fewer turnovers in nine games this season. Iowa committed a season-low four turnovers at Michigan on Dec. 7.

**EFFICIENT OFFENSE**

The Hawkeyes continue to be a highly efficient offensive team under head coach Fran McCaffery, ranking in the top 20 nationally in each of the last seven seasons.

**18 FROM DISTANCE**

- The Hawkeyes made 18 3-point field goals in the victory over Southern on Nov. 7. They are the most for the program since the 2022 Big Ten Tournament and tied for the fifth-most under head coach Fran McCaffery at Iowa.
- The Hawkeyes finished with 17 3-pointers (in 35 attempts) in a Big Ten home win over Nebraska on Jan. 7.
  - Iowa has made 10+ 3-pointers in 10 games and 8+ 3s in 16 contests. The team averages 10.8 makes per contest (1st in the Big Ten, 13th nationally), while shooting 39.8 percent (first in Big Ten, 10th in nation).

**PAYTON WATCH**

- Senior Payton Sandfort currently is 21st in program history with 1,357 career points. If Sandfort matches his 2023-24 production, he would climb to 11th place in program history.
- Sandfort is third in program history with 234 career 3-point field goals. Should he match his junior year totals, he would finish second in program history to Jordan Bohannon (455 makes) in the record books.

**PAYTON AT THE STRIPE**

- Senior Payton Sandfort enters his final season as a Hawkeye with a chance to break the program's all-time free throw percentage record.
- Sandfort currently has an 88.8 (223-of-251) career free throw percentage, which is the top mark in program history. Jordan Bohannon holds the record, making 88.7 (370-of-417) of his attempts from 2017-22.

**P3... PAYTON SANDFORT...**

- has made at least one 3-pointer 15 of 17 games this season and in 62 games in his career.
- has made two or more 3-pointers in 55 career games, 3 or more in 32 games and and four or more in 25 career contests.
- has made five or more 3s seven times in his career, including a career-best seven 3-pointers in the NIT victory over Kansas State in 2024.

**THELWELL APPROACHES 1K**

Graduate transfer Drew Thelwell has scored 979 career points in 130 career games at Morehead State and Iowa. He is 21 points shy of the 1,000 point milestone.

**HAWKEYE FASTBREAKS**

- Iowa is 173-37 when scoring 80 points or more, the last 14+ seasons. The Hawkeyes are 98-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 61 points, the last 14+ years.

**IOWA HISTORY**

Iowa has played 2,992 games since beginning basketball in 1902. Iowa's overall record is 1,770-1,222 (.591). Iowa's 1,770 wins are 38th most among Division I programs. That includes a 1,134-386 (.745) record in home games, a 636-836 (.433) record in contests away from Iowa City, an 839-834 (.502) mark in Big Ten games and a 538-160 (.769) record in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

**SANDFORT: PRESEASON FIRST-TEAM ALL-BIG TEN**

Senior Payton Sandfort was one of 10 players named to the preseason All-Big Ten team. It is the fifth time in the last six seasons a Hawkeye has been named to the list. Sandfort is also a preseason all-league selection by Blue Ribbon and he is tabbed as one of the top sharp shooters and seniors in college basketball by Andy Katz at NCAA.com.

- He was also named to the John R. Wooden Preseason Watch List, Julius Erving Small Forward of the Year Preseason Watch List and Lute Olson National Player of the Year early season list.
- Sandfort put up career-best numbers across the board during the 2023-24 season, averaging 16.4 points, 6.6 rebounds and 2.7 assists, while shooting 44.6 percent from the floor, 37.9 percent from distance and 91.1 percent from the free throw stripe. His 94 3-pointers led the Big Ten.

### 3-HEADED MONSTER

- The Hawkeyes return three starters in Payton Sandfort, Owen Freeman and Josh Dix. All three players earned All-Big Ten recognition a season ago. Sandfort was a third-team All-Big Ten selection, while Freeman and Dix both were honorable mention all-league selections. Freeman was also the Big Ten Co-Freshman of the Year.
- Sandfort averaged a team-best 16.4 points and 6.6 rebounds, reaching double figures in 27 games with 11 20-point contests.
  - Freeman averaged 10.6 points and 6.6 rebounds, while shooting 61.4 percent from the floor. He had five double-doubles and had an Iowa freshman record 61 blocks.
  - Dix averaged 8.9 points and 2.2 rebounds, while ranking third on the team with 59 assists. He was one of the most efficient players in the Big Ten, shooting 55.2 percent from the floor, 42.1 percent from 3-point range and 86 percent from the free throw stripe.

### A VERSATILE ADDITION

- Sophomore forward Seydou Traore gives Hawkeyes a versatile piece in 2024-25. The New York native was an All-Metro Atlantic Conference Rookie Team selection a season ago at Manhattan College, averaging 11.9 points and 8.1 rebounds to go along with 62 assists and 34 blocks. He was the only player in the MAAC with 300+ points, 200+ rebounds, 60+ assists, 40+ steals and 30+ blocks.

### WINNINGEST PLAYER IN MOREHEAD HISTORY

- Graduate transfer Drew Thelwell won 94 games during his four-year career at Morehead State, making him the winningest player in program history. Thelwell helped the Eagles to two OVC regular season and two OVC tournament titles and to three postseason appearances (two NCAA, one NIT).
- Thelwell won his 100th career game on Nov. 26 in Iowa's victory over USC Upstate.
  - The Florida native averaged 10 points and 6.2 assists as a senior. He led the OVC in assists (15th nationally) and assist-to-turnover ration (2.71).

### FAMILY BUSINESS

- Iowa will have a set of brothers on the roster for the sixth straight year in 2024-25 with Payton and Pryce Sandfort teaming up for a second straight season.
- The team has three players on the roster -- Carter Kingsbury, Cooper Koch, Jacob Koch -- whose fathers played for the Hawkeyes. Chris Kingsbury played at Iowa from 1994-96, J.R. Koch from 1996-99 and Nate Koch from 1993-95.

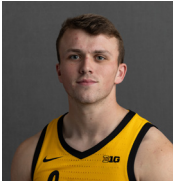
